VIRIDIAN RUBY made a pleasing debut when staying on well. She is drawn nicely and can only improve. PEACH COBBLER can be dangerous as she finally lands a good draw and must be respected.

IGNITE THE FIRE didn't do badly in sprints recently and should relish the step up in distance. He is one to watch for big improvement. ROCKANROLLIN appears a bit better than last performance from the widest draw. He could be a threat this time. Many more with earning potential.
