

## R3 ENGHEN [L-H]

### C1 - PRIX DE SAINT-CERNIN - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 12,000

1. **JUTLAND** - Returns to the amateur category after failing to deliver in a Laon Class F early this month. Is by no means the worst horse here and will have her supporters
2. **JAGUAR'S EYES** - Finished 4th in a Class F at La Capelle over 2,700m on 24 July. Is never the easiest of horses to gauge but breaks from the 2 slot and should be retained
3. **KISS ME DUTOLLEM** - Fourth in a Class F at Vittel over 2,700m on 14 July. Is a tough nut to crack when barefoot and looks the main threat to KID DE LA BANIO (13)
4. **JAVA DU PLESSIS** - Form has done nothing but regress since encouraging at Biarritz 3 weeks ago, and even from the 4 slot, will have few takers
5. **JAOUEN** - Finished 11th in a Class F at Le Mans over 2,200m on 13 July. Has limited references at this level but has been handed the 5 slot and Theo Perrier will be keen to make hay
6. **KANEM** - Fourth in a Class F Amateurs' race at Royan-La Palmyre over 3,100m on 19 July. Is very much at home in the amateur division and from the front row will be expected to give this a good go. Place prospect
7. **KINNAIRD** - Has been completely out of the picture for some time, latterly 10th in a Montignac Class H on 16 July, and in this company will have nothing to offer
8. **IMITCH DU MOULIN** - Lost his action at Vittel before being trounced at Abbeville 2.5 weeks ago, and is unlikely to make any impact
9. **JALAYA DES BROUETS** - Finished 10th in a Class F at Montier En Der over 3,025m on 5 July, continuing her poor run of form, and can be passed over
10. **ICARE DU FAOUET** - Won a Class G at Arras over 2,900m on 2 August, making it 2 wins in 4 starts. Is shod as he was when victorious at Elbeuf and, despite the draw, must be afforded respect
11. **KEZIO JOSSELYN** - Has not been as sharp since winning a 2875m claimer here on 23 June, and the draw will do him no favours
12. **IBLISS MAYBE** - Won 2 of last 3, most recently a Laon Class F early this month, but reverts to a previous formula and looks more a minor place chance this time around
13. **KID DE LA BANIO** - Disqualified in last 2 starts, the latest a Class E at Graignes over 2,725m on 22 May. Has pulled a poor number but, with application, will have every chance of imposing

**Summary:** KID DE LA BANIO (13) will have to start from the second row but has the ability to make an immediate impact at this level if he keeps his mind on the job. KISS ME DUTOLLEM (3), well-positioned and in top form, and JAOUEN (5), looking to bounce back, will be ready to pounce on any mistake, as will KANEM (6), who is clearly close to his race.

## C2 - PRIX D'EXCIDEUIL - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. NOBEL DU VIVIER** - Winner of both starts to date, most recently an Avranches Class F last week. Is not taking much of a hike in category and is eminently capable of securing the hat-trick
- 2. NUGGET RIVER** - Finished 4th in a Class E at Montignac-Charente over 2,600m on 23 July, a month after having won at Eauze. Is clearly in shape and returns to a hard surface with a decent chance of picking up a cheque
- 3. NINO TOSCA** - Runner-up in a claimer at Vincennes over 2,100m on 20 February. Has not been seen since but sports pads for comeback, and the draw only works to his advantage. Chance
- 4. NEEDREAM** - Disqualified in a Class D at Biarritz over 2,150m on 4 July 2026. Has shown some potential and in this category can finish in the money
- 5. NOBLE AVENUE** - Finished 7th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,725m on 21 July. Is not devoid of ability though and, if behaved, can play a small role
- 6. NOMIS** - Got off the mark in a Class E at Agon-Coutainville 3 weeks ago, on just her second start for Mathieu Mottier, and from the front line is not incapable of repeating
- 7. NAPOLI DU BOUFFEY** - Should not be too quickly condemned for being eliminated in a Cabourg Class C 3 weeks ago. Takes a notable dip in category and can get in on the action if Franck Nivard successfully negotiates the start
- 8. NELATI DE MORGANE** - Finished 5th in a Class C at Cabourg over 2,750m on 24 July 2026. Has pulled a wide number here but can still compete for minor honours
- 9. NAYA DE MYE** - Has yet to show any particular aptitude for the harness game. Has pulled a rough number and, even with pads fitted, is unlikely to spice things up
- 10. NEPTUNE MADRIK** - Kicked her career off nicely but has done nothing of note since. Has been re-shod for Enghien bow but still has too much to do
- 11. NINO SAINT CHARLES** - A complete disappointment at any level since his modest April debut and can be ruled out

