C1 - PRIX DE LA PORTE DE CHOISY - 2250m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 33,000

- 1. OCELOT DU PONT** - Qualified best of all in 1'17"8 at Caen on 20 May. He is well related and could make a winning debut
- 2. OKAVANGO** - Qualified in 1'17"3 in 4th position at Caen in on 7 May. Will have Benjamin Rochard in the driver's seat and a big run is expected
- 3. OLIUSANTU MAG** - Qualified in 1'20"5 at Grosbois on 15 May. He will need to improve on that effort to be a contender
- 4. ONYX D'AVRIL** - Qualified in 13th position in 1'18"6 at Caen on 20 May. Trained by Philippe Allaire and needs to be respected
- 5. OPERA WOOD** - Qualified in 1'19"6 at Le Mans on 13 May. With Eric Raffin as the driver he cannot be underestimated
- 6. ORIZON** - Qualified in 1'17"8 at Caen on 5 May. He is well bred and is from a stable that does well with their two-year-olds
- 7. ONLY THE BRAVE ONE** - Qualified at Le Croise-Laroche on 26 June in 1'17"4. Has a lot more to show if he is to be competitive
- 8. OK BERTRANGE** - Finished 6th in a Class F at Le Touquet over 2,100m on 14 July 2026. Will need to improve on his debut performance
- 9. OPEN D'OAM** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class F at Bernay over 2,300m on 12 July 2026. Will need to up his game to feature

Summary: Most of the field are recent qualifiers having their first official race and on that basis OCELOT DU PONT (1) could be worth following. He qualified is a good time and is well bred. The same applies to OKAVANGO (2) who will have Benjamin Rochard as his driver. ORIZON (6) and ONYX D'AVRIL (4) both come from stables that have a good record with their youngsters so they need to be considered.

C2 - PRIX DE CLIGNANCOURT - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

1. **NAPOLITANO D'AWA** - Finished 2nd in a Class D at Le Croise-Laroche over 2,825m on 22 June 2026. Still looking for his first win and could struggle in this event
2. **NEO** - Made short work of rivals in a Class E at La Capelle over 2,700m on 19 June 2026. That was an impressive debut and he can win again
3. **NELSON DU RIB** - Disqualified in a Class C over 750m at Cabourg on 10 July. Will need to up his game to be competitive
4. **NAPOLITANO VERO** - Disqualified in a Class A at Vincennes over 2,700m on 8 February 2026. Another coming back from a break but could place if ready
5. **NUAGE MYSTIC** - Victorious in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,050m on 3 July 2026. He is looking for a hat-trick and which is achievable
6. **NELOMBO BELLO** - Only modest and finished 7th in a Class C at Enghien over 2,150m on 11 July 2026. Will need to do more to be a threat
7. **NEVADA JAMES** - Finished 4th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 31 March 2026. This is his first run after an almost four-month break but he could run well racing fresh
8. **NEMO DU VARLET** - A mediocre fifth in a Class B at Enghien over 2,875m on 25 June 2026. Has struggled recently and is best overlooked in this event
9. **NICOU CHAK** - Showed improvement when fourth in a Class C at Enghien over 2,875m on 1 July 2026. He was putting a strong finish and needs to be respected
10. **NOVIALO** - Finished fourth in a Class C at Enghien over 2,875m on 23 June 2026. Eric Raffin rode him to victory three runs back and he will be back aboard for this race
11. **NOURKIS** - Finished 6th in a Class C at Enghien over 2,875m on 1 July 2026. Would do well to run a place in this company
12. **NEED YOU MESLOIS** - Excellent runner-up in a Class C at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 27 June 2026. He is closing in on a win and with the help of Benjamin Rochard he could achieve that goal

Summary: There was a lot to like about the manner in which NEO (2) won his last start at La Capelle and there could be more to come from him. NEED YOU MESLOIS (12) is improving with each run and this race provides him with the ideal opportunity to claim a victory. NUAGE MYSTIC (5) is looking to notch up his third successive victory while NOVIALO (10) looks a threat teaming up with Eric Raffin again.

