

R5 CAGNES-SUR-MER [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DES MILLEFONDS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 33,000

1. **JUNIOR STEED** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class F Apprentices' race over this track and trip on 3 August. Can go one place better
2. **KRAK D'AZUR** - Disqualified in a Class E at this course over 2,950m on 10 August. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
3. **JEEK D'ACADIE** - Disqualified in a Class F over this course and distance on 3 August. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role at very best
4. **JOE TEJY** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class F over this track and trip on 3 August. Remains barefoot and can bounce back to score
5. **KRUNCHY** - Disqualified in a Class E at this course over 2,950m on 10 August. Successful in his penultimate start and is clearly not out of it
6. **JOKER DU MIDI** - Disqualified in a Class E at Avignon over 2,675m on 26 July. Not reliable and needs to find a few lengths to score
7. **KANSAS DE CASTELLE** - Disqualified in a Class E at this course over 2,950m on 10 August. Reverts to barefoot and should be a real threat if smart

Summary: JUNIOR STEED (1) finished second on his return to the Côte d'Azur and sets the standard here. KANSAS DE CASTELLE (7) should not be judged on his recent mistake and can bounce back to challenge for top honours. KRUNCHY (5), wearing plates only on his front feet for greater comfort, is another with claims. JEEK D'ACADIE (3) is capable of a big performance on his day.

C2 - PRIX AHMES - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 33,000

1. HASHTAG DE TAGOR - Disqualified in a Class B at Biarritz over 2,950m on 25 July. Remains barefoot and scored in his penultimate start. Not out of it

2. ICARE FILE - Finished 7th in a Class E over this course and distance on 3 August. Remains barefoot and needs to do a bit more to score

3. HAPPY LYL - In very good shape and was runner-up in a Class D at Aix Les Bains over 2,700m on 2 August. Remains barefoot and can go one place better

4. GIRLY VICTORY - Disqualified in a Class C over this course and distance on 29 July. Remains barefoot and is capable of playing a minor role when smart

5. IGGY FAFA - Has some fair form and came home 5th in a Class C at this track over 2,925m on 25 July. Remains barefoot and could earn some minor money

6. IL MAGNIFICO - Usually competitive and was third in a Class E at this course over 2,700m on 27 July. Remains barefoot and should be a threat yet again

7. HARING OKINA - In good form and was third in a Class E over this track and trip on 3 August. Remains barefoot and should make a bold bid at victory

8. I LOVE IGNY - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class E over this track and trip on 3 August. Has a place chance on best form

9. IBRA DE LOU - Much improved last run when a runner-up in a Class F Amateurs' race over this track and trip on 10 August. Might play a minor role

Summary: A small field, but the winner looks difficult to predict. HARING OKINA (7) is a formidable finisher and faces a good opportunity in the absence of the six- and seven-year-olds. HAPPY LYL (3) is in top form and returns to the course where he recorded his latest victory with strong claims. HASHTAG DE TAGOR (1) was still competitive when making a mistake at Biarritz and deserves another chance. IL MAGNIFICO (6), who has been faultless this summer, also has some claims.

C3 - PRIX DE RIMPLAS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. HACKER MESLOIS** - Unplaced in a Class H at Avignon over 2,675m on 26 July. Remains barefoot but is battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 2. HOUSTON D'ARIANE** - Finished 4th in a Class F Apprentices' race over this track and trip on 3 August. Remains barefoot and could earn some more money
- 3. JEREZ** - Finished 9th in a Class G at Hyeres over 2,875m on 12 August. Remains barefoot but needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 4. IDEAL DU BRIEU** - In good form and was third in a Class F over this course and distance on 3 August. Remains barefoot and should be very competitive yet again
- 5. JUST D'HERIPRE** - Finished 5th in a Class F at this course over 2,925m on 22 July. Consistent and can get involved with the finish once again
- 6. JOSE DU CHERISAY** - Disqualified in a Class F over this course and distance on 22 July. Remains barefoot and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 7. JAMES BOND** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class F Amateurs' race at this course over 2,150m on 10 August. Remains barefoot and could follow up
- 8. JUNIOR DU VIVIER** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class D at this course over 2,925m on 27 July. Reverts to barefoot and has claims in an open looking race
- 9. JACK FLAC** - Disqualified in a Class F at Hyeres over 2,850m on 12 August. Unreliable but is quite capable of scoring when in the right moof
- 10. JUP AND STAR** - Disqualified in a Class F over this course and distance on 7 August. Remains barefoot and is capable of making the frame

