C1 - PRIX DES DROSERAS - 2725m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **KING DE LARRE** - Has struggled of late and was 9th in a Class H at Abbeville over 3175m on 26 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
2. **KAISER TURGOT** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class E at this over 2,750m on 24 July. Capable of making the frame
3. **KUEENTRASS** - Unplaced in a Class F at Enghien over 2,150m on 25 July. Has won twice this year already and is capable of scoring once again
4. **KOKO DU CANTER** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Class E at Granville over 3,125m on 26 July. Might play a minor role at very best
5. **KANELLE D'OUVILLE** - Returned to form when fourth in a Class G mounted race at this course over 2,750m on 24 July. Better in harness races and can score
6. **KABALVA** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Class D at Caen over 2,200m on 22 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
7. **KRACK DESBOIS** - Finished 9th in a Class F at Lucon over 3,025m on 5 July. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
8. **KANELLE BUROISE** - Disqualified last time out in a Class F at Vichy over 2,950m on 10 May. Not easy to trust and could need this run returning from a break
9. **KASPER FAC** - Disqualified in three of last five starts, including last time out in Class E at Granville over 3150m on 26 July. Hard to trust but can make the frame when smart
10. **KATINKA COTON** - Finished 7th in a Class F at Laval over 2,850m on 18 February. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
11. **KID SMILE** - Did not show his best when 11th in a Class D at Le Mans over 2,950m on 21 May. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
12. **KALIPETTE JELOCA** - Disqualified last time out in a Class F at Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 16 July. Not reliable but is capable of scoring when smart
13. **KNOX JENILOU** - Threatening another victory when runner-up in a Class H at Montier En Der over 3,025m on 5 July. Can be right there at the finish yet again
14. **KAZAAL** - In good shape and was third in a Class F at Pornichet over 2,725m on 16 July. Can get involved with the finish once again

Summary: With Yoann Lebourgeois in the sulky, KANELLE D'OUVILLE (5) looks particularly well placed to shine, especially given her advantageous starting position on the front row. KAZAAL (14), sent out with strong confidence from his yard, also commands respect despite a less favorable draw. KNOX JENILOU (13), consistent and capable, is hard to ignore. KALIPETTE JELOCA (12) has the ability to secure a good placing if at her best as well. A very open race.

C2 - PRIX DES JOUBARBES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **LADY ROCK** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class H at Francheville over 2475m on 14 July. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
2. **LA VERITE** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class E at Reims over 2,550m on 23 April. Returns from a break and could need this run
3. **LA DESIRADE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Class F at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,650m on 15 July. Capable of better and is not out of it
4. **LINKA D'ADELE** - Consistent and finished third in Class H at Guerlesquin over 2925m on 26 July. Can be a threat to these rivals as well
5. **LHASSA DU SCION** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, the latest in Class F at Brehal over 2875m on 27 July. Very hard to trust but can make the frame when smart
6. **LADY PURPLE** - Has been moderate of late, finishing 7th in a Class F at Questembert over 3,125m on 12 July. Needs to do more to score
7. **LILI MARLEEN** - Disqualified last time out in Class E at Cherbourg over 2625m on 24 June. Can bounce back to score if smart
8. **LUEUR DES LANDES** - Not reliable but was runner-up in Class F at Cazaubon-Barbotan over 2600m on 20 July. Should be a threat if in the right mood
9. **LADY DE RICO** - Has struggled of late and was 9th in a Class F at Ecommoy over 2,750m on 19 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
10. **LEAMOA** - Finished 8th in a Class E at Tours Chambray over 2,800m on 10 May. Returns from a break and could need this run
11. **LOVE ME DAXEL** - Disqualified last time out in Class H at Bacqueville-en-Caux over 2550m on 12 July. Not reliable but does have a place chance when staying in stride
12. **LEXIA** - Finished 7th last time out in Class F over this track and trip on 24 July. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
13. **LOLITA** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F over this course and distance on 7 July. Capable of an upset on best form
14. **LOVELY BRUYERE** - In good form and finished runner-up in a Class F at this course over 2,725m on 17 July. Can get involved with the finish
15. **LINE MAJYC** - Finished 10th in a Class E at Lisieux over 2,675m on 15 July. Has struggled of late and makes little appeal this time
16. **LUANA SPORT** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest in Class E at Lisseux over 2675m on 16 July. Not easy to trust but is capable of earning some money

