

R5 LA GACILLY [LA GACILLY]

C4 - GRAND PRIX DE LA GACILLY - 3100m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 50,000

- 1. KHARA DRY** - Disqualified last time out in Class E at Meslay-Du-Maine over 2875m on 28 July. Had some fair form before that and could play a minor role if smart
- 2. KINGSTON DE BLARY** - Excellent runner-up in a Class D at Lisieux over 2,725m on 15 July. Knocking on the door and is barefoot, so ready to strike
- 3. HOTESSE NAY** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class F at St Jean De Monts over 2,625m on 2 August. Can earn some minor money at very best
- 4. HELLO DAXEL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class F at Evommoy over 2750m on 19 July. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. GRANDIOSE DES PRES** - Finished 11th in a Class F at Ecommoy over 2,750m on 19 July. Struggling to find best form and others are preferred
- 6. GALLAGHER WIND** - Finished 16th in a Claimer at Vincennes over 2,850m on 21 April. Returns from a break and looks likely to need this run
- 7. HALL BLACK MESS** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, including last time out in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 29 July. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 8. JASON** - Unplaced last time out in Class D at Carentan over 2900m on 26 July. Fitter and barefoot this time. Can earn some money
- 9. INHERIT** - Not disgraced when fifth in Class D at Montignac 3350m on 23 July. Can play a minor role for Eric Raffin
- 10. IMELDA** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class C at Enghien over 2,875m on 25 July. Can be competitive yet again
- 11. ILEO PIERJI** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class D at Montignac over 3325m on 23 July. Has a place chance on best form
- 12. HELIOS SI** - Finished 8th in a Class B at Enghien over 2,875m on 22 July. Unreliable and probably needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 13. ILTON ROYAL** - Finished 5th in a Class B Apprentices' race at Enghien over 2,875m on 17 March. Not reliable and could need this run returning from a break
- 14. HERO SIBEY** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class D at Carentan over 2850m on 26 July. Improving and could make the frame
- 15. KING OPERA** - Made short work of rivals in a Class A at Royan-La Palmyre over 3,100m on 19 July. Has won two stages of Green Trophy and can complete the hat-trick
- 16. IDEAL DU ROCHER** - Not disgraced when fifth at Solvalla over 1,640m on 30 May. Has ability and should contest the finish

Summary: Already a winner of two legs of the Green Trophy and despite starting from a 50-meter handicap, KING OPERA (15) can shine once again in this event. IDEAL DU ROCHER (16), racing barefoot from his comeback, along with KINGSTON DE BLARY (2) may be the best chance on the front line. HERO SIBEY (14), who is clearly on the upgrade, look set to challenge him as well.
