C1 - PRIX DE NOUZONVILLE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. NOBELL DALLAUCH** - In good form and finished third in Class E over this course and distance on 26 July. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of scoring
- 2. NORWEGIAN GIN** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class E at Deauville-Clairefontaine over 2925m on 12 July. Others make more appeal
- 3. NEWTON DE L'AVRE** - Very consistent and finished third in Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 25 July. Should challenge for top honours this time around
- 4. NINETY TWO** - Not disgraced when fifth in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 31 July. Often competitive and is not out of it in this line-up
- 5. NATO JOSSELYN** - Successful twice in just four starts, including last time out in Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 30 July. Has disqualification issues but can double up
- 6. NOLIO DU BARBEY** - Disqualified last time out in Class D at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 5 August. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 7. NIMEO FLOWER** - Disqualified last time out in Class C at this course over 2875m on 18 April. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 8. NERPRUN** - - Disqualified last time out in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 31 July. In good form before that and is a threat if smart this time
- 9. NINO VERO** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 6th in Class E at this course over 2875m on 6 August. Has disqualification issues and more is needed to score
- 10. NUSTANG JOLY** - Returned from a short break and finished 8th in Class E over this course and distance on 26 July. Fitter this time and might play a minor role
- 11. NURLAN** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2875m on 6 August. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

Summary: NATO JOSSELYN (5) should be capable of making his presence felt in a field of this nature if putting his best foot forward. NOBELL DALLAUCH (1) looks ready to open his account and is a threat. NINETY TWO (4) failed to show his best at Cabourg last time, is another with the ability to bounce back. NEWTON DE L'AVRE (3), who will be driven by Alexandre Abrivard, also merits consideration.

C2 - PRIX DE VAUVILLERS - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MADE IN MARETTES** - Disqualified in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,775m on 31 July. Reverts to barefoot and can get involved with the finish
- 2. MISTER YELLOW** - Unplaced in a Class D at this track over 2,150m on 25 July. Battling to fine best form and others are much preferred
- 3. MEDICI DE BUSSET** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Class D at Laval over 2,850m on 25 June. Can complete the treble of wins
- 4. MIGUEL DE LOU** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in a Class D at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,650m on 11 July. Remains barefoot and can get involved with the finish once again
- 5. MARCUS BERRY** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 25 July. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 6. MYLEY ELDE** - Consistent and fourth in a Class D at Vichy over 2,950m on 1 August. Remains barefoot and has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. MEGINO** - Finished fourth in a Class D at Rochefort Sur Loire over 3,000m on 3 August. Has some fair form and could ean some more money
- 8. MAJON** - Not disgraced when third in a Class D over this track and trip on 16 July. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 9. MOONLIGHT DU RHIN** - Showed improvement and was runner-up in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 25 July. Hard to trust but cannot be ruled out
- 10. MAGNIFICAT** - Unplaced in a Class D at Clairefontaine over 2,900m on 13 July. Remains barefoot and will be fitter this time. Can upset on best form
- 11. MISTER MOUROTAIS** - In very good form and was runner-up in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 25 July. Can go one place better this time
- 12. MAJOR MESLOIS** - In good form and was third in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,750m on 31 July. Capable of earning some more minor money
- 13. MACBETH** - Finished 7th in a Class D over this course and distance on 16 July. Remains barefoot and could be a threat on best form
- 14. MEGAFLO BELLO** - In good shape and was fourth in a Class D over this track and trip on 16 July. Capable of making the frame once again
- 15. MELKIOR CASTELLE** - Disqualified in a Class B at Meslay-du-Maine over 2,875m on 28 July. Reverts to barefoot and could upset if staying in stride

Summary: MISTER MOUROTAIS (11) shaped well when finishing strongly over this track and trip on July 25th, his first start for Alexis Grimault, and is taken to confirm that promise. MAJON (8) is in good form and should be competitive. MEDICI DE BUSSET (3), who combines with Éric Raffin, forms a formidable partnership and must be respected. MIGUEL DE LOU (4) continues to improve and can also have a say,