Summary: JUNIOR DU VIVIER (8) finished a respectable fifth at the end of July and, having been prepared specifically for this objective, should be involved in the finish. IDEAL DU BRIEU (4), who particularly enjoys this course, looks a serious threat. JAMES BOND (7) arrives in top form and must be respected. JUP AND STAR (10) is capable of making the frame on the best of his form.

C4 - PRIX IDEAL PICARD - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **L'AIGLE** - Came home 6th in a Class F at this course over 2,925m on 5 August. Reverts to barefoot but more is needed to score
2. **LEADER DU MOUCHEL** - Came home 4th in a Class F at this track over 2,925m on 27 July. Holding form and could make the frame once again
3. **LARRE** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class F at this course over 2,925m on 7 August. Can go one place better
4. **LIVE ON** - Finished 7th in a Class F at this course over 2,925m on 27 July. Remains barefoot but needs to do a bit more to score
5. **LIGHTNING RIVER** - Not reliable and was 7th in a Class F at Hyeres over 2,650m on 5 July. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
6. **LOTTERIO** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class F at this course over 2,925m on 7 August. Remains barefoot and can score again
7. **LLUC DES BOSC** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at this course over 2,925m on 27 July. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish when smart
8. **LOVE ME DO** - Finished 7th in a Class F at Vittel over 2,725m on 12 July. Needs to do more and makes little appeal in this line-up
9. **LATINO DREAM** - Came home 8th in a Class H at Avignon over 2,650m on 4 July. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
10. **LONGING VENESI** - Disqualified in a Class F at this course over 2,150m on 29 July. Reverts to barefoot and might earn some minor money at very best
11. **LONELY RIDER** - Finished 7th in a Class F at this over 2,925m on 22 July. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
12. **LANDEVY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class F at this course over 2,925m on 7 August. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
13. **LUCKY D'AVIGNERE** - Disqualified in a Class E at this course over 2,925m on 7 August. Remains barefoot and can be a threat if at best
14. **LEPTON** - Disqualified in a Class F at this track over 2,925m on 7 August. Remains barefoot and is capable of playing a minor role at very best
15. **LEONITO STAR** - Came home 6th in a Class F at Hyeres over 2,850m on 31 July. Remains barefoot but does need to do a bit more to score
16. **LINGFIELD** - Finished 4th in a Class F at this track over 2,925m on 7 August. Not reliable but can earn some minor money

Summary: LOTTERIO (6) arrives on the back of two straight wins and has already beaten several of today's rivals, so he is taken to confirm his superiority. LUCKY D'AVIGNERE (13), third in the key race on July 27th, looks the main danger. LLUC DES BOSC (7) can play a leading role if maintaining his rhythm. LEADER DU MOUCHEL (2) is proven in this grade and has solid claims as well.

C5 - PRIX DURVALO - 2925m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. MANDARINO FLEURY** - Disqualified in Class E over this track and trip on 5 August. Not reliable but is capable of earning some money when staying in stride
- 2. MOONLIGHT DANICA** - Came home 5th in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 1 August. Might need to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 3. MACARENA D'HOULBEC** - Finished 5th in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 10 July. Has some fair form and might play a minor role
- 4. MYSTERE DE L'AVRE** - Successful in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 1 August. Better that short distance but is also not out of it
- 5. MANUELLA DE PLAY** - Finished runner-up in a Class D at this course over 2,150m on 1 August. In good form and can be competitive once again
- 6. MANHATTAN ROUSSAC** - Disqualified in Class C over this course and distance on 3 August. Not reliable but is capable of earning some minor money
- 7. MEMORY STAR ELGE** - Victorious in Class C over this course and distance on 3 August. Should fight out the finish once again
- 8. MASCARET** - Remains in great shape and was runner-up in a Class C over this track and trip on 8 July. Can go one place better
- 9. MANZANA ERA** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in a Class A at Marseille-Borely over 3,000m on 10 June. Returns from a short break but has a chance if fit enough

