

R3 CABOURG [R-H]

C1 - PRIX DE GLANVILLE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

1. **NOUVELLE ERE EMDE** - Career debutante that qualified in 1'17"7 at Caen on 17 June and will be worth monitoring first time out
2. **NIKITA DU BOUILLON** - Disqualified on debut in a Class F at Alencon over 2,650m on 6 September and will have nothing to contribute
3. **NOSTALGIE JIEL** - Disqualified in a Class E over course and distance on 21 August and even with Pierre-Yves Verva riding is unlikely to make much of an impact
4. **NOEMIE D'AVEL** - Ran 5th in a Dozule Class F on debut last weekend but faces a much tougher task this time around
5. **NAUSICAA JIEL** - Has not been seen out since finishing 6th in a harness Class G at Gournay En Bray over 2,550m on 25 May. Failed to make any impression on monte bow last winter and is unlikely to this time either
6. **NETIQUETTE** - Has undeniable ability but has been disqualified in both monte starts to date and would be preferred with pads fitted
7. **NUANCE D'ORGUEIL** - Third in a Class E under these conditions on 1 September. Is not a priority but Theo Peltier stays faithful and will have her supporters
8. **NO TIME TO JYL** - Disqualified in a harness Class F at Alencon a fortnight ago. Is as complicated as they come but has bags of promise and the change of code may be just what the doctor ordered
9. **NAGOYA MESLOISE** - Ran second over course and distance on debut last month. Returns to Cabourg after two disqualifications in Paris and, on good behaviour, can make a big impact
10. **NUSICA ASSCHADEL** - Sprang something of a surprise when 2nd in a Bernay Class E 3 weeks ago but is biting off more than she can chew this time
11. **NANALAND** - Should not be too hastily-judged for losing her action in a Class E over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. Gave a much better account here 10 days earlier and, if behaved, can challenge for a place on the podium
12. **NINA DU MINON** - Debuts in the discipline after some modest harness performances and is unlikely to create an upset
13. **NOUVELLE D'ATOUT** - Finished 5th in a Class E over course and distance on 21 August. Has taken well to the monte code and looks a respectable first-five chance
14. **NIKALY D'EOLE** - Will be fully-fit following a brace of harness fresheners. Sports front pads for the first time and has every chance of getting off the mark
15. **NUIT DU QUENNE** - Finished 4th in a harness Class E at Chartres over 2,800m on 11 September. Alexis Collette aboard for her ridden bow and has the class to get straight down to business

Summary: NIKALY D'EOLE (14), who caught the eye more than once in this code during the spring, has had two comeback runs under harness and, sporting a fresh configuration, looks a formidable contender. NAGOYA MESLOISE (9), whose prospects will be dictated by her spirit, and NUIT DU QUENNE (15), shod and worth watching on her debut in the discipline, are best placed to challenge her. NANALAND (11), if applied, will be no pushover.

C2 - PRIX DE DARNETAL - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **NACRE BLANCHE** - Disqualified in a Class H at Agon-Coutainville over 2,200m on 30 August. Has been reconfigured for the first time but others still easier to back
2. **NOUNE DE GAGOU** - Disqualified in a Lisieux Class G last Monday. Has yet to show any particular flair and can be ruled out
3. **NINA DES LIARDS** - Lost her maiden status a fortnight ago when successful in an Evreux Class H. Takes a notable step up in category but can still put on a good show
4. **NOUNASSIMA** - Capable but complicated filly making right-handed debut after being disqualified in a Vincennes Class E a fortnight ago. Has been re-shod for the occasion which may prove key to her rehabilitation. First five
5. **NYMPHE DE FLEUR** - Unplaced in a Class D over course and distance on 18 August. Has been rather disappointing since the spring and will have little to contribute
6. **NINA CHARENTEAISE** - Disqualified on comeback in a Class D at Les Andelys last Sunday. Will have come on for the run and even though shod should not be far from the action
7. **NEURO BELLA** - Tricky individual making first appearance since running 4th in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 3 March. Is clearly in race-mode but looks no more than a minor place chance
8. **NYMPHADORA TONKS** - Should not be condemned for losing her action in a Vincennes Class E earlier in the month. Is plainly in excellent shape and can make her Cabourg debut a winning one
9. **NESSY D'AR** - Finished 4th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2,100m on 4 September, a fortnight after having run 2nd at Saint-Galmier, and is not incapable of getting off the mark
10. **NORMA DE CAHOT** - Finished 4th in a Class E at Erbray over 2,675m on 30 August, 3 weeks after failing to deliver here. Is competitively-shod for the first time though and can play a leading role
11. **NEBELINE LEMAN** - Fourth in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,150m on 23 July, but returns to racing shod and best to keep one's powder dry

