

R4 HYERES [R-H]

C1 - PRIX DU DOMAINE SIOUVETTE - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17,500

- 1. MANGOUSTANE** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in Class H at Aix-les-Bains over 2000m on 2 August. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 2. MOON STRYCK** - Disqualified in three of four starts so far, including last time out in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 5 August. Can surprise if smart
- 3. MY WAY ENJOY** - Not reliable and finished 5th in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 22 July. Might need to do a bit more to score
- 4. MUTINE DU LUDE** - Disqualified in Class F at this course over 2650m on 31 July. Battling to find best form and others make much more appeal
- 5. MIGNONNE DE PLAY** - Not disgraced when third in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 5 August. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of scoring when smart
- 6. MASTER JACK** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 5 August. Capable of earning some minor money
- 7. MISS DU CHASTANG** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Class F at Feurs over 2,100m on 17 July. Has disqualification issues but can earn some money
- 8. MILADY DE NIMES** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 22 July. Capable of doing better thsi time. Place chance
- 9. MY MILLION GAGOU** - Disqualified in Class E at this over 2650m on 19 July. In good form before that and should be competitive in this line-up if smart
- 10. MAGICIEN D'OZ** - Returned to form and was 3rd in Class F at this course over 2650m on 31 July. Has claims in an open looking race
- 11. MAPPA DA VINCI** - Disqualified last time out in Class F at this track over 2650m on 31 July. Not reliable but can make the frame when stayng in stride

Summary: MAGICIEN D'OZ (10) shaped well when finishing strongly over the course and distance last time and is taken to go one better. MIGNONNE DE PLAY (5) is an obvious threat on her first start without shoes. MY MILLION GAGOU (9), placed here in her penultimate outing, is capable of bouncing back if keeping her action. MAPPA DA VINCI (11) is well drawn and proven at the venue so completes the shortlist.

C2 - PRIX DE L'AYGUADE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- 1. NACRE DU VALLON** - Disqualified last time out in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 3 April. Unreliable but is not out of it if smart
- 2. NOMADO** - Has improved of late and was successful last time out in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 1 August. Looks quite capable of doubling up
- 3. NIGHT DE LA COUR** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 3 August. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 4. NINA ERA** - Not disgraced when fifth in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 3 April. Successful before that and can bounce back to score
- 5. NIKITA D'ORGUEIL** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 3 August. Victorious in her penultimate start and must be respected for that
- 6. NORTHERN WAY** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 1 August. Has disqualification issues but could be ready to score
- 7. NORREY** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in Class F at this course over 2850m on 12 July. Can go one place better this time around
- 8. NEGUNDO** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in Class F at Aix-les-Bains over 2000m on 4 August. Should fight out the finish
- 9. NECTAR DE FAEL** - Disqualified in two of his three starts so far, including last time out in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 1 August. Not easy to trust and others are preferred

Summary: NORTHERN WAY (6) should strip fitter after two recent runs and could be ready to reverse form with NOMADO (2), who had his measure at Cagnes-sur-Mer. NACRE DU VALLON (1) catches the eye fitted with all four shoes on this occasion and is worth close consideration. NORREY (7) shaped well over this track and distance last month and a similar effort would see him firmly in the mix.

C3 - PRIX PARIS-TURF - 2650m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 19,500

1. MELODIE D'HOULBEC - - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 29 July. More is needed to score

2. MANILLE SOMOLLI - In good shape and was fourth in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 29 July. Can get involved with the finish again

3. MONEYPUS DUCAMPUS - Disqualified last time out in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 29 July. Was in good form before that and can bounce back to score

4. MALIDA - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 29 July. Others make more appeal

5. MAMBA DES DURIEZ - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class E at Nimes over 2775m on 14 June. Remains barefoot and could be a threat

6. MAMZELLE CARLESS - Has only been modest of late and was 7th in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 25 July. Capable of an upset back at this track

7. MAGELLAN FOR CLARA - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 29 July. Capable of making the frame

Summary: MONEYPUS DUCAMPUS (3) has the ability for a race of this nature but remains far from straightforward, so much will depend on his temperament. MANILLE SOMOLLI (2) went close over at track two starts ago and looks a major player. MAGELLAN FOR CLARA (7) tries a first-time barefoot setup and could spring a surprise. MAMBA DES DURIEZ (5), ideally drawn, is another with solid claims.

