

## R3 AMIENS [R-H]

**C1 - PRIX DE LA BAIE DE SOMME - 2400m (a1m1/2) - Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000**

- 1. JANETTE TY** - Unreliable but finished third in Class F at Craon over 2775m on 6 July. Can get involved with the finish
- 2. JUNIOR DU GADE** - Disqualified in three of the last four starts, including last time out in Class F at Arras over 2900m on 21 June. Hard to trust but can score when smart
- 3. JUST A WINNER** - Battling to find best form and finished 8th in Class G at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 27 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. HECTOR DE CORDAY** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class G at Arras over 2900m on 21 June. Capable of better and is not out of it
- 5. KABOTIN CHENEVIERE** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 February. Could need this run returning from a break
- 6. GYPSIE MAGIQUE** - Victorious last time out in Class G at Caen over 2200m on 22 June. Broke a long losing run that day but might well follow up
- 7. IMITCH DU MOULIN** - Disqualified twice in the last three starts, including last time out at Arras over 2900m on 21 June. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 8. JAMBAVAN** - Has struggled of late and was 11th at Mons over 2300m on 26 May. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 9. ICAM** - Faulted last time out at Moulins in Class F over 2800m on 5 July. Unreliable but might earn some minor money

**Summary:** A competitive looking opening event. GYPSIE MAGIQUE (6) recently returned to winning ways in a similar event at Caen. The field looks weaker this time, and she appears capable of following up. Generally reliable, HECTOR DE CORDAY (4) is racing in his category and should lead the opposition. JANETTE TY (1) drops in class but is not the most consistent. If he behaves, JUNIOR DU GADE (2) can bounce back and contest the finish.

## C2 - PRIX DES HORTILLONNAGES - 2400m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. NYMEAS D'ELA** - A winner of a class F at Bernay over 2800m on 31 May. Improving and does look capable of doubling up in this line-up
- 2. NAYKO DE LA CRIERE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class E at this track over 2900m on 11 June. Should contest the finish
- 3. NANCY ANGANO** - Successful in a class G at Ranés over 2150m on 21 June. Tougher task but cannot be ruled out from following up
- 4. NELSON DAIRPET** - Disqualified in three of four starts, including last time out in a class E at Cherbourg over 2625m on 24 June. Can be a threat if staying in stride
- 5. NOHOLITA MAY** - Finished 7th in a class E at Caen over 2450m on 15 June. A bit of a disappointment that day but can be a threat to these rivals
- 6. NAHIA DIBAH** - Successful in a class F mounted race at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 4 April. Has disqualification issues and is probably better under the saddle
- 7. NEW TALK SHOW** - Holding form and was third in a class F at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. can get involved with the finish once again
- 8. NOBLESSE DU CHENE** - Finished third in a class D at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Has disqualification issues but can earn some money if smart
- 9. NUAGE DU RABUTIN** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class F at Reims over 2550m on 20 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 10. NOBLESSE DE JANY** - Victorious in a class G at Chalons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Has improved with each start and can make the frame
- 11. NICEGIRL DE TAVIET** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class F at Laon over 2850m on 7 June. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 12. NIKITA DE MONCHEL** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a class F at this track over 2400m on 27 June. Needs to do a bit more to score

**Summary:** NYMEAS D'ELA (1) opened his account in authoritative fashion on the grass track at Bernay and looks set for a bright future. NEW TALK SHOW (7) already has some experience and should quickly reward his new connections. NAYKO DE LA CRIERE (2) is likely to benefit from the step up in distance. With some improvement, NOHOLITA MAY (5) can get involved in the fight for top honours.

