C1 - HARAS DE FRESNAY-LE-BUFFARD PRIX DE TANCARVILLE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - - Flat - EUR €  
45,700

1. **MAJNOUN** - A two-year-old colt by Wootton Bassett out of Malicious who is making his debut. His dam won once in 7 starts but was placed twice in Listed races. Should be ready to score

2. **TRIPOLITAIN** - A two-year-old colt by Blue Point out of Symposium who is making his debut. His dam won a handicap. Capable of earning some money

3. **AIBAR** - A two-year-old colt by Kingman out of Provocateuse who is making his debut. His dam won once in 6 starts. Can be ready for this

4. **IMPERIAL STRIKE** - A two-year-old colt by Lucky Vega out of Smart Dorie who is making his debut. His dam never raced in France. Can challenge for top honours

5. **TAKAVOR** - A two-year-old colt by Goken out of Minnipa who is making his debut. His dam won once in 7 starts. Capable of making the frame

6. **ODU ILAM** - A two-year-old colt by Galiway out of Tishka who is making his debut. His dam never won a race after 11 starts. Can contest the finish

7. **MAHASIAH** - A two-year-old colt by Donjuan Triumphant out of Armelle d'Haguenet who is making his debut. His dam never won a race after ten starts. Could need this experience

**Summary:** By top sire Wootton Bassett and out of a Galileo mare, the Graffard-trained MAJNOUN (1) is likely to start as a strong favourite. Watch out for the Fabre-trained IMPERIAL STRIKE (4), whose pedigree suggests precocity. Closely related to our selection, AIBAR (3) is also likely to attract plenty of support. Partnered by Maxime Guyon, TAKAVOR (5) does not make the trip to Normandy without ambition so must be respected.

**1. HAVANISTA** - A two-year-old filly by Havana Gray out of So Hi Society who is making her debut. Her dam won once and was placed fourth in a Group 2. Monitor the betting

**2. PERKA FAL** - A two-year-old filly by Kameko out of Perfect Melody who is making her debut. Her dam was unraced in France. Others make more appeal

**3. ALDAYEN** - A two-year-old filly by Bayside Boy out of Schmusli who is making her debut. Her dam never won after four starts. Could need this experience

**4. OISEAU BLEU** - A two-year-old filly by Blue Point out of Miss Kittyhawk who is making her debut. Her dam was unraced in France. Can make the frame

**5. PERLE DE LUNE** - A two-year-old filly by City Light out of Keepthedreamalive who is making her debut. Her dam never won a race after 4 starts. Could need this experience

**6. PRIMETIME EMMY** - A two-year-old filly by Extreme Choice out of Princess Emmy who is making her debut. Her dam was unraced in France. Can score

**7. SAOUDIENNE** - A two-year-old filly by Olympic Glory out of Adriana who is making her debut. Her dam never raced in France. Can contest the finish

**8. AMNESIA** - A two-year-old filly by Showcasing out of Gonzeville who is making her debut. Her dam never won a race after 5 starts. Should be competitive

**9. VERITE VRAI** - A two-year-old filly by Armor out of Shazia who is making her debut. Her dam won once in 7 starts. Can make the frame

**10. DIVINA FE** - A two-year-old filly by Calyx out of Serendib's Glory who is making her debut. Her dam never raced in France. Could need this experience

**Summary:** By an Australian sire and out of a New Zealand mare—two countries renowned for producing top-class sprinters—PRIMETIME EMMY (6) could prove very quick. SAOUDIENNE (7) represents the somewhat unusual Rouget/Guyon combination and commands respect. Always effective with juveniles, the Lerner stable saddles the well-bred AMNESIA (8). The pedigree of OISEAU BLEU (4) also warrants close attention as well.