C3 - PRIX DE LA PORTE DIDOT - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MISS MELODY PEEL** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 14 July 2026. She did not have the best of luck last time so did well under the circumstances. Will race unshod this time
- 2. MIRABELLE DE LARRE** - A poor 9th in a Class D at Vichy over 2,950m on 15 June 2026. She has a lot more to do if she is to be considered
- 3. MACUMBA DU VIVIER** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2650m at Le Sables D'Olonne on 11 July. This will be her third run for her new trainer and she now looks primed for a big performance
- 4. MACARENA** - Runner-up in a Class E at Enghien over 2,875m on 4 July 2026. She has proven herself at this track and should be competitive as long as she can stay focused
- 5. MILADY DE LA PIECE** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class E at Enghien over 2,875m on 25 June 2026. She comes off an impressive last win and is ideally placed at the top of the earnings bracket
- 6. MAJUSCULE** - Third in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 27 June 2026. Has been racing in mounted races and will battle in this event. Will race fully shod
- 7. MIRZA DU BOUILLON** - Has only been modest and finished 6th in a Class D at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,650m on 11 July 2026. Based on recent form she cannot be fancied
- 8. MOON DES ARRIS** - Successful in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,725m on 3 July 2026. She has hit her best form and should be competitive
- 9. MISS EUROPA** - Disqualified in a Class H over 2550m at Bacqueville en Caux on 12 July, Previous form was decent so could place on a good day
- 10. MAYA D'AUBRIERE** - Has been moderate of late and finished 8th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 1 July 2026. She will need to up her game to feature
- 11. MA BICHE NOA** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 8 July 2026. Does need to keep her mind on the the task at hand to have any chance
- 12. MINERVE DE VANDEL** - Victorious in a Class E at Agen Le Passage over 2,575m on 17 June 2026. She is in top form and should be a threat despite her place on the second row
- 13. MILKA DES THUYAS** - A moderate 6th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,100m on 7 February 2026. Has little to offer based on recent form
- 14. MANILLE D'ERABLE** - Finished 11th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,050m on 10 July 2026. Recent form has been poor and she looks unlikely to feature
- 15. MASCOTT DU CHOQUEL** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,050m on 10 July 2026. Benjamin Rochard was aboard her last time and they will be teaming up again

Summary: MILADY DE LA PIECE (5) won with authority last time and has found the perfect vehicle to make it two wins in succession. MACARENA (4) could provide the main threat, but she will need to keep her mind on the job. MINERVE DE VANDEL (12) is racing at the top of her game and will be teaming up with Raffin again. MACUMBA DU VIVIER (3) can redeem herself after having made a mistake last time.

C4 - PRIX DE LA HAUTE MARNE - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 41,000

1. **SAM PIERJI (BEL)** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2700m at Vincennes on 22 February. He won his penultimate race well and despite the break, could be a threat
2. **FRISEE KB FONT** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2850m at Vincennes on 9 June. Recent form is moderate and is best left alone
3. **DUKE OF NEW YORK** - Unplaced in a Class D over 2850m at Vincennes on 19 June, Has yet to win in France but is does have some potential and could contest the finish
4. **L'AMOUR** - Finished 5th in a Class E over 1800m at La Capelle on 7 July. After two races he should have enough experience to be competitive
5. **SEVEN SEAS S** - Was 5th in a Class D over 2850m at Vincennes on 9 June. Overall form has been mediocre and will need to show more
6. **LE ROCKER DE PLAY** - Disqualified last time out in a Class E at Cherbourg over 2,625m on 24 June 2026. Won his penultimate start but needs is not consistent
7. **TAURUS CROWN** - Unplaced in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,850m on 19 June 2026. Things did not go his way last time and the fact Eric Raffin has stuck with him is significant
8. **READY HILL** - Winner of a Class E over 2700m at Vincennes on 27 January. Coming back from a break but does stand out as the runner to beat, especially returning unshod
9. **LOUVIERS** - Runner-up in a Class E Apprentices' race at Chartres over 2,800m on 28 June 2026. Will be facing stronger this time and will need to show more
10. **LOTUS DE BEYLEV** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class D at Le Croise-Laroche over 1,900m on 22 June 2026. He is performing better than his rating and could continue the good run

Summary: READY HILL (8) comes back from a layoff after an impressive victory, but since he is retuning to race without shoes, he should be primed for a good run. TAURUS CROWN (7) may have disappointed last time out but he is better than that and should not be ignored. L'AMOUR (4) looks ready to show his best, while DUKE OF NEW YORK (3) appears to have potential and now needs to be considered.