### C3 - PRIX DU CROTOY - 2400m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 17,500

1. **MAHINE D'OCCAGNES** - Showed some improvement when third in a class F at this track over 2900m on 11 June. Has a place chance
2. **MY LOVE STORY** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a class E over this track and trip on 8 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
3. **MAFIA DU BAS BOSQ** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in a class F at Caen over 2200m on 30 May. Remains barefoot and more is needed to score
4. **MAYA DU LANDREAU** - Did not show her best when 8th in a class F at Lisieux over 2725m on 30 June. Remains barefoot and has a place chance in this line-up
5. **MOURASIE LEPINE** - Disqualified in a class F at Jallais over 2975m on 14 June. not easy to trust but can make the frame when smart
6. **MY QUEEN BLUE** - Unreliable and was fifth in a class F at La Roche-sur-Yon over 2600m on 28 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
7. **MAIN D'OR** - Often competitive and was third in a class F at Bernay over 2800m on 28 June. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
8. **MISS WINNER** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 27 June. Can play a minor role when staying on the trot
9. **MAROUBRA** - A winner of a class G at Le Touquet over 2600m on 20 June. Clearly unreliable but is capable of doubling up
10. **MISS FINE** - In good form and finished fourth in a class F at Nancy over 2600m on 26 June. Yet to win but can make the frame
11. **MISS TERBEKEN** - Very consistent and was third at Mons over 2300m on 28 April. Consistent and is capable of scoring in a very open looking race
12. **MICKAELLA** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class F at this track over 2900m on 11 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred
13. **MIA DU BLEQUIN** - In good form and was third in a class F at Reims over 2500m on 20 June. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish once again
14. **MISSY MELODY** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 27 June. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal

**Summary:** A very open contest. MISS TERBEKEN (11) arrives from Belgium on the back of several good performances. Even though she is returning from a short break, her connections have secured the services of Benjamin Rochard, and she looks capable of scoring. MIA DU BLEQUIN (13) appears to be settling with experience. Constantly improving, MISS FINE (10) has solid claims. MAROUBRA (9) did not have to exert herself much to score at a lower level and could make the frame.

## C4 - PRIX DE CAYEUX SUR MER - 2400m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 17,500

1. **MY SIMON** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 22 June. Capable of contesting the finish
2. **MONOGAME** - In good shape and was third in a class F at Reims over 2500m on 23 April. Can get into the mix of things once again
3. **MON ROYAUME** - Disqualified last time out in a class F at Laon over 2850m on 7 June. In good form before that and could play a minor role when smart
4. **MANSFIELD D'OYSE** - A winner of two of last three starts, including last time out in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 4 July. Remains barefoot and can score again
5. **MIVASO DU JACKY** - Did not show his best when 8th in a class F at Lisieux over 2725m on 20 June. Has a place chance on best form
6. **MARNAON VINGUY** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class F at Villedieu-les-Poeles over 2800m on 3 July. Capable of an upset
7. **MISTER MARTIN** - Showed some improvement and was a runner-up in a class F over this course and distance on 27 June. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
8. **MUST WIN DE REM** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class F at Les Andelys over 2525m on 21 June. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
9. **MAESTRO DE FERFAY** - Unreliable but was third in a class F at Nancy over 2600m on 26 June. Capable of making the frame yet again
10. **MAN IN THE MIRROR** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class F at Nancy over 2600m on 26 June. Yet to win a race and more is needed to score
11. **MYSTIC VERTAC** - Did not show his best when 8th in a class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 24 May. Tries barefoot but does have disqualification issue
12. **MODEL DE JOUX** - Disqualified in a class F at Reims over 2500m on 23 April. Not easy to trust and might need to find a few lengths to score
13. **MIGNON DE LASTELLE** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a class F over this track and trip on 27 June. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role at best
14. **MAESTRO AWAGNE** - A four-year-old gelding by Treizième Jour out of Brise d'Awagne who is making his debut. His mother won 3 of her 74 starts. Could need this experience

**Summary:** MANSFIELD D'OYSE (4) turns out again quickly but did not appear to have emptied his tank when scoring at Graignes. He is the one to beat. MY SIMON (1), after a much-needed comeback run is a threat. MONOGAME (2), carefully campaigned by his connections, will be ready to pounce on any weakness from the selection. MAESTRO DE FERFAY (9) would only need to repeat his latest performance at Nancy to play a leading role.