**Summary:** NOBEL DU VIVIER (1) bids to maintain his unbeaten record after winning at Francheville and Avranches. He makes his first appearance on sand, and in a claimer, but will be padded for the first time and looks the horse to beat. Yoann Lebourgeois will need to be wary though of the well-placed NINO TOSCA (3), absent since 20 February but fitted with pads for the first time, and recent winner NOMIS (6), who will also sport pads. NEEDREAM (4), back in this category, should have a say.

### C3 - PRIX DE REUILLY - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

**1. NOSTALGIA QUICK** - Has placed just once in six starts to date and will need to show marked improvement on recent Enghien performance

**2. NAYANA DES EPINES** - Ran flattering 4th of 10, on monte debut, in a 2250m Class E here a fortnight ago. Sports pads this time, with Paul Ploquin in the saddle again, but looks a minor place chance at best

**3. NIDORINA DE VIVOIN** - Gave a good account at Graignes first time out, but was eliminated in a Cabourg Class F last week, and others preferred

**4. NICOLETTA DU CLOS** - Finished 3rd in a Class F at St Jean De Monts over 2,625m on 2 August. Is shod as she was at Graignes in June and ought to be taken seriously

**5. NAGOYA MESLOISE** - Finished 2nd on debut in a Class F at Cabourg over 2,750m on 4 August 2026. Will only have improved for the race and should prove the principal threat to NORMANDIA (10)

**6. NIKITA DU BOUFFEY** - Finished 2nd in a Class F at Clairefontaine over 2,900m on 19 July. Has limited monte references, and tends to go better right-handed, but Pierre-Yves Verva will be in the saddle for the first time and will have her supporters

**7. NORMA FIRST** - Unplaced in a harness Class E at Cabourg over 2,725m on 21 July when being prepared for a return to the code. Sports pads for the first time and, with application, can make first 5

**8. NEPHY ELDE** - Disqualified in 4 of last 5, the latest a Class B over course and distance on 27 June 2026. Has considerable merit though and can play an important role if her new handler keeps her focused

**9. NIGHT LILOMA** - Runner-up in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 24 July 2026, after having got off the mark at Graignes the previous month. Sports 4 pads this time and should again prove competitive at the business end of the race

**10. NORMANDIA** - Clinched a Class F at Cabourg over 2,750m on 17 July 2026, on just her second start since the spring break. Benefits from a good entry and Mathieu Mottier can be forgiven for feeling bullish. Claim

**Summary:** NORMANDIA (10), nicely-engaged at the limit of earnings, has what it takes to win a race of this nature and looks just to have the edge over NAGOYA MESLOISE (5), who made a promising debut at Cabourg, and a fully-padded NIGHT LILOMA (9), in top form. The tricky but promising NEPHY ELDE (8), now under new management, can also be considered a player.

