

R3 ENGHIEEN [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DE LA PORTE DOREE - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 12,000

1. **JULIE DU NORD** - Ran 3rd in a similar event across town last month but was unable to confirm when last but one in a Clairefontaine amateurs Class H a fortnight ago. Is new to Enghien but will still generate interest
2. **JAZZ OPERA** - Excellent campaigner that ran 2nd in a Class G Amateurs' race over course and distance on 16 July 2026. Enjoys a front-line start and can impose this time
3. **JOKER DREAM** - Finished 5th in a Class F at Cabourg over 2,725m on 10 July 2026 after twice finishing 2nd at Rambouillet. Is due a win one of these days and will be expected to finish close once more
4. **HADDOCK D'ECOUVES** - Made up for Moulins elimination when 3rd in a Clairefontaine amateurs Class H on 19 July. Tends to show more going clockwise though and is not a priority
5. **GRAAL DE MY** - Produced quite the surprise when 2nd in a Chinon amateurs Class H 3 weeks ago, however a repeat seems most unlikely
6. **ICONE PLANCHETTE** - Secured a Class F Amateurs' race at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 11 July 2026. Incurs the penalty again but still looks main threat to JAZZ OPERA (2)
7. **HOLLY GREEN** - Kicked the season off well but has since lost her way, and latest Mauquenchy elimination does little to inspire confidence
8. **HORSE DE GRAMMONT** - Unplaced in a Class E at La Capelle over 2,700m on 24 July 2026. Is significantly better than recent results would suggest and, with pads fitted, should be taken seriously
9. **JOGGER KILY** - Finished 4th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 14 July 2026. Returns to racing with 4 pads fitted and should give another competitive account

Summary: As is often the case at Enghien, proceedings get under way with an amateurs' event. The relentless JAZZ OPERA (2) looks to have a good opportunity to return to winning ways. ICONE PLANCHETTE (6), a proven performer at this level, is preferred to JOKER DREAM (3), who returns to a left-handed track, and HORSE DE GRAMMONT (8), who sports 4 pads for the occasion.

C2 - PRIX DU BALLON D'ALSACE - 2875m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. NUIT D'IVRESSE JAF** - Finished 6th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,850m on 16 June. Is not the most courageous of horses and is not about to upset the status quo
- 2. NOVA DU FER** - Twice 2nd at La Capelle before being eliminated in a Class D over course and distance last weekend, and is unlikely to garner much support
- 3. NALISMA** - Third in a Class D over track and trip on 26 July, making up for her Vincennes blip. Is competitively-shod for the first time and Benjamin Rochard can be forgiven for feeling bullish
- 4. NOBLESSE JISCE** - Finished 8th in a Class C over 2,150m here on 18 July. Has otherwise been in good shape and although unlikely to open her 2026 account, should nevertheless hold her own
- 5. NEPTUNE DE BLARY** - Made up for June elimination here when fifth in a Class C over 2,150m here 2 weeks ago. Has demonstrated considerable talent and enjoys a realistic chance of imposing
- 6. NOUMEA DES BROUETS** - Showed early promise but has been particularly disappointing over recent months. Sports 4 pads for the first time but still represents no more than a minor place chance
- 7. NI OUI NI NON** - Finished 6th in a Class C at Enghien over 2,150m on 18 July. Is better than that though, has won under these conditions this term, and can bring the fight to NEPTUNE DE BLARY (5)
- 8. NOUMEA COCONUT** - Finished 3rd in a Class C over course and distance on 1 July. Has shown a particular liking for the venue, is hard to knock when focused, and can play a prominent part
- 9. NIGHT OF CARLESS** - Good, consistent filly that imposed in Marseille before coming 3rd in a 2925m Cagnes Class C 3 weeks ago. Consistently gives her best and will not be far off the mark

Summary: Although not the easiest of horses to handle, NEPTUNE DE BLARY (5) reassured in stronger company over a shorter trip last time. In less-exalted company on this occasion, she can return to winning ways if she stays in stride. Winner over course and distance in late-May, NI OUI NI NON (7) and the progressive, and reconfigured, NALISMA (3), who has been patiently campaigned since the start of her career, are preferred next. The consistent NOUMEA COCONUT (8) also has claims.

