

R5 CABOURG [R-H]

C1 - PRIX DE FERVAQUES - 2725m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. NIERMES DE GUEZ** - Has not been seen out since finishing 6th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 23 May and will not be given a hard race
- 2. NOBLE BARRA** - Surprise second in a 2950m Class E at Le Mans in late-July but was disqualified at Divonne a month later and is unlikely to spice things up
- 3. NOBODY DU NOYER** - Got off the mark at Saint-Galmier on 29 August but was trounced in a Mauquenchy Class E 12 days later, and despite the good draw, can be passed over
- 4. N'OUBLIE PAS** - Fourth in a Class E over 2,750m here on 19 September. Consistently acquits himself competitively and is unlikely to return home empty-handed
- 5. NABUCCO JOSSELYN** - Finished 3rd in a Class D at Vichy over 2,950m on 18 June. Has not been seen since but will have been prepared for this and Benjamin Rochard will be eager to get a win into him
- 6. NEVER ENDING** - Comfortable winner of both starts to date, most recently a Class F at La Ferte-Vidame over 2,750m on 23 August. Makes first appearance on a hard surface and has a realistic chance of making it a successful one
- 7. NODSON D'ECHAL** - Has turned a corner since starting to race with pads, most recently fifth in a 2400m Chateaubriant Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Breaks wide but should nevertheless appreciate the new conditions and is unlikely to disappoint
- 8. NAPOLEON** - Put a trio of eliminations behind him to come 4th in a 2850m Laval Class E on 28 August. Has pulled a tricky number but, with application, could still play small part
- 9. NEVERSOIS** - Victorious in a Class F at Bernay over 2,300m on 13 September. Has yet to deliver on a hard surface but has been learning his trade well and can play a minor role
- 10. NAVAJO DE FLEUR** - Runner-up in a Class F at Chateaubriant over 2,400m on 7 August. Has not been seen since, and starts on back row, but is a decent future prospect and worth a second look
- 11. NON STOP DE CONDE** - Lost his maiden status in a Class F at Lannemezan on 26 August, but failed to confirm when disqualified at Valence 10 days later and is unlikely to trouble the opposition
- 12. NEFERT D'ALESA** - Ran 6th in a Class E over 2,750m here on 19 September. Has struggled to find his mark this term and is unlikely to cause an upset
- 13. NORIGANO** - Starts for the first time since running 7th in a Class D at Caen over 2,200m on 27 May and is going to need the race
- 14. NOBEL** - Dominated a 2150m Vichy Class F on 12 September. Has pulled a poor number for Cabourg debut but can wrap this up if he replicates his last performance

Summary: NOBEL (14), who made a very good impression at Vichy, unbeaten NEVER ENDING (6), who makes his debut on the sand, the returning NABUCCO JOSSELYN (5), who should soon open his account, and NODSON D'ECHAL (7), entrusted to Yoann Lebourgeois, all look capable of fighting out the finish.

C2 - PRIX DES OPHRYS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - - Mounted - EUR € 23,000

- 1. KIFILE DANICA** - Has evident ability but has been showing her spirit and is unlikely to generate much interest
- 2. KOSCA DES CAILLONS** - Showed improvement when 5th in a Vichy Class D on 12 September, however a repeat seems most improbable
- 3. KALOU DES NOEES** - Fifth in a harness Class F Apprentices' race at Tours over 2,800m on 6 September, when preparing for this. Imposed easily under the saddle at Plouescat 16 days earlier and looks thoroughly capable of confirming
- 4. KETCHUP** - Imposed at Bagnoles on 23 August, a fortnight before coming 3rd in a Landivisiau Class H. Is unbeaten in his last two starts over course and distance and must be considered a serious proposition
- 5. KADOR DELO** - Made up for harness disqualification when 4th in an Amiens Class G on 19 September, but at this level will have too much to do
- 6. KOURSE MAGIC** - Finished 9th in a Class F Apprentices' race at Pornichet over 2,725m on 6 August. Has ample ability though and the change of code may be just what the doctor ordered
- 7. KIVIANA** - Finished 3rd in a Class G Apprentices' race at Amiens over 2,900m on 19 September. Has previously imposed under these conditions and must be afforded respect
- 8. KIRELLA** - Won a Class D over course and distance on 21 July but has failed to make any impact in 3 since and others easier to back
- 9. KALLISTO DE LASTEL** - Finished 2nd in a harness Class F at Vire over 2,800m on 31 August. Has done everything well except win over recent months but likes Cabourg and should nevertheless acquit himself competitively
- 10. KAVIVE** - Ran 6th in a Class G at Mauquenchy over 2,850m on 10 September. Seldom gets her nose in front, but always gives her best, and even though shod can play a part

Summary: KALOU DES NOEES (3) runs sparingly under the saddle but to good effect; he has been re-shod and legitimately bids to make it three for three in 2026. KETCHUP (4) gets on well with Lou-Ann Lecoq and will lead the opposition together with KOURSE MAGIC (6), worth watching closely on her monté debut, and KIVIANA (7), whose form is headed in the right direction.

