C1 - PRIX DU BOURG SAINT-LEONARD - 2500m (a1m1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 - Flat - EUR € 15,400

- 1. KHAMEPHIS GAME** - Supplemented and finished 11th in a Class 3 Handicap over 2400m at Dieppe on the 30th of July 2026. Can be involved if wise
- 2. HOLLYWOOD AFRICANS** - Pleasant 4th in a Class 4 Claimer over 2400m at Dieppe on the 23rd of June 2026. Each way chance on form
- 3. TALGAT** - Furnished into 2nd in a Class 4 Claimer over 2650m at Chateaubriant on the 21st of July 2026. Good winning chance
- 4. ODIN NORMANDY** - Supplemented and was a winner in a Class 4 Claimer over 2400m at Vichy on the 25th of July 2026. Can follow up
- 5. COMBERMERE** - Inconsistent run into 8th in a Class 4 Handicap over 2400m at Vittel on the 11th of August 2026. Erratic of late
- 6. ROULETTE** - Hearty 5th in a Class 3 Handicap over 1900m at Deauville on the 26th of June 2026. Can place at best
- 7. USER KINDLY** - Trying 6th in a Class 4 Claimer over 2400m at Vichy on the 25th of July 2026. Can disrupt the top 4 play
- 8. LORENZO DE MEDICI** - Ran 5th in a Class 2 Handicap over 3100m at Parislongchamp on the 19th of October 2025. Returns after 10 months and may need the comeback run
- 9. DRAGONS BLOOD** - Difficult 4th in a maiden over 2000m at Aix Les Bains on the 14th of July 2026. One to respectfully pass by
- 10. PUNICA** - Another 6th in a Class 4 Claimer over 1950m at Les Sables-D'olonne on the 6th of August 2026. Include in all plays

Summary: TALGAT (3) furnished up finely into second in his previous attempt and if he continues this way, he can make a winning stance here. HOLLYWOOD AFRICANS (2) is an experienced soldier being an eleven-time winner and if the top choice fluffs his lines, he will be waiting to take advantage of that. Supplemented ODIN NORMANDY (4) comes into this race off a victory and can continue his upward trend if he puts his best foot forward here. ROULETTE (6) on form must be included in everything as he can make a big splash.

- 1. MAJNOUN** - Broke the maiden in a maiden over 1200m at Lion D'Angers on the 2nd of August 2026. Can repeat his last run
- 2. ROSBERG** - A winner on British tracks over 1500m at Beverly on the 4th of July 2026. Debuts on French tracks and can go close to winning
- 3. QUINTE FLUSH AAS** - Pleasing 3rd in a maiden over 1600m at Clairefontaine on the 1st of August 2026. Place chance here
- 4. BIG MONEY MAN** - A solid winner in a maiden over 1400m at Compiègne on the 10th of July 2026. Can easily follow up in this Listed
- 5. JAMINUS** - Ran 3rd in a maiden over 1800m at Saint-Malo on the 18th of August 2026. Still a maiden runner but his experience can get him involved

Summary: BIG MONEY MAN (4) found the winners box in his second start when he broke his maiden and his confidence could be on the rise where he could snatch this Listed contest. MAJNOUN (1) romped home last time out and should appreciate stepping to the mile here. He has every quality to make him threaten the top elect. ROSBERG (2) has his first run on French soil and could set the tracks on fire. He must be considered in everything. QUINTE FLUSH AAS (3) will be involved in the equation.