Handicap - Flat - EUR € 52,800**

- 1. MAI DIRE MAI** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Listed race at Chantilly over this distance on 31 May. Capable of earning some money on best form
- 2. WESTMINSTER CHERRY** - Did not show his best when tenth in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 5 May. Has been at best on the PSF but could be a threat to these rivals
- 3. ARDEN MIST** - Has only been modest this year and was 8th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1600m on 18 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. TANQUES** - Consistent and finished fourth in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over this distance on 12 June. First time in a handicap but should contest the finish
- 5. ZAHARA** - Improving and was victorious in a handicap at Chantilly over this distance on 4 May. Carries a penalty but can double up
- 6. VIZIOSA** - Has only been fair of late and was fifth in a handicap at Dieppe over 1100m on 6 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 7. MISTER GEORGE** - Finished fourth last time out in a claimer at Chantilly over this distance on 19 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 8. ORYA** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Conditions race at Dax over 1400m on 29 June. Tries a handicap and could play a minor role
- 9. MARBELLESA** - Consistent and finished third in a Conditions race at Angers over 1350m on 8 June. Can make the frame trying a handicap
- 10. ROZARION** - Did not show his best when 8th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 11 June. Can bounce back to beat these rivals
- 11. ELEGANTE WOMAN** - Not reliable and finished 11th in a handicap at Dax over 1400m on 18 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 12. MISS DE PANAME** - Off form and finished 11th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 11 June. More is needed to score
- 13. NAY** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 11 June. Can go one place better
- 14. SHY FEELING** - Finished third in a Conditions race at Marseille-Borély over 1200m on 12 June. Tries a handicap and is not out of it
- 15. GOUTTES DE DIEU** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 1400m on 11 June. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 16. DAISY DAISY** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a claimer at Chantilly over this distance on 19 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**Summary:** ROZARION (10). Trained by Mikel Delzangles, he has been knocking on the door and should not be judged on his latest run, where he was unlucky. The fillies NAY (13), for whom Jérôme Reynier has expressed strong confidence, and MARBELLESA (9), who should appreciate this track, look best placed to challenge him. TANQUES (4) has a good rapport with Alexis Pouchin and is always reliable, so he can be trusted. MARBELLESA (9) is consistent and should contest the finish.

- Flat - EUR € 21,100**

- 1. PRINCESSE BLONDE** - Not reliable and finished fifth in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 24 June. Capable of being a threat over this course and distance
- 2. DOUBLE EFFECT** - Successful last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1800m on 19 June. Probably better on the grass but can score carrying a penalty
- 3. BURATTINA** - Unreliable but was victorious in a claimer at Compiègne over 1800m on 13 June. Tackles tougher but is not out of it
- 4. KAPETANIOS** - Not reliable and finished fifth in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 2150m on 24 February. Could need this run returning from a break
- 5. SEIGNEUR** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a handicap at Compiègne over 2000m on 13 June. Not out of it in this line-up
- 6. KUPKA** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2500m on 24 May. Drops in distance and can earn some money
- 7. DARNETAL** - Not reliable but did finish fourth in a handicap at Aix-les-Bains over 2000m on 30 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 8. GIUSEPPE BALLOCCO** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a handicap at Compiègne over 1600m on 9 June. Needs major improvement to win
- 9. ACCLAM** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1600m on 24 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 10. FADO** - Off form and finished 9th in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1400m on 19 June. Others make more appeal
- 11. PROXIMA CENTAURI** - Finished 8th in a handicap at Lyon-La Soie over 2150m on 24 February. Returns from a break and should need this run
- 12. CARLSTON** - Not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1800m on 19 June. Can be a threat over this track and trip
- 13. MAIZIERES** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a handicap at Chantilly over 1800m on 19 June. Might play a minor role
- 14. SAVANNENSTERN** - Showed some improvement when third in a handicap at Compiègne over 1600m on 9 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 15. CORONADO** - In good shape and was runner-up in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 2 July. Can contest the finish
- 16. LAST SINN** - Unreliable but was successful last time out in a handicap at Chantilly over 1800m on 19 June. Carries a penalty but must be respected

**Summary:** A very open looking race. DOUBLE EFFECT (2) made a winning return for David Smaga and, equally effective on both sand and turf, will attempt to follow up. LAST SINN (16) recently landed his first handicap at the age of eight and could go in again. PRINCESSE BLONDE (1) is enjoying a very good year. A surface specialist, SEIGNEUR (5) is capable of settling matters with a strong turn of foot and is capable of shining brightly.

