

R4 SAINT MALO [R-H]

C1 - PRIX J. DU BOUEXIC - 3400m (a2m1/8) - TURF - Claiming - Hurdles - EUR € 19,000

- 1. DEAL DAILY** - Not reliable and was 5th in a hurdles claimer at Auteuil over 3000m on 2 May. Returns from a break but could be a threat if fit
- 2. NOUVELLE MAREE** - Successful second time out in a Claiming hurdles over this course and distance on 22 July. Looks capable of doubling up
- 3. MASTER AND SERVANT** - Finished 6th in a Conditions hurdle at Dieppe over 3400m on 27 June. Can be a threat dropped to a claimer
- 4. POP STARS** - Has some fair form and was fourth at this level at Clairefontaine over this distance on 27 July. Can make the frame
- 5. CHERIE DES BRIERES** - Showed improvement when third in a Class 5 Conditions Hurdle over this course and distance on 1 August. Can earn some more money
- 6. NOUBA D'HUISNES** - A three-year-old gelding by Tin Horse out of Hashtag des Dunes who is making his debut. His Dam ran fourth in her only starts. Could need this experience
- 7. ERA CHO** - Finished third on debut at this level over this track and trip on 22 July. Capable of making the frame once again
- 8. HARYNA DES OBEAUX** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in this division over this track and trip on 22 July. Should fight out the finish once again
- 9. BRICCONCELLA** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a Conditions hurdle over this track and trip on 1 August. Can go one place better
- 10. NOUKAT STAR** - Not disgraced when fifth in this division over this course and distance on 22 July. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

Summary: NOUVELLE MAREE (2) won the key trial on July 22nd in convincing fashion and, despite carrying 71kg, can confirm that form. HARYNA DES OBEAUX (8) is the obvious danger, meeting the selection again on significantly better weight terms. POP STARS (4) shaped well at Clairefontaine recently and has claims. DEAL DAILY (1), returning to action after finishing fifth at Auteuil in the spring, also has the ability to make the frame.

**C2 - PRIX CARCARADEC (PRIX MAHE DE LA BOURDONNAIS) - 3900m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Claiming -
Hurdles - EUR € 19,000**

1. CANONBIE LAD - Has struggled of late and was 6th in a chase claimer at Auteuil over 3600m on 6 May. Returns from a break but can upset back over hurdles

2. MONTVALEZAN - Usually competitive and finished third in this division over this course and distance on 1 August. Can challenge for top honours once again

3. MARIGOLD SACREE - Not reliable and was 7th in a Conditions flat race at Le Lion-d'Angers over 2400m on 9 August. Has won at this course before and cannot be ruled out

4. MORRA - Consistent and was third last time out in a chase claimer at Clairefontaine over 3700m on 27 July. Should be right there at the finish yet again

5. HALTREE DES OBEAUX - Came home 8th in a Class 4 Condition Hurdle at Dieppe over 3,400m on 9 July, Has not shown much yet and others make more appeal

6. MELBA BAM'S - Finished 6th on debut in a flat race at Molleres over 2900m on 26 July. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal

7. PROVERBIAL - Unreliable and was unplaced in a handicap hurdle at Dieppe over 3400m on 7 August. Quite capable of scoring at this level

8. MAJESTE DECIERGUES - Has hit the crossbar twice in a row, the latest in a hurdles claimer over this track and trip on 1 August. Deserves a winning turn

9. GOLDEN CRACK - Not reliable and was fifth in a chase claimer at Clairefontaine over 3700m on 27 July. Can be a danger back over the smaller obstacles

10. MAYAGUA DU LARGE - Unplaced last time out in a handicap hurdle at Dieppe over 3400m on 7 August. Needs to find a few lengths to score

Summary: Impeccable since the start of the year, MAJESTE DECIERGUES (8) deserves to see her consistency rewarded and looks a leading contender. MORRA (4) has also been producing a string of good performances and should be involved once again. MONTVALEZAN (2) can build on his recent third over this course and distance is capable of at least matching that effort. GOLDEN CRACK (9) needed his recent comeback run and is another who can make the frame.