C3 - PRIX DE MORANGIS - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- 1. MERCEDES DU LOISIR** - Pleasantly surprising 2nd in a Jullianges claimer on 14 July. Races barefoot for Enghien bow but still has too much to do
- 2. MEDINA DREAM** - Finished 6th in a Class E over track and trip on 25 June. Has not got her nose in front since last November, but can trot and should not be ignored
- 3. MINDIE DES PRES** - Placed in 2 before finishing 6th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 21 July. Sports 4 pads for the first time but others still easier to back
- 4. MISS ROBINSON** - Excellent servant making Enghien bow on a three-timer, most recently clinching victory in a Cherbourg Class F in mid-June. Comes here fresh and has every chance of pulling it off
- 5. MA BIMBO** - Finished 3rd in a Class E over course and distance on 26 July. Is not the easiest of horses to use but on good behaviour can pick up a first-five payout
- 6. MOON NORMANDY** - Won 2 of 3 earlier in the season before being eliminated in next 2, the latest a Class D at Vichy over 2,950m on 24 June. Has otherwise been hard to fault when barefoot and can be brought back into the fold. Chance
- 7. MA DOUCE DE DALINE** - Third in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 21 July, putting her Cholet performance behind her, and in similar shape can repeat
- 8. MAYWENN DU GUERET** - Below-par 8th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 14 July, but will be reunited with Mathieu Mottier who won with her at Caen in June, and must not be underestimated
- 9. MINYA KONKA** - Ran 2nd at Cabourg before being eliminated in a Meslay Class B last Tuesday. Gave a good account under these conditions in late-June and, with application, can go far

Summary: In top form at present and sporting a new configuration, MISS ROBINSON (4) will be reined by Benjamin Rochard this time and can extend her winning run despite stepping up in class. Racing barefoot, MOON NORMANDY (6) looks the main danger, ahead of MINYA KONKA (9), who should not be condemned for her recent elimination. MA DOUCE DE DALINE (7) is more one for the minor honours.

C4 - PRIX DE TOURTOIRAC - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 18,000

1. **IKILIK** - Form has done nothing but regress since returning in May from his lengthy layoff and will have few friends
2. **IDEE SHANNON** - Unplaced in a Class F at Le Mans over 2,950m on 25 July, 12 days after placing 3rd in an amateur event at the same venue. Is not a priority but can play a small role
3. **ILICO D'AMOUR** - Unplaced on re-entry in a Francheville Class F on 14 July. Did win his lone run at Enghien but others still easier to back
4. **HORIZON D'AMARO** - Encouraging 4th in a 2900m Guerlesquin Class F a week ago, but faces a tough bunch here and is unlikely to create an upset
5. **GALON D'AMIRAL** - Takes a notable dip in category after running 8th in a Class E at La Capelle on 24 July. Sports a fresh configuration though and, if applied, can make first 5
6. **GREFFIERS FLINOIS** - Capable on a good day but has done nothing noteworthy all season and can be passed over
7. **KARMA QUICK** - Appears to be getting back in the game following some health issues, most recently 6th in an Agon Class F on 24 July, and in this category should have a good hand to play
8. **HAPPY ATOUT** - Finished 4th in a Class D over course and distance on 11 July 2026, a fortnight after having come 3rd at Nancy. Has not got his nose in front since March 2024 but under these conditions is easy to recommend for a place in the frame
9. **GALAXIE DU HOME** - Has picked up in 2026 where she left off last season and appears to have too much to do once more
10. **IQUITO PLANCHETTE** - Has been off the boil since securing an amateur event in April, but ability is not in question. Has won 3 of 6 here, and with application can win a race of this nature
11. **HIPPOCRATE DU TRIO** - Has been very disappointing at all levels this season. Has placed just twice in 5 Enghien runs and is not a contender
12. **GLOUGLOU D'EMI** - Tricky character that has made no impact this term and recent re-entry run did nothing to convince
13. **ISIS DE LA FERME** - Somewhat erratic but has already won twice this year. Came 2nd in an Avignon Class E last weekend and, considering the entry, will have her chances

Summary: A competitive claimer in which the tough IQUITO PLANCHETTE (10), who appreciates this track, looks to have a fine opportunity to get back in the winners' circle. Consistent throughout the season, ISIS DE LA FERME (13) has been reconfigured and also looks close to her race. HAPPY ATOUT (8) has been competing in stronger company this year and should have a part to play, as should KARMA QUICK (7).