Summary: NYMPHADORA TONKS (8) has the best credentials and will be hard to beat if she stays focused. Well-engaged and reconfigured, NESSY D'AR (9) has been showing improvement, while the in-form NORMA DE CAHOT (10) sports four pads for the first time. NINA CHARENTEAISE (6) will be expected to bounce back from her recent sanction.

C3 - PRIX VICTOR HUNGER - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 18,500

1. **MARCO DU VERGER** - Ran 5th in Lisieux then confirmed in a Vire Class E a fortnight ago. Will not be as competitively-shod this time though and is not an obvious choice
2. **MADISON** - Eliminated more often than not but has evident potential. Has been freshly reconfigured for monte bow and, with application, will not be going home empty-handed
3. **MATUVU** - Ran 3rd in a Lisieux Class F 3 weeks ago, 8 days prior to losing her action in a Vire Class E. Is not entirely without merit though and could yet get a look in
4. **MAESTRO DES HETRES** - Ran 5th in a Class E at Le Croise-Laroche last Monday on first appearance under the saddle, but still needs to find more
5. **MYSTIC FISH** - Finished 7th in a harness Class F at Lisieux over 2,675m on 14 September. Ran 5th on monte debut here in late-July, will be barefoot again, and can pick up another cheque
6. **MUSCAT DE L'ITON** - Makes monte debut after being disqualified in a harness Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles last Sunday and has no realistic chance
7. **MINOS DE LA VALLEE** - Would have finished 3rd here earlier in the month had he kept his action together, and can again figure prominently if Adrien Lamy keeps him focused
8. **MALOU DE DIGEON** - Disqualified in a Saint-Omer harness Class F last Sunday. Has placed just once in 3 monte starts and cannot be considered a player
9. **MAGICO DODVILLE** - Unplaced in a harness Class H at Ploermel over 2,900m on 29 August. Is shod this time and will have few takers
10. **MANU D'HUCHELOUP** - Has demonstrated decent aptitude for the discipline but is on a disqualification three-timer and others easier to trust
11. **MAECO DELADOU** - Has not been seen out since finishing unplaced in a harness Class H at La Gacilly over 2,300m on 5 July. Has been freshly re-shod but still has a lot more to find
12. **MONDIAL** - Gave an excellent account to run 2nd to a very good horse in a Class F over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago, and is easy to fancy for the win this time
13. **MISTRAL DEL PHEDO** - Makes first public appearance under the saddle after running sixth in a Cholet Class F on 8 days ago and is not about to spring any surprises
14. **MILLE DOLLARS** - Complicated individual returning to Cabourg on a hat-trick of disqualifications but has form under these conditions and should prove main danger to MONDIAL (12)
15. **MEMPHIS PARIS** - Back under the saddle following 2 modest efforts in the other code. Sports a new formula but is still not a priority
16. **MARTIN DE REGO** - Finished 3rd in a Class F over course and distance on 1 September. Will have come on for the race and can again finish in the mix
17. **MIEL MADRIK** - Nicely-engaged colt taking first competitive monte steps following a pair of fine harness runs. Won under harness on sole association with Antonin Andre who will be eager to keep their undefeated status intact
18. **MON TWIST** - Has been struggling in both codes since imposing under harness in June and will first need to get his house in order

Summary: Beaten only by the useful Mojito Planchette here last time, it should not be long before MONDIAL (12) opens his account. MILLE DOLLARS (14), who will be no soft touch if focused, and MIEL MADRIK (17), making his monte debut in cracking form, will provide tough opposition. MARTIN DE REGO (16), and a reconfigured MINOS DE LA VALLEE (7), who caught the eye behind our selection at the beginning of the month, are logical choices.

