

# R5 HYERES [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX AEROPORT TOULON HYERES - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000**

- 1. JEREZ** - Has struggled of late and was 10th in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Reverts to barefoot but others make more appeal
- 2. JEWELLE OF JANE** - Victorious in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Not reliable but is quite capable of following up
- 3. JUST D'HERIPRE** - Consistent and finished third in a class G mounted race at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 27 June. Can be competitive once again
- 4. KASH D'URZY** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a class F over this track and trip on 26 June. Remains barefoot and could make the frame
- 5. KHEOPS TURGOT** - Showed some improvement and was runner-up in a class E at Feurs over 2850m on 12 June. Has disqualification issues but could score
- 6. KATSUMOTO** - Disqualified in a class H at Lannemezan over 2200m on 24 June. In good form before that and might play a minor role
- 7. KENAVO DU BOUILLON** - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2850m on 26 June. Capable of earning some minor money when staying in stride
- 8. KANSAS DE CASTELLE** - Usually competitive and was third in a class F at Nancy over 2600m on 26 June. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish again

**Summary:** KHEOPS TURGOT (5) was only beaten by a well-treated filly at Feurs. If he stays wise, he holds a leading chance in this field. KANSAS DE CASTELLE (8) is consistent and clearly enjoys this track, so he commands serious respect. The same applies to JEWELLE OF JANE (2), who scored in pleasing fashion at Marseille-Borely last time out. KASH D'URZY (4) is much better than his latest run would suggest and can also challenge for top honours.

## C2 - PRIX DU DOMAINE LOLICE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 43,000

1. **GOLDEN VISAIS** - Holding form and was fourth in a class B over this course and distance on 16 June. Can get in the mix of things once again
2. **GYS** - In good form and finished third in a class B over this course and distance on 16 June. Remains barefoot and is clearly not out of it
3. **GALANT DE CAREL** - Finished 6th in a class B over this track and trip on 16 June. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
4. **ICARE DU BERYL** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class B over this track and trip on 16 June. Remains barefoot and could earn some more money
5. **GAI MATIN** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including in a class D at Zonza over 3150m on 28 June. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal
6. **HERALDIQUE** - A winner at Gelsenkirchen over 2000m on 25 May. Remains barefoot but tackles stronger this time around. Might play a minor role
7. **HELLO PANAME** - Off form and was unplaced in a class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 June. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
8. **HERODE DU CORTA** - Successful twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class C at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Remains barefoot and can add another win to tally
9. **IBROX PARK** - Did not show his best when 8th in a class A at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Could bounce back and be a threat to these rivals
10. **HOT SUMMER** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a class C over this course and distance on 27 May. Remains barefoot and a bit more is needed to score
11. **HYDROMEL** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a class B at this track over 2850m on 1 May. Can go one place better
12. **INSTRUCTOR** - Showed some improvement when third in a class C over this track and trip on 27 May. Could earn some more money

**Summary:** HERODE DU CORTA (8) has been faultless for many months and should once again play a leading role, despite a wide draw. HYDROMEL (11) is back to his best, as evidenced by his runner-up finish at this track on 1 May. GYS (2) is enjoying a resurgence in the South-East and looks competitive. GOLDEN VISAIS (1), who surprised when finishing fourth over this course and distance last time out could also get involved with the finish.

### C3 - PRIX DES CIGALES - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 29,000

1. **JOLI MEC D'AMOUR** - Disqualified in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 2850m on 27 June. Remains barefoot and is capable of scoring for David Békaert
2. **IPSOS D'ARIANE** - Showed some improvement when third in a class E over this course and distance on 26 June. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
3. **HELIOS D'EURVAD** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class F over this course and distance on 26 June. Might play a minor role
4. **IBRA TEJY** - Disqualified in a class F at Nimes over 2750m on 14 June. Remains barefoot and was in good form before that. Not out of it
5. **HARLEM DE L'ITON** - Disappointing recent form and was 10th in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 20 June. Remains barefoot but others are preferred
6. **JUDOPOCK** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 7 June. Can go one place better
7. **JAGUAR DU BOCAGE** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in a class E over this course and distance on 26 June. Remains barefoot and can complete the hat-trick
8. **JOE TEJY** - Disqualified in a class E over this course and distance on 26 June. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
9. **ISLA** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance
10. **ILDA DE BERTRANGE** - Finished 8th in a class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 June. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to score
11. **IPSO SIMARDIERE** - In good shape and was third in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Remains barefoot and could contest the finish once again

**Summary:** JOLI MEC D'AMOUR (1) broke into a gallop last time out when strongly fancied. He has never disappointed when racing barefoot at Hyères and is expected to make amends. JAGUAR DU BOCAGE (7) has recorded two convincing wins over this track and trip recently and, once again fully barefoot, looks a serious danger. Back in form and presented with confidence by Christophe Martens, JUDOPOCK (6) has a chance, along with IBRA TEJY (4), who has been specifically prepared for this race.

