C1 - PRIX MANDORE - 1900m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Condition - Flat - EUR € 16,000

- 1. AINHOA GOLDWIN** - Unplaced last time, a win previously over 1800m at Gabarret in a conditions race on May 8. Others seem better equipped
- 2. MANARAH EL IZZ** - Ran with promise to be 5th on debut over 1900m at this track on June 3 and can improve from that. Key chance
- 3. CHAKIFA** - Placed 3rd on the last run over 1800m at Gabarret on May 8 behind AINHOA GOLDWIN (1). Has work to do to feature
- 4. ATHENA** - Finished 9th on the sole start over 1900m at this track on June 3. Showed promise on debut until getting tired late on. Progress expected and she warrants respect
- 5. MISS DES VIALETES** - Two unplaced runs since a 4th at Mont-De-Marsan in a conditions race on March 23 over 2000m. Merits consideration
- 6. HAFIDA AL CHAM** - Placed 4th on her last run over 1900m at La Teste on June 3 in a conditions race. Can put her experience to good use and get off the mark
- 7. MN SHAHRAZAD** - Filly on debut by Dahess, the dam never raced. Can be expected to improve for this run and others make more appeal

Summary: HAFIDA AL CHAM (6) finished a promising fourth over this course on June 3, staying on well and finishing ahead of four rivals she meets again here. MANARAH EL IZZ (2), who was fifth that day, is expected to improve on what was an encouraging debut. ATHENA (4) should come on for her latest start and can be more competitive, while MISS DES VIALETES (5) is also worth a mention.

- 1. SIRE CHOP** - Placed on both runs the latter when 3rd over 1200m at La Teste in a Class 3 race on June 3. Place contender
- 2. LUDWIG** - Placed 2nd on both runs, the latter over 1200m in a Class 3 race at this track on June 3. Live chance of scoring
- 3. MEDRONHO** - Back in 9th on the sole run over 1000m at Deauville on April 7 on debut. Needs to show more to make the frame
- 4. CHANSON DOUCE** - Non partante
- 5. ORANGETTE** - Improved to be 4th on second run over 1400m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat in a Class 3 on June 15. Ought to be involved in the shake-up
- 6. SEALISKY** - Finished 6th on the last run over 1200m at this track on June 3 in a Class 3 race. Looks safely held
- 7. SARMAD** - Colt by Wooded, the dam won 1 race. Nice pedigree and worth watching in the betting for any market support
- 8. EL LAGAR** - Colt by City Light, the dam ran twice. Can improve for this debut run unless the betting market says otherwise
- 9. GALAYO** - Colt by The Grey Gatsby, the dam never raced. Stable runners tend to improve for a run or two and he is best watched for now
- 10. WAL HUNTER'S** - Colt by Hunter's Light, the dam ran once on the flat. Likely to improve for this run and is best watched for now
- 11. DREAMS CHOPE** - Filly by Gutaifan, the dam won 2 races. Looks good on paper and she is one to consider if the betting market is positive
- 12. ALYA CHOPE** - Filly by Gutaifan, the dam was placed a few times. Can improve for this run and is one to watch with the future in mind
- 13. FRISSONANTE** - Filly by Cracksman, the dam won 1 race. Looks good on paper and she is worth a market inspection on her first day at school
- 14. GOSEA** - Filly by Goken, the dam never raced in France. Nice profile and can be expected to know what is required on her racecourse bow
- 15. ZEA MAYS** - Filly by Masar, the dam won 1 race on debut. Likely to need further in time and is best watched on her racecourse bow
- 16. IT'S ONLY LOVE** - Filly by Latrobe, the dam was placed on the flat. Does not appeal as a likely first time out winner and is best watched for now

Summary: LUDWIG (2) has solid claims of getting off the mark. He has been knocking at the door with two second place efforts and deserves success. His main threat could be GOSEA (14), who has a nice profile and comes from a stable that does well with newcomers. ORANGETTE (5) showed improvement to be fourth last time and can make the frame. FRISSONANTE (13) appeals on her pedigree and is one to consider on her racecourse bow.