Summary: LILI MARLEEN (7), lightly raced with just five starts, has already displayed promising ability and, from an inside draw, looks particularly well placed to make a big impact. LUEUR DES LANDES (8), currently in excellent form is an obvious threat. LINKA D'ADELE (4), who has been in the placings in all her outings also brings solid credentials. LA DESIRADE (3), partnered by Yoann Lebourgeois, is another serious contender.

C3 - PRIX DES JACINTHES - 2725m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. IPSO D'AVIGNERE** - Has only been fair of late and finished fourth in Class E at La Capelle over 2700m on 24 July. Might play a minor role once again
- 2. IMAKO VERDERIE** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 18 July. Capable of being a threat at this lower level
- 3. JAGERBOMB** - Often competitive and finished fourth in a Class F at Ecommoy over 2,750m on 19 July. Should be competitive once again
- 4. JOG JELOCA** - Remains in very good form and was runner-up in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 27 June. Can go one place better
- 5. HISTORY MAJYC** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class E at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 24 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. HORACIO DE CERISY** - Unplaced in a Class E at Caen over 2,450m on 15 November. Returns from a lengthy break and is likely to need this run
- 7. HEIDI DU BISET** - Not reliable, finishing 7th in a Class E at Amiens over 2,900m on 18 July. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 8. GOLDORACK DU BOIS** - Not reliable and finished fourth in Class G at Cabourg over 2750m on 21 July. Would not be a surprise winner this track and trip
- 9. INSTAGRAM** - Finished 15th in a Class F at Saint Malo over 2,950m on 9 July. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 10. JACK L'EVENTREUR** - Showed some improvement and was runner-up in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,150m on 23 July. Can go one place better
- 11. IRIS DU LIVIER** - Returned to form and finished third in a Class E at La Roche-Posay over 3,150m on 18 July . Should be involved with the finish yet again
- 12. INCREDIBLE GO** - Finished 3rd in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,150m on 23 July. Has been competitive lately and is capable of making the frame

Summary: The race looks set to revolve around JOG JELOCA (4), who has been consistently delivering strong performances since the beginning of the year, and JAGERBOMB (3), whose true ability is arguably better than his earnings suggest. IMAKO VERDERIE (2), well drawn on the front row, has the backing of his trainer and should be competitive. IRIS DU LIVIER (11), a proven specialist on right-handed tracks, also has the credentials to play a leading role.

C4 - PRIX DES AULNES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. NUÉE DES ARRIS** - has disqualification issues and finished 6th last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 21 July. Can be a lively danger when staying on the trot
- 2. NOVENA D'OURVILLE** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest in Class E over this track and trip on 14 July. Can surprise if staying on the trot
- 3. NEPTUNE D'AVE** - Not disgraced when third in a Class E over this course and distance on 14 July . Is clearly not out of it in this line-up
- 4. NATURE VRIE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E at Enghien over 2,150m on 11 July. Needs to do more to score
- 5. NEW LIFE STAR** - Disqualified last time out in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 23 July. In good form before that and has claims if smart
- 6. NEFERTITI DU LERRE** - Successful in a Class F at Caen over 2,450m on 12 March. Unreliable and is likely to need this run returning from a break
- 7. NORMA DU VIVIER** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class F at Saint Malo over 2,950m on 9 July. Improving and looks capable of doubling up
- 8. NACARA BELLA** - Disqualified last time out in a Class D at Chartres over 2,800m on 17 June. Not reliable and others make more appeal
- 9. NEZUKO JIEL** - Victorious in a Class E at Vittel over 2,700m on 12 July. Remains in good form and could follow up if staying in stride
- 10. NICCA BREED** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 14 July. Capable of scoring if smart
- 11. NOSTALGIE DAIRPET** - Finished 8th in a Class D at La Capelle over 2,750m on 7 July. Has only been modest of late and others make more appeal
- 12. NOORDZEE** - Disqualified in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 16 July. Not easy to trust but is capable of making the frame when smart

Summary: After finishing second on her debut on June 20th, NORMA DU VIVIER (7) stepped up markedly to win impressively at Saint-Malo and sets a strong standard here. NICCA BREED (10) and NEZUKO JIEL (9) have both shown clear ability and look like serious challengers. NEPTUNE D'AVE (3) is capable of finishing strongly and an interesting outsider.