C3 - PRIX DES PERDRIX - 2750m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **LEOPARD DE LARRE** - Finished 9th in a Class F Apprentices' race at Evreux over 2,725m on 27 September. Has been a write-off for some time and has nothing to bring to the party
2. **LURISTAN** - Useful on a good day but has been disappointing since the spring and can be confidently passed over
3. **LORD DU GRAIS** - Unexceptional 6th in a Toulouse Class G last week. Has never shown any particular liking for the venue and is not about to start now
4. **LENNY D'EP** - Is not without merit, and is confirmed here, but 5 straight disqualifications do nothing to inspire confidence
5. **LUCIFER MELOC** - Returns to winning ways in early-August but has twice failed to confirm and at this level will have his work cut out for him
6. **L'OCEAN VERT** - Fourth in a Class E at Vire over 2,800m on 31 August, a fortnight after imposing at Francheville. Sébastien Baude in the bike this time and, although not a priority, is still worth monitoring
7. **LUCKY FIX** - Raced better in a Sables-d'Olonne Class E on 12 September than his 6th place would suggest. Ran 3rd last time at the venue and is not incapable of picking up a cheque
8. **LEOPOLD DU BANNEY** - Finished 8th in a Class F at La Gacilly over 3,100m on 9 August. Stays shod for re-entry and is unlikely to upset the status quo
9. **LANCOME DE JUMILLY** - Tough individual that was disqualified at Le Croise-Laroche due to mechanical problems, 2.5 weeks ago. Has been knocking at the door for some time, starts in front, and looks main threat to LINO DE FONTAINE (14)
10. **LE VOLONTAIRE** - Finished 6th in a Class F at Guingamp over 2,700m on 13 September, after having placed in 3 straight. Benefits from a superb entry on the front line and could pleasantly surprise
11. **LAMA DE CORDAY** - Tricky element but has merit. Makes Cabourg bow after being withdrawn before the start at Argentan last week. Has form with his young driver and should not be written off
12. **LEADER DE L'ITON** - Runner-up in a Class E at Vichy over 2,150m on 19 September. Has hardly put a foot out of line for past 13 months and looks competitive for a place in the picture
13. **LEWIS D'ALEXIANE** - Returns to a hard surface after running 2nd in an Erbray Class F in late-August. Is clearly better on turf but still cannot be discounted
14. **LINO DE FONTAINE** - Won 4 from 5 before being disqualified in a Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 12 September. Should not be too hastily-condemned though and Mathieu Mottier will be keen to put things right
15. **LINO GUILLERVILLE** - Finished 3rd in a Class E at Vire over 2,800m on 31 August. Is plainly back on the right road and can challenge for a place on the podium
16. **LOOPING RENARDIER** - Missed out on the hat-trick when 3rd in a Class E at Argentan over 2,875m on 16 August. Benefits from a good entry and, in current shape, is unlikely to let the side down

Summary: LINO DE FONTAINE (14) enjoyed a remarkable summer, like the rest of his stablemates, and should put his recent blunder behind him. LANCOME DE JUMILLY (9), whose latest outing can be overlooked, LEADER DE L'ITON (12) and LINO GUILLERVILLE (15), who have been highly consistent, and LOOPING RENARDIER (16), well-engaged and in top form, are also potential winners.

C4 - PRIX DES DECUMARIAS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 29,000