- 1. TOP TEAM GUN** - Not seen since a 2nd over 3900m at La Teste in a handicap hurdle on July 4 2025. Fitness to prove and and can be avoided
- 2. KEL STORY** - Has not featured this year in five runs, the latter over 3800m at Dieppe in a handicap hurdle on June 18. Pass over
- 3. BOOPER DU POUHEY** - Recent win over 3900m at Toulouse in a handicap hurdle on May 21 when last seen. Can make the frame at nice odds
- 4. LORELEY DES PLACES** - Fair 3rd last time over 3900m in a Class 2 chase at Dieppe on June 1. Won at Royan in April in a Class 3 hurdle. Can not be overlooked
- 5. RISK DU BRIZAIS** - Easy win by 10L on the last run at Dieppe on June 18 in a divided handicap over 3800m. Dangerous to rule out
- 6. L'ARRABIATO** - Failed to complete last time in November , 2nd before that at Auteuil on October 12 over 3700m in a handicap chase. In the mix
- 7. KING D'ALENE** - Fair 2nd last time in a Class 1 chase at Toulouse on May 27 over 4200m. Course winner over fences in 2025 over 3900m. Among the top chances
- 8. MR DIAFOIRUS** - Won on the last run over 3600m at Strasbourg on June 16 in a Class 3 hurdle. Capable of following up
- 9. PINK PERSEVERANCE** - Two wins from the last three runs, the latest success over 3600m at Auteuil in a handicap hurdle on May 30. She can be competitive
- 10. KIMFLY** - Placed 2nd last time over 3650m at Mont-De-Marsan in a handicap hurdle on March 12. Might need a few to misfire
- 11. HARDI BLUE TROIS AA** - Fair 5th in a Class 3 handicap hurdle on June 6 at Dax, not the most reliable recently although he has won 7 races
- 12. JESPER** - Good 2nd on the only run this year at Dax over 3800m in a Class 3 handicap hurdle on June 7. Others rate higher

Summary: MR DIAFOIRUS (8) impressed when scoring with authority over 3600m in a handicap hurdle at Auteuil in mid-June and looks capable of following up under James Reveley. His main danger could be RISK DU BRIZAIS (5), who bolted up by ten lengths in a divided handicap at Dieppe when last seen in mid-June. KING D'ALENE (7) appeals as a solid each-way proposition, while PINK PERSEVERANCE (9) has been in good form and cannot be ruled out of the placings.

1. **AF MEZAN** - Finished 4th on debut over 1600m at this track on May 15. He will need to improve a good deal to make the top three
2. **MIMOSA STAR** - Finished 5th on the last run over 1600m at this track on May 15. Unlikely to threaten the main protagonists
3. **ANTAAR** - Decent effort to be 3rd over 1600m at this track on May 15 on his debut . With improvement expected he warrants attention
4. **JARASH** - Placed on both starts, the latter when 4th over 1500m at Tarbes in a conditions race on April 17. In the mix
5. **SALIMA NOUR GRINE** - Ran well to be 3rd on debut over 1600m at this track on May 15. Can improve and get off the mark this time
6. **DORRAH** - Filly by Azadi, the dam never raced.Stable runners warrant respect on debut and she is one to consider if the betting speaks volumes
7. **NABLUS** - Unraced filly by Mister Ginoux, the dam was placed a few times. Likely to improve for this outing unless the betting says otherwise
8. **SI CHIC AL MAURY** - Filly on debut by Manarak, the dam won 1 race. Nice pedigree and should be well prepared by her astute trainer. Player

Summary: SALIMA NOUR GRINE (5) made a promising start to her career when finishing second over a slightly longer trip at this track in May. The drop back in distance should hold no fears, and she is taken to go one better. SI CHIC AL MAURY (8) has an appealing pedigree and is expected to be well prepared for her racecourse debut. ANTAAR (3) showed talent on the sole start at this track in May and can be sharper for that outing. JARASH (4) looks best of the remainder.

- 1. ROYAL MARVEL** - Placed on the last three runs, the latter when 2nd at Dax in a Class 5 hurdle on June 7. Looks ready to win
- 2. SARALD** - Two wins of late, on the flat in May and a recent success over 3000m at Jallais in a hurdle race on June 13. IN top form and is hard to ignore
- 3. SUBLI CHOPE** - Finished 5th last time over 3600m at Clairefontaine in a claiming hurdle on June 24. Hard to recommend
- 4. DON DINO** - Gelding by Doctor Dino, the dam won 3 races over jumps. From a good stable that can ready a newcomer to oblige on debut. Player
- 5. TIME IS MONEY** - Ran with promise to be 6th over 3400m in a hurdle race at Clairefontaine on June 24. Ought to be thereabouts
- 6. EL PROFESSOR** - Several unplaced runs, the latter over 3400m at Clairefontaine in a hurdle on June 24. Has to show a good deal more to be involved
- 7. KA ZAR** - Five unplaced runs, the latter over 3400m in a claiming hurdle at Dieppe on June 10. Faces a stiff task

Summary: ROYAL MARVEL (1) has been placed on his last three starts, most recently when runner-up at Dax in early June over hurdles, and looks ready to shed his maiden tag. SARALD (2) is the obvious danger as he bids for a hat-trick after his latest success at Jallais over hurdles in mid-June and continues to improve. DON DINO (4) has an appealing profile on paper and is worth considering on his racecourse debut. TIME IS MONEY (5) completes the shortlist.