C5 - PRIX DE FORGES-LES-EAUX - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- 1. LUCRECE DE CORDAY** - Put a pair of eliminations behind her when 4th to LISBETH DRY (7) over longer here last weekend. Is never far from faulting but on good behaviour can get in on the action
- 2. LYLOU DES THUYAS** - Surprisingly lacklustre 8th in a Class D at Amiens over 2,400m on 8 June, after having placed in 3 previous starts. Breaks in front and is not incapable of getting a look in
- 3. LOZEN DE BANVILLE** - Finished 12th in a Class E at Enghien over 2,875m on 22 July 2026. Is better than the result would suggest but others still preferred
- 4. LICORNVERASPERANZA** - Decent runner-up in a Class E at Laval over 2,850m on 11 June 2026. Is clearly in good shape but may just have too much to do this time
- 5. LISBETH** - 8th on comeback in a Class D at La Capelle over 2,750m on 19 June. Will race barefoot this time and from the 5 slot should not be entirely overlooked
- 6. LADY MAJOR** - Unplaced in a Class F at Cabourg over 2,750m on 24 July 2026. Is some way off her best form and is unlikely to spice things up
- 7. LISBETH DRY** - Comfortable winner of a Class E over 2,875m here on 25 July. Can prove a handful but with form maintained can repeat
- 8. LUBIE DE CELINIERE** - Generous mare that comfortably secured a Class E at Lisieux over 2,675m on 15 July 2026. Forced to start wide but in present form is hard to ignore
- 9. FEDE JET** - Yet to get fully into her stride following the break, but has 2 runs under her belt and, with application, can finish close
- 10. FITNESS GRIF** - Makes Enghien bow after a pair of Vincennes conditioners. Will race shod for the occasion and despite a second-line draw can play a prominent role
- 11. LA MISS ROYALE** - Finished 3rd in a Class E at La Capelle over 2,700m on 20 July, a month after running 5th over course and distance, but has little going for her this time
- 12. FEDORA KEY COL** - Produced a 23-1 surprise when 2nd in a 2875m Class E here last weekend, however a repeat seems unlikely
- 13. FORNARINA ROSS** - Returns to France following some good performances in Turin, latterly coming 5th over a mile. Will appreciate returning to a somewhat longer trip and will be no pushover if Andrea Guzzinati successfully navigates the start
- 14. SHE'S A WINNER** - Makes Enghien debut after winning both return runs at Waregem, picking up where she left off in February. Not ideally-drawn but has won at this level at Vincennes and will be expected to contest the finish

Summary: An impressive winner here last time, LISBETH DRY (7) is drawn a rather wide but nonetheless looks capable of following up. She will, however, face stiff opposition from the accomplished, and barefoot pair of SHE'S A WINNER (14) and FORNARINA ROSS (13), both of which bring strong credentials. Despite the tough draw, FEDE JET (9) also has claims.

C6 - PRIX DE CHALONS DU MAINE - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 46,000

1. KARA DE PIERREPONT - Won an amateurs Class F over course and distance in June but failed to confirm 3.5 weeks ago when 7th under similar conditions. Is no slouch on a good day though and should not be underestimated

2. KELLE BELLE JASMA - Third in a Class G at Langon over 2,800m on 14 July. Has hardly put a foot out of line this year, ran 2nd on sole Enghien start, and looks competitively well in

3. KOREA - Decent dual-discipline mare that was eliminated in a Class D under these conditions early last month. Should be fully fit by now, has form at this level, and on better behaviour can contest a place in the picture

4. J'ADORE D'EURVAD - Finished 6th in a Class E at La Capelle over 2,750m on 20 July. Has twice been unable to confirm Chartres success and is unlikely to spring any surprises

5. KAYA DU SAPTEL - Took little time getting back in the game following her break, latterly runner-up in a Class E at La Capelle over 2,750m on 20 July, and in similar shape could well open her 2026 tally

6. KARLA DE BANVILLE - Undeniably capable but has been out of sorts for a number of months and must first get her house in order

7. JUSTESS VIKING - Has been enjoying a decent run of form in both codes but is less competitively-shod this time and others easier to support

8. KASBAH PERRINE - Has made the first 5 just once in 10 starts this year and latest runs do nothing to inspire confidence

9. KARA D'OR - Quality mare that has been somewhat off the boil recently. Has placed just once in 6 Enghien starts but can trot when the mood takes her and should not be discounted

10. KEVA LUDOISE - Facile winner of a Class D at Laval over 2,850m on 25 June 2026. Has been like a horse reborn since early-May and, given the engagement, is easy to fancy for the win

Summary: In sparkling form this season, KEVA LUDOISE (10) will bid to raise the bar against stronger opposition than she has faced in recent starts. Back to her best, KAYA DU SAPTEL (5) is preferred next ahead of the ultra-consistent KELLE BELLE JASMA (2). KOREA (3) should not be underestimated.

