

R1 VINCENNES [L-H]

C1 - PRIX CLEOMEDE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 59,000

1. **MARK SCHERMER** - Runner-up in last 2, most recently over 2500m in Berlin-Mariendorf. Has no French references and can expect to find the going rather tough
2. **IMPERATUR AM** - Makes French debut after coming 3rd over 2140m at Romme on 9 August. Stays shod for the occasion but with Eric Raffin reining is unlikely to be far off the mark
3. **JACKPOT MEARAS** - Has taken his game to another level since coming to France, most recently making short work of a Class D over 2,850m here on 11 September, and is in with a realistic shout of doubling his money
4. **JADOU DU LUPIN** - Finished 3rd in a Class D at Laval over 2,850m on 28 August after having imposed at Lignieres in July. Presents fine Vincennes references, will be barefoot this time and no soft touch
5. **DAYAK (ITY)** - Won a brace earlier in the summer before 2 straight disqualifications. Got his head in front last time here and should not be ruled out
6. **JOYEUX DU LANDRET** - Victorious in a Class D at Laval over 2,850m on 19 August. Seldom disappoints in present configuration and although not a priority, is still not to be underestimated
7. **HAPPY PACHA** - Fourth in a Class D over 2,175m here on 5 September. A repeat, however seems most improbable
8. **IOUPY TOLLEVILLE** - Sports a new configuration following a trio of uninspired runs but can still be confidently passed over
9. **JIBI DU FRUITIER** - Finished 6th in a Class C over 2,850m here on 29 August. Takes a dip in category and is not incapable of picking up a first-five cheque
10. **JUST DU CHATELET** - Unplaced in a Class D at La Capelle over 2,700m on 2 September. Has bags of talent though, will be barefoot for first target of the autumn, and must be considered a player
11. **NEO TURBO** - Runner-up in a Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 7 August, just missing out on the double. Has earned the right to take his chances here and the Alexandre Abrivard-factor cannot be ignored

Summary: JACKPOT MEARAS (3) was hugely impressive in a Quinte last Friday and is clearly the one to beat. JADOU DU LUPIN (4), barefoot this time, and JUST DU CHATELET (10), prepared for this race, are closely-matched and impossible to ignore. After a fine meeting at Cagnes-sur-Mer, NEO TURBO (11) returns to the capital with a good hand to play.

C2 - PRIX EROS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

1. **MALIZIOSA** - Returned to winning ways at Carentan in mid-August but failed to confirm early this month in a Cabourg Class E and can be ruled out
2. **MELLYNGA** - Unexceptional filly that was disqualified in a 2800m Vire Class E on 6 September and is not about to upset the natural order of things
3. **MAFIA RINGEAT** - Respectable 5th in a Class D at La Capelle 3.5 weeks ago but will have nothing to contribute here
4. **MY LOVELY LADY** - Third in a Class E over course and distance on 31 August. Steps up in category but is plainly in shape and cannot be discounted
5. **MADONE PIYA** - Ran 6th in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,050m on 21 August and is unlikely to spring any surprises
6. **MIRA DE BAFFAIS** - Runner-up in a Class E at Enghien over 2,150m on 10 August, complementing her Cabourg performance of 10 days earlier. Is new to Vincennes but has shown good versatility and is unlikely to let the side down
7. **MAISY DU DONJON** - Fifth in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 11 August, after having run 2nd in her previous two outings. Damien Bonne gets the nod this time and should show some improvement
8. **MAGABYLOU** - Failed to complete the hat-trick when 2nd in a Class E at Pornichet over 2,650m on 20 August. Faces a stiffer test this time but is patently at the top of her game and is worth retaining for minor honours
9. **MAYA PONT VAUTIER** - Was unable to confirm Le Mans victory when 7th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 4 September. Is confirmed under these conditions though, sports a fresh configuration, and should not be overlooked
10. **MOANA DE WALLIS** - Opened her 2026 account at Cabourg on 14 August but was eliminated a week later under similar conditions. Has bags of ability but others still easier to trust
11. **MARBELLA** - Third in a Class E at Angers over 3,125m on 9 September. Put in an excellent performance that day, and in the absence of the colts looks a major player
12. **MASCOTTE DU STADE** - In the frame in 3 after winning at Villedieu in early-May, most recently runner-up in a Class E at Argentan over 2,150m on 16 August. Is reunited with Robin Lamy who won with her that day and must be respected
13. **MUSICA JULMA** - Disqualified in a Brehal Class E on comeback early last month. Has picked up where she left off last April and will have few friends
14. **MOON NORMANDY** - Tricky but talented filly that failed to confirm her Enghien performance when disqualified in a 2050m Cabourg Class D on 21 August and others preferred
15. **MIAMI** - Somewhat surprising 2nd in a Class E at Bernay over 2,800m on 30 August and a repeat seems most improbable
16. **MALINE DES ARRIS** - Enjoys a fine entry but has been out of sorts since returning to competition and will first need to reassure
17. **MOUVANCE DANICA** - Just missed out in a 2100m Class E here 10 days ago, a month after having imposed at Graignes. Benefits from a terrific entry and Eric Raffin has stayed faithful. Claim

