

R5 CAGNES-SUR-MER [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DE ROME - TOR DI VALLE - MEMORIAL C - 2925m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 38,000

1. GIRLY VICTORY - Finished 11th in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 6 July. Battling to find best form and others are preferred

2. KALENCIO FLAC - Disqualified last time out in a Class D over this course and distance on 6 July. Might play a minor role if smart

3. KOMPANY VINCENT - Outclassed the opposition in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 8 July. Remains barefoot and can follow up if smart this time

4. EVERYTHING BI - Disqualified at Eskilstuna over 2640m on 17 July. Capable of doing better and cannot be ruled out

5. KEY LADY - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in a Class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 3 July. Remains barefoot and could make the frame

6. KAPORAL DES FORGES - Off form and finished 9th in a Class D over this course and distance on 6 July. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score

7. IDEM JIHEM - Has really struggling of late, finishing 10th in a Class D at Hyeres over 2650m on 12 July. Remains barefoot but needs major improvement to score

8. JUSSEO - Made short work of rivals in a Class D at Pornichet over 2725m on 8 July. Has won twice in last three starts and can score again

9. KOTKIE - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class D over this course and distance on 6 July. Can go one place better

Summary: Absent from competition for a year and a half, JUSSEO (8) has returned in excellent form and remains unbeaten in five starts over this course and distance and with this shoeing configuration, making him a leading contender for victory. That said, he is not entirely reliable, and his younger rivals KOTKIE (9), could challenge him. KOMPANY VINCENT (3), capable on a going day, and KEY LADY (5), who cannot be dismissed, are also ready to capitalize on any misstep.

C2 - PRIX CAGNOTTEAUTISME.COM(BAIE DES ANGES) - 2925m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 43,000

- 1. IDEAL GREEN** - Disqualified last time out in a Class B at Marseille Pont De Vivaux over 2650m on 29 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 2. ILLUSTRE FERM** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class D at Marseille Pont De Vivaux over 2650m on 27 June. Capable of an upset on best form
- 3. COOL KRONOS** - Has really struggled and finished 14th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 June. Remains barefoot but is capable of better and can be competitive if at best
- 4. ASTRONASCENTE ZAC** - Consistent and was runner-up at Waragem over 2400m on 31 May. Remains barefoot and could earn some more money
- 5. JOY DU CARNOIS** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 1 July. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
- 6. DANGER BI** - Victorious last time out at Treviso over 1609m on 20 June. Remains barefoot and has improved of late. Could make the frame
- 7. GOLDEN VISAIS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class B over this course and distance on 13 July. Needs to do more to score
- 8. COCCO BFC** - Showed some improvement when third at Modena over 2080m on 25 June. Clearly better in Italy and others are preferred
- 9. GERICAULT** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class A at Toulouse over 2950m on 5 June. Remains barefoot and should be a threat to these rivals
- 10. CANTO DEI VENTI** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class B at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role at very best

Summary: JOY DU CARNOIS (5) has finished outside the top two only once this season and looks well placed to return to winning ways. She will still need to keep an eye on the Martens-trained runners, notably GERICAULT (9), who has been knocking on the door, and COOL KRONOS (3), now racing barefoot after a beneficial comeback run. DANGER BI (6), a recent winner, also deserves consideration in this competitive lineup.

C3 - PRIX ANDRE FAURE - 2925m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 29,000