C3 - PRIX DE JOUY EN JOSAS - 2875m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. NUTTY DREAM** - Successful last time out in Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 25 July. In good form and looks capable of doubling up
- 2. NOVA DU FER** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class C over this course and distance on 2 August. She can make the frame when staying in stride
- 3. NANCY BOURBON** - Has done little wrong so far and was victorious last time out in Class D at Maquenchy over 2850m on 5 August. Has ability and can complete a hat-trick
- 4. NOTRE FLIBUSTE** - Successful twice in just four starts and finished third last time out in Class D at Pornichet over 2725m on 23 July. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 5. NEPTUNA** - Victorious twice in just three starts, including last time out in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 14 July. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 6. NEUILLY** - Yet to win a race but was third last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 7 April. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 7. NOBLESSE MIKA** - Disqualified last time out in Class D at Biarritz over 2975m on 23 July. In good form before that but this does look a tougher task
- 8. NOTRE HISTOIRE** - Has only been modest of late and was fifth in Class D over this track and trip on 26 July. Might play a minor role
- 9. NO ONE** - Finished unplaced last time out in Class A at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 April. Returns from a break but is a threat to these rivals if fit enough
- 10. NICE GRIFF** - - A winner of her last two starts, the latest in Class E at this course over 2150m on 11 July. Better over shorter distances but cannot be ruled out
- 11. NIGHT DE REUX** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in Class A at this course over 2150m on 29 July. Could be better over that distance but must be respected in this line-up

Summary: A wide-open contest features several runners with leading claims, headed by NUTTY DREAM (1), who impressed at Le Mans and now has Benjamin Rochard in the sulky. NEPTUNA (5), a Duvaldestin-trained talent who has been faultless so far, is another major player. Recent course winners NIGHT DE REUX (11) and NICE GRIFF (10) command some respect as well.

C4 - PRIX DE LA PORTE DE PASSY - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 52,000

- 1. TOSCANA SOUTHWIND** - Disqualified last time out in a Class E at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,650m on 6 July. Not easy to trust but could be the surprise package of the race
- 2. KOSY D'ERONVILLE** - Finished fourth in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 19 June. Remains barefoot and can get involved with the finish once again
- 3. KLASSE DE BRUZEAU** - Unreliable but was a runner-up in a Class F at Rochefort Sur Loire over 3,000m on 3 August. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 4. JEALOUS GIRL** - Finished 6th in a Class E at La Capelle over 2,700m on 24 July. Capable of doing better and might play a minor role at very best
- 5. EL DORADO BAR** - Made short work of rivals in a Class F over this track and trip on 29 July. In good form and can follow up if smart
- 6. FASHION MONGER** - A winner of a Class C at this course over 2,875m on 13 June. Remains barefoot and is capable of doubling up this distance
- 7. INTREPIDE TURGOT** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 13 July. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 8. KARVINA D'ELA** - Not disgraced when third in a Class D at Laval over 2,850m on 25 June. Very consistent and is clearly not out of it
- 9. VASTERBO BLIZZARD** - Finished 6th on in a Class F at Enghien over 2,150m on 22 July. Remains barefoot and needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 10. BEENTHERESEENTHAT** - Unplaced in a Class F over this track and trip on 22 July. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 11. PURE STEEL** - Finished 4th in a Class F over this course and distance on 29 July. Remains barefoot and can be a threat to these rivals
- 12. EMPIRE AS** - Disqualified in a Class F at Enghien over 2,150m on 29 July. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
- 13. MERCEDES STAR** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class F over this track and trip on 22 July. Remains barefoot and is capable of doubling up
- 14. UNDERGROUND ARTIST** - In good shape and was a runner-up in a Class F over this course and distance on 22 July. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
- 15. RAGAZZA DU CHENE** - Victorious in a Class F over this course and distance on 25 July. Not reliable but cannot be ruled out from more success
- 16. EVER SO MUCH** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class F at Argentan over 1,609m on 8 August. Remains barefoot but is not easy to trust and others make more appeal

Summary: EL DORADO BAR (5) was a convincing winner over this course and distance on July 29th and is taken to follow that up. FASHION MONGER (6) gets on particularly well with Éric Raffin, rates a serious threat. KOSY D'ERONVILLE (2) is ideally placed at the top of the earnings bracket and should be involved as well. The consistent KARVINA D'ELA (8) is another to consider despite a difficult draw behind the starting gate.