C4 - PRIX DU LAVANDOU - 2650m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LEGENDE GAMES** - - Disqualified last time out in Class C at Vichy over 2950m on 1 August. Unreliable but is capable of scoring when in the right mood
- 2. LEADER DE CERISY** - Disqualified last time out in Class E at this course over 2850m on 19 July. Capable of making the frame when staying in stride
- 3. LUGANO** - Has only been modest of late and was 7th in Class F at this course over 2875m on 31 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. LEE ROCK BOND** - Disqualified last time out in Class F at this course over 2875m on 31 July. Successful in his penultimate start and is not out of it
- 5. LITTLE CROWN** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class D at this course over 2850m on 27 May. Returns from a break but can be a threat if fit enough
- 6. LATINUS DU PRE** - Remains in very good form and was runner-up in Class E at this course over 2850m on 19 July. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 7. LIBERTIN MAZA** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class G mounted race at this course over 2875m on 31 July. Was in good form before that in harness races and has claims in this line-up
- 8. LE POULIGUEN** - Disqualified in three of his last four starts, the latest in Class F at this track over 2875m on 31 July. Hard to trust but is capable of scoring

Summary: LIBERTIN MAZA (7) has struggled to show his best under saddle of late but is expected to improve now reverting to harness racing. LEE ROCK BOND (4) was still in contention when making a recent error and is worth another chance; LATINUS DU PRE (6) is particularly effective when racing barefoot and should be involved in the finish. LE POULIGUEN (8), though not the easiest to handle, has enough ability to feature if everything falls into place.

C5 - PRIX XPENG BY ETOILE 83 - 2650m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. KALYPSIA BOND** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 1 August. Might play a minor role at best
- 2. KOSMOS DE SOCERY** - Off form and finished 8th in Class F at Aix-les-Bains over 2025m on 26 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. KEDERMANN** - In good form and finished third in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2000m on 21 July. Can get into the mix of things once again
- 4. KASHMIR'S FELLA** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class G over this track and trip on 19 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. KLEPPER DU LOIR** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in Class G over this track and trip on 31 July. Has claims in this line-up
- 6. KLASSIC DE SYVA** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class G at this course over 2850m on 31 July. Capable of doing better and could make the frame
- 7. KAP PAASLOO** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 7 August. Should fight out the finish if smart
- 8. KALLIOPE DU CAIEU** - Knocking loudly at the door and was runner-up in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 1 August. Big chance

Summary: KALLIOPE DU CAIEU (8) has been in good heart throughout the summer and, despite a wide draw, looks capable of going close; KAP PAASLOO (7) has thrived since joining Danny Brouwer and is likely to be popular again. KLEPPER DU LOIR (5) arrives in excellent form and can make his presence felt. KLASSIC DE SYVA (6), third in a key recent trial, also holding some claims.

C6 - PRIX DU ROMAN LE COUP DE SABOT - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. KURLING ATOUT - - Not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 7 August. Better over this distance and can contest the finish

2. LE LAUREAT DU PARC - - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 24 July. Capable of doing better and can score at this course

3. JACK FLAC - Consistent and finished fourth in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 29 July. Should fight for top honours this time around

4. JASON FAC - Did not show his best when 8th in Class F at Aix-les-Bains over 2000m on 4 August. Was in good form before that and should be competitive

5. LOGAN JIEL - Holding form and finished fourth in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 7 August. Can play a minor role once again

6. JAGUAR DU BOCAGE - Finished fifth last time out in Class F at this course over 2875m on 19 July. Capable of better and can earn some money

7. JUDOPOCK - Victorious last time out in Class E at Amiens over 2900m on 18 July. Remains in great shape and could follow up

Summary: Small field but plenty in with a chance, with a tentative vote going to LE LAUREAT DU PARC (2), the progressive 5yo who takes on his elders from a favourable front-line position; JUDOPOCK (7) arrives in top form and rates the main threat. JACK FLAC (3), also well drawn on the front row, should be in the mix,. JASON FAC (4), who looks to have been targeted at this race, is another to consider.