- 1. GRAN HABANO** - Unplaced on the last three starts , the latter over 1400m at Compiègne in a Class 3 handicap on June 6. Placed form in January and can bounce back to form
- 2. DON NICOLAS** - Several unplaced runs recently , the latter over 1400m at Toulouse in a Class 4 claimer on June 8. Seems of limited talent
- 3. SEVEN FOR ALL** - Has not featured in all five runs this year, the latter over 1600m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat in a Class 3 handicap on April 27. Others make more appeal
- 4. YACHT SHOW** - Placed on three of the latest four runs, the latter over 2100m at Dax on May 18 in a conditions race. Player
- 5. HURRICANGO** - Nice effort two runs back when 2nd over 2100m at Angers on May 2 in a conditions race. One to pay close attention
- 6. PIRAILLAN** - Placed on the last two runs, the latter over 2100m at Dax in a conditions race on May 18. Ought to be thereabouts
- 7. GOUVERNE** - Fair 2nd two runs back at Royan over 2900m on May 8. Not disgraced last time and can be considered each-way
- 8. JUST FOR GAB'S** - Two unplaced runs since a 3rd in April over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap on April 19. Has work to do to be involved

Summary: GRAN HABANO (1) can bounce back to form after a few unplaced efforts in handicaps of late. He posted some respectable placed performances earlier this year and gets the nod over HURRICANGO (5), who finished a solid second in a conditions race at Angers two starts ago in early May. GOUVERNE (7) arrives with recent placed form at Royan and has solid claims of finishing in the first three. YACHT SHOW (4) appeals as the best of the remainder and cannot be ruled out.

1. **ALMAZYOUNA** - Finished 6th on the only run over 1600m at this track on May 15. Can improve from that experience. Unlikely to be a threat
2. **MOUJIBA AL CHAM** - Showed some talent when 8th over 1800m in a conditions race at Langon-Libourne on the only start on June 19. Can be opposed
3. **NETRA DE FAUST** - Finished 6th on the one run over 2000m at Toulouse in a conditions race on May 27. Has to improve to be involved
4. **BALSAM** - Unraced filly by Mister Ginoux, the dam won 1 race. From a respected trainer that can produce first time out winners
5. **SHEHANA** - Unraced filly by Al Mamun Monalu, the dam never raced. Stable runners tend to improve for a run or two and she is best watched for now
6. **AYLA** - Unraced filly by Al Mourtajez, the dam was placed once. Her trainer can ready one to strike on debut and the betting can be the best guide
7. **COCO** - Filly by Gazwan, the dam won 1 race. From a good stable that knows the time of day and she is worth a market check
8. **SHATOUSH** - Unraced filly by Af Mathmoon, the dam won 1 race and was placed Group PA races in the UAE. Nice profile and from a good stable. One to monitor in the betting for clues
9. **GINA DU SOLEIL** - Unraced filly by Mister Ginoux, the dam won 1 race. Her trainer can produce first time out winners and the betting should be the most informative guide
10. **DESTINY** - Filly by Sivit Al Maury, the dam was placed twice. Can be expected to need this run for experience and others rate higher
11. **ALMAHA** - Filly by Al Mourtajez, the dam ran twice. Stable runners are respected on debut and this filly is one to keep a close eye on in the betting market
12. **SHAKIRAH** - Unraced filly by Mister Ginoux, the dam ran a few times. Her trainer does well with newcomers and she is worth watching for any market moves
13. **SHALIMAH** - Filly by Muraaqib, the dam won 3 races. Some good aspects to her profile and she is one to pay close attention to in the betting exchanges
14. **ANKAA AL CHAM** - Filly by Al Mouwaffak, the dam was placed once. One to monitor in the betting for any market support
15. **KHAWLAH** - Filly by Mahabb, the dam never raced. From a respected trainer. Nice profile and she can be involved at the business end
16. **NOUHA** - Filly by Raaziq, the dam never raced. Stable runners are not renowned for first time out winners and she is best watched with the future in mind

Summary: With the majority of the field making their racecourse debuts, it may pay to side with ALMAHA (11), who is expected to be well prepared by her astute trainer. She gets the narrow vote over KHAWLAH (15), who boasts an appealing pedigree and should also be ready to make a bold first impression. BALSAM (4) and AYLA (6) both have attractive profiles and warrant close attention, especially if they attract strong support in the betting.

