

R5 CAGNES-SUR-MER [L-H]

C1 - GRAND PRIX DE LA VILLE DE NICE - 2925m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 69,000

- 1. JERICHO** - Did not show his best when 9th in a class E over this track and trip on 1 August. Remains barefoot and can earn some money
 - 2. HEYDAY** - In good form and finished third in a Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 29 July. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
 - 3. COOL KRONOS** - Has struggled of late, finishing 7th in a Class B at Hyeres over 2,650m on 31 July 2026. Remains barefoot and is capable of doing better. Not out of it
 - 4. ASTRONASCENTE ZAC** - Unplaced in a class B at Hyeres over 2,650m on 31 July. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance in this line-up
 - 5. INTOUCHABLE** - Finished 8th in a Class D at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,800m on 6 July. Battling to find best form and makes little appeal
 - 6. GYS** - Holding form and was fourth in a Class C at this course over 2,150m on 29 July. Might play a minor role once again
 - 7. DANGER BI** - Remains in very good shape and was runner-up in a class C over this track and trip on 20 July. Remains barefoot and can be a lively danger
 - 8. CANTO DEI VENTI** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class C over this course and distance on 20 July. Needs to do a bit more to score
 - 9. IRON DU GERS** - Finished 4th in a Class C over this course and distance on 25 July. Remains barefoot and can make the frame once again
 - 10. FLOREAL** - Has struggled of late, finishing 7th in a Group 3 at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,950m on 27 July. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
 - 11. HUDO DU RUEL** - Very consistent and was runner-up in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 27 July. Remains barefoot and is capable of scoring
 - 12. HARLEY GEMA** - Returned to form and finished third in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 27 July. Remains barefoot and could be a threat to these rivals
- Summary:** The times posted by HUDO DU RUEL (11) and HARLEY GEMA (12), who finished second and third respectively here on July 27th, may be slightly misleading, but both still have strong claims. They will, however, face stiff competition from the front, notably the two Martens runners IRON DU GERS (9) and COOL KRONOS (3).

C2 - PRIX DE CIMIEZ - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 33,000

1. **LYRIKO BELLO** - Finished 7th in a Class B at this track over 2,925m on 27 July. May need to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
2. **LET ME SIXTY ONE** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class B at this course over 2,925m on 27 July. Remains barefoot and can play a minor role
3. **KANELLE STAR** - Disqualified last time out in a class D at this course over 2,925m on 27 July. In good form before that and might play a minor role if smart
4. **KIRA BO FACE** - Returned to form and was fourth in a Class E over this track and trip on 3 August. Distance suited and capable of scoring
5. **LORKY RED** - Successful in a Class C over this track and trip on 3 August. Remains barefoot and quite capable of doubling up
6. **LUTIN VENESI** - Finished 8th in a Class B at this course over 2,925m on 27 July. Reverts to barefoot and might make the frame this distance
7. **KAPORAL VISAIS** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class E at this course over 2,950m on 1 August. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
8. **LIVANTO KALOUMA** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a cCass B at this track over 2,925m on 27 July. Remains barefoot and can earn some money

Summary: KIRA BO FACE (4) barely got a chance to show her true ability here last time and, entrusted to Théo Briand, deserves another chance. LORKY RED (5) was a convincing winner in a blistering time over this course and distance so will be a formidable opponent if reproducing that effort. KAPORAL VISAIS (7), a different proposition when racing barefoot, and LUTIN VENESI (6), who has been prepared for this as his main target of the meeting, should not be underestimated.