C3 - PRIX PONTAVICE - 3900m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Class 3 - Hurdles - EUR € 22,000

1. LARGO DU BEARN - Holding form and ran well when third in a Class 4 Conditions Hurdle over this track and trip on 1 August. Should contest the finish once again

2. HARTHUR DES OBEAUX - Finished 7th in a Class 1 Condition Chase at Pau over 3,900m on 31 December. Returns from a break but can be competitive if fit enough

3. HARLEM SCHUFFLE - Finished third last time out in a hurdles race at Merano over 3500m on 28 September. Has won a Group 3 last year and is not out of it returning from a break

4. LA BELLE HISTOIRE - Not reliable and finished 6th in a handicap hurdle at Dieppe over 3800m on 9 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

5. HERE WE GO - Probably best to ignore the last run when unplaced in a handicap chase at Auteuil over 4400m on 29 November. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough

6. FENGBO - Finished 7th on debut in a Class 4 Condition Hurdle over this course and distance on 1 August. Capable of improvement but others are preferred

7. BATHYMOON - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a Conditions hurdle at Le Lion-d'Angers over 3700m on 3 August. Fit and could earn some money

8. LUTKA ROCK TAVEL - Finished 4th in a Class 4 Condition Chase at Questembert over 4,200m on 2 August. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal

9. LOLLYPOP DE COTTE - Victorious on debut in a Class 4 at Wissembourg La Harot over 2,400m on 12 April, Returns from a break but deserves some respect for that success

Summary: After an excellent 2025 campaign in handicap chases, HERE WE GO (5) is taken to make a winning return to action. LARGO DU BEARN (1) is the main danger, with current form on his side and a proven record at this course. HARTHUR DES OBEAUX (2) has beaten the selection several times in the past and is particularly effective when fresh so must be respected. Fellow returnee HARLEM SCHUFFLE (3) has solid credentials and should not be overlooked.

C4 - PRIX VINCENT DE GOURNAY - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 21,000

1. TRIUMPH RETURN - Unplaced in a Class 3 at Chantilly over 1,200m on 19 May. Returns from a break and has not shown much in two starts. Others are preferred

2. GOLDEN RUN - Consistent so far and finished fourth in a claimer at Compiègne over 1400m on 28 July. Can get involved with the finish once again

3. JAMINUS - Finished 7th in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 1,800m on 10 August. Has only been modest so far and needs to do more to score

4. GADZART - Finished 15th in a Maiden at Vichy over 1,400m on 20 July. Struggled on debut and needs major improvement to beat these rivals

5. JIEPIE ET JO - Came home 5th in a Class 2 at Vichy over 1,600m on 12 August. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role at very best

6. AL AHYAASHI - A two-year-old gelding by Al Wukair out of Heal The World who is making his debut. His Dam never won after three starts. Can make the frame

7. SHAZAL - A two-year-old gelding by Zelzal out of Shagah who is making his debut. His Dam was placed in a Group 2. Monitor the betting

8. CONFLUENT - A two-year-old gelding by Sea The Moon out of La Jonction who is making his debut. His Dam won her first two starts. Can be a threat

9. DILJIT - A two-year-old colt by Zarak out of Louve Nationale who is making his debut. His Dam won once in just three starts. Can score

Summary: DILJIT (9), a half-brother to Ligne d'Or, winner of the Prix de Flore (Gr.3), makes a highly anticipated debut and sets an interesting standard on breeding. GOLDEN RUN (2) has already had three starts and can draw on that experience so can score. CONFLUENT (8) represents a powerful stable with an excellent record with juveniles and deserves close attention. AL AHYAASHI (6) was also entered in the Prix de Montagu at Deauville, which suggests he could be a leading contender on debut.

**C5 - PRIX JULIEN BROSSAIS (PRIX DE LA SOCIETE DES COURSES DE NANTES) - 1800m (a1m1/8) -
TURF - - Flat - EUR € 21,000**

- 1. LE VERDON** - Good 3rd in a maiden over 1400m at Lion D'Angers on the 24th of July 2026. Will inch closer as she steps up in trip
- 2. LILY ANGEL** - Finished 9th on debut in a maiden over 1400m at Lion D'Angers on the 24th of July 2026. Will look for improvement
- 3. JUST YET** - Hearty 7th on debut in a maiden over 1600m at Clairefontaine on the 1st of August 2026. Place chance
- 4. COSMIC MALPIC** - Supplemented and finished 6th in a Claimer over 1600m at Saint-Malo on the 1st of August 2026. Can disrupt the top 4 play
- 5. MAGIC INSPIRATION** - Improved effort into 2nd in a maiden over 1600m at Clairefontaine on the 1st of August 2026. Strong winning chance
- 6. LIONNE ROUGE** - This filly is out of the unraced mare Double Secret. She has her first run and will be looking for a learning effort
- 7. LAST CARAT FAL** - This filly is out of the two-time winning mare Amourette who also placed in a Listed over the mile. She could put up a bold debut effort
- 8. MALAVELLO** - This filly is out of the unraced mare Marillana. Not much on pedigree but follow the betting for a guide
- 9. OUNHA** - This filly is out of the three-time winning mare Golden Bere who was successful over the hurdles. Could be anything