C4 - PRIX DE DIVES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. NAME OF LOVE** - Imposed on debut before being disqualified in a Class E at Caen over 2,450m on 15 June. Comes here fresh, reconfigured, and eminently capable of winning a race of this nature
- 2. NOWAK BONBON** - Was unable to confirm Granville performance when eliminated in a Craon Class E a fortnight ago. Is a colt of considerable promise and, with application, should not disappoint
- 3. NEVER D'AVE** - Did not enjoy the best of trips in a Class E over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago. Pierre-Yves Verva is back in the bike and can contest the finish if he keeps his colt trotting
- 4. NOBLE DIABLE MEF** - Left a good impression at Lisieux 3 weeks ago when 3rd in a 2725m Class E, however a repeat seems unlikely
- 5. NICO ARCTIC** - Useful sort making first start since finishing runner-up in a Class E at Vire over 2,800m on 18 May. Will have work under his belt and, if applied, can pick up a cheque
- 6. NEFERT D'ALESA** - Finished 4th in a Class E over 2,050m here on 21 August, confirming his performance here the previous month, but would be better-suited to a mobile start
- 7. NIGHTMARE** - 3rd in a Bernay Class E late last month. Is more dependable on turf but sports a fresh configuration and could pleasantly surprise
- 8. NEO DE SOMMAIRE** - Sprang quite the surprise when victorious in a Brehal Class F but failed to confirm at Vire late last month, and can be passed over
- 9. NARVIK DU BESSIN** - Finished 4th in a Class E at Bernay over 2,800m on 30 August. Has shown considerable promise and can compete for a place in the frame
- 10. N'OUBLIE PAS** - Finished 4th in a Class E at Vire over 2,800m on 31 August, 10 days after failing to produce the goods here. Has merit though and cannot be discounted

Summary: NAME OF LOVE (1), sporting four pads for the first time, is the selection and has potential in abundance. However, NEVER D'AVE (3), with a serious driver in the bike this time, NIGHTMARE (7), reconfigured and difficult to fault when focused, and NARVIK DU BESSIN (9), who debuts for his new handler, are all contenders.

C5 - PRIX D'ANNEBECQ - 2750m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MAYA DES DUNES** - Produced career-best performance when 4th in a Class H at Neuillé-Pont-Pierre 3 weeks ago but in this field has no possible chance
- 2. MINI COOPER'S ERA** - Starts for the first time since being disqualified in a Class F at Graignes over 2,725m on 30 December 2025 and will have nothing to contribute
- 3. MISSISSIPPI QUEEN** - Took time to come to hand this summer but ran reassuring third in a Class E over course and distance 8 days ago and with stride in check is unlikely to let the side down
- 4. MAMAN BAO** - Eliminated in 2 of last 3, lastly a Chateauroux Class H last weekend, but seldom disappoints when focused and must be considered a priority
- 5. MALAVITA** - Serious filly that imposed at Le Touquet on 22 August before running 2nd in a Class E over course and distance 2.5 weeks ago and can expect the lion's share of support
- 6. MAYA DE CLARBEC** - Imposed at Avranches in early-August but has twice failed to confirm and is not about to shake things up
- 7. MOMINETTE** - Unplaced in a monte Class E under these conditions on 31 July. Is here for reasons of conditioning and can be passed over
- 8. MILADY DREAM** - Has been a complete write-off since winning a Caen Class E in June and will have nothing to offer
- 9. MOLLY WHITE** - Not without merit but is a complicated filly and would be preferred in the other discipline
- 10. MELVIANA** - Quality individual but has not been seen out since being disqualified in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 28 April. Stays shod and will need the run
- 11. MIRZA DU BOUILLON** - Showed improvement 10 days ago when 5th in a Marseille-Borely Class D but has never delivered here and is not about to start now
- 12. MAKARINA DE BOMO** - Unplaced in a Class D over course and distance on 31 July, after having placed at Lisieux earlier that month. Is twice a winner over course and distance but appears to be out of her depth this time
- 13. MINDIE DES PRES** - Victorious in a Class E at Bernay over 2,800m on 30 August. Placed here in July and, despite the handicap, should be good enough to challenge for a place in the money
- 14. METALLICA SMART** - Serious filly making first appearance since running 2nd in a Vincennes Class D on 5 May. Is barefoot for the occasion, and clearly means business, but will not be over-extended
- 15. MOON LIGHT RIVER** - Ran 7th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,100m on 22 August. Drops down the category-ladder but others still preferred
- 16. MISS DU PERCHE** - Did not enjoy the best of runs in a Class D under these conditions on 21 August but has otherwise been in excellent form and looks a serious proposition