1. **LESSLEPASSER** - Pleasant 5th in a Class 1 Handicap over 1200m at Deauville on the 2nd of August 2026. Will be right on top of them
2. **SUMMER SAIL** - Ran his heart off into 11th in a Group I over 1300m at Deauville on the 9th of August 2026. Lurker chance here
3. **ALEM** - Positive 3rd in a Class 1 Handicap over 1200m at Deauville on the 2nd of August 2026. Will firmly be involved
4. **MISTER CHANG** - Honest form when running into 7th in a Class 1 Handicap over 1200m at Deauville on the 2nd of August 2026. Can make his presence known
5. **GRAND SCOOP** - Confident winner in a Class 1 Handicap over 1200m at Deauville on the 2nd of August 2026. Can follow up
6. **HEYBETLI** - Hard 6th in a Class 2 Condition over 1400m at Clairefontaine on the 3rd of August 2026. Best to look elsewhere
7. **ROYALWOOD** - Off form finishing 12th in a Class 1 Handicap over 1200m at Deauville on the 2nd of August 2026. Others preferred
8. **FOU FURIEUX** - Finished 14th in a Class 1 Handicap over 1200m at Deauville on the 2nd of August 2026. One to respectfully pass by
9. **AWAITING CHRISTMAS** - Cruised into 2nd in a Class 1 Handicap over 1200m at Deauville on the 2nd of August 2026. Each way chance
10. **MAJOR OAK** - Hearty run into 9th in a Class 1 Handicap over 1200m at Deauville on the 2nd of August 2026. Can bounce back here
11. **BAILEYS BACHELOR** - Not disgraced when finishing 9th in a Listed over 1000m at Deauville on the 9th of August 2026. Include in everything
12. **SCHUMAN** - Trying 8th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1100m at Dieppe on the 13th of July 2026. Hard to make a confident case for
13. **REGALIEN** - Discouraging 16th in a Class 1 Handicap over 1200m at Deauville on the 2nd of August 2026. Top choices look more attractive
14. **PRINCE AUBOIS** - Finished 4th in a Class 2 Handicap over 1200m at Deauville on the 2nd of August 2026. One to overlook
15. **CORTADO** - Respectable 2nd over 1200m at Hoppegarten on the 19th of July 2026. Has the form on his side and is one for the larger backend of quartets
16. **LE CENTRAL** - A winner in a Class 4 Handicap over 1200m at Les Sables-Dolonne on the 6th of August 2026. Can earn a minor chance

Summary: The top selections all represent the last form line over the track and trip and now renew their rivalry here while MAJOR OAK (10) can be forgiven for running ninth and looks to seek redemption and vengeance this time around. GRAND SCOOP (5) confidently won the race and it would be no surprise if he scoops this race once again. He has the ammunition to strike again. AWAITING CHRISTMAS (9) was behind Grand Scoop in the race and he will look to turn the tables and reverse the results. ALEM (3) holds a promising podium chance. BAILEYS BACHELOR (11) heads the rest and must be given serious acknowledgement.

C4 - PRIX DE MONTAIGU - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 27,400

1. **CANTAVIR** - A colt that is out of a 6-time winning mare Candarliya who relished in Group contests in her career. He could make a loud debut appearance
2. **ROYAL SPIRIT** - Another Colt that is out of a 1-time winning mare who raced in Listed and Group races. Capable of popping up
3. **COLOSAAL** - This colt is out of a 2-time winning mare Briviesca who also conquered a Listed race. He must be respected in everything
4. **CHOIX DU CHAT** - A Gelding out of a mare who raced twice and placed twice in her career. One to not discount here
5. **KARISMATIK** - Colt that is out of a 1-time winning mare Santenay. Best to follow the betting for a better guide here
6. **LANCELOT BROWN** - A colt that is out of a 1-time winning mare Bouquet who found success on the British track. From a good yard and should be ready here
7. **VALIANTUS** - A colt out of the mare Outside Inside who won once in her career on the Irish tracks. Top choices preferred
8. **SEAL THE DEAL** - This Gelding is out of the mare A New Opportunity who was a one-time winner in her career. Others seem more intriguing
9. **OURGAME** - A colt that is out of a 1-time winning mare Your Game who also raced once in a Group II. He will be in the mix
10. **ARTHUR BEAR** - This colt is out of the unraced mare Midnight Thoughts. Not much on pedigree but could be anything

Summary: CANTAVIR (1) is a colt with a sparkling pedigree who is out a Group winning mare. Mickael Barzalona is served to do justice and could very well do so. LANCELOT BROWN (6) makes his debut in the famous Godolphin silks and he could be well tuned to make his first appearance. ARTHUR BEAR (10) is the stable companion to the second choice and from a yard that gets them ready, he is one to note that can be electrifying here. OURGAME (9) wraps up the top four selection.