## C4 - PRIX DE LA PORTE DE CLIGNANCOURT - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 37,000

1. **L'ELITE DU CHOQUEL** - Has been acquitting herself well of late, lastly runner-up in a Mauquenchy Class F 3 weeks ago. Should appreciate the new profile but is possibly being aimed too high
2. **LADY MASTER** - Form has regressed since running 3rd at Les Andelys in early-July and is unlikely to create an upset
3. **LOLITA DE MIELOUI** - Put a pair of eliminations behind her to win a Class F at La Capelle 2 weeks ago. Takes on a better bunch this time but should nevertheless hold her own
4. **L'IDOLE DRY** - Produced a trio of fine performances last month before being eliminated in a Graignes Class F last Saturday. Backs up in a superior field but will be reconfigured and can still get a look in
5. **LINA LA RAVELLE** - Showed improvement when 3rd in a Neuillé-Pont-Pierre Class F earlier in the month but still has more to find
6. **LOVE WITH YOU** - Sports modified shoeing after having come 6th in an Amiens Class F late last month and will have little to contribute
7. **LIO DE PIENCOURT** - Not the most courageous of mares, latterly 5th in an Amiens Class F in late-July, however at this level will struggle to make much of an impact
8. **LA JOCONDE** - Should not be too hastily-judged for losing her action in a Craon Class E early last month. Will appreciate a return to a hard surface and will be expected to make amends
9. **LOVESTORY DU YUCCA** - Disqualified in a Class F at Neuille Pont Pierre over 3,000m on 2 August. Has already won this summer, gets on well with her driver, and is unlikely to let the side down. Place chance
10. **LIBERTY AVENUE** - Disappointing on the whole over recent weeks. Held her own here in June but faces a much stiffer test this time
11. **LICENCE CASTELETS** - Comfortably won a 2150m Mauquenchy Class F 3 weeks ago. Should take well to Enghien conditions and has every chance of confirming
12. **LA BAULE HAUFOR** - Disqualified in a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2,875m on 28 July. Has otherwise been in excellent shape, enjoys a good engagement, and has a reasonable chance of making her Enghien debut a winning one
13. **LINEA DE L'ALBA** - Has turned a corner over recent weeks, most recently running 2nd in a Biarritz Class F 3 weeks ago. Is unlikely to get her nose in front but benefits from a terrific entry and William Claire will be eager to deliver. First 5
14. **LET'S GO SMART** - Will be shod to preference after being conditioned in a Lisieux Class E in mid-July. Has no Enghien references but in this company should not be too far off the mark

**Summary:** LICENCE CASTELETS (11) and Karla Renault recently impressed at Mauquenchy and will be aiming to repeat. The main opposition is headed by LA BAULE HAUFOR (12), who can be forgiven her latest effort, along with a re-shod LOVESTORY DU YUCCA (9) and LA JOCONDE (8), both of whom also made an early mistake last time out.

## C5 - PRIX DE PONT SAINT-MARTIN - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. NAIADE JAYF** - Third in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,725m on 21 July 2026. Gave a good account here last month and, with Eric Raffin reining, can return to victorious ways
- 2. NATACHA CASTEL** - Fourth in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 16 July. Has been knocking at the door lately and from the 2 slot is hard to ignore. Place prospect
- 3. NUIT DE MAI** - Finished 6th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 16 July, 11 days after having imposed at Les Andelys. Is competitively-shod for the first time and deserves to be taken seriously
- 4. NANA DE L'ISLE** - Won a Class E at Langon over 2,800m on 14 July. Ran 2nd in a claimer here on penultimate start, breaks from the 4 slot, but still has more to find
- 5. NOSTRA DE LAUNI** - Finished 9th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 26 July, her first appearance since early-May. Is still being conditioned and can be passed over
- 6. NAVIDA PURA VIDA** - Disqualified last time out in a Class D at Biarritz over 2,150m on 4 July 2026. Has yet to get off the mark but has demonstrated good consistency, although in this company she may just be out of her depth
- 7. NUIT D'IVRESSE JAF** - Ran 7th in a Class C at Enghien over 2,875m on 2 August. Has looked decidedly ordinary this season and is unlikely to trouble the judge
- 8. NENIGMA** - Failed to remain unbeaten, and pull off the hat-trick, when disqualified in a Class D at Pontchateau over 2,800m on 4 June. Starts for new handler and even though drawn wide, still warrants considerable respect
- 9. NINA DAIDOU** - Was untaxed on re-entry here on 16 July, when unplaced in a 2875m Class D. Is not ideally-drawn but is better than her latest result would imply, and is hard to discount
- 10. NIMES** - Runner-up in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,150m on 23 July. Has been fitted with pads for the first time and, although stepping up in category, will generate some interest
- 11. NAHIA DIBAH** - Outclassed the opposition, on re-entry, in a Class F at Amiens over 2,400m on 10 July. Will have improved for the run and despite the draw can confirm

