C1 - PRIX DES BORDS DE L'OISE - 2800m (a2m) - TURF - Class 2 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 50,900

1. **CHESS** - Finished 13th in a Class 2 Handicap at Deauville over 3,200m on 25 August. Very consistent before that and could be a threat
2. **STEP MORNING** - Fifth in a Class 2 at Du Lion D'Angers over 3,000m on 2 August. Has some fair form and might earn some minor money
3. **A BEAUREGARD** - Victorious in a Class 2 Handicap at Deauville over 3,200m on 25 August. carries a penalty but cannot be ruled out
4. **MAIA STAR** - In good form and finished runner-up in a Class 2 Handicap at Deauville over 3,200m on 25 August. Can be a lively danger
5. **RAM SEA** - Unplaced in a Class 2 Handicap at Dieppe over 2,400m on 30 July. Capable of doing better but this is a tougher task
6. **MIGHTY BOY** - Very consistent of late and was third in a Class 2 Handicap at Deauville over 3,200m on 25 August. Should be competitive once again
7. **MISTER GATZ** - Came home 7th in a Class 2 Handicap at Longchamp over 2,400m on 6 September. Not disgraced that day and is capable of scoring
8. **DEMPY** - Finished 7th in a Class 2 Handicap at Deauville over 3,200m on 25 August. A good winner of his penultimate start and must be respected for that
9. **HAVIASSOR** - Unplaced in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 3,200m on 25 August. Unreliable but might play a minor role at very best
10. **MONEY TIME** - Came home 7th in a Group at Deauville over 2,500m on 30 August. Clearly capable of scoring if finding best form
11. **AVANT L'ORAGE** - Came home 9th in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 2,500m on 18 August. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
12. **SAPRISTI** - Unplaced in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 3,200m on 25 August. Has struggled of late but is capable of an upset on best form
13. **SPRING EVE** - Came home 8th in a Class 3 at Deauville over 2,500m on 6 August. Not reliable and might need to do more to beat these rivals
14. **LIKE IT OR NOT** - Came home 6th in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 3,200m on 25 August. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
15. **LORENZO DE MEDICI** - Not disgraced when third in a Class 4 at Deauville over 2,500m on 22 August. Usually competitive and can get into the mix of things yet again
16. **MEASTER OWEN** - Successful in a Class 4 Handicap at Vichy over 2,400m on 14 August. Carries a penalty but could earn some minor money

Summary: MISTER GATZ (7) made an encouraging return at Deauville and subsequently ran well at ParisLongchamp, despite not enjoying a clear run in the straight. He is clearly on the up and could dictate matters from the front. DEMPY (8) won comfortably in a Class 3 race on his penultimate start, notably beating Odemar, who has since won the Prix Gladiateur (Group 3). CHESS (1), whose latest defeat can be forgiven. MIGHTY BOY (6), who has formed an excellent partnership with Mickaël Barzalona, also has claims.

C2 - PRIX DES VINEUX - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 21,000

1. BOGLIASCO - In good form and was runner-up in a Class 2 at Clairefontaine over 2,400m on 7 August. Should fight out the finish once again

2. LOVING QUEEN - Successful in three of last four starts, including last time out in a Handicap at Vichy over this distance on 6 August. Clearly is not out of it

3. PAIUTE - Outclassed the opposition in a Maiden at Dieppe over this distance on 30 July. Improving and is quite capable of doubling up

4. ENTLEBUCH - Unplaced in a Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2,400m on 31 August. Had some fair form before that and might play a minor role at very best

5. NANCY DES PLACES - Threatening a victory and was runner-up in a Maiden at Saint-Cloud over this distance on 7 September. Can contest the finish once again

6. TAKERYA - Finished fifth in a Class 2 at Vichy over 2,000m on 25 July. Has some fair form but might need to do a bit more to beat these rivals

Summary: PAIUTE (3), a daughter of Homerique, who won a Group 3 race for Francis-Henri Graffard, made a commanding winning debut at Dieppe and should have more to offer. BOGLIASCO (1) also has plenty of stamina and represents the successful Provost-Munch partnership, which recently landed a Group 3. Always finishing in the first four since her debut, NANCY DES PLACES (5) can also play a leading role. LOVING QUEEN (2) continues to improve and should not be overlooked.