Summary: There are plenty of possibilities among these 4-year-old fillies. MOUVANCE DANICA (17), narrowly beaten on her Vincennes debut, should have the class to compete at this level. Beaten by two good colts at Angers, MARBELLA (11) will have her supporters, as will MASCOTTE DU STADE (12), who is clearly close to her race. MIRA DE BAFFAIS (6) and MAISY DU DONJON (7) are in good form and will be expected to finish in the mix.

C3 - PRIX ELISA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 53,000

1. **LIKE MESLOIS** - Has been showing more in the provinces lately, lastly 3rd in a 2750m Cabourg Class D on 21 august, and is unlikely to shake things up
2. **LUCKY MESLOIS** - Unplaced in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 12 August after having won twice in the provinces. In this company though will have nothing to contribute
3. **LIQUIDATEUR** - Unremarkable sort that lost his action in an Enghien Class C on 11 July. Has not raced since, will be shod for comeback, and can be ruled out
4. **LULU DES CARREAUX** - Won a Class D at Argentan over 2,150m on 8 August, his first appearance for 2 months. Will have only improved for the race and Mathieu Mottier gets the nod this time. First five
5. **LOCO FLIGNY** - Unplaced in a Class D at Laval over 2,850m on 23 August. Has previously imposed under these conditions but in current shape it is hard to make a case
6. **LOOK MESLOIS** - Highly impressive winner of a Class D at Vincennes over 2,850m on 4 September, and with form maintained can repeat
7. **LEXCELLENT DU METZ** - Eliminated in a 2750m Cabourg Class D three weeks ago. Is never far from faulting but has buckets of ability and can figure prominently if Yoann Lebourgeois keeps him focused
8. **LOYAL DU CHOQUEL** - Unplaced in a Class B at Enghien over 2,875m on 6 August. Should not be too hastily-judged though, presents excellent main-track references, and looks a player
9. **LEVEL ONE SYGA** - Runner-up in a Class D over 2,100m here on 24 August. Has returned to competition in fine shape but at this level looks a minor place chance at best
10. **LE BOLIDE** - Placed in last 2, most recently 3rd in an Arras Class E on 23 August. Is not a priority but should nevertheless acquit himself honourably
11. **LUGANO DE LOU** - Put three straight sanctions behind him to dominate a 2100m Class D here 3.5 weeks ago. Goes over any trip and is unlikely to return home empty-handed
12. **LOQUIDY** - Unplaced in a Class B at Laval over 2,850m on 19 August, his first appearance since February. Excels here and, considering the engagement, must be considered a leading contender

Summary: It's very open but LOOK MESLOIS (6), brilliant winner of a Quinte here 2 weeks ago, may just be good enough to confirm. LOYAL DU CHOQUEL (8) was not at his best at Enghien this summer but should not be written off. LOQUIDY (12), who ended last season with a Vincennes hat-trick and who will be shod as he was during the winter, and the complicated but serious L'EXCELLENT DU METZ (7), can also figure prominently.