C5 - PRIX DU MEDOC - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 75,000

- 1. HOLD UP DES VENTES** - Consistent and was fourth in a Class D at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 6 July. Quite capable of making the frame once again
- 2. JUST A MIDI** - Unreliable and finished 10th in Class B over this track and trip on 11 July. Might op up in a place when in the right mood
- 3. IGUANE DE CAPONET** - Successful in a Class D at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 6 July. A solid winner that day and is not out of it
- 4. GUERRIER CASTELETS** - Showed promise and was third in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 12 June. Unreliable but has a place chance in this line-up
- 5. HELIOS SI** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 12 June. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
- 6. HOMARD LAND** - Did not show his best when 6th in a Class A at Vincennes over 2,850m on 21 June. Should fight out the finish
- 7. CHARMY CHARLY AS** - Finished 3rd in at Berlin-Mariendorf over 2500m on 30 June. Tougher task but might play a minor role at very best
- 8. HOLD UP DU SAPTEL** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class B over this course and distance on 11 July. Needs to do more to score
- 9. JOTUNN DU DOME** - Disqualified last time out in a Group 3 at Enghien over 2,875m on 4 July. In good form before that and should be a threat to these rivals
- 10. HABIT DE SOIREE** - Showed some improvement when ifth in a Class B over this track and trip on 11 July. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 11. JE TE CHERCHE** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class B at this course over 2,150m on 23 May. Complted a hat-trick and can add another win to the tally

Summary: JE TE CHERCHE (11) is bidding for a fourth consecutive victory and will naturally attract plenty of support. JOTUNN DU DOME (9), deserves another chance and looks one of the main dangers. HOMARD LAND (6), whose latest run can be excused is another IGUANE DE CAPONET (3) has returned to peak form and is another that could trouble the judge.

C6 - PRIX DE CRESPIERES - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- 1. LA BOISBONNIERE** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in class D over this track and trip on 11 July. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 2. LOZEN DE BANVILLE** - Not reliable and finished 8th in class D at La Capelle over 1800m on 7 July. capable of doing better and might play a minor role
- 3. LESPANA DU BOCAGE** - Made short work of rivals in a Class E at Pornichet over 2,725m on 8 July. Has solid recent form and could double up
- 4. LUNA DOMA** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 3 July. Needs to confirm that run and others make more appeal
- 5. LADY PRINCESS** - Has only been moderate of late and was 6th in class D at La Capelle over 1800m on 7 July. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 6. LYRE D'ERABLE** - Victorious in a Class E at Le Mans over 2,950m on 21 May. Not reliable but cannot be ruled out from doubling up
- 7. LITTLE DU RIB** - Usually competitive and was fourth in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,850m on 19 June. Can get into the mix of things yet again
- 8. LUNE LUMALO** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 3 July. Has some fair form and could earn some minor money at best
- 9. LILI DES ORMES** - Disqualified twice in a row, the last time out in a Class E at Bernay over 2,800m on 28 June. Can be a threat when staying on the trot
- 10. LOULIANA DE VANDEL** - Disqualified last time out in a Group I at Vincennes over 2,700m on 29 May. Has some ability and is capable of an upset
- 11. LARA MAKs** - Off form and finished 11th in a Class F at Saint Malo over 2,950m on 23 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 12. LOLLIPOP DU CEBE** - Disqualified ;ast time out in class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 27 June. Capable of contesting the finish when in the right frame of mind
- 13. LEGENDE DE NILREM** - Only modest of late and was 6th in class E at Amiens over 2900m on 10 July. Barefoot this time and could strike
- 14. LA KIFFANCE PIYA** - Often competitive and was 4th in class E at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2900m on 12 July. Should have claims in this line-up

Summary: LA KIFFANCE PIYA (14) has a fine opportunity to return to winning ways and should be highly competitive. LESPANA DU BOCAGE (3), currently in top form, can give her a strong challenge if she remains focused. LEGENDE DE NILREM (13), specifically prepared for this race has to be respected. LOLLIPOP DU CEBE (12), reunited with Mathieu Mottier is also capable of playing a role of the outcome.