C7 - PRIX FLORENCE LECELLIER - 2850m (a2m) - Class G - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. **JUPITER DELO** - In good form and was runner-up in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 22 July. Can go one place better
2. **JORDANA** - In good shape and was third in a Class G at this course over 2,650m on 31 July. Can get involved with the finish once again
3. **JOLIE COSTARDIERE** - Disqualified in Class G at this course over 2650m on 31 July. Capable of making the frame when staying on the trot
4. **JOKERO BELLO** - Unplaced in a Class H at Avignon over 2,650m on 26 July. Clearly capable of doing better and is not out of it in this line-up
5. **JAPON DAIRPET** - Disqualified in Class G at this track over 2650m on 31 July. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
6. **JEFFREY** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in class G at this track over 2650m on 31 July. Not easy to trust but is capable of scoring
7. **JERICO BADREC** - Not disgraced when third in a Class F over this course and distance on 19 July. Has a place chance in this line-up
8. **ITYA DE BOSSENS** - Made short work of rivals in a Class F at this track over 2,650m on 31 July. Capable of completing a hat-trick
9. **JET DU RAVARY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class F at this course over 2650m on 31 July. Very unreliable but is capable of a surprise when in the right frame of mind
10. **JUAN PERRINE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,700m on 17 July. Capable of earning some money at this track
11. **IBERICO** - Finished 10th in a Class H at Avignon over 2,650m on 26 July. Off form and needs major improvement to core
12. **JEREZ** - Finished 8th in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 27 July. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
13. **INSAISSABLE DUO** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class F Amateurs' race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 20 July. Might play a minor role at very best
14. **JEEN LOVER** - Disqualified last time out in class H at Villeneuve-sur-lot over 2625m on 12 July. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
15. **HAMYOT DE BOMO** - Finished 4th in a Class H at Avignon over 2,650m on 26 July. Showed some improvement that day but others make more appeal
16. **IPSO SIMARDIERE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class E at this course over 2,650m on 5 July. Capable of getting into the mix of things

Summary: JUPITER DELO (1) has been thoroughly convincing in his last three starts and sets a solid standard. ITYA DE BOSSENS (8) arrives on the back of two comfortable victories and remains a big player despite a less-than-ideal draw. JET DU RAVARY (9) would have gone close but for a recent error and is a danger if keeping his action. IPSO SIMARDIERE (16), is also capable of getting into the mix of things.

C8 - PRIX DE LA CAPTE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- 1. KEOPS DU RIL** - Finished 8th in a Class E at this course over 2,850m on 26 June. Successful before that and is capable of bouncing back to score
- 2. KULYSSONE D'ISQUES** - Finished 6th in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 1 August. Has been been unreliable but is quite capable of scoring
- 3. JUNINHO SPORT** - Finished 11th in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 5 August. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 4. KERCHAK** - Off form and was 9th in Class E at Feurs over 2850m on 4 July. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 5. KRISTINA DU CLOS** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class G at this course over 2,650m on 19 July. Needs to do more to score
- 6. JUSSIE** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in a Class F at Aix Les Bains over 2,700m on 26 July. Should be competitive once again
- 7. KILLER MELOC** - Made short work of rivals in a Class F mounted race at Saint-Galmier over 2,650m on 21 July. Just as good in harness races and can double up
- 8. INDIGO QUICK** - Finished 9th in a Class G at Carpentras over 2,675m on 14 July. Clearly capable of better and has a place chance at this level
- 9. KING DES FONTAINES** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 22 July. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 10. KOCKTAIL** - Finished 5th in a Class H at Sault over 2,175m on 9 August. Capable of a bit better and could play a minor role at very best

Summary: An open looking lucky last race. KILLER MELOC (7) arrives on the back of a recent success under saddle and, back in harness with a capable amateur at the controls, looks well placed to follow up; KEOPS DU RIL (1) is better than his latest effort and is worth another chance to bounce back. KULYSSONE D'ISQUES (2) benefits from a favourable set-up and can get involved with the finish as well.