**C5 - HARAS DE FRESNAY-LE-BUFFARD PRIX JEAN PRAT - 1400m (a7f) - TURF - - Flat - EUR €  
400,000**

- 1. RAYIF** - Won the Poule D'Essai Des Poulains (Gr.1) on his return run of the year over 1600m on May 10. Top-class operator who should improve for that run and has leading claims
- 2. SAMANGAN** - Fair 6th last time in the Commonwealth Cup (Gr.1) at Ascot (UK) over 1200m on June 19. Group 2 and Group 3 success last year over 1200m and 1400m.In the mix
- 3. THESECRETADVERSARY** - Won on the last start over 1400m in the Jersey Stakes (Gr.3) at Ascot (Uk) on June 20. Up in class and warrants respect
- 4. GO MAN** - Recent 2nd in the Prix Paul De Moussac (Gr.2) over 1400m at Parislongchamp behind NIGHTTIME (7) on June 7. Others rate higher
- 5. TIME TO TURN** - Fair effort to be 2nd in a Listed race at Sandown (UK) over 1600m on May 28th when last seen. Might find a few too smart
- 6. IMPERIOR** - Finished 5th at Prix Paul De Moussac (Gr.2) over 1400m at Parislongchamp behind NIGHTTIME (7) on June 7. Must improve to trouble some of these
- 7. NIGHTTIME** - Nice success in the Prix Paul De Moussac (Gr.2) over 1400m at Parislongchamp on June 7 when last seen. Classy performer who warrants close attention
- 8. TRUE LOVE** - Solid Group 1 form, she won the English 1000 guineas (Gr.1) at Newmarket on May 3, and two placed runs since, the latter in the Coronation Stakes (Gr.1) when 3rd at Ascot (UK) over 1600m on June 19. Takes on the colts and must be respected

**Summary:** RAYIF (1) is expected to build on his winning seasonal return in the Poule d'Essai des Poulains (Gr.1) in early May and gets the vote. TRUE LOVE (8), winner of the English 1,000 Guineas, has since posted two excellent Group 1 efforts, most recently finishing a close third in the Coronation Stakes at Ascot, and rates the main danger. NIGHTTIME (7) comes here in top form after landing the Prix Paul de Moussac (Gr.2) on June 7 and should have another major role to play. THESECRETADVERSARY (3), the Jersey Stakes (Gr.3) winner at Ascot in June, completes the shortlist.

WEATHER - - Flat - EUR € 14,400**

- 1. AKAGERA** - Three unplaced runs recently, well beaten at Nancy over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap on May 20. Needs to get back on track
- 2. JOHNNY JANE** - Placed 4th on the last run over this track and trip in a Class 3 handicap on February 7. Fitness to prove and can be opposed
- 3. TWIN BOY** - Out of form of late, well held on the turf at Parislongchamp on July 2 over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap. Can bounce back at nice odds
- 4. ROYAL RIGHT** - Fair 4th last time over 1800m at Chantilly in a Class 3 handicap on the turf on June 19. Hard to dismiss
- 5. CLOUD MAN** - Finished 5th last time over 2000m at Parislongchamp in a Class 4 handicap on July 2. Among the leading chances
- 6. SEMEUR** - Three unplaced runs of late, a win before that over 2100m on the PSF at Pornichet in a Class 3 handicap on January 3. Hard to fancy
- 7. DIAMONDS** - Three unplaced efforts of late, the most recent over 1900m at this track in a handicap on December 12. She won on turf last year, and has placed form over this track and trip last November. Pass over
- 8. ANONYME** - Two unplaced runs recently, the latter on June 4, 3rd on April 7 over this track and trip in a Class 4 handicap and a track and trip win last October in a Class 4 race. Can be involved
- 9. SPINNING MIST** - Ran a better race to be 3rd at Senonnes over 2300m on March 13 in a Class 4 handicap last time out. Has work to do to feature
- 10. COMTESSE VERA** - Finished 6th last time over 1800m at Dieppe on June 23 in a Class 4 handicap. Unlikely to trouble some of these
- 11. BELLA CIAO** - Recent 7th over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap at Parislongchamp on July 2. She won on the PSF on December at Pornichet. Outside place chance
- 12. YOUM IN LOVE** - Creditable 5th last time over 1600m at Compiegne in a Class 4 handicap on June 9. And two placed runs on the PSF in May at Chantilly. Player
- 13. ZAADOR** - Ran well to be 2nd over 2000m at Chatillon in a Class 4 race on June 8. Good racing weight and can make the top four
- 14. ECLAIR DE VATI** - Reasonable effort when 5th over 2300m at Senonnes in a Class 4 handicap on March 13, and a win over 2500m at this track in a Class 4 on January 22. Better over a stiffer test of stamina
- 15. DSCHINGIS ANGEL** - Well held in a Class 4 handicap at Senonnes over 2300m on March 13, placed over 2500m at this track in February in a Class 4 handicap. Looking for her first win after 27 runs
- 16. LA MOMY** - Three unplaced runs of late, the latter on June 13 in a Class 3 handicap. She won at Chantilly over 1900m on May 4 in a Class 4 handicap on this surface. Ought to be thereabouts