C4 - PRIX EUCHARIS - 2100m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. MIDDLE EARTH** - Has not been seen out since dominating a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 16 April. Is barefoot for the occasion though and, already a winner over course and distance, can get straight down to business
- 2. MA LIBERTE** - Finished 2nd in a Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2,850m on 4 September, complementing her re-entry run at Enghien. Enjoys a good spot on the front line and can bring the fight to MERRY (13)
- 3. MINILADY DE CHOC** - Has not been seen out since finishing unplaced in a monte Class D over 2,175m here on 26 May and will have other priorities
- 4. MAGIE MESLOISE** - Won a Class D here before being put away. Has a race under her belt, goes barefoot this time and, from the 4 slot, can make a big splash
- 5. MALICIA BELLA** - Successful in a Class B at Grenade-Sur-Garonne over 2,700m on 15 August. Boasts a 75 percent win-rate and will be expected to give this a good go
- 6. MARINA JAMES** - Returns to Vincennes after running 5th in a Carentan Class D in mid-August but still has more to find
- 7. MAGIE DE CHAHAINS** - Fourth in a Class B at Lisieux over 2,725m on 17 August. Has not put a foot out of line for the past three months and can again make the first five
- 8. MOUSTACHE** - Runner-up in a Class D over course and distance on 11 September. Is not the most reliable of horses but has recently taken a liking to the main track and should not be ruled out
- 9. MANDARINA DE LOU** - Is not without merit and has form under these conditions but has just one race in her since June and is unlikely to garner much support
- 10. MALVINA MADRIK** - Finished 9th, following a layup, in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,100m on 11 September. Is no star but will have come on for the run and will have her supporters
- 11. MILADY OF PARIS** - Finished 2nd in a Class B at Lisieux over 2,725m on 17 August. Did win over course and distance earlier in the year, however a repeat seems most unlikely
- 12. MOONSTAR JYL** - Complicated but has ample ability, most recently fifth in a 2700m Class D here 2 weeks ago, but would be preferred competitively-shod
- 13. MERRY** - Finished 10th in a Class D over course and distance on 11 September but can be considered unfortunate. Has nothing to prove at this level and despite the draw can win this
- 14. MOSCANTIDA PEAL** - Ran 6th in a Class D under these conditions on 11 September. Is some way off her best form and can be passed over
- 15. MILANTERA** - Ran reassuring 5th in a Class D over course and distance on 11 September. Eric Raffin stays faithful but others still easier to back
- 16. MONNAIE COURANTE** - Eliminated in last three, most recently a 2700m Class D here on 4 September. Has pulled a rough number and will have few takers

Summary: Most unlucky here a week ago under these very conditions, MERRY (13) may be forced to start on the back line again but she showed her form and can impose this time. Unbeaten in 2 barefoot starts, MIDDLE EARTH (1) may not have been seen out since April but she will have work under her belt and will be no easy touch. MA LIBERTE (2) has got straight back on track since the layoff and with application can finish close, as can MAGIE MESLOISE (4) who is barefoot for her first objective of the autumn. Similarly well-positioned, MALICIA BELLA (5) was imperious at Grenade-sur-Garonne when barefoot for the first time and must be taken seriously.

C5 - PRIX LACADEIRA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 35,000

1. **NAUTILUS DES PRES** - Produced career-best performance at Brehal 3 weeks before being disqualified in a Class F at Sable-sur-Sarthe on 9 August, and others easier to like
2. **NECTAR DE MONTCEAU** - Has not been seen out since running 6th in a Class D over 2,200m here on 14 April and is not about to spring any surprises
3. **NUCIFER** - Handy sort sporting 4 pads for the first time, having faulted in a Cabourg Class E on 1 September, but nevertheless appears to be taking on too much
4. **NISOS DU GOUTIER** - Failed to confirm Laval success when disqualified in a Cabourg Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Is a good future prospect though and Eric Raffin will be justifiably hopeful of keeping their undefeated status intact
5. **NEMO D'ARNHEM** - Finished 6th in a Class D over course and distance on 26 August, having reassured at Vittel the previous month, and is unlikely to trouble the opposition
6. **NASCO DE MIRE** - Respectable sort that ran flattering 4th in a 2100m Class E here on 1 September but is unlikely to improve on that
7. **NOROMAOR** - Produced a pair of fine efforts at Pornichet before being eliminated in a 2175m Class D here 10 days ago. Is clearly in good shape though and Mathieu Mottier will be keen to set the record straight
8. **NORDLAND VEDAQUAIS** - Won 2, disqualified in 2, the last a Class D under these conditions late last month. Is patently in rude health though and, with application, can wrap this up
9. **NEBULO** - Lost his maiden status at Avranches in early-August but was eliminated at Mauquenchy last week. Pleased on sole start with David Thomain and is easy to fancy for a first-five payout
10. **NIDOR DE SUBLIGNY** - Second in a Class E at Bernay over 2,800m on 30 August, after having got off the mark at Ecommoy the previous month. Sports front pads for the first time and can again finish in the mix
11. **NEW YORKER** - Disqualified in last three starts, the latest a Class D over course and distance on 26 August. Has demonstrated significant promise though and it is only a question of time before he gets back in the game
12. **NOVATEUR DU VIF** - Finished 3rd in a Class E at Laval over 2,850m on 28 August. Always gives his best but is being aimed a bit too high this time