1. **MISTER DUAL** - Disqualified in a Class E over this track and trip on 6 July. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
2. **MOONLIGHT DANICA** - Finished 5th in a Class C over this course and distance on 8 July. Capable of playing a minor role at very best
3. **MAVERICK ELLIS** - Not reliable but wasas fourth in a Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 12 June. Capable of scoring when staying in stride
4. **MEMORY STAR ELGE** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in a Class D at this course over 2150m on 10 July. Remains barefoot and is an obvious danger
5. **MOGADOR BLEU** - Victorious in a Class D at this course over 2150m on 10 July. Constinues to win races and deserves the utmost respect
6. **MALICE D'ATOUT** - Successful in a Class C at Hyeres over 2650m on 16 June. Remains barefoot and is clearly not out of it in this line-up
7. **MORETIME DU CAMPUS** - Disqualified in a Class C at Agen Le Passage over 2575m on 20 June. Remains barefoot and could be a threat when smart
8. **MANHATTAN ROUSSAC** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class A over this track and trip on 8 March. Returns from a break and could need thsi run
9. **MAMJACK SACHA** - Has some fair form and was fifth in a Class C at Agen Le Passage over 2575m on 20 June. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
10. **MAESTRIA GALAA** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 4 July. Reverts to barefoot and might play a minor role
11. **MIDNIGHT EXPRESS** - Not disgraced when third in a Class C over this track and trip on 8 July. Has a place chance in this line-up

Summary: This looks like a wide-open affair. MAVERICK ELLIS (3), a promising type entrusted to David Békaert for the first time, gets a tentative nod. However, MORETIME DU CAMPUS (7), unlucky on his return is a real danger. MOGADOR BLEU (5) and MEMORY STAR ELGE (4), closely matched on form are also quite capable of getting involved with the finish over thsi course and distance.

C4 - PRIX DE SAINT-PAUL-EN-FORET - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 33,000

- 1. IL MAGNIFICO** - In good form and finished third in a Class F over this course and distance on 10 July. Remains barefoot and is not out of it
- 2. IZARA DE VIETTE** - Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2150m on 10 July. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 3. JASMIN BLEU** - Successfull twice in last three starts, including last time out in a Class F over this track and trip on 10 July. Can double up
- 4. KRISTAL DREAM** - Remains in good form and was third in a Class F at Hyeres over 2850m on 5 July. Reverts to barefoot and should fight out the finish yet again
- 5. IGGY FAFA** - Has some fair form and was fourth in a Class E at this course over 2150m on 10 July. Reverts to barefoot and is not out of it
- 6. KANAKA DE BUSSET** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class D at Laval over 2850m on 25 June. Remains barefoot and has claims in this line-up
- 7. KIRA BO FACE** - Victorious in a Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 24 April. Returns from a break but cannot be ruled out of it and must be respected
- 8. I LOVE IGNY** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E at this course over 2700m on 8 July. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 9. JAURESS DE CANI** - Has really struggled and finished 10th in a Class F at Avignon over 2650m on 21 June. Remains barefoot but needs to do more to score

Summary: KANAKA DE BUSSET (6) may not be a frequent winner—her last success dates back to October 2023—but she finds a golden opportunity here. That said, she's not entirely reliable, and caution is advised. JASMIN BLEU (3) and IL MAGNIFICO (1), closely matched on form, look solid alternatives, while the athletic KRISTAL DREAM (4), returning to the scene of her last victory, also commands respect in this competitive field.

C5 - PRIX LUCKY MARCEAUX - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 25,000

- 1. JAZZ BUROIS** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a Class E at Marseille Pont De Vivaux over 2650m on 27 June. Capable of scoring when staying in stride
- 2. JAKARTA DU LEVANT** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a Class G at Hyeres over 2650m on 12 July. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 3. JOBERT DU MOULIN** - In good form and was fourth in a Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 14 July. Remains barefoot and can get involved with the finish once again
- 4. JOG DE JAVIE** - Has really struggled of late and finished 10th in a Class F at Le Mans over 2200m on 13 July. Remains barefoot and others are preferred
- 5. JAGUAR D'HERMES** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class F at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 24 June. Remains barefoot and could double up
- 6. JAZZ LINOIS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 5th in a Class F at this course over 2700m on 13 July. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 7. JINA FAST** - In good form and finished runner-up in a Class F at Avignon over 2675m on 4 July. Remains barefoot and can be a threat once again
- 8. JADA MOKO** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a Class F at this course over 2700m on 13 July. Remains barefoot and more is needed to beat these rivals
- 9. JIMMYZ** - Disqualified in a Class F at This course over 2700m on 13 July. Capable of earning some minor money at very best
- 10. JULIA DOCTOR** - Disqualified last time out in a Class G at Hyeres over 2850m on 12 July. Did win before that and is capable of an upset if smart