C3 - PRIX DU REYRAN - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **KALAGA DU CADRAN** - Ultra-consistent and finished 3rd in a Class E at this track over 2,150m on 25 July. Can get into the mix of things yet again
2. **KYLLIAN** - Finished fifth in a Class E at this course over 2,150m on 25 July. Probably better over shorter distance but can earn some money
3. **KANSAS DE CASTELLE** - Knocking loudly at the door and was runner-up in a Class E at this course over 2,150m on 25 July. Must be respected in this line-up
4. **KRUNCHY** - Successful in a Class F at this course over 2,925m on 10 July. In good form and is capable of following up
5. **KISS ME** - Holding form and finished 4th in a Class D at Marseille Pont De Vivaux over 2,675m on 27 June. Remains barefoot and might earn some more minor money
6. **KATSUMOTO** - Finished 7th in a Class D at Hyeres over 2,650m on 5 July. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
7. **KRAK D'AZUR** - Unplaced in a Class F at Le Touquet over 2,625m on 20 June. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
8. **KELLY GEDE** - Disqualified last time out in a class D at this course over 2,925m on 27 July. In good form before that and might play a minor role if smart
9. **KISMET** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class D at Feurs over 2,850m on 3 July. Remains barefoot and can go one place better

Summary: KISMET (9) has no reason to be discouraged by finishing behind the talented Koureas d'Ela at Feurs and is reunited with Jean-Christophe Sorel, with whom he recorded his last two victories. He looks a logical choice. KRUNCHY (4), who recently returned to form over this course and distance is a danger. KANSAS DE CASTELLE (3) and KALAGA DU CADRAN (1), both tend to place more often than win but are clearly not out of it.

C4 - PRIX DE LA ROYA - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. LAIKA D'ESPACE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 27 July. Remains barefoot but is hard to trust and others are preferred
- 2. L'HISTOIRE SECRETE** - Returned to form and was third in a Class F at Montier-en-Der over 3,050m on 26 July. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
- 3. LIKE THAT** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class F at this course over 2,150m on 29 July. Has disqualification issues but can score
- 4. LILLY DE GOUYE** - Finished fourth in a Class F at this course over 2,150m on 29 July. Not reliable but is capable of making the frame
- 5. LUNA DE MALAC** - Finished fourth in a Class E over this course and distance on 13 July. Remains barefoot and has a place chance in this line-up
- 6. LETOILE AMERICAINE** - Disqualified in a Class E at Avignon over 2,650m on 24 May. Returns from a short break and could need this run
- 7. LOVELY LA CHENAIE** - Not disgraced when third in a Class E over this track and trip on 13 July. Can be competitive once again
- 8. LESLIE DE VANDEL** - Finished 7th in a Class E over this course and distance on 13 July. Unreliable but might play a minor role at very best

Summary: Seeking a win, LIKE THAT (3) has a good opportunity to achieve her goal in this fillies-only contest. She will, however, need to fend off L'HISTOIRE SECRETE (2), who is returning to form after a year on the sidelines. LOVELY LA CHENAIE (7) gets on particularly well with Nicolas Mortagne and should again be in the mix of things. LILLY DE GOUYE (4) is improving, could prove a serious spoiler.

C5 - PRIX DE L'OBSERVATOIRE DE LA COTE D'AZUR - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. MIGUEL DU CHERISAY** - Unreliable and finished fourth in a Class D at this track over 2,150m on 25 July. Capable of earning some more money
- 2. MADGIC STRYCK** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 1 August. Capable of scoring when staying in stride
- 3. MINK BOKO** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a Class E at this course over 2,925m on 29 July. Can contest the finish
- 4. MINDFREAK** - Looking to complete a hat track, the latest was a success in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 28 February. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough
- 5. MAX D'OLMEN** - Made short work of rivals in a Class E at this course over 2,150m on 17 July. Has won two of last three starts and can follow up
- 6. MYSTIC BOND** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 1 August. Remains barefoot and is capable of scoring
- 7. MAESTRO CASTELETS** - Not disgraced when third in a Class D at this course over 2,925m on 25 July. Can get into the mix of things once again
- 8. MILLER DU VIVIER** - Disqualified in a Class D at this track over 2,925m on 25 July. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
- 9. MAJOR JENILOU** - Disqualified in the last two starts, the latest in a Class E at this course over 2,925m on 29 July. Remains barefoot but is hard to trust and others are preferred
- 10. MILLESIME STAR** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class D at this course over 2,925m on 25 July. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal

Summary: A tricky looking race. Carefully managed, MINDFREAK (4) is only entered when the conditions are right and has been prepared with this comeback in mind. He will, however, have no margin for error against MAX D'OLMEN (5), who has a similar profile, and MINK BOKO (3), who is capable of going fast and staying the distance. MAESTRO CASTELETS (7), in impeccable form is another with a chance of scoring.