C3 - PRIX DE L'ABBAYE SAINT-CORNEILLE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 20,100

- 1. BILLION GOLD** - Finished 6th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 3 September. Tons better than his finishing position suggests and is not out of it
- 2. IRISH D'AUNOU** - Came home 5th on debut in a Maiden at Saint Malo over 2,500m on 28 August. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role
- 3. KENERGY** - Consistent so far and was runner-up in a Conditions maiden race at Deauville over 2000m on 25 August. Can go one place better this time
- 4. VALIKA** - Finished 8th in a Maiden at Vichy over 2,000m on 23 July. Did much better on debut and can make the frame
- 5. EUNICE** - Showed promise on debut when a runner-up in a Conditions maiden at Clairefontaine over 2400m on 3 August. Drops in distance but is capable of winning
- 6. RITZY ROXY** - Improving and was runner-up in a Maiden at Vichy over 2,400m on 14 August. Drops in distance but can earn some money
- 7. NICOSIE ESSEF** - Came home 6th on debut in a Maiden at Beaupreau over 2,400m on 22 August. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
- 8. FAROUKH** - A three-year-old gelding by Golden Horde out of Elraazy who is making his debut. His Dam was unraced in France. Others are preferred
- 9. PACIFIC SKY** - A three-year-old gelding by Toronado out of Painted Girl who is making his debut. His Dam never raced in France. Others make more appeal
- 10. LALLYBROCH** - A three-year-old filly by Almanzor out of Larceny who is making her debut. Her dam only raced once and was unplaced. Could need this experience

Summary: EUNICE (5), a niece of Group 1 winner Nighttime, battled all the way to the finish on her debut and notably beat a stablemate who has since won. KENERGY (3) showed plenty of tenacity when making the running at Deauville and is another serious contender for victory. VALIKA (4) can be involved on the strength of her debut, while supplemented BILLION GOLD (1) should certainly not be written off.

C4 - PRIX DE CARLEPONT - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 18,300

1. **COLOSAAL** - Finished 6th on debut in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1600m on 22 August. Likely to improve and could make the frame
2. **NOGAI KHAN** - - Finished 6th on debut in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 1400m on 21 August. Likely to improve and could be a lively danger
3. **CORMAC** - Only modest on debut when 8th in a Conditions Maiden at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 28 August. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
4. **MON ANGE** - Finished 7th on debut in a Conditions Maiden at Saint-Cloud over 1400m on 2 June. Returns from a break but does have a place chance
5. **CORRADO** - Did not show much when unplaced on debut in a Conditions Maiden at Vichy over 1400m on 20 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
6. **MAGIC INSPIRATION** - Knocking very loudly at the door and was runner-up again, in a Conditions Maiden at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 18 August. Can go one place better
7. **SHALOM** - Finished fifth last time out in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 1600m on 2 September. Did win a claimer before that and has a place chance
8. **EDONISTA** - A two-year-old gelding by Galileo Gold out of Bayargal who is making his debut. His dam won 4 of her 12 starts. Could be a threat
9. **ALLEZ PAPA** - A two-year-old colt by Galileo Gold out of Aghaany who is making his debut. His dam never raced in France. Could need this experience
10. **DINGSON** - A two-year-old colt by The Gray Gatsby out of Mutahamisa who is making his debut. His dam won one of her five UK starts. Could play a minor role
11. **COLCHESTER** - A two-year-old colt by Ribchester out of Polemic who is making his debut. His dam won 1 of her 20 starts. Could need this experience
12. **CALETTE** - A two-year-old filly by Al Wukair out of Cetova who is making her debut. Her dam won once in just 3 starts. Can be a threat
13. **VANILLA** - A two-year-old filly by Intello out of Vinye who is making her debut. Her dam never raced in France. Others make more appeal
14. **INDIAN BELLE** - A two-year-old filly by Taj Mahal out of Amelia May who is making her debut. Her dam never raced in France. Others make more appeal

Summary: MAGIC INSPIRATION (6) finished second over this distance last time and is bidding for a deserved first win. Well bred and partnered by Maxime Guyon from the outset, CALETTE (12) will attract plenty of attention on debut. NOGAI KHAN (2) and COLOSAAL (1) both led the field home on their debuts and should have more to offer.