1. **JAVA DE GARAMBEAU** - A complete write-off so far this year and even with Mathieu Mottier in the bike, will have nothing to offer
2. **KALINKA DE SEE** - Has done nothing noteworthy since returning to competition this summer and will have few friends
3. **KUEEN DE MONGUERET** - Is not devoid of ability but has struggled since returning to competition, most recently disqualified in a 2875m Argentan Class E last week, and is unlikely to spring any surprises
4. **KASSIOPEE** - Has not been seen out since winning a Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2,600m on 14 April. Is competitively-shod though, with Paul Ploquin reining, and from the front line looks particularly competitive
5. **JESABELLE DU JOUR** - Ran fifth in a Class F over course and distance on 19 September, then came 5th in a Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles 8 days later, but at this level will have too much to do
6. **KERIDA BEST** - Finished 4th in a Class F at Moulins La Marche over 2,800m on 13 September. Takes on a considerably better lot here and others preferred
7. **KORBA DE GODREL** - Ran 2nd over course and distance on 25 August, 12 days before winning an amateurs Class H on turf. Is unlikely to repeat but should nevertheless give this a good go. First five
8. **KRACANTE A JOJO** - Produced a pair of good efforts on turf in July before coming sixth in a Class F at La Chartre-sur-le-Loir on 16 August, and is simply taking on too much
9. **KOKINE BECO** - Ran 6th in a Class F at Plouescat over 2,600m on 22 August, a fortnight after having run 3rd at La Roche-Posay. Starts in front but looks a minor place prospect at best
10. **KOMMUNES DE PLAY** - Ran 3rd at Angers on 9 September but failed to confirm last Sunday when 11th in an Evreux Class H, and can be passed over
11. **JACINTHE DES BOIS** - Has enjoyed a decent run of form over past 2 months, lastly 5th in a Cholet Class F 11 days ago, and can repeat
12. **KAROLINE CADE** - Ran reassuring 3rd in a Bernay Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Benefits from a terrific entry, has been re-shod, and will not be far from the action if Sébastien Ernault keeps her trotting
13. **JAINA D'ESSARTS** - Performant during the spring but oddly sanctioned in last 2. Has been reconfigured for the occasion though and will have a lot to contribute if she keeps her action together
14. **KOH LANTA** - Won 3 on the trot before being disqualified in a Chateauroux Class H on 13 September. Imposed here in late-August and, with application, can confirm
15. **JIVA** - Got back in the game at Cholet 11 days ago when 2nd in a 2800m Class F. Has previously won under these conditions, is by some margin the wealthiest horse here, and will be no easy touch

Summary: KOH LANTA (14), who must be forgiven for her latest effort, and JIVA (15), who looks close to her race, can be preferred to a reconfigured JAINA D'ESSARTS (13), provided she remains trotting, and re-shod front-line starter KASSIOPEE (4) who is worth following closely on her return to competition.

C5 - PRIX DE COULVAIN - 2050m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **OR DE DOMPIERRE** - Lost his action in a Class C at Enghien last Saturday, but left a good impression nonetheless. Trainer in the bike this time and will not be far off the mark if he keeps his colt trotting
 2. **OBOY BILOU** - Has placed just once in six starts to date and latest Enghien performance did nothing to allay any fears
 3. **OCCHIOLINO** - Serious colt that should not be condemned for blundering on debut at Vichy early last month. Looks better than most here and can win this time if kept focused
 4. **OLD STYLE** - Fourth in a Class F at Alencon over 2,650m on 6 September, first time out. Will have come on for the run but still faces a tough challenge
 5. **OTHELLO D'AVE** - Finished 7th in a Class D at Cholet over 2,100m on 27 September, after having run 3rd over course and distance earlier in the month. Benefits from a decent spot behind the car and can trot her way into the money
 6. **OXFORD DREAM** - Beaten only by a good Duvaldestin horse in a Class F at Alencon over 2,650m on 6 September, first time out. Will have improved for the run and can contest the finish this time
 7. **OPERA WOOD** - Ran 6th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,175m on 24 August. Starts wide here and is unlikely to spice things up
 8. **ONE DIDO** - Qualified in 1'18 over 2000m at Caen in early-May. Faces some serious horses first time out and others easier to back
 9. **OLD SOUL** - Nicely-related colt that qualified in 1'18 at Caen on 9 July and is one to keep a close eye on
 10. **OPEN JAZZ** - Unplaced in a Class E at Bernay over 2,300m on 30 August and will need to find considerably more
 11. **OBAMI** - Ran 7th in a Class F at Laval over 2,050m on 24 September. Is significantly better than that though and can play a prominent role if David Thomain successfully negotiates the start
 12. **OMEGA DU FER** - Disqualified on debut in a Class E at Chateaubriant over 2,400m on 13 September. Sébastien Baude in the bike this time but is still not a concern
- Summary:** Philippe Allaire looks to hold a strong hand with OCCHIOLINO (3), who would surely have fought for victory on his debut at Vichy but for a mistake at the end of the back straight, and OBAMI (11), a nephew of Gotland whose recent debut can be discounted. OXFORD DREAM (6), who made a good debut behind a good horse at Alencon, could separate them though. The nicely-qualified newcomer OLD SOUL (9) is worth following closely.