**Summary:** NAHIA DIBAH (11) made a strong impression at Amiens last month and, padded for the first time, is just preferred to NAIADE JAYF (1), who has done little wrong, and NATACHA CASTEL (2), ideally placed at the limit of earnings. NENIGMA (8), making her debut for new connections, can also have a say.

## C6 - PRIX D'ELANCOURT - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MALINE DES ARRIS** - Moderate filly that was eliminated, on comeback, in a Cabourg Class D late last month. Goes barefoot this time but still not an obvious choice
- 2. MIRABELLE DE LARRE** - Finished 9th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 22 July. Is still chasing that elusive first win and is unlikely to have anything to contribute
- 3. MALINE DU PLESSIS** - Third in a Class E over 2,875m here on 4 July, following 2 straight victories. Sports are fresh configuration and should be good enough to challenge for a place on the podium
- 4. MERCEDES DU LOISIR** - Got straight down to business for new trainer when successful in a Class E under these conditions early this month, however a repeat seems most improbable
- 5. MAKITA BERRY** - Won 2 in a row before coming fifth in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,750m on 31 July. Adrien Lamy gets the drive this time and will be expected to finish in the mix
- 6. MANA MIX** - Failed to pull off the four-timer when disqualified in a 2750m Cabourg Class D a fortnight ago. Is quite clearly at the top of her game and, with application, can play a leading role
- 7. MIA DE SIMM** - Finished 4th in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,725m on 21 July. Has no particular love for Enghien but is plainly in form, and the Eric Raffin-factor cannot be ignored
- 8. MANOLA DE MUZE** - Made up for two straight eliminations when comfortably winning under these conditions 2.5 weeks ago. Is nicely entered here and Yoann Lebourgeois will be justifiably confident of a big run
- 9. MILADY DE LA PIECE** - Third in a Class D over 2,150m here on 22 July, a month after having imposed over course and distance, and looks thoroughly capable of confirming
- 10. MA LIBERTE** - Won 3 on the trot last winter before following up with a trio of sanctions. Has not raced since February, but is barefoot for comeback, and must be taken seriously

**Summary:** The choice is not an easy one between MILADY DE LA PIECE (9), in good form, MANOLA DE MUZE (8), who bounced back last time, MANA MIX (6), who must be forgiven her latest effort, and the consistent and reconfigured MALINE DU PLESSIS (3).

## C7 - PRIX DE LA PORTE D'ORLEANS - 2250m (a1m1/2) - - Mounted - EUR € 52,000

**1. EBANO D'ARC** - Takes to the monte code for the first time after comprehensively failing to impress under harness this term. Sports a fresh configuration, with Alexander Abrivard back in charge, but others still preferred

**2. KALIMERO JASMA** - Gave a good account on comeback 10 days ago when 2nd in a Châtelailon-La Rochelle Class F. Will have progressed for the run and will again be partnered by Emma Lacomblez. First 5

**3. KRISTAL DE JANZE** - Reassuring 4th in a Class C at Les Sables-d'Olonne 3 weeks ago. Is confirmed here and will be reunited with Adrien Lamy who imposed with him on their sole association. Attention