C7 - PRIX DE MARMAGNE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 43,000

1. **TROGIR** - Victorious at Berlin-Mariendorf over 1609m on 7 June. Talented and is capable of following up if staying in stride
2. **UNDERGROUND ARTIST** - In good form and was runner-up in class E at Pornichet-La Baule over 2650m on 8 July. Might play a minor role at very best
3. **ENJOY THE MOMENT** - In good form and was 3rd in class D at Enghien over 2875m on 27 June. Drops in distance but is clearly not out of it
4. **UTAH SOUTHWIND** - Only moderate of late and finished 6th at Aby over 2640m on 4 June. Might be the surprise package of the race
5. **EVER SO MUCH** - Holding form and was 4th in class C at this course over 2875m on 13 June. Can be a lively danger to these rivals
6. **KNOCK OUT** - Not reliable and was 6th in class D at this course over 2875m on 11 July. Capable of an upset on best form
7. **MERCEDES STAR** - Unreliable and was 4th in class D at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 20 May. Returns from a short break and could need this run
8. **OH CEAN** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Class F at Cabourg over 2,725m on 10 July. Can get into the mix if in the right mood
9. **VASTERBO BLIZZARD** - Holding form and finished 4th at Hagmyren over 2140m on 19 June. Capable of earning some more minor money
10. **BOTTNAS JUSTIN** - Finished 7th in class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 10 July. Capable of doing better and could make the frame
11. **JACQUES MEARAS** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class F at Cabourg over 2,725m on 10 July. Can contest the finish once again
12. **LOVEISLOVE PELLINI** - Off form and was unplaced in a Class E at Pornichet over 2,650m on 8 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
13. **BEENTHERESEENTHAT** - Finished 11th in Class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 10 July. Capable of better and could be a threat on best form
14. **MAN OF STEEL (GER)** - Unreliable and finished 9th in class D at this course over 2875m on 27 June. Others make more appeal
15. **AMERICA DREAM** - Showed some improvement when 4th in class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 10 July. Needs to confirm that run and others make more appeal
16. **RED D'OVER** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a Class D at this course over 2,875m on 27 June. Capable of earning some money

Summary: Back on home soil TROGIR (1) reunites with Benjamin Rochard and gets the tentative preference. He is selected ahead of EVER SO MUCH (5), who is knocking on the door. BOTTNAS JUSTIN (10), was unlucky at Cabourg, and could contest the finish. BEENTHERESEENTHAT (13) has not always had the rub of the green but is capable of making the frame.

C8 - PRIX DE PICPUS - 2875m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 46,000

1. **MAGIC JOHN** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 19 June. Might need to do a bit more to score
2. **MERMOZ** - Holding form and finished fourth in a claimer at this course over 2,150m on 29 June. More is needed to beat these rivals
3. **MY LOVE ALWAYS** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class C at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 27 June. Might play a minor role at very best
4. **MEYDAN VOIRONS** - Made short work of rivals in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 4 July. Can complete the hat-trick over a longer distance this time
5. **MICHEL MARTIN** - Finished 7th in a Class C at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 27 June. Capable of better and has a place chance in this line-up
6. **MARS COBBA** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 19 June. Might play a minor role at very best
7. **MORE LOVE DUCAMPUS** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class D at Caen over 2,450m on 2 March. Could need this run returning from a break
8. **MISTI DE CORDAY** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class C at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 27 June. Can challenge for top honours once again
9. **MONTANA KALOUMA** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class C over this track and trip on 26 June. Capable of following up with more success
10. **MERCURE D'ELLE** - Not disgraced when third in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 19 June. Should be competitive in this line-up as well
11. **MISTER CHARLY** - Unreliable and finished 9th in class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 29 May. Capable of doing better but others are preferred
12. **MARADONA ELLIS** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in class C over this course and distance on 1 July. Needs to do a bit more to score
13. **MAVERICK DE FAEL** - Successful last time out in a Class C at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 27 June. Remains in good shape and could double up
14. **MOURILLON** - Threatening a victory and was runner-up in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 June. Can go one place better
15. **MAESTRO DU CHOQUEL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class B at Vincennes over 2700m on 29 May. Not easy to trust but can make some money when smart

Summary: MEYDAN VOIRONS (4) has only eight starts to his name and faces this level of opposition for the first time, but he created a big impression on this track last time out, leaving his rivals trailing. Racing barefoot for the occasion, he is capable of scoring again. He will, however, need to see off the "Duvaldestin" pair MONTANA KALOUMA (9), whose chances depend on staying focused, and MAVERICK DE FAEL (13), who has been faultless since the beginning of his career. MERCURE D'ELLE (10) has yet to reveal his full potential and, with Benjamin Rochard in the sulky, must be regarded as a contender as well.