**Summary:** YOUM IN LOVE (12) is well drawn and acquitted himself well enough on turf last month when he was fifth at Compiegne. Back on a surface that he likes he is preferred ahead of CLOUD MAN (5) , who was a decent fifth at Parislongchamp 10 days ago and likes the PSF surface. ANONYME (8) ran well to be third over this track and trip in April and is a previous course winner last October. She is one to keep onside, as is AKAGERA (1), who is better than her latest form figures and looks like an option for the each way backers to latch on to.

**C7 - HARAS DE FRESNAY-LE-BUFFARD PRIX DE BEAUMONT-LE ROGER - 1200m (a6f) - TURF -  
Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 26,900**

1. **ROCK OF ROSHA** - She has been placed on all three runs this year, 4th on the latter over 1200m at Marseille Borely in a maiden race on June 12. One to keep safe
2. **CROOK** - Finished 3rd last time over 1100m at Dieppe in a handicap on June 6. One to pay close attention to
3. **SANAWARI** - Placed 2nd on his last run over 1500m at Marseille Vivaux in a handicap on June 6. Others seem to be better equipped
4. **SIGHISH** - Recent 6th over 1400m in a maiden race on June 20. Tries a handicap today and warrants attention each-way
5. **SBIKHA** - Two wins of late, the most recent over 1100m at La Teste in a handicap on June 26. Creeping up in the handicap but merits consideration
6. **SKY DREAM** - Placed 4th on the last three runs, the latter over 1400m at Parislongchamp on June 11 in a handicap. Enters each-way calculations
7. **TERRITOIRE** - Ran well to score over 1400m at Parislongchamp in a handicap on June 15 when last seen. Hard to ignore
8. **THIBERVILLE** - Decent 4th over 1200m at Chantilly in a handicap on May 4 when last appearing. Might find a few of these too smart
9. **BAIETA** - Finished 7th on her third run over 1100m at Dieppe in a maiden race on May 16. Handicap debut and can be opposed
10. **WHY AM I BEAUTIFUL** - Encouraging 2nd over 1100m at La Teste in a handicap on June 26 and has acquitted herself well before that. In the mix
11. **DAMN PRECIOUS** - Finished 7th over 1100m at Dieppe on June 6 in a maiden race last time. Hard to be enthusiastic about
12. **PRINCESS ZALTANA** - 5th on her latest start over 1200m at Chantilly in a claiming race on June 19. Still looking to get off the mark after 13 runs
13. **DHIFUSHI** - Got off the mark over 1100m in a handicap at Dieppe on June 23 when last appearing. Looks progressive and can be on the premises
14. **ZANINA** - Finished 6th on her last run over 1350m at Cholet in a maiden race on June 30. Unlikely to be a threat
15. **STAR FIXX** - Well beaten in 13th over 1400m in a maiden race at Saint-Cloud on June 2 when last seen. Can be opposed
16. **KENDARO** - Placed 2nd on his most recent start over 1100m at Dieppe in a handicap on June 6. Can be effective from the foot of the weights