- 1. HEAVEN D'ECAJEUL** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class E at La Capelle over 2,700m on 24 July. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 2. HELEN DES OUBEAUX** - Fifth in a Class E at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 24 July. Battling to find best form but might play a minor role
- 3. HOUSTON DE CUIGNY** - Unplaced in a Class E at Enghien over 2,150m on 4 July. Remains barefoot and could be a surprise package for Alexandre Abrivard
- 4. HEAGLE ONE** - Disqualified in a Class E at Agon-Coutainville over 3,475m on 7 August. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 5. HORSERIS** - Has only been modest f late and finished 6th in a Class E at Le Mans over 2,950m on 25 July. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 6. HAPPY ATOUT** - Holding form and finished fourth in a claimer over this course and distance on 2 August. Remains barefoot but more is needed to beat these rivals
- 7. GISARO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class E at this course over 2,150m on 6 August. Remains barefoot and can be a threat when smart
- 8. HEROS DHELPA** - Finished 10th in a Class E at Enghien over 2,150m on 6 August. Not reliable but is capable of bouncing back to score
- 9. GENERAL DE CONNEE** - Finished 8th in a Class E Apprentices' race at Pornichet over 2,725m on 6 August. Reverts to barefoot and can win a race of this nature
- 10. HORACE D'ARTHENAY** - Unplaced in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,775m on 24 July. Reverts to barefoot and could be ready to strike
- 11. HATE YOU BEYLEV** - Finished ffth in a Class D over this course and distance on 8 August. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role
- 12. FIRST LADY BLEUE** - Disqualified in a Class D at Eauze over 3,050m on 2 August. On a long losing run and others are much preferred
- 13. HERAKLION DESBOIS** - Finished 7th in a Class D at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,650m on 8 August. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
- 14. HETRE D'OURVILLE** - Finished 9th in a Class D at La Capelle over 2,700m on 20 July. Off form and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 15. HERMES PAT** - Finished fifth in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 25 July. Better this distance and could contest the finish

Summary: Another very competitive-looking race. HEROS DHELPA (8) produced a much better effort than his finishing position suggests last time and can bounce back and score. GENERAL DE CONNEE (9), racing barefoot with Éric Raffin, is another leading contender. The tricky GISARO (7) has the ability to feature if keeping his action. HORACE D'ARTHENAY (10), reunited with Benjamin Rochard, also warrants respect and can fight out the finish.

C6 - PRIX DU PONT DE L'ALMA - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 59,000

1. INES DE LA ROUVRE - - Remains in good form and was fourth in Class D at Durtal over 2850m on 20 July. Has a place chance in this line-up

2. HOLD UP RANAIS - Has only been moderate of late and finished 9th in a Class C mounted race at this course over 2250m on 2 August. Capable of better but others are preferred

3. JAIN MAB - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class C at this course over 2875m on 29 July. Did better over this distance before that and has claims

4. JALIMEDE - Returned to form and finished third in Class C at this course over 2875m on 29 July. Has already won twice this year and is not out of it

5. HEAD OF STATE - Disqualified last time out in Class D at Langon over 2825m on 14 July. Did better in his penultimate start and could earn some money

6. IRISH NICE ELGE - Finished 8th last time out at Tongeren over 2675m on 28 July. Capable of doing better and could earn some money for Alexandre Abrivard

7. IMAGE D'ATALANTE - In good shape and was third in Class D over this course and distance on 18 July. Should contest the finish yet again

8. JOKER DES CHALIERS - Victorious last time out in Class C over this track and trip on 27 June. Not reliable but might well follow up

9. IDYLLE DU PERSIL - Victorious last time out in Class D at Amiens over 2400m on 29 July. Tougher task this time but might play a minor role

10. JIBI DU FRUITIER - In good form and was fourth in Class B at Châtelailon-La Rochelle over 2625m on 12 July. On a long losing run but might earn some minor money

11. IXELLE BLEUE - Finished 9th last time out in Class C at Vichy over 2950m on 1 August. Successful before that at this course and cannot be ruled out

12. HORIZON D'EYMY - Has only been modest of late and was 6th in Class G over this course and distance on 18 July. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

13. IDEAL DE CASTELLE - Holding form and finished fourth in Class D over this track and trip on 18 July. Capable of contesting the finish again

Summary: JOKER DES CHALIERS (8) returned to winning form over this course and distance last time and will attempt to follow up with Benjamin Rochard in the sulky, despite a difficult outside draw behind the starting gate. JAIN MAB (3), whose latest effort can be forgiven, looks the main danger. JALIMEDE (4) and IDEAL DE CASTELLE (13) both have the ability to finish strongly again and must be respected for that.