C5 - PRIX DE VERBERIE - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 18,300

1. **MARASI DRIVE** - Victorious in a Class 3 Conditions race at Clairefontaine over 1600m on 21 August. Distance suited and can get involved in the finish
2. **PIYANGO** - Unplaced in a Maiden at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 18 August. Threatening to win a handicap before that and is not out of it
3. **UTXA** - Successful in a claimer last time out at Clairefontaine over 1800m on 29 August. Can contest the finish
4. **TOCOA** - Fourth in a Class 3 at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 31 August. Yet to win a race but is capable of making the frame
5. **MAINE DE BIRAN** - Holding form and finished fourth in a handicap at Vichy over 2000m on 15 August. Can be a threat to these rivals
6. **SANAWARI** - Not reliable but was fourth in a handicap at Vichy over 2000m on 3 August. Has a place chance on best form
7. **ICE CRACKER** - May have needed the last run when only 8th in a handicap at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 1000m on 15 June. Might need this run as well returning from a break
8. **SPIELER** - Came home 7th in a Maiden at Dieppe over 2400m on 30 July. Tries a handicap but others make more appeal
9. **MARYCHA** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 27 August. Has run well at this course and is capable of an upset
10. **AL GHARIYA** - Returned from a short break and was unplaced on handicap debut at Clairefontaine over 2400m on 10 August. Drops in distance and others are preferred
11. **BLANQUETTE** - Remains in good shape and finished third in a Class 3 Conditions race at Clairefontaine over 1600m on 21 August. Capable of scoring
12. **ZEUDI** - Unreliable so far and finished 7th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 5 May. Could need this run returning from a break
13. **LA BELLE HELENE** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up again, this time in a handicap at Saint-Malo over 1800m on 28 August. Has claims in this line-up

Summary: BLANQUETTE (11) caught the eye with a strong finish at Clairefontaine last time and, having already finished second over this course and distance can score this time around. MARASI DRIVE (1), a recent winner over the selection, will benefit from Léo-Paul Bréchet's allowance this time. UTXA (3) recently won a claiming race and has since returned to Philippe Decouz's stable. MAINE DE BIRAN (5) arrives in excellent form and should also have a say.

C6 - PRIX DE PONT-SAINT-MAXENCE - 2800m (a2m) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 20,100

1. ALLEZ FRERES - threatening a victory and was runner up in a claimer at Lyon-Parilly over 2400m on 2 September. Can get involved with the finish

2. MARANTAO - Finished fifth in a Maiden at Moulins over 2,400m on 28 August. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role

3. NEPTUNE DU HUTREL - Finished 7th on debut in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 2,400m on 21 August. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal

4. OPA HOPPENSTEDT -

5. GOOD TIMING - Finished 9th in a Maiden at Dieppe over 2,400m on 30 July. Capable of improvement but others are preferred

6. JANNET - Came home 8th in a Maiden at Dieppe over 2,400m on 30 July. Capable of doing better and can bounce back to score

7. MEYN ZUN - In good form and finished 3rd in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 2,400m on 21 August. Should fight out the finish once again

8. STORY WAY - Finished 6th in a Maiden at Dieppe over 2,400m on 30 July. Clearly capable of doing better and is a threat to these rivals

9. CARMEL - Finished 11th in a Maiden at Saint-Cloud over 2,400m on 24 April. Did better on debut and can contest the finish if fit enough

10. ROSARIA - A three-year-old filly, by Moises Has out of Energy d'Olivette who is making her debut. Her Dam won 5 of her 28 starts. Could need this experience

Summary: With two runners in the field, the Fabre stable can rely on JANNET (6), who will once again be partnered by Pierre-Charles Boudot despite her disappointing return. STORY WAY (8) is in excellent form but found 2,400 metres too short last time and can be expected to appreciate this test. Initially entered in the Prix de Diane (Group 1), CARMEL (9) has been freshened up following a disappointing effort at the end of April and is worth watching. ALLEZ FRERES (1) can rely on her experience and is also a threat.