- 1. LUZERAISE** - Failed to complete the course on the last two runs, the latter in a Listed hurdle over 3900m at Auteuil on November 23. Class 1 hurdle winner in June last year and can bounce back with fitness taken on trust
- 2. GINO'S LINE** - Unplaced in a Listed hurdle at Auteuil on September 23, last year. Course winner over hurdles previously and can not be ignored
- 3. LEBANDACARL** - Has been absent since a fall at Auteuil over 4400m in a Class 2 chase on November 23. Good placed form over hurdles and can get off the mark
- 4. PLEIN SUD** - Placed 4th on the last run over 3700m at Sable-Sur-Sarthe in a Class 5 hurdle on May 31. Needs a few to misfire
- 5. LOCCA DE THAIX** - Finished 5th last time over 3500m at Moulins in a Class 3 hurdle on May 9. Lightly raced and warrants respect
- 6. LADY DE MONTOT** - Not seen since a win over 2450m at Cluny in a flat race on October 5 2024. Should be well schooled and fitness is a slight worry, but she can be involved

Summary: LEBANDACARL (3) has been off the track since falling in a Class 2 chase at Auteuil last November, but he is expected to be fit enough to make a winning return. He had produced several solid placed efforts over hurdles prior to that outing. LADY DE MONTOT (6) signed off with a victory on the Flat in October 2024 and should be well schooled for her hurdling debut, with fitness taken on trust. GINO'S LINE (2) has useful hurdling form to his name but also returns from a lengthy absence and commands respect.

- 1. WITCHWAY** - Ran well to be 4th last time over 1000m in a Listed race at Vichy on May 13, and two wins before that at Marseille Borely. Player
- 2. JUMBOTRON** - Nice win over the track and trip in a Class 3 race on his only start on June 3. Open to progress and can be competitive
- 3. ASKAM CHOPE** - Won on the only start over 1200m at this track in a Class 3 race on June 3. Can improve and not be ruled out
- 4. EL TELENO** - Colt on debut by Marianafoot, the dam won 2 races in Spain. Likely to need this racecourse bow and others preferred
- 5. CHARMINGSTAR** - Gelding by Gutaifan, the dam won 4 races. Tough task on his debut against some useful types and he is best watched for the time being
- 6. APPEN** - Fair 3rd last time over this track and trip behind ASKAM CHOPE (3) in a Class 3 race on June 3. Has place claims

Summary: WITCHWAY (1) has shown plenty of ability in three career starts, most recently when finishing fourth in a Listed contest at Vichy in May. He sets the standard and can prove too strong for the main danger, ASKAM CHOPE (3), who impressed when winning by three lengths on her debut over this course and distance early last month. JUMBOTRON (2) also scored over this track and trip last month and is open to further progress. APPEN (6) finished third behind ASKAM CHOPE (3) last time and heads the rest.

- 1. HIPNOVEL** - Unplaced on each run so far, the latter over 1800m at Langon - Libourne in a conditions race on June 18. Pass over
- 2. DURGHAM** - Colt by Dahor De Brugere, the dam won 1 race and was placed several times. Nice profile and he is from a good stable that can ready a newcomer. Respect
- 3. ADIL** - Colt by Marid, the dam won 9 races, including 5 Group 1 PA races and was placed in a Group 2 PA race. Choice pedigree and should know what is required on debut
- 4. HADLAN DE LA GLOIRE** - Colt by Al Mourtajez, the dam never ran. Can improve for this debut run and is unlikely to feature unless the betting says otherwise
- 5. NPEDOR DE BOZOULS** - Colt by Al Mourtajez, the dam , ran twice. Stable runners are not renowned for producing many first time out winners and others seem more likely

Summary: DAWWAAS (9) is out of a top-class performer that won twice in Group 1 PA class and his astute trainer will have him ready to play a lead role on his racecourse bow. ADIL (3) can also be expected to have a say. He is out of a top-class mare that won five Group 1 PA races and he will know what is required on debut. NOTABLE DE L'AIGLE (8) and DURGHAM (2) both have choice pedigree's and are worth a market check for clues.

- 3. EDANTZA AA** - Two nice runs of late, 2nd on the latter over 2400m at Toulouse on May 27 in a conditions race on May 27. Ought to be in the shake-up