C5 - PRIX DES GAZANIES - 2050m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. ONE NIGHT IN RIO** - Finished 6th last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2250m on 26 july. Did better on debut and has a place chance
- 2. OCACINA** - Disqualified on debut in a Class F at Bernay over 2,300m on 26 July. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 3. OLINA BELLA** - Finished fifth on debut in a Class F at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,150m on 24 July. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role
- 4. OF AMERICA** - Finished third on debut in a Class F at Ecommoy over 2,225m on 19 July. Should improve and get involved with the finish once again
- 5. OJERIS D'ALCI** - Finished 3rd on debut in a Class F at Le Touquet over 2,100m on 14 July. Capable of making the frame once again
- 6. OLYMPIC JOY** - Finished fifth on debut in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 18 July. Capable of improvement and has claims
- 7. ORNAISE DU HANOY** - Disqualified on debut in a Class F at Bernay over 2,300m on 26 July. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 8. OLYMPE ETOILEE** - A two-year-old filly by Diable de Vauvert out of Etoile Montaval who is making her debut. Her Dam won four of her 84 starts. Could need this experience
- 9. OPALE DELKARLITO** - A two-year-old filly by Ici C'est Paris out of Dona de Touchyvon who is making her debut. Her Dam never won a race after 73 starts. Qualified at Caen and is not out of it
- 10. ORIGINE CASTELLE** - A two-year-old filly by Idao de Tillard out of Icône de Castelle who is making her debut. Her Dam won 6 out of her 26 Starts. Qualified in a good time and could score

Summary: Trained by Thierry Duvaldestin, ORIGINE CASTELLE (10) appears to have the class required to take control of a race of this nature and score on debut. OLYMPIC JOY (6), from the Philippe Allaire yard, looks like a major rival and should provide a strong challenge. OF AMERICA (4) and OJERIS D'ALCI (5), both of whom showed promise on their respective debuts at Ecommoy and Le Touquet, add further depth to the field and are worth considering.

C6 - PRIX DES VERVEINES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - - Mounted - EUR € 20,000

1. LA CANDEUR - Holding form and finished fourth in a Class F mounted race at Mauquenchy over 2,850m on 23 July. Can earn some more money

2. L'ULKA DI LEONE - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a Class F harness race at Agon-Coutanville over 3475m on 14 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score

3. LARIANA CLEVILLE - Disqualified last time out in a Class F mounted race at Clairefontaine over 2200m on 19 July. Consistent before that and has a place chance

4. LILI GUILLERVILLE - Finished 7th in a Class F at Biarritz over 2,950m on 1 July. Has only been modest of late and needs to do more to beat these rivals

5. LAZIE PONT VAUTIER - Not disgraced when third in a Class E mounted race at La Capelle over 2,750m on 24 July. Can be competitive yet again

6. LOU DU DERBY - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class F mounted race over this course and distance on 10 July. Can be a threat to these rivals

7. LISA DU HEURT - Unreliable of late, finishing 7th in a Class F harness race at Mauquenchy over 2,150m on 23 July. Might play a minor role

8. LOLLY MACKER - Retuned to form and was fourth in a Class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 22 June. Solid under the saddle and can score

9. LOU DE LANGE - Not reliable and was 7th in a Class F harness race at Agon-Coutanville over 3450m on 24 July. Can do a lot better in a mounted race and is not out of it

10. LILOU TREMBLADAISE - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class F mounted race over this track and trip on 10 July. Can make the frame

Summary: A tricky looking race. Judging by her best efforts this year, LOLLY MACKER (8) looks a leading player, especially with the confidence of her connections behind her. LOU DE LANGE (9) and LILOU TREMBLADAISE (10), both well placed in this lineup, should provide the main opposition. LAZIE PONT VAUTIER (5) has shown enough ability and also has the credentials to be competitive.