**Summary:** KENDARO (16) ran a pleasing race when second at Dieppe recently over 1100m early last month and can be effective over this extra 100m. He gets the vote ahead of TERRITOIRE (7), who won over 1400m at Parislongchamp in mid-June and should not be inconvenienced by the slight drop back in distance. CROOK (2) ran well when third in the same handicap as the main selection last month and has solid claims each-way. SBIKHA (5) is seeking a hat-trick of wins and warrants respect despite her rise in the handicap.

- 1. PIERRE LE GRAND** - Placed on his last four runs, 2nd on the most recent over 1800m at Salon Provence in a Class 4 race on June 17. Key chance
- 2. GRAND MACHO** - Finished 6th on his most recent start over 1500m at Deauville in a Class 4 race on June 26. Warrants respect despite a wide draw in 15
- 3. HEMATITE** - Several unplaced runs of late, well beaten in 11th at Nantes in a Class 4 handicap over 2400m on July 1. Hard to recommend
- 4. RED GRACE** - Finished 6th on July 2 in a Class 4 race, 2nd before that at Orleans in a Class 4 race over 2200m on May 17. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 5. RIVER QUARTZ** - He has been unplaced in four runs this year, well held in a Class 3 handicap at Compiègne on June 13 when beating only one rival. Others preferred
- 6. BOBBY JEAN** - Finished 2nd at Chantilly in a Class 3 handicap on June 19 when last seen. Well handicapped and can be competitive
- 7. ILLUSTRE BERE** - Nice 4th over 2300m at Angers on May 2 in a Class 4 handicap on his last outing. Capable of making an impact
- 8. DARIYANGEL** - Below par on June 5 on turf, but a decent 3rd at Chantilly on the PSF over 1900m in a Class 4 handicap on May 19 was a better effort. Likes this surface and can not be discounted
- 9. HEY MAN** - Not disgraced when 6th over 2000m at Le Lion D'Angers on June 5 in a Class 4 handicap. Has work to do to make the frame
- 10. DAHARIZ** - Two unplaced runs of late, 3rd before that over 1900m at Argentan on April 9 in a Class 4 handicap. Look for an alternative
- 11. ESTELLA MOBRAY** - Two wins this year from three runs, the most recent over 1950m at Chateaubriant in a Class 4 handicap on May 5. Placed form on the PSF at Pornichet. This will be more difficult
- 12. GOLDEN RIVER** - Finished 6th on the last run over 2300m at Senonnes in a Class 4 handicap on March 13. One to steer clear of
- 13. LA JAVANAISE** - Finished 7th over 2000m at Compiègne in a Class 3 handicap on June 13 last time. Track winner over 2500m in August 2025. Outside place contender
- 14. CIRCO MASSIMO** - Two unplaced runs this year, well held over 2000m at Parislongchamp on July 2 in a Class 3 handicap when last seen. Faces a stiff challenge
- 15. POLMINHAC** - Not seen since a well beaten 12th at this track on December 29 in a Class 4 handicap. Course winner in 2025 over this distance in a Class 4 handicap on July 2025. Best watched for now
- 16. KAPO ROSSO** - Recent 4th at Craon in a Class 4 handicap on June 4 over 2400m. Could be suited by a stiffer test of stamina

**Summary:** PIERRE LE GRAND (1) has been running consistently well without getting his head in front this season and can gain a deserved success. A solid runner-up at Salon Provence last time, he should appreciate the return to the PSF. ILLUSTRE BERE (7) rates the main danger after two placed efforts on turf this year and is equally effective on this surface. BOBBY JEAN (6) returned to form with a runner-up finish at Chantilly in June and appeals as a solid each-way contender. GRAND MACHO (2) completes the shortlist.