**C7 - PRIX DES BORDS DE L'ARONDE - 2800m (a2m) - TURF - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR €
21,100**

1. MY EDEN JAMES - Came home 9th in a Class 3 Handicap at Dieppe over 2,400m on 24 August. Not reliable but is capable of getting into the mix of things

2. ORLHENA - Finished 5th in a Claimer at Clairefontaine over 2,200m on 29 August. Probably needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

3. BRIGHTON SPORT - Victorious in a Maiden at Moulins over 3,400m on 28 August. Improving but this is a tougher task. Might play a minor role

4. GOD SAVE THE QUEEN - Hat-trick seeking after some solid wins, the latest in a Class 3 Handicap at Clairefontaine over 2,900m on 3 July. Must be respected again

5. LA BOBRIDE - Unplaced in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 2,500m on 11 August. Not reliable and needs to find a few lengths to score

6. BARBADIN - Finished 11th in a Class 3 Handicap at Clairefontaine over 2,900m on 3 July. Clearly unreliable but can be competitive in this line-up

7. GRAND ART - Holding form and finished 4th in a Class 3 Handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2,400m on 31 August. Can win a race of this nature

8. MISS BRESIL DELF - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 2,500m on 11 August. Liked the PSF but might make the frame

9. ERIDITA DOVER - Finished 15th in a Class 4 Handicap at Craon over 2,200m on 5 September. Needs to find a few lengths to score

10. AND WE DANCED - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class 4 Handicap at Le Lion D'Angers over 3,000m on 4 September. Can earn some more money

Summary: GRAND ART (7) made a promising return to racing after almost a year off, performing well in two outings on the Flat this summer, and looks close to winning again. At 10, fellow veteran BARBADIN (6), a Quinté+ winner in 2023, will need to be respected after another solid effort at Clairefontaine. Trained by the in-form Eric Lecoiffier, GOD SAVE THE QUEEN (4) and MISS BRESIL DELF (8) are capable of making the frame.

**C8 - PRIX DES BORDS DE L' AISNE - 2800m (a2m) - TURF - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR €
25,900**

- 1. SPLENDINO** - Finished 7th in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 3,200m on 25 August. Clearly capable of doing better and is a real threat
- 2. VENDOMYA** - In good form and finished third in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 3,200m on 25 August. Should fight out the finish once again
- 3. LE GAST** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 2,500m on 18 August. Has run well for this jockey and is not out of it
- 4. SONNAZ** - Returned to form and finished fourth in a Class 4 at Aix Les Bains over 2,500m on 14 July. Could play a minor role
- 5. SEVENNA'S BAY** - Outclassed the opposition in a Maiden at Le Lion D'Angers over 3,000m on 20 August. Could earn some minor money
- 6. LUCIO VERO** - Victorious in a Class 4 Handicap at La Teste De Buch over 3,000m on 19 August. Unreliable but cannot be ruled out
- 7. KING MOTIF** - Finished 6th in a Class 3 Handicap at Saint Malo over 2,500m on 28 August. Not reliable but is capable of bouncing back to score
- 8. GOT MAN** - Finished 15th in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 2,500m on 18 August. Has struggled of late and others are preferred
- 9. HAPPY LADY** - Finished 10th in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 2,500m on 18 August. Capable of better and can be a lively danger
- 10. RIO GRANDE** - Finished 6th in a Class 4 Handicap at Vittel over 2,400m on 11 August. Has only been modest of late and more is needed to score
- 11. DADDY JOY** - Finished 11th in a Class 3 Handicap at Angers Eventard over 2,300m on 8 June. Successful before that but is unreliable. Might place

Summary: VENDOMYA (2) finished strongly at Deauville last time and looks to have the necessary handicap form to be competitive off this handicap mark. KING MOTIF (7) was held up by tiring rivals on the final turn at Saint-Malo but still ran well enough and can do better. SPLENDINO (1) has rarely put a foot wrong with Lorette Gallo in the sulky and should again be involved. LE GAST (3), judged on his penultimate effort, also has claims in a competitive lucky last race.