Summary: MAGIC INSPIRATION (5) ran a cracking race when finishing second and she certainly looks the filly that will take a power of beating here. LAST CARAT FAL (7) is a filly out of a mare that placed in a Listed and found success twice in her career. She could put up a bold debut effort. LE VERDON (1) has run two consecutive thirds to date and must be given serious consideration in this contest. JUST YET (3) holds a place chance at best.

**C6 - PRIX ROBERT SURCOUF (PRIX DE LA SOCIETE DES COURSES DE PORNICHET) - 1800m
(a1m1/8) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 15,600**

- 1. PIYANGO** - Solid 2nd in a Handicap over 1800m at Compiègne on the 9th of June 2026. Bold winning chance on form
- 2. BELLO CONDOR** - Difficult 11th on debut in a maiden over 1800m at Dieppe on the 30th of July 2026. Top choices look more attractive
- 3. AS CELESTE** - Finished 4th on debut in a maiden over 1800m at Dieppe on the 30th of July 2026. Can disrupt the finishing
- 4. FEE ZELEE** - Pleasant 4th in a maiden over 1800m at Saint-Malo on the 22nd of July 2026. Could strike in this contest
- 5. PRINCESS MAITHA** - Positive 2nd in a maiden over 1400m at Catterick on the 23rd of July 2026. Debuts on French surfaces and could surprise
- 6. BYMOON** - Ran 6th in a maiden in Milan on the 25th of October 2025 over 1700m. She returns after a long layoff and may need it
- 7. MAJARA** - Finished 7th in a maiden over 2400m at Dieppe on the 30th of July 2026. Must not be discounted on form
- 8. MIDNIGHT MAGIC** - Better run into 2nd in a maiden over 1700m at Pornichet on the 29th of November 2025. Returns after a rest and can run well fresh
- 9. EYNARD** - Tough 11th in a maiden over 1800m at Saint-Malo on the 22nd of July 2026. One to respectfully pass by
- 10. TREZY CREME** - Credible 5th in a maiden over 1800m at Dieppe on the 30th of July 2026. Can make the necessary improvement to inch closer
- 11. MARTINELLI** - Forgivable 8th in a Handicap over 1600m at Vichy on the 24th of July 2026. Has the potential to threaten

Summary: PIYANGO (1) is in highly threatening form and has the urge to break the maiden shackles off his hooves. He looks the bright candidate to execute it this time around. MARTINELLI (11) is a filly that is never far off the action and although being erratic on form, she has the credentials to conquer if wise. MIDNIGHT MAGIC (8) can give the top two a run for their money if they go missing here, FEE ZELEE (4) wraps up the quartet mix.

C7 - PRIX JOSEPH ET JOBIC SEVERE - 2500m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Condition - Flat - EUR € 16,000

- 1. NECTAR DE MIRANDE** - This gelding is out of an unraced mare Apaisante. Best to follow the betting for a better guide
- 2. NARCO D'AINAY** - This gelding is out of the unraced mare Funny Vic. Not much confidence on pedigree but will be one to note after here
- 3. NERINO** - This gelding is out of the two-time winning mare Quaresca who also went the distance in the steeplechase and hurdles races. He should be flying at them
- 4. NIGHTMARE DU LIVET** - This colt is out of the four-time winning mare Dream D'Art who conquered over the 2950m and further. Lurker chance of surprising this field
- 5. NIKOSY** - This filly is out of a one-time winning mare Interdite who found success over the 2400m. She could be suited to the trip on debut
- 6. NON BINAIRE** - A filly out of the mare Garde Ton Wisky who raced six times in her career but was unsuccessful in each event. Best to look elsewhere
- 7. NANA AU RHUM** - Supplemented filly who is out of a three-time winning mare who competed in the steeplechase and hurdles races. She could put up a bold debut experience

Summary: Supplemented NANA AU RHUM (7) is out of a three-time winning mare who also competed at a Listed level in her career. She could go close to winning on debut. NECTAR DE MIRANDE (1) not much to drive confidence on pedigree but is best to follow the betting support as the yard could have him ready. NIKOSY (5) is bred for success and will be one that can shine bright on debut if the first-time experience does not hold her back. NERINO (3) he will be mowing them down.