## C5 - PRIX DE MERS LES BAINS - 2900m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **LEXUS DE GUIBRAY** - Finished 6th in a class H at Villedieu-les-Poeles over 2800m on 3 July. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset on best form
2. **LE BOSS DE LUBEL** - Knocking very loudly at the door and was runner-up in a class F at Reims over 2500m on 20 June. Can go one place better
3. **LAVEZZI PEJI** - Disqualified in a class E at Bernay over 2800m on 28 June. In good form before that but has yet to win a race. might place
4. **LOVHELEN D'OR** - Not reliable but was third in a class F at La Capelle over 1800m on 14 June. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
5. **LICENCE CASTELETS** - Disqualified in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 27 June. Remains barefoot and is capable of earning some money when smart
6. **LORD DE FONTAINE** - Not disgraced when fourth in a class F at Caen over 2450m on 15 June. Has improved of late and could score again
7. **LUDMILLA HAUFOR** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 1 June. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
8. **LYNX DU SAPTEL** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 20 February. Could need this run returning from a break
9. **LADY POP** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a class E at Bernay over 2800m on 28 June. Capable of much better and is not out of it
10. **LATINA TOURNIBOIS** - Unreliable but was a runner-up in a class D at this track over 2400m on 8 June. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
11. **LEGENDE DE NILREM** - Finished 9th in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 24 January. Returns from a break and could need this run
12. **L'INTOUCHABLE** - Finished 7th in a class D at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals

**Summary:** Well positioned on the front line, LORD DE FONTAINE (6) and LE BOSS DE LUBEL (2) look the most likely to fight out the finish. LORD DE FONTAINE (6) has shown improvement and gets the vote to score. Consistent overall and effective when racing barefoot, LOVHELEN D'OR (4) should once again be involved at the finish. Lighter in her shoeing after a comeback run, LADY POP (9) is another possible winner and must be considered.

## C6 - PRIX DE L'ETE AMIENOIS - 2900m (a2m) - Claiming - Mounted - EUR € 26,000

1. **JOKE DU HOUSSEL** - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a Class H mounted race at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 5 July. Needs to do more to score
2. **ICARE DE MONTFORT** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a Class E harness race at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 5 July. Tries a mounted race and could surprise
3. **ILEPSON** - Disqualified last time out in a Class F mounted race at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
4. **JOKER DE LA BRETTE** - Successful last time out in a Class F harness race at Nancy over 2600m on 26 June. Not reliable but can follow up
5. **JUST PACHA** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a Class E mounted race at Vichy over 2950m on 24 June. Can get involved with the finish
6. **JEDEO DES VAUX** - Not reliable but finished fourth in a Class E mounted race at Vichy over 2950m on 24 June. Has a place chance if smart
7. **IMTITI** - Disqualified twice in the last three starts, including last time out in a Class H mounted race at Montmirail over 3225m on 28 June. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
8. **JUSQUIAME** - Faulted last time out in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 29 June. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
9. **HEPAX SPEED** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class F mounted race at Moulins over 2800m on 28 June. Might earn some minor money
10. **ISARIC** - Unreliable and finished tenth in a Class H harness race at Granville over 3125m on 23 June. Did better in his penultimate start and has a place chance
11. **JANARDAL CLUB** - Victorious last time out in a Class F mounted race at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. Can double up and beat these rivals
12. **JACKPOT DU WALLON** - Successful in four of the last five starts, including last time out in a Class E harness race at Montmirail over 3200m on 28 June. Can score again

**Summary:** On his return to mounted racing, JOKER DE LA BRETTE (4) could go a long way on this track, which should suit him well. JANARDAL CLUB (11) scored impressively on his return to the discipline at La Capelle. Well known at this level, JUST PACHA (5) will have plenty of supporters. JACKPOT DU WALLON (12) has been in good form in harness races and could be a danger trying a mounted race this time.