Summary: MALAVITA (5) appears to have everything going for her; form, appreciation for the venue, and an ideal engagement in front. Also well-entered, but on the back line, MISS DU PERCHE (16) was unlucky here last month but should bounce back if kept out of harm's way. From the front, MAMAN BAO (4), reconfigured and dangerous if applied, and MISSISSIPPI QUEEN (3), significantly improved when barefoot here eight days ago, are logical rivals.

C6 - PRIX DE CONDE-SUR-NOIREAU - 2750m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **MAX DE COQUERIE** - Complicated trotter that keeps on amassing disqualifications and can be confidently disregarded
2. **MY HOPE FLIGNY** - Showed improvement when fifth in a Lisieux Class F last Monday. Is not about to spring any surprises but starts in front and should be good enough to hold his own
3. **MELO DU LOCHEUR** - Should not be too quickly-judged for faulting in a Class E over course and distance on Wednesday and backs up with a realistic chance of finishing close
4. **MARTIN DU SOUND** - 7th in a Class F over 2450m at Agon on 24 August. Has plenty of ability though, and it is only a question of time before he gets his head back in front
5. **MON ROI** - Failed to confirm promising Agon run when 7th in a Vibraye Class F 3 weeks ago, but is not devoid of ability and cannot be ruled out
6. **MISTER LOVE QUICK** - Has been disappointing for the most part over recent weeks, lastly disqualified in a 2750m Class F at Ecommoy last weekend, and can be passed over
7. **MADE IN MOUROTOIS** - Fifth in a Class E at Vire over 2,800m on 6 September. Consistently gives his best and looks a decent first-five chance here
8. **MAGIC LOMIG** - Has struggled in all six starts this year, most recently 7th in an Angers Class E 10 days ago, and can be ignored
9. **MICKEY DE CRENNES** - Ran good third in a class D over 2050m here 3.5 weeks ago, a fortnight before losing his action at Angers, but is no slouch when focused and even from the back line can finish in the money
10. **MAESTRO D'IDEF** - Stayed on well to win a Class E at Argentan over 2,150m on 16 August. Incurs the penalty this time but still looks a class above his rivals
11. **MULTIPASS** - Ran 7th in a Class E at Vire over 2,800m on 31 August. Is shod as he was when third here in late-July and will be expected to apply the pressure on MAESTRO D'IDEF (10)

Summary: MAESTRO D'IDEF (10) bounced back with victory at Argentan and even from the second line can follow up. Also starting from the back row, MULTIPASS (11) is competitively-shod and has plenty going for him. From the front, MELO DU LOCHEUR (3), who should not be judged on his latest effort, and MARTIN DU SOUND (4), whose mood will dictate his result, are best-placed to challenge them.

C7 - PRIX DE MORTREE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

1. **LUMIERE VENESI** - Made up for Agon elimination when 4th in a Class F under these conditions on 25 August. Takes on some better mares this time and is unlikely to spice things up
2. **LEXA DE LA CROIX** - Back under the saddle after being eliminated on re-entry under harness at Laval 2 weeks ago and is still being prepared
3. **LENOLA DE CORTEM** - Has done nothing noteworthy since winning a Class F over course and distance in July 2025 and can be confidently disregarded
4. **LADIVA DE PARIS** - Third in a Class F over course and distance on 25 August, complementing her Le Mans performance, but a repeat seems unlikely
5. **LIVIA DES LANDES** - Disqualified in a Bagnoles Class H on 14 July. Useful but never far from faulting and can be passed over
6. **LIGELLA DU VIVIER** - Has been enjoying a good run of form since early-summer and even though stepping up in category, she won under these conditions late last month and must be afforded respect
7. **LERIDA STED** - Sprang something of a surprise 3.5 weeks ago when 2nd to LIGELLA DU VIVIER (6) in a Class F under these conditions, however looks more a minor place chance at best this time
8. **LEMILIE SAINT BAR** - Ran 4th in a Vibraye Class F late last month but if she races as she did at Iisieux in July, she will have a major part to play
9. **LARIANA CLEVILLE** - Ran fifth in a Class F over course and distance on 4 August prior to winning a Class H on turf three weeks ago. Is barefoot again and unlikely to be far off the mark
10. **LAZIE PONT VAUTIER** - Good servant with a pair of harness fresheners under her belt. Gave a fine account here last month and looks the closest threat to LIPSKA (12)
11. **LISA MI FOR CLARA** - Has bags of talent but has been off the boil in both codes for some time and must first re-establish her credentials
12. **LIPSKA** - Nicely-engaged mare returning to Cabourg on a hat-trick. Has never delivered here but in current condition is very hard to ignore. Claim
13. **LADY BECO** - Finished 9th in a harness Class F Apprentices' race at Vire over 2,800m on 6 September, her first appearance since March. Is new to the discipline but with Victor Saussaye onboard will be afforded every chance