C5 - PRIX D'HUDIMESNIL - 1400m (a7f) - ALL WEATHER - Class 1 - Flat - EUR € 34,800

1. FORT PAYNE - Distance suited and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine over 1400m on 3 August. Can go one place better

2. IRONICO - Finished 10th in a handicap at this course over 1300m on 26 November. Returns from a break and others make more appeal

3. TOMAKAY - Successful in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine over 1400m on 3 August. Game and is capable of doubling up

4. FAST RAAJ - Finished 16th in a handicap at this track over 1600m on 9 August. Capable of better and might play a minor role

5. KING GOLD - Finished 5th in a Group 3 at Chantilly over 1600m on 19 July. Did better last year and can bounce back to score

6. SIAM PARAGON - Finished 3rd in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine over this distance on 3 August. Can earn some more money

7. ZOOM - Needed the last run when 5th at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 10 April. Returns from a break but can be a threat to these rivals

Summary: KING GOLD (5) shaped well over a mile in the Prix Messidor and looks a formidable contender back at 1,400 metres. This Group 1 winner will nevertheless need to respect stablemate FORT PAYNE (1), while ZOOM (7) is another who should be closely monitored from the outset. SIAM PARAGON (6) made a good comeback and also deserves consideration.

C6 - PRIX DE LA REBOURSIERE - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 27,400

1. PERSIAN SAMA - A two-year-old filly by Persian King out of Ego Dancer who is making her debut. Her Dam won 3 of her 22 starts and was placed in a Listed race. Can be a threat

2. QUEEN OF QUEENS - A two-year-old filly by Mare Australis out of Queen Of Beaufay who is making her debut. Her Dam won four times in the Czech Republic. Might play a minor role

3. LADY ZARA - A two-year-old filly by Zarak out of Grace Lady who is making her debut. Her Dam won 3 of 16 starts, including a Group 2. Can score

4. FINACRA FAL - A two-year-old filly by Cracksman out of Finata who is making her debut. Her Dam won twice in 9 starts. Monitor the betting

5. HODAYA - A two-year-old filly by Intello out of Galtika Coat Frity who is making her debut. Her Dam was unraced in France. Could need this experience

6. SAXEEN - A two-year-old filly by Saxon Warrior out of Green Diamond Lady who is making her debut. Her Dam was unraced in France. Can make the frame

7. SHANTIR - A two-year-old filly by Mehmas out of Mary Someville who is making her debut. Her Dam only raced once and was unplaced. Can make the frame

8. ROYALLY - A two-year-old filly by Kingman out of Under Offer who is making her debut. Her Dam was unraced in France. Could be a threat

9. ALMOONTASIRA - A two-year-old filly by Madhmoon out of Gametwist who is making her debut. Her Dam never won a race after 22 starts. Could need this experience

10. SYNNEFIA - A two-year-old filly by Motivator out of Pale Pearl who is making her debut. Her Dam never won a race after 5 starts. Others make more appeal

11. ROSE MANGUE - A two-year-old filly by Hello Youmzain out of Lilas Mauve who is making her debut. Her Dam never raced in France. Monitor the betting

12. ARIZONA'S VICTORIA - A two-year-old filly by Arizona out of Nathalie who is making her debut. Her Dam never raced in France. Others make more appeal

13. ALLELA - A two-year-old filly by Night Of Thunder out of Romanciere who is making her debut. Her Dam only won once but was placed in a Group 1. Could win on debut

Summary: ALLELA (13), a daughter of the high-class Romancière, has an appealing pedigree and could make a striking debut. ROYALLY (8) is the obvious danger, with a Group 3 winner in Ireland among her siblings. SHANTIR (7) also boasts strong family credentials, her sister Queen of Science having shown plenty of precocity. SAXEEN (6) comes from another family with a strong record of producing precocious performers and also warrants consideration.