## C4 - PRIX JEAN BOILLEREAU - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. LUEUR DE LOIRON** - In very good form and was runner-up in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 20 June. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
- 2. LEADER DE CERISY** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in a class E at Amiens over 2400m on 11 June. Capable of doing better and others are preferred
- 3. LUTIN D'HERMES** - Successful in a class F at Avignon over 2650m on 21 June. Remains barefoot but is clearly unreliable. Might place
- 4. LECTURE PRIVEE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Can be a real threat to these rivals if smart
- 5. LOOK DES VALLEES** - Unreliable but was a runner-up in a class F at Avignon over 2650m on 21 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 6. LIBERIAN GIRL** - Disqualified in a class F at Julliangers over 2425m on 21 June. Remains barefoot and was in good form before that. Not out of it
- 7. LE DESTIN** - Disqualified in a class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 31 May. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of earning some money when smart
- 8. LOLA DU CHERISAY** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a class F at Bollene over 2800m on 28 June. Remains barefoot and could earn some minor money
- 9. LUTECE SMART** - Unreliable and was fourth in a class D at Marseille-Vivax over 2650m on 13 June. Remains barefoot and could earn some money
- 10. LUNE D'ERABLE** - Did not show her best when 8th in a class D at Marseille-Vivax over 2650m on 13 June. Reverts to barefoot and can contest the finish
- 11. LUCULLUS DU DOLLAR** - A winner of a class F at Avignon over 2650m on 1 April. Unreliable but cannot be ruled out of a winning again
- 12. LAIKA D'ESPACE** - Disqualified five times in a row, the latest in a class F at Avignon over 2650m on 21 June. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 13. LIGHTNING RIVER** - Showed some improvement when third in a class F at Avignon over 2650m on 21 June. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 14. LA FLEUR** - Finished ffth in a class F at Avignon over 2650m on 21 June. Showed some improvement but more is needed to score

**Summary:** LUEUR DE LOIRON (1) has been in excellent form since joining the Simon Laloum yard. Particularly effective racing right-handed, she looks a solid banker. LECTURE PRIVEE (4) excels at this course and performs well when barefoot behind; she is expected to bounce back. LIBERIAN GIRL (6) looks hard to ignore in this company. LUNE D'ERABLE (10), racing barefoot and partnered by David Békaert, also warrants serious consideration.

## C5 - PRIX GERARD NOUGIER - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. IDOCTRO DE HOUELLE** - Remains in good shape and was 4th in class G at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 19 June. Has disqualification issues but can be competitive yet again
- 2. JEAN D'HOLLENBOURG** - Returned to form with a runner-up performance in class D at this over 2850m on 5 June. Has disqualification issues but is clearly not out of it
- 3. KEONA DELALANDE** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in class G at this course over 2850m on 26 June. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 4. JIRENZO** - Not reliable and was 9th in class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 19 April. On a long losing streak and is best watched for now
- 5. KIEFFER D'OURVILLE** - Disqualified in class E at Nimes over 2750m on 14 June. In good form before that and could make the frame if smart
- 6. KERNEL DE NUIT** - Victorious in Class E at this course over 2850m on 26 June. In good form and is capable of doubling up
- 7. ITXASSOU** - In good shape and was runner-up in a claimer at Bollene over 2800m on 7 June. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 8. HOOLIGAN ONE** - Off form and finished 11th in Class H at Montlucon over 3025m on 7 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 9. JUAN LES PINS** - In very good form and finished 4th in class F at Vichy over 2150m on 18 June. Capable of bouncing back to score
- 10. INGENIOUS BOND** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest in class E at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 27 June. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred

**Summary:** JUAN LES PINS (9) looked likely to grab second place for a long way last time out at Vichy. Back on his preferred track, he gets the nod. IDOCTRO DE HOUELLE (1) did not disgrace himself on at Marseille-Borély despite not enjoying the best of trips and must be considered a solid contender. KEONA DELALANDE (3), reassuring at this track last month also has claims. JEAN D'HOLLENBOURG (2) is hard to ignore on form and is another to consider.