C7 - PRIX D'AIGREMONT - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- 1. LUCKY LUCIANO** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class E at Enghien over 2,150m on 25 June, 2 weeks after having won a Vichy Class E. Is forced to start on the rail but will be barefoot this time and will have his supporters
- 2. TAURUS CROWN** - Third in a Class E over 2150m here on 22 July. Is not always the most dependable but considering his latest performance, and the draw, can turn the tables on DUKE OF NEW YORK (4) and win this
- 3. FONZIE MABEL** - Returns to France after winning over 2100m in Turin 3.5 weeks ago. Is new to Enghien but should appreciate its profile and the draw will do his chances no disservice
- 4. DUKE OF NEW YORK** - Surprise, but convincing, runner-up in a a Class E over 2150m here on 22 July. Enjoys an ideal spot in front this time and will be expected to contest the finish
- 5. FRENCHCONNECTION** - Completely lost his way after winning a Vincennes Class E earlier in the year. Has been fitted with a new formula but still not a priority
- 6. SOKRATES** - Quality German trotter making French debut after running 2nd over 2000m in Berlin a fortnight ago. Starts on front line and with Alexandre Abrivard in the bike will be afforded every chance
- 7. LORD DES GRANGES** - Finished 4th in a Class E at La Capelle over 2,700m on 20 July. Will not be sent out at 83-1 this time but is unlikely to be as performant either
- 8. SEVEN SEAS S** - Ran 6th in 22 July race of reference following a tough trip. Has ample ability though and can trot his way into the frame provided Mathieu Mottier successfully negotiates the start
- 9. SAM PIERJI (BEL)** - Gave a good account when 4th behind DUKE OF NEW YORK (4) in 22 July race of reference. Has pulled a rough number but Christophe Martens gets the nod this time and is unlikely to disappoint

Summary: Well-placed behind the car, TAURUS CROWN (2) can turn the tables on DUKE OF NEW YORK (4) who had his measure here recently. Despite a second-row draw, SAM PIERJI (9), who confirmed his form that day, is a leading contender, while SEVEN SEAS S (8), who was unlucky on that occasion, is worth another chance.

C8 - PRIX DE LA PLACE VAUBAN - 2250m (a1m1/2) - - Mounted - EUR € 68,000

1. **HARRY DU LYS** - Unplaced in a Class C at Enghien over 2,875m on 25 July, failing to confirm June performance here, and can be passed over
2. **STACCATO HL** - Has not been seen out since finishing 7th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 15 February. Is barefoot for re-entry though, has ample ability, and can get straight back in the game
3. **IBIS DE CHAHAINS** - Finished 4th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 1 July. Seldom disappoints at the venue and is unlikely to start now
4. **I LOVE D'AMOUR** - Starts for the first time since coming 7th in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 8 January. Is barefoot for the occasion, confirmed over course and distance, and is unlikely to let the side down
5. **IROKO DU LOIR** - Finished 3rd in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 1 July 2026. Has endured an interrupted career, is behind in earnings, and unlikely to return home empty-handed
6. **ILIO MANNETOT** - Finished 8th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 18 July. Is useful on a good day and even though in quality company here, should not be ignored
7. **HOTKATISSIME** - Unplaced in a Class C at Enghien over 2,150m on 9 July, his first start for 11 months. Is confirmed under the day's conditions but others still preferred
8. **JOKER DE FROULAY** - Quality element that was pulled-up on comeback in a 2875m Class C here last weekend. Will have progressed for the run all the same and Mathieu Mottier will be eager to set the record straight. Claim
9. **HUMOUR FESTIF** - Was unable to confirm good Laval performance when 7th in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,750m on 10 July, but has otherwise been in fine form and will have his supporters
10. **HOLD UP RANAIS** - 6th in a harness Class C at Enghien over 2,150m on 27 June 2026, his first appearance since January. Will have come on for the race but is not an obvious choice on monte debut
11. **JOIE DE LA COTE** - Just headed in a Class D at Vichy over 1,609m on 4 July. Has form under these conditions and with Alexandre Abrivard in the irons will be no pushover
12. **HURIEL LUDOIS** - Placed twice in June but went off the boil in July and will need to get his house in order
13. **IF I TELL YOU** - 3rd in a harness Class C at Vincennes over 2,100m on 21 June, 8 days after having run 2nd on re-entry over 2875m here. Sports 4 pads this time but may still have more to find

Summary: Although disappointing on his seasonal return, JOKER DE FROULAY (8) looks capable of bouncing back in a field well within his compass. Should Mathieu Mottier's gelding fail to deliver again, speed specialists STACCATO HL (2), JOIE DE LA COTE (11) and I LOVE D'AMOUR (4), who has already shown his ability in this type of contest, are the obvious alternatives.