C6 - PRIX FANEUR - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. NEMROD GEDE** - Victorious in a Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 25 July. Showed what he is capable of and must be respected in this line-up
- 2. NAPOLEON DE GOUYE** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 3 August. Might earn some minor money
- 3. NOLANN DES AGETS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class D at this track over 2,150m on 3 August. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 4. NO WOMAN ERCA** - A winner of a Class F over this course and distance on 29 July. Distance suited and is clearly not out of it
- 5. NISSA STAR** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a Class D at Hyeres over 2,650m on 31 July. Has a place chance
- 6. NOUMEA D'AMOUR** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a Class C over this track and trip on 27 July. Capable of earning some money
- 7. NYCIA RED** - In good shape and was third in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 3 August. Quite capable of getting involved with the finish
- 8. NADA MAS HILLPERON** - Disqualified in a Class C over this track and trip on 27 July. Not easy to trust but can be a threat when smart
- 9. NILDA LAND** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class E at this track over 2,150m on 17 July. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of scoring
- 10. NEVADA DARBY** - A winner of a Class D at Hyeres over 2,650m on 31 July. Not reliable but is capable of doubling up in this line-up
- 11. NOT A BAD DEAL** - Made short work of rivals in a Class E at this course over 2,150m on 20 July. Not reliable but can follow up
- 12. NIKKO DE JOUDES** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class C at Hyeres over 2,650m on 1 May. Returns from a break and could need this run

Summary: A very open looking race. In this field of promising three-year-olds, NEVADA DARBY (10) and NOT A BAD DEAL (11), both impressive winners last time out, hold the advantage on paper. However, the fillies NILDA LAND (9) and NYCIA RED (7), who filled the first two places in an exacta in mid-July, look capable of giving them plenty to think about.

C7 - PRIX COCO BEACH - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 8,000

1. **IKA JOSSELYN** - Disqualified twice in a row,, the latest in a Class F at Marseille-Borely over 2,300m on 24 June. Reverts to barefoot but is hard to trust and others are preferred
2. **GAETAN** - Disqualified in a Class E at Avignon over 2,650m on 18 April. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
3. **DANILO SPRITZ** - Successful twice in a row in Italy, the latest at Turin over 2060m on 1 July. Tougher task but is not out of it
4. **JIRENZO** - Finished 3rd in a Class G at this track over 2,925m on 5 August. Not reliable but can contest the finish
5. **JAMES BOND** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class F at Hyeres over 2,650m on 31 July. Remains barefoot and has a big winning chance
6. **KEROZEN** - Successful in a Class G at this course over 2,950m on 5 August. Drops in distance but can double up if staying in stride
7. **IBRA DE LOU** - Only modest of late, finishing 9th in a Class F at Hyeres over 2,650m on 31 July. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
8. **KEPI DU HOME** - Finished 4th in a Class F at over this track and trip on 8 July. Quite capable of earning some more money
9. **CANDY GROUP** - Consistent of late and was third at Turin over 1,620m on 22 July. Tougher task but might play a minor role
10. **ELETTRA GRIF** - A winner of her last two starts, the latest at Cecena over 1,660m on 4 July. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money

Summary: AMES BOND (5) arrives in good form and won with his current partner on his first start in the amateur category, making him a leading contender for this lucky last race. KEROZEN (6) has a similar profile, looks the main danger, while the Italian raiders DANILO SPRITZ (3) and ELETTRA GRIF (10) arrive on the back of two recent victories and could get involved with the finish.
