The latter is drawn in pole position and was only just beaten on her debut on the poly so could be dangerous this time. MISS MASTI MAKER put up a fair debut when running on nicely down the straight at Hollywoodbets Scottsville. She is well bred and is one to keep an eye on. CARTEL QUEEN and FLICKERING LIGHT must have earning potential in this contest.

BIG DIPPER showed some potential on debut on the turf at this venue. Interestingly, while bred for more he drops in distance and will have his work cut out again from the widest gate. XIPHOS has run some creditable races on this surface. He is better than his recent form and now returning to a suitable distance he can give of his best. RUN GEORGE RUN had valid excuses and should improve as his best run was on the poly.

He could get the race run to suit this time. GOT THE WORD is knocking at the door and may finally get the job done but needs to jump on terms. CAPPELLINO appreciated the step up to 1200m and finally got back to winning ways. He could prove dangerous but has drawn wider out.

CHAKALAKA has been showing good pace but not been finishing his races off. The drop in distance could do the trick. KAZ FROM ALCATRAZ is another that hasn't been suited to further and could pop up.

RED CARDINAL was second best behind NO PRESSURE last time out. He has to make up 2 lengths on his rival but is 1.5kg better off. GARDENER'S PRIDE could prove difficult to peg back off a light weight.

GREEN MILE displayed his love for the poly and can win coming off a rest. If allowed to dictate matters from the front he can be dangerous. SKIPPER ZIP has run well on the poly and from a good draw can make his presence felt. FINE ADMIRAL has run in stronger races and from a decent draw is one to keep an eye on. It would be good to see KING'S ISLAND come back to form. He is capable on this surface.