C6 - PRIX DES ROUGES-GORGES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 22,000

- 1. MON LOOK A MOI** - Disappointing on the whole since his March debut. Failed to make any impression on sole monte start and will have nothing to offer
- 2. MOLITOR FLIGNY** - Put a trio of disqualifications behind him when second over 2275m at Mons a week ago but in this company will struggle to make any impact
- 3. MARCO DU VERGER** - Modest individual that has yet to show any particular aptitude for either code and can be confidently disregarded
- 4. MYSTIC FISH** - Lost his action in a Class F under these conditions on 19 September. Has been reconfigured for the occasion but others still preferred
- 5. MATUVU** - Ran reassuring 4th in a Class F over course and distance 12 days ago and, with stride in check, can get a look in
- 6. MISTRAL DEL PHEDO** - Disqualified on monte debut in a Class F over course and distance 12 days ago and is not about to set off any fireworks
- 7. MAGNOLIA NAY** - Got off the mark at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne in late-August but was unable to confirm when 5th in a Class F at Les Andelys 2.5 weeks ago, and will need to improve his game
- 8. MELO DU LOCHEUR** - Switches to monte code for first time following 2 harness sanctions here last month. Serious jockey on board for ridden debut and should represent main threat to MAESTRO D'IDEE (14)
- 9. MILLE DOLLARS** - Got back in the game 12 days ago when 3rd in a Class F under these conditions. Is unlikely to impose but has the wherewithal to pick up a cheque
- 10. MISTRAL DE LA LEUE** - Showed marginal improvement when 5th in a Class E at Ecommoy 2.5 weeks ago but not enough to be considered a contender
- 11. MADISON HUB** - Produced a pair of superb efforts in August but has since come off the boil, lastly eighth in a 2750m Ecommoy Class E 2.5 weeks ago, and is unlikely to create an upset
- 12. MOSS DU HOULBET** - Finished 4th in a Class F at Cabourg over 2,750m on 14 August, having imposed at Durtal the previous month. Is not a priority at this level but still has the wherewithal to get in on the action
- 13. MINAO DE MAJEBE** - Ran fourth here earlier in the month before finishing sixth in a 2750m Ecommoy Class E 2.5 weeks ago, and in this company will have too much to do
- 14. MAESTRO D'IDEE** - Debuts under the saddle after finishing 9th in a Landivisiau Class E early last month. Is made for the discipline and can get straight down to business
- 15. MAGNUM DU LEVANT** - Opened his monte account in a 2800m Vire Class E 3.5 weeks ago and could even double his money if Marius Durville keeps him focused
- 16. MILORD DREAM** - Made up for Francheville blip when 5th in a Class F under these conditions a month back. Has been re-shod but is not the most generous of horses and looks little more than a minor place chance
- 17. MAXIMO BELLO** - Well-engaged individual that ran 11th in a monte Class E at Ecommoy, on re-entry, 2.5 weeks ago. Will have progressed for the run and will be expected to trot his way into the money this time
- 18. MYTHIQUE RENKA** - 7th in a Vincennes Class E on 31 August. Sports a new formula for return to the venue and, considering the entry, should be retained

Summary: MAESTRO D'IDEE (14), reconfigured and entrusted to Mathieu Mottier, and MELO DU LOCHEUR (8), shod and partnered by Paul Ploquin, are both bred to excel under the saddle and can be preferred to the tricky MAGNUM DU LEVANT (15), who was most convincing last time out, MAXIMO BELLO (17), who sports a new configuration for his first objective of the autumn, and MILLE DOLLARS (9), provided he keeps his action together.

C7 - PRIX DE CATTEVILLE - 2725m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. NAOMI DE LA VALLEE - Finished 2nd in a Class E at Ecommoy over 2,750m on 13 September. Has been fitted with pads for her debut on sand and although not a priority, is still worth keeping an eye on

2. NALA DE MALIKEN - Left a good impression when 4th in a Vire Class E 3.5 weeks ago. Is well-placed behind the car, with Mathieu Mottier in the bike again, and must be considered a player

3. NOZELENN D'AVEL - Placed in 2 before coming 5th in a Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne 2.5 weeks ago. Has been handed a good number but seems to have more to find

4. NOBLESS DU NOYER - Has not been seen out since finishing runner-up in a Class D at Reims over 2,550m on 25 May but is clearly in race-mode here and winning this is well within her capability

5. NICE GIRL QUICK - Made it 2 in a row when successful in an Amiens Class F on 5 September. Looks a serious future prospect and from the 5 slot can make this her own