Summary: NORDLAND VEDAQUAIS (8), who was disqualified after having done all the hard work on his Vincennes debut, will be re-shod and can redeem himself. NISOS DU GOUTIER (4), who caught the eye after his mistake at Cabourg, will also sport pads and looks a useful colt. NOROMAOR (7) showed his form despite being disqualified here recently and deserves another chance. NEW YORKER (11) has been very spirited of late but has potential and represents an interesting punt.

C6 - PRIX ARTEMIS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Mounted - EUR € 46,000

1. **MANOLA DE MUZE** - Debuts in the discipline after running 5th in an Enghien harness Class D on 13 August. Presents decent harness credentials but others still preferred
2. **MERRY CHRISTMAS** - Makes monte bow following a string of modest harness efforts and is unlikely to spring any surprises
3. **MINA DRY** - Sprang a 23-1 surprise when 2nd in a Class D over track and trip on 26 August. Confirmation, however, seems unlikely
4. **MARECHAL TURGOT** - Second in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 1 August, 2.5 weeks after having imposed at Cabourg, but in this category is unlikely to spice things up
5. **MEANDRE DE VANDEL** - Won a Class D over course and distance before finishing runner-up in a Class F at Lisieux over 2,725m on 2 July. Comes here fresh, but patently in competition-mode, and is unlikely to disappoint
6. **MILLESIMA** - Victorious in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 1 August. Has previously won here and could do so again if Mathieu Mottier keeps her trotting
7. **MUST D'HERMES** - Made up for a pair of Enghien disqualifications when second in a 2750m Cabourg Class E on 14 August, and will not be far from the action if Anthony Barrier keeps him focused
8. **MAURICIO DU DERBY** - Has been completely out of sorts since winning a 2200m Class D over the inner course, at 55-1, in April and can be disregarded
9. **MONSTER SPEED** - Successful in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 10 August. Eric Raffin has stayed faithful and can legitimately expect to finish close
10. **MAORI NUEVO** - Has not been seen out since finishing 10th in a Class B at Vincennes over 2,850m on 9 June. Has a lot going for him this time and Benjamin Rochard will be eager to put things right
11. **MUSCADE LEMAN** - Fourth in a harness Class B at Chartres over 2,825m on 11 September 2026, but returns to the monte code with little to contribute
12. **MISSY DE JIEL** - Has turned a corner since returning to the monte code, most recently winning a Class D over course and distance on 26 August, and will be well-backed for a repeat
13. **MONACO** - Made up for Hyeres sanction when close 2nd in a Cagnes Class F in mid-August. Is not a priority but on good behaviour should be able to hold his own

Summary: Most convincing in her last two starts under the saddle, MISSY DE JIEL (12) has every chance of confirming last month's course-and-distance success. MAORI NUEVO (10) races barefoot for the first time, will be partnered by Benjamin Rochard, and must be given plenty of respect. The two Monclin runners, MONSTER SPEED (9) and MUST D'HERMES (7), have already proved themselves at this level, and are both in excellent shape.

