She lacked extra on her Poly debut but must now strip filler in her second run after a rest. BLAZING BELLE may also have needed her last run after a lengthy break but the run was decent. Both her starts have been in the soft so the poly can suit. YEAH BABY was at long odds when making her debut on the poly but was not far back. She should come on lengths from that. Well-bred newcomer INTERSTELLAR and Western Cape-based filly THAT'S A GIMME must be watched.

TREASURE ISLAND is never far back on the turf and could be anything on the Poly first time. She must be respected. Lightly framed BLUE POPPY was narrowly beaten first up on the poly and has been consistent since. Another in with a fair chance.

SESAME was well beaten by EBISU last time out but now gets a 4kg claimer aboard and is now 7kg better off for a 6.70-lengths beating. GOLDEN ANGEL was a beaten favourite last run but has been in good form on the poly. She gets 4.5kg from EBISU so there is a lot in her favour. ANOTHER DREAM has been up against stronger of late and showed signs of a return to form last run.

ULTRA QUICK is on a roll and from gate one can make it three wins on the bounce. PLEASED TO SEE YOU is relatively lightly raced and was also a beaten favourite over course and distance last time out. NAVAJO DANCER is up in class but goes well on the poly and has a light weight. PEMBURY has not been far back in recent starts but has dropped markedly in the ratings. The blinkers are back and he gets a 4kg claimer aboard so could make the exotics pay.

He was narrowly beaten over course and distance last time out and must rate a big threat. WINTER WAVES and HEAVEN'S WILL are both capable of getting into the fight and need to be respected. WILLIAM OF ORANGE hasn't been far off on the poly. He has drawn well and the stable is in form. MUSIC IS LIFE has the widest draw but ran a cracker under an inexperienced apprentice last start.

PREVIEW: BANGKOK MAGIC is a two-year-old taking on older horses but impressed in his second outing. He does face stronger but should keep improving and could be up to the task. CHICARITO was gutsy last time but will need the race run to suit. UNITED NATION is a poly specialist but does appear to be tested over this trip. A 4kg apprentice claim lightens the 63.5kg load. RED BOMBER has started favourite at his last two and has been close-up in both. He should be right there. SEVEN NO TRUMP makes her local debut on the poly and boasts some useful Cape form over the trip.

PREVIEW: VICTOR RAIL goes well over course and distance and was less than 2 lengths behind BLESS ME FRED when last they met. He is now 7kg better off taking the apprentice claim into account. CAPPELLINO has good form over course and distance, was a close-up second to BLESS ME FRED, and is now 1.5kg better off so the tables should be turned. LITTLE CRACKER suddenly impressed - he could repeat. One can never write of TRAFALGAR SQUARE who has been consistent under big weights. He has drawn well and must have a say along with veteran PURPLE POWAHOUSE who jumps from gate one.