C7 - PRIX DES SOUCIS - 2050m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 18,000

1. OTANGO BELLO - Only modest on debut 7th in a Class F at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,150m on 24 July. Capable of improvement but others are preferred

2. OAKLAND PAULCA - Finished 6th on debut in a Class F at Bernay over 2,300m on 26 July. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal

3. OSSAU DU PRE - A two-year-old colt by Idao de Tillard out of Geisha du Pré who is making his debut. His Dam won twice in 35 starts. Can be a threat

4. ONE WAY - A two-year-old colt by Helgafell out of Downing Street who is making his debut. His Dam won 7 of her 32 starts. Qualified well and could score

5. OSCAR THORIS - Showed some improvement when 5th in Class G at Brehal over 2325m on 20 July. More is needed to beat these rivals

6. OVERMARS ELLIS - A two-year-old colt by Italiano Vero out of Elma de Vandel who is making his debut. His Dam won once in 19 starts. Could earn some money

7. OZZARO DIBAH - Finished fourth on debut in a Class G at Brehal over 2325m on 20 July. Capable of making the frame once again

8. OFFSHORE MIJO - A two-year-old colt by Earl Simon out of Just Love Money who is making his debut. His Dam never raced in France. Qualified at Caen and should be a threat

Summary: ONE WAY (4) made a good impression during qualification and looks capable of making a bold showing on debut. OFFSHORE MIJO (8) also posted a solid qualifying effort and warrants respect, while OSSAU DU PRE (3), a son of Idao de Tillard, comes from a productive lineage and is sure to attract support. OZZARO DIBAH (7), with the benefit of recent race experience and some encouraging form, adds further depth to this competitive lineup.

C8 - PRIX DES ERABLES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 19,500

- 1. NAGOYA MESLOISE** - A three-year-old filly by Helgafell out of Tootsie who is making her debut. Her Dam won twice in 35 starts. Could need this experience
- 2. NAPOLIA DAIRPET** - A three-year-old filly by Inoui Danica out of Tactique Honey who is making her debut. Her Dam never won after 22 starts. Others make more appeal
- 3. NACRE DE LA CHAULE** - Disqualified in all three start so far, the latest in a Class F over this course and distance on 17 July. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- 4. NAELE DU POMMEREUX** - Showed some improvement last time out when fourth in a Class F mounted race at Gaon-Coutanville over 2200m on 14 July. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 5. NARAGONAISE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a harness claimer at Laon over 2650m .Needs major improvement to score
- 6. NACRE D'ORIENT** - Finished 7th last time out in a Class H harness race at Brehal over 2325m on 20 July. Could do a bit better trying a mounted race
- 7. NATIVE D'AUVERS** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class F mounted race over this course and distance on 17 July. Can be competitive once again if smart
- 8. NUSICA ASSCHADEL** - Has only been modest so far and finished 6th in a Class E mounted race at Cabourg over 2,750m on 24 July. More is needed to score
- 9. NATURE DU RIB** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class E mounted race over this course and distance on 24 July. Clearly is not out of it
- 10. NIDORINA DE VIVOIN** - A runner-up on debut in a Class F mounted race at Graignes over 2,700m on 27 June. Should contest the finish
- 11. NOUBA CASTELETS** - Unreliable but was fifth in a Class E mounted race over this track and trip on 24 July. Not easy to trust and more is needed to score
- 12. NANALAND** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a Class E mounted race over this track and trip on 24 July. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 13. NOKITA DU RIB** - Excellent runner-up in a Class F mounted race over this course and distance on 17 July. Can go one place better
- 14. NOUVELLE D'ATOUT** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class F over this track and trip at Cabourg on 17 July. Capable of making the frame

Summary: NOKITA DU RIB (13) showed encouraging signs under saddle over this course and distance so emerges as a leading contender. NIDORINA DE VIVOIN (10) made a strong impression on debut and is clearly one to follow. NATIVE D'AUVERS (7), on an upward trajectory, along with NOUVELLE D'ATOUT (14), who is well positioned are other possible winners of this lucky last race.