## C6 - PRIX CARRUS - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- 1. MAGIC OHEM** - Has only been fair of late and was 5th in class F at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 27 June. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. MAJAX DE REVE D'OR** - Victorious in Class H at Challons en Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Improving and could be capable of a follow up success
- 3. MARCO POLO** - Victorious in Class F at Bollene over 2800m on 28 June. Improving but does tackle stronger this time around. Might place
- 4. MADRELLO** - Disqualified in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 26 February. Returns from a break but is talented and could score if fit enough
- 5. MERCEDES PAN** - Disqualified in class F at Avignon over 2650m on 21 June. Unreliable and has yet to win a race. Others make more appeal
- 6. MONUMENTAL** - Only modest of late and was 7th in class F at Avignon over 2650m on 21 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 7. MYSTERY SIXTY ONE** - Consistent and was 4th in class F at Carpentras over 2100m on 31 May. Should contest the finish once again
- 8. MY MILLION GAGOU** - threatening a victory and was runner-up in class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 1 June. Can be competitive yet again
- 9. MAGICIEN D'OZ** - Unreliable and finished 5th in class F at Amiens over 2400m on 23 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 10. MISTER DES THUYAS** - Off form and finished 9th in class F at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 19 June. Others are much preferred
- 11. MOANA DE L'AUMANCE** - Not reliable but was a runner-up in class E at Nimes over 2750m on 14 June. Capable of playing a minor role
- 12. MATCHO LOUANGES** - Not reliable and was 7th in class E at Vichy over 2150m on 18 June. Has a place chance when in the right mood
- 13. MINOS DES CHARRONS** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in class E at this course over 2650m on 16 June. Could make the frame

**Summary:** Returning from a break, MADRELLO (4) has already proven himself in stronger company. Barefoot behind for the first time, he could take all the beating. MAJAX DE REVE D'OR (2) continues to improve and looks the main danger. MYSTERY SIXTY ONE (7) and MY MILLION GAGOU (8) are consistent performers and are well positioned on the front line, giving them solid podium claims in this line-up

## C7 - PRIX BAHIA QUESNOT - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 26,000

- 1. KHEOPS DU PERRON** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class G mounted race at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 27 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 2. KLEPPER DU LOIR** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Class F harness race at Avignon over 2650m on 21 June. More is needed to win
- 3. KHAZAR DES CORVEES** - Holding form and finished 4th in a Class F harness race at Marseille-Borély over 2800m on 24 June. Capable of being competitive once again
- 4. HERCULE DU LEVANT** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class F mounted race over this course and distance on 16 June. Has a place chance
- 5. JET DU RAVARY** - Did not show his best when 9th in a Class D mounted race at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 17 June. Can bounce back to score
- 6. ISAAC DE SYVA** - In good shape and was fourth in a Class F mounted race over this course and distance on 16 June. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 7. ILLICO DE LOU** - Returned to form and finished 3rd in a Class F mounted race over this track and trip on 16 June. Can contest the finish
- 8. KRISTAL DREAM** - Usually competitive and finished fourth in a Class C harness race at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 10 June. Could score trying a mounted race

**Summary:** KRISTAL DREAM (8) has shown good ability in harness races and, presented with confidence by his connections, is an interesting prospect on his mounted debut. ILLICO DE LOU (7) was only beaten by two progressive six-year-old mares last time out and should be very prominent. JET DU RAVARY (5) is better than his latest run suggests. KHAZAR DES CORVEES (3), barefoot for the first time under the saddle, is an intriguing outsider from the front.

## C8 - PRIX FRANCIS JOLIT - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. NILDA LAND** - Disqualified last time out at this course over 2650m on 16 June. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 2. NINO DE LIGNY** - Has done little wrong so far and was runner-up at Angoulême over 2750m on 14 June. Tougher task but could make the frame
- 3. NADA MAS HILLPERON** - Successful last time out in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 19 June. Tougher task but might well follow up
- 4. NIGHT DE LA COUR** - Disqualified last time out in a claimer at Graignes over 2700m on 13 June. Had some fair form before that and could earn some money
- 5. NAIADE VRIE** - A runner-up in three of last four starts, the latest in Class D at Chartres over 2800m on 17 June. Big chance in this line-up
- 6. NICE GIRL DU MIDI** - Showed some improvement when third in class F at Bollene over 2800m on 28 June. Liked the grass but might play a minor role
- 7. NOUMA ROSA** - Not disgraced when fifth in Class D over this course and distance on 16 June. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 8. NOLANN DES AGETS** - Disqualified last time out at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 3 June. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 9. NEVADA DARBY** - Disqualified last time out in Class D at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Successful before that but this is a tougher task

**Summary:** A tricky lucky last race. NAIADE VRIE (5) lacks experience racing right-handed but arrives on the back of two solid efforts and could well have her day. NADA MAS HILLPERON (3) opened her account in convincing fashion at Marseille-Borély and, although the opposition is stronger this time, she is capable of confirming. NOUMA ROSA (7) performed better than her finishing position suggests last time and is preferred ahead of NINO DE LIGNY (2), who has been convincing in his last two outings.