6. NORMA DES CHARMES - Fifth in a Class E at Vincennes over 2,700m on 18 September. Is unlikely to get off the mark this time either but is thoroughly capable of getting in on the action

7. NEBELINE LEMAN - Fifth in a Class E over 2,750m here on 19 September. Faces a tougher test this time around and will struggle to make her presence felt

8. NORMA CASTELLE - Fifth in a Class E over 2,750m here on 16 September, 11 days after running 3rd at Amiens, but has little going for her here and chances appear limited

9. NIKITA D'AUVILLIER - Successful in a Class F at Bernay over 2,300m on 13 September, but takes a significant step up the category-ladder, and others easier to back

10. NESSIE EXPRESS - Comfortably lost her maiden tag in a Vichy Class F on 12 September. Is not ideally-drawn here but is plainly in shape and should not be overlooked

11. NIGHTSHIFT - in the frame in 3 of last 4, most recently 2nd in a Chateauroux Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Is forced to start on the back line but will be padded this time and could pleasantly surprise

12. NEMESIA - Fifth in a Class E over 2,050m here on 7 July. Is not about to lose her maiden status but should appreciate Cabourg conditions and, despite the draw, should not be underestimated

13. NAIADE SIBEY - Fifth in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,150m on 10 September. Appears to be getting back on track but will need to find more this time around

14. NICE GIRL BECO - Got off the mark at Tours on 6 September but looked decidedly ordinary in a Vincennes Class E 12 days later, and the draw only compounds matters

Summary: NICE GIRL QUICK (5), unbeaten, NOBLESS DU NOYER (4), fitted with pads for the first time, NALA DE MALIKEN (2), also sporting pads but reunited with Mathieu Mottier, and NORMA DES CHARMES (6), on the right road, are all difficult to separate.

C8 - PRIX DE FAVIERES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 22,000

1. **MIMI D'AUVILLIER** - Eliminated in a Class F over course and distance on 16 September and appears to have no possible chance
2. **MISTY DES LANDIERS** - Won a pair on turf in August but out of the picture in three starts since, lastly a Class F over course and distance two weeks ago, and others easier to trust
3. **MAMA DE L'ORMERIE** - Unplaced in a harness Class F at Villedieu Les Poeles over 2,800m on 13 September. Has no monte references and is not about to shake things up
4. **MILLONGA VRIE** - Showed her form despite being eliminated in a Class F under these conditions a fortnight ago. Has the wherewithal to win a race of this nature and should not be underestimated
5. **MAHANA OF LOVE** - Switches code for the first time following a string of poor performances under harness. Victor Saussaye in the saddle but others still preferred
6. **MUTINE DU VIVIER** - Won 4 in a row under harness, most recently a 2675m Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel 10 days ago, and looks the nearest danger to MA JOLIE CHOSE (14)
7. **MAYA DU CHEVREL** - Has taken part particularly well to the monte code, lastly third in a Class F over course and distance a fortnight ago. Is unlikely to get her head in front but could still pick up some prizemoney.
8. **MILONGA DE LOU** - Debuts in the discipline after losing her action in a Rambouillet Class F early last month. Clement Frecelle gets the nod and could well make her presence felt
9. **MA BELLE ASSHADEL** - Ran 5th here in late-August but was trounced in next two and will need to get her house in order
10. **MALDIVE DE TILLARD** - Has come close more than once under the saddle but has been found wanting this year and can be passed over
11. **MALICE LUDOISE** - Useful in both codes but can prove a handful, as she demonstrated at Ecommoy 2.5 weeks ago. Is clearly in form though and with Benjamin Rochard onboard will be afforded every chance
12. **MALAVISTA SOMOLLI** - Was going well when disqualified on monte debut in a Vire Class E 3.5 weeks ago. Returns to racing shod and is unlikely to influence the result
13. **MAMOUNE DE VISAIS** - Made short work of a Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne on monte debut on 12 September. Paul Ploquin in the irons this time and he can be forgiven for feeling bullish. Place chance
14. **MA JOLIE CHOSE** - Superb winner on monte bow under these conditions on 11 August. Returns to the code after a pair of harness sanctions and looks set to take all the beating

Summary: If she reproduces her performance of 11 August, MA JOLIE CHOSE (14), barefoot again, will be difficult to beat. Reconfigured for the occasion, MUTINE DU VIVIER (6) has been racking up wins under harness, and debuts under the saddle with a good hand to play. MAMOUNE DE VISAIS (13), an impressive winner on her monté debut, and MALICE LUDOISE (11), who must be forgiven her latest effort, come next.