**4. INSERT DES MONTS** - Modest individual making just 2nd appearance in the discipline and, quite simply, has no realistic chance

**5. KENYAN BLUES** - Unplaced on re-entry in a harness Class B over 2,150m here on 6 August. Boasts a good record with Eric Raffin and is expected to figure prominently when push comes to shove

**6. KISS ME SIMON** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class F at Vittel over 2,700m on 14 July. Has delivered just the once at Enghien though and cannot be considered a priority

**7. KADO SHINING** - Made short work of a Class E over course and distance on 16 July when entrusted to Mathieu Mottier for the first time, and is in with a realistic chance of doubling his money

**8. KENTUCKY FIRST** - Unplaced in a harness Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 24 July 2026, his first appearance since March. Is shod to preference this time, and will be reunited with Mehdi Lelièvre for whom he excels. Chance

**Summary:** A convincing winner here last time with Mathieu Mottier, KADO SHINING (7) lines up in the same configuration and can confirm that form, despite the presence of a re-shod KENTUCKY FIRST (8), and a barefoot KENYAN BLUES (5), both returning to their preferred discipline after a comeback under harness.

## C8 - PRIX DE LA PORTE DU PRE-SAINT-GERVAIS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 35,000

1. **MEETING MESLOIS** - 7th in a Class E at Laval over 2,850m on 5 July. Will be barefoot this time though and, with application, can play a prominent role
2. **MAGE DES MONTS** - Disappointing since winning a brace in May, lastly 6th in a Mauquenchy Class E last week. Is better than latest results would suggest though and must not be underestimated
3. **MAGISTRALO BELLO** - Won 2 in a row before coming 4th in a Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne early last week. Is dynamic when barefoot and is well-placed to give this a good go
4. **MAGIC DE BANVILLE** - Comes here on the back of 3 straight sanctions, but showed last time that he was plainly in form, and Mathieu Mottier gets the nod. Chance
5. **MARCEL SEVEN** - Fourth in a Class D at Royan-La Palmyre over 2,475m on 19 July, with JMB in the bike. Was good enough to win that day and from the 5 slot can redeem himself and impose
6. **MIKONOS DE MAHEY** - Finished 4th in a Class E at Lisieux over 2,675m on 15 July 2026. Sports a new configuration for his left-handed debut and cannot be discounted
7. **MAESTRO DE FORGAN** - Complicated sort that has been disqualified in 5 of last 6 starts and can expect to have few friends
8. **METEORE ETOILE** - Modest individual that lost his way after imposing at Mauquenchy in January and desperately needs to reassure
9. **MOVING QUICK** - Well-beaten on re-entry in a Class E at Les sables-d'Olonne earlier in the month and even though re-shod, is still facing a very tough task
10. **MYSTERIOUS LOVE** - Finished 9th in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,850m on 5 August and must get his house in order
11. **MEPHISTO JAVANAIS** - Has a pair of runs under his belt since the spring break. Gave a good account at Cabourg despite losing his action early, but on better behaviour can make amends. First 5
12. **MIGNON DES MACE** - Has been hard to fault over recent weeks, lastly 4th in a Graignes Class E last weekend, however at this level can expect to find the going tough
13. **MURMURE** - 2nd in a Class F at La Capelle 3 weeks ago, on just 2nd start back. Is never far from faulting, and has pulled a rough number, but is still worth keeping an eye on
14. **MOMO DES CARREAUX** - Finished 8th in a Class E Apprentices' race at Graignes over 2,700m on 8 August 2026. Is not the easiest of horses to handle and others easier to back

**Summary:** MARCEL SEVEN (5), who was expected to do better last time at Royan, and MAGIC DE BANVILLE (4), provided he keeps trotting, are worth considering ahead of MAGISTRALO BELLO (3), who is in top form, and MAGE DES MONTS (2), who can bounce back with Yoann Lebourgeois.