Summary: Winner of her last 2 on turf, LIPSKA (12) returns to a hard surface but sports modified shoeing and has what it takes to complete the hat-trick. Competitively-shod for a return to her code of preference, LAZIE PONT VAUTIER (10) is an obvious danger. LEMILIE SAINT BAR (8), judged on her best form, and LARIANA CLEVILLE (9), recent winner at Le Sap, are capable of giving the Vanmeerbeck mare something to think about.

C8 - PRIX DE CINTHEAUX - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 29,000

1. **JASKA DES LANDES** - Has been a complete write-off so far this year and is not about to change her ways
2. **JOYAU DU VIVIER** - Won a Class A on turf on 9 August but has twice failed to confirm and can be ruled out
3. **JESABELLE DU JOUR** - Raced better in an Angers Class F 10 days ago than her 6th place would suggest and with Yoann Lebourgeois reining must not be underestimated
4. **JOKER DE VOUEDE** - Has been acquitting himself respectably of late, most recently 5th in a Little Class H, but in this category will have nothing to bring to the party
5. **JUDICIOUS DAYDREAM** - Finished 6th in a Class F Apprentices' race at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,650m on 3 September. Can trot when the mood takes him but is unlikely to create an upset
6. **JUST RAPID** - Out of the picture in 3 after having imposed on turf in early-August and will have few friends
7. **JUNTA DES THIRONS** - Imposed at Amiens on 18 July but was eliminated in next 2. Is no slouch when focused and is worth monitoring
8. **JUMPING DU RIB** - Second in a Class F at Ecommoy over 2,750m on 3 May. Has turned a corner since returning to racing barefoot but will be shod for comeback and best to hold off
9. **JUILLET** - Impressively tenacious winner of a Class E over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Starts in front again and can repeat
10. **JUNIOR DU CHERISAY** - Showed improvement when 5th in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class G 9 days ago. Will be barefoot for the occasion and cannot be discounted
11. **JOUR DES RACQUES** - Unplaced in a Class G at La Capelle 2.5 weeks ago. Won his only barefoot start and must be taken seriously
12. **JAB KISS** - Got back in the winners' circle at Vire a fortnight ago. Did win in this configuration at Lisieux in June but would still be preferred more competitively-shod
13. **JADE** - Ran 6th in a Class E over course and distance on 18 August, 18 days after having come 4th under similar conditions. Is unlikely to get his nose in front but can figure prominently
14. **JAMAIQUE DAIRPET** - Comes to the venue on a hat-trick but is clearly in conditioning-mode this time and cannot be considered a player
15. **JUNE D'ERABLE** - Imposed under these conditions in July before losing her action in a Lisieux Class E a month back, but on better behaviour can finish close
16. **JAZZMAN** - Has been most impressive over recent months winning 2 of 3, lastly a Bernay Class F late last month, and despite the handicap he benefits from an excellent entry and can confirm

Summary: JUILLET (9) will remain out of reach of JAZZMAN (16) and JUNE D'ERABLE (15) if he reproduces his latest performance, when winning here in 1'13"2. The latter pair are both in excellent form, however. Partnered by Yoann Lebourgeois, JESABELLE DU JOUR (3) is a potential spoiler. JADE (13) is in decent shape and should not be far from the action.