Summary: Since arriving in the region this spring, JAGUAR D'HERMES (5) has made an immediate impact and appears to have a bright second career ahead of him. Provided he stays composed, JAZZ BUROIS (1) looks the most likely to pose a serious challenge. JOBERT DU MOULIN (3), currently in top form, and JINA FAST (7), who is progressing nicely, both have the credentials to target a podium finish.

C6 - PRIX DES GLAIEULS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **NEMO DU LEARD** - Disqualified in a Class F at Hyeres over 2850m on 9 May. Did win on debut before that and cannot be ruled out
2. **NOT A BAD DEAL** - Only modest and finished 7th in a Class E at La Capelle over 2700m on 19 June. Capable of improvement for David Békaert and is a threat
3. **NIJINSKY ATALANTE** - Disqualified in a Class F at Le Mans over 2950m on 13 July. Can contest the finish if staying in stride this time around
4. **NINO DU PLESSIS** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class D at Agen Le Passage over 2575m on 20 June. Can make the frame once again
5. **NAPOLEON DE GOUYE** - Showed some improvement and was third in a Class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 26 June. Capable of earning some money when smart
6. **NORTHERN WAY** - Has been disqualified in 3 consecutive starts, the latest in a Class E at Vire over 2150m on 1 March. Capable of scoring when smart
7. **NOBEL DE FAEL** - Finished 6th in a Class F at this course over 2700m on 15 July. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to score
8. **NOIR DARBY** - Made short work of rivals in a Class G this course over 2925m on 8 July. Improving and could follow up this shorter distance
9. **NEXPRESSO BLEU** - Disqualified twice in both starts, the latest in a Class F at this course over 2700m on 15 July. Capable of improvement but others are preferred

Summary: NOIR DARBY (8) made a striking impression when defeating a well-regarded Baudron-trained filly on her track debut and looks capable of confirming that form. That said, with young horses, the pecking order can quickly change. NORTHERN WAY (6), making his debut in this region, NOT A BAD DEAL (2), with David Békaert in the sulky, and NIJINSKY ATALANTE (3), racing with shoes, are all poised to take advantage of any misstep.

C7 - PRIX MARA BOURBON - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 8,000

1. HAYRTON MAGIC - Has struggled of late, finishing 13th in a Class F at Agen Le Passage over 2625m on 17 June. Reverts to barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score

2. HARMONIA THE BEST - In good form and was runner-up in a Class G at this course over 2925m on 15 July. Should be right there at the finish once again

3. JEWELLE OF JANE - Made short work of rivals in a Class D at Hyeres over 2650m on 5 July. Can complete the hat-trick and must be respected

4. INSAISSABLE DUO - Finished 8th in a Class D at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 27 June. Remains barefoot and is capable of better. Has a place chance

5. JOY FOR EVER - Outclassed the opposition in a Class F over this track and trip on 8 July. Remains barefoot and is capable of scoring again

6. JOE TEJY - Disqualified last time out in a Class E over this track and trip on 13 July. Remains barefoot but is hard to trust and others are preferred

7. ISLA - Not reliable and was only 8th in a Class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 5 July. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

8. JUNIOR DU VIVIER - Knocking loudly at the door and was runner-up in a Class D at Marseille Vivaux over 2650m on 27 June. Should fight out the finish once again

Summary: An interesting lucky last race. JOY FOR EVER (5) has been performing superbly with her partner and should logically confirm her comfortable victory over this course around ten days ago. However, JEWELLE OF JANE (3) and JUNIOR DU VIVIER (8), both coming off solid efforts in professional races, could make her work hard for victory. Back at the top of her game, HARMONIA THE BEST (2) will be considered a possible alternative.