## C7 - PRIX DE LA BAIE D'AUTHIE - 2900m (a2m) - Claiming - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. HIJO MOKO** - Has lost the way and was 10th in class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 2 July. Unreliable and others make more appeal
- 2. IPATINGA** - Only modest of late and was 6th in class H at Molieres over 2500m on 5 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. IGLOO DE BEAULIEU** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class E at Cherbourg over 2625m on 14 June. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
- 4. JOKER D'AMARO** - Victorious in Class E at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 5 July. Not reliable but is quite capable of following up
- 5. JURASSIC** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in class G at Reims over 2550m on 20 June. Should fight it out once again
- 6. IFALCO DE MAY** - Disqualified in class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 27 June. Unreliable this year but might play a minor role if at best
- 7. JALMAROSA** - Battling to find best form and was 7th in class F at Lisieux over 2675m on 2 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 8. INDIAN PARK** - Unreliable and was 9th in class F at Durtal over 2825m on 21 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 9. JICKY GIRL** - Consistent and was 3rd in a claimer at Enghien over 2150m on 27 June. Might earn some more minor money
- 10. JALBA DU FER** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class F at Arras over 2900m on 21 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 11. JOKER DU MATCH** - In good form and finished 3rd in class E at Ecommoy over 2750m on 20 June. Has claims in an open looking race
- 12. IGOLO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at Arras over 2900m on 21 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred

**Summary:** Close to winning, JOKER DU MATCH (11) can be a solid betting base in a race of this nature. JOKER D'AMARO (4) won last Sunday at Montier-en-Der after a strong battle. If he has recovered well from that effort, he looks capable of following up. JURASSIC (5) is very consistent and should fight out the finish once again. INDIAN PARK (8) particularly enjoys the Amiens track and is another that can get involved with the finish.

## C8 - PRIX DU PATRIMOINE PICARD - 2900m (a2m) - Claiming - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. JUMBO DES PRES** - Unreliable and was unplaced last time out in Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2725m on 1 June. Needs to do more to score
- 2. JAPPELOU** - Victorious in Class F at Durtal over 2825m on 21 June. In good shape and can get into the mix of things
- 3. IDEALE D'ABBEVILLE** - Disqualified in class E at Châteaubriant over 3000m on 7 June. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 4. ICLO** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in class F at Caen over 2450m on 16 March. Might play a minor role if smart
- 5. JEALOUS GIRL** - In good shape and was 3rd in class F at Enghien over 2150m on 23 June. Capable of making the frame once again
- 6. HECTOR DU MINON** - Disqualified in class F at Les Andelys over 2525m on 5 July. Battling to find best form and needs major improvement to score
- 7. JUGEMENT D'AVE** - Not disgraced when 5th in class E at this course over 2400m on 27 June. Capable of getting involved with the finish
- 8. JADORE D'ISQUES** - Threatening a victory and was runner-up in class F at Arras over 2900m on 21 June. Is in decent form and can score again
- 9. JOYCE DU VAL** - Returned to form and was runner-up in class F at Caen over 2450m on 18 June. Can go one place better
- 10. JAVA DU CHERISAY** - Disqualified in class F at Moulins-La-Marche over 2800m on 5 July. Has major disqualification issues and others make are preferred

**Summary:** An interesting lucky last race. Preference is given to the seven-year-olds, with JOYCE DU VAL (9), who was narrowly denied at Caen last time and should not be long in returning to winning ways. Unshod behind after two preparatory runs, JUGEMENT D'AVE (7) looks a serious contender. Very consistent, JADORE D'ISQUES (8) will once again give her all. A strong finisher, JEALOUS GIRL (5) will need a favourable race to show her best form but is not out of it.