Summary: MASCARET (8) is a quality colt who was caught for speed last time but finished his race strongly and can be forgiven that effort. He sets the standard in this company. MANZANA ERA (9), who was narrowly beaten by her rival in early June, has been freshened up and can reverse the form. Recent course winner MEMORY STAR ELGE (7) could have a major say in the outcome. MYSTERE DE L'AVRE (4) is back in top form and can also have ambitions at this level.

C6 - PRIX JEAN DAUSSET - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. NEMELIOS JIEL** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in class F at this course over 2925m on 5 August. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. NOTCH UP** - Finished fourth in a Class F at this course over 2,925m on 1 August . Drops in distance but can be competitive once again
- 3. NIKO PLEIN CHENE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class F at this track over 2925m on 1 August. capable of earning some money when staying on the trot
- 4. NOLAN D'OR** - In good form and was third in a Class F at this course over 2,925m on 5 August. Drops in distance but is not out of it
- 5. NARUTO WILLIAMS** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class F at this course over 2,925m on 1 August. Drops in distance and can contest the finish
- 6. NET DU MOUCHEL** - Came home 6th in a Class F at this course over 2,925m on 5 August. Has only been moderate so far and more is needed to score
- 7. NADJIM KALOUMA** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class G at Laon over 2,225m on 19 July. Showed improvement and could follow up
- 8. NEMO DU LEARD** - Finished 8th in a Class E over this course and distance on 20 July. Capable of doing better and can make the frame
- 9. NEW JACK AMERICA** - Finished fifth in a Class F at this track over 2,925m on 5 August. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 10. NARSEO** - Disqualified in three of four starts so far, the latest in Class F at this course over 2925m on 5 August. Hard to trust and makes little appeal

Summary: NADJIM KALOUMA (7) missed the break on debut but put the record straight on July 19th, winning in determined fashion, and can make his presence felt on his first start on the Côte d'Azur. NOTCH UP (2) has plenty of scope for improvement and is another with leading claims. NARUTO WILLIAMS (5), who has already shown ability, should not be underestimated. NEMO DU LEARD (8) drops in class and could take advantage to bounce back to form.

C7 - PRIX DES IMPATIENS - 2925m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 23,000

- 1. KHEOPS DU PERRON** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class H harness race at Sault over 3,000m on 9 August. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. LUCKY MAJYC** - Came home 5th in a Class E harness race over this course and distance on 7 August. Can earn some more money
- 3. MONACO** - Disqualified last time out in a Class G mounted race at Hyeres over 2850m on 31 July. Capable of better and is not out of it
- 4. KRAKITO BELLO** - Victorious in a Class G mounted race at Hyeres over 2850m on 31 July. Not reliable but can follow up in this line-up
- 5. LIOUBA JAMES** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Class F harness race over this track and trip on 5 August. Can contest the finish back under the saddle
- 6. L'AVENIR** - Unplaced in a Class C harness race at this course over 2,150m on 3 August. Can make the frame back in a mounted race

Summary: RAKITO BELLO (4) returned to winning ways in good style at Hyères and looks capable of following up and taking out this lucky last race. MONACO (3) finished second that day but lost the benefit of his effort after an inquiry; if his partner can keep him focused, he is capable of setting the record straight. LIOUBA JAMES (5) can be prone to mistakes but has claims if keeping her action. L'AVENIR (6) is worth close attention on his return to the mounted discipline.