C7 - PRIX DE LA PORTE BRUNET - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- 1. LARGO DU PONT** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Class F at Capelle over 2,700m on 30 July. Remains barefoot and could complete the hat-trick
- 2. L'ALPHA DE LAUNI** - Disqualified in a Class F at La Capelle over 2,700m on 24 July. Remains barefoot but is not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 3. LUTIN DE LA BESVRE** - Disqualified in a Class F at La Capelle over 2,700m on 24 July. Did win two races earlier this year and cannot be ruled out
- 4. LORD MIL** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a Class F at Pornichet over 2,725m on 18 July. Clearly is not out of it
- 5. LOTUS MADRIK** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class F at Pornichet over 2,725m on 30 July. Should be competitive once again
- 6. LET'S GO VAL** - Disqualified in a Class F at Le Mans over 2,950m on 25 July. Did win earlier that month and could bounce back to score
- 7. L'AMOUR** - Finished 7th in a class E at Enghien over 2,875m on 22 July. Capable of doing better and has claims in a race of this nature
- 8. LORD DE LA FUTAIE** - Finished third in a Class E at Vichy over 2,150m on 29 June. Remains barefoot and could earn some more minor money
- 9. LIGHTNING JIEL** - Unplaced in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,100m on 5 February. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 10. LE ROCKER DE PLAY** - Finished 8th in a Class E over this course and distance on 22 July. Has struggled of late and others are preferred
- 11. LUDO PAROYO** - Disqualified in a Class E at Pornichet-La-Baule over 2,725m on 8 July. Not easy to trust and needs to do more to score
- 12. LOUXOR BOCAIN** - Not reliable and finished 5th in a Class E at Chatelaillon over 2,650m on 29 July. Has a place chance on best form
- 13. LE CHARLY D'YVI** - Successful in a Class F at Mauquenchy over 2,150m on 23 July. Has shown improvement of late and could follow up

Summary: L'AMOUR (7) is reunited with Jean-Michel Bazire and can bounce back to his best in this company. Recent winner LE CHARLY D'YVI (13) heads the opposition and arrives here after a solid win at Maquenchy. LARGO DU PONT (1) is bidding to maintain his unbeaten record with Pierre-Yves Verva and must be respected. LET'S GO VAL (6) has more to offer than he showed last time, is another worth keeping onside.

1. **LA BOISBONNIERE** - Successful last time out in Class E at Vittel over 2725m on 2 August. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of following up with more success
2. **L'AS DE SAINT JEAN** - Victorious last time out in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 25 June. Consistent and should be involved with the finish yet again
3. **LEVEL ONE SYGA** - May have just needed the last run when fifth in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 June. Returns from a short break but would not be a surprise winner
4. **LIMO DE MER** - Disqualified last time out in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 June. Fitter this time and is capable of making the frame
5. **LEONARDO DU DERBY** - Consistent of late and finished third in Class D at Cabourg over 2775m on 17 July. Has a place chance in this line-up
6. **LUNIK DU CHOQUEL** - Victorious twice in his last three starts, including last time out in a claimer over this track and trip on 26 July. Tougher task this time. Might place
7. **LUNGA DES BROUSSES** - Has struggled this year and was unplaced in Class C at this course over 2150m on 25 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
8. **LUCIFER DU PONT** - Not disgraced when fifth in Class C at this track over 2150m on 25 July. Better over this distance and could be a lively danger
9. **LOLLIPOP DU CEBE** - Unreliable but was successful last time out in Class D over this course and distance on 1 August. Unreliable but is not out of it
10. **LORIGRE** - Off form and finished 7th in Class C at this course over 2150m on 25 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
11. **LOLA DU CAMPUS** - Needed the last run when unplaced in Class C at this course over 2150m on 9 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
12. **LUCKY MESLOIS** - A winner of his last two starts, the latest in Class F at Plessé over 3125m on 26 July. Has improved of late and could complete the hat-trick
13. **LITTLE ITALY** - Unreliable and finished fourth in Class B at Bernay over 2825m on 26 July. Capable of doing better and might play a minor role
14. **LOVE YOU PHYT'S** - Victorious in three of his last four starts, the latest in Class D over this track and trip on 27 June. Can add another win to the tally

Summary: Sometimes prone to mistakes since the start of his career, LOVE YOU PHYT'S(14) has been very cooperative this season and won twice in June, making a strong impression. He should only need to repeat his recent performances to win. The opposition will be led by LUCIFER DU PONT (8), whose last two placings here were very encouraging, L'AS DE SAINT JEAN (2), presented with plenty of freshness, and LEVEL ONE SYGA (3), who doesn't need to be unshod to achieve a good result in this company.