C7 - PRIX LYRA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 35,000

1. **NAIROBI DE LAHAYE** - Respectable for the most part, most recently fifth in a Class F at Saint-Omer on 30 August, but at this level will have too much to do
2. **NODESSA JOSSELYN** - Third in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 5 August, her first start since her February debut. Tackles a much more difficult challenge here and can be passed over
3. **NOMINEE** - Modest element that ran 8th in a Rambouillet Class F earlier in the month and is not about to lose her maiden tag
4. **NEW CREATION** - Won a Class F, on comeback, at Sable Sur Sarthe over 2,825m on 9 August. Sports front pads for the first time, however confirmation is most unlikely
5. **NICE GIRL BECO** - Got off the mark on 6 September when securing a Tours Class G over 2800m. Has no left-handed references and is not about to influence the result
6. **NOMADE VRIE** - Finished 6th in a Class D over 2,175m here on 11 September. Is better than the result would suggest and should not be overlooked
7. **NINA DE BASSIERE** - Posted 3 straight disqualifications before imposing at over 100-1 at Pornichet on 24 August. A repeat seems unlikely but it might be unwise to discount her
8. **NIKITA DE MONTCEAU** - In the frame in 3 of last 4, most recently 2nd in an Amiens Class F a fortnight ago, however in this category will need to find more
9. **NORMA DES CHARMES** - Fifth in a Class E at Laval over 2,850m on 28 August, 2.5 weeks after having run 2nd in a Saint-Malo Class F, and others easier to back
10. **NATURE D'ECHAL** - Complicated filly but has ample ability. Showed a bit too much spirit here a week ago, but Alexis Collette takes over and can finish close if he keeps her mind on the game
11. **NEWMARKET** - In the frame in last 2, most recently third in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,050m on 25 August. Is confirmed left-handed and will be no pushover if she takes to the new conditions
12. **NIKITA WOOD** - Made up for early-August elimination when 2nd in a Pornichet Class E on 20 August. Is well-regarded at home and can contest the finish
13. **NOUBA DE CHINE** - Did not enjoy the best of runs when disqualified in a Class D under these conditions late last month. Showed her form though and with application can set the record straight
14. **NATURA** - Confirmed debut victory when comfortably winning a Class F at La Capelle on 30 July. Comes here fresh, ideally-engaged and, reunited with Eric Raffin, will be well-backed to secure the three-timer

Summary: Unbeaten in 2 starts, NATURA (14) faces something a test in Paris but still has the wherewithal to complete the hat-trick. Blessed with plenty of stamina, NOUBA DE CHINE (13) will be expected to make amends for losing her action here late last month. NIKITA WOOD (12) has been knocking at the door, as has NEWMARKET (11), who was just narrowly beaten at Cabourg. If she stays focused, NATURE D'ECHAL (10) has the class to compete at this level.

C8 - PRIX AQUITANIA - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 38,000

1. **OASIENNE** - Qualified respectively in July but has been disqualified in both starts to date and is unlikely to generate much interest
2. **ONALISA** - Finished 7th in a Class C over 2,175m here on 26 August 2026, first time out, and will need to find significantly more
3. **ON THE BEACH** - Second on debut in a Class E at Rambouillet over 2,000m on 6 September. Is sure to have come on for the race and is worth keeping an eye on
4. **OVADA** - Runner-up to OH FAMILY (7) in a Class F at Cabourg over 2,050m on 1 September. Has earned the right to race here and represents the principal danger to the Duvaldestin filly
5. **OLGA STAR** - Got off the mark at the first time of asking, securing a 2200m Class G at Agon-Coutainville on 24 August. Takes on a better bunch here but should nevertheless hold her own
6. **OBELLA DES BORDES** - Finished 5th in a Class C over 2,175m here on 26 August. Should take well to the inner course and can make the frame this time
7. **OH FAMILY** - Made short work on debut of a Class F at Cabourg over 2,050m on 1 September. Will have progressed for the run and looks set to take all the beating
8. **OLA VALLIERE** - Finished unthreatening 4th in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,050m on 21 August, after having imposed at Bernal first time out. Is an interesting future prospect and must be respected
9. **OCEANIE DE TILLARD** - Runner-up in first two before running fifth in a 2250m Enghien Class C early last month. Takes on a considerably better bunch this time and is unlikely to create an upset
10. **OLGA DES MALBERAUX** - Has not been seen out since getting off the mark in a Brehal Class G on 20 July. Makes first public appearance on dirt and will justifiably garner support

Summary: OH FAMILY (7) made a comfortable winning debut at Cabourg and only needs to stay focused in order to follow up. Runner-up to her that day, OVADA (4) may struggle to reverse the form but can still play a leading role. OBELLA DES BORDES (6) was far from disgraced on her Vincennes debut and should appreciate the inner track. OLA VALLIERE (8) has shown promise in the provinces.