**C7 - PRIX DE LA FONTAINE MORNAY - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR €

- 1. BID FOR CHESTER** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in a Class 2 Handicap over this course and distance on 2 August. Capable of better and could make the frame
- 2. KING ROBBE** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Class 4 Handicap at Vichy over 1,000m on 12 August. Can complete the treble
- 3. GALLIUS** - Finished 6th in a Class 2 Handicap over this track and trip on 2 August. Has only been modest of late and others are preferred
- 4. WILD WEST** - Came home 7th in a Class 2 Handicap over this course and distance on 2 August. Capable of doing better and should be a threat
- 5. WHITE PLATIN** - Finished fifth in a Class 3 Handicap at Vichy over 1,400m on 20 July. Can get into the mix of things this time
- 6. GARRIS** - Not disgraced when third in a Class 4 Handicap at La Teste De Buch over 1,100m on 5 August. Consistent of late and could play a minor role
- 7. BACCHILIDE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class 4 Handicap at Vichy over 1,000m on 12 August. Needs to do more to score
- 8. FUCHSIA** - Consistent of late and finished 3rd in a Class 2 Handicap over this track and trip on 2 August. Can be a real threat yet again
- 9. ANDARTIS** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Class 4 Handicap at Vichy over 1,000m on 12 August. Can go one place better
- 10. IMPITOYABLE** - Finished 7th in a Class 3 Handicap at Dieppe over 1,100m on 13 July. Has only been moderate of late and needs to find a few lengths to win
- 11. TUDO BEM** - Successful in a Class 4 Handicap at Vichy over 1,000m on 12 August. Remains in good form and could follow up
- 12. ZEOLAKIS** - Finished 13th in a Class 2 Handicap over this course and distance on 2 August. Has struggled of late and others are preferred
- 13. COOLMEEN ROYAL** - Came home 5th in a Class 4 Handicap at Vichy over 1,000m on 12 August. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 14. SOIF DE VIVRE** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class 3 Handicap at Dieppe over 1,100m on 13 July. Can earn some more money
- 15. YAKFEEK** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class 3 Handicap at this course over 1,300m on 13 August. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 16. CULCOR** - Finished 6th in a claimer at Chantilly over 1,000m on 2 April. Returns from a break and needs major improvement to score

Summary: WHITE PLATIN (5) made a respectable return to handicaps when finishing fifth and should improve for that run, making him a leading contender. ANDARTIS (9) is clearly on the upgrade and heads the opposition. FUCHSIA (8) has been highly consistent for several months and would not be a surprise winner. COOLMEEN ROYAL (13) finished strongly last time and can also feature.

WEATHER - - Flat - EUR € 17,400**

- 1. ZACAPO** - Finished 9th in a handicap over this track and trip on 11 August. Has only been modest of late and others make more appeal
- 2. SAINT HELLIER** - Finished 7th in a handicap at Mont-de-Marsan over 2000m on 26 July. Capable of doing better and can be a threat
- 3. WILLY WINNER** - Successful in a conditions qualifying handicap at this track over 2500m on 6 August. Capable of doubling up
- 4. VIVRE LIBRE** - - A winner of a claimer at Les Sables over 1950m on 16 August. Has improved of late and could play a minor role
- 5. CHEVALDOR** - Finished 6th in a handicap at Dieppe over 1800m on 18 July. Distance suited and capable of doing better. Might place
- 6. SAMWEST** - Returned to form and was runner-up at this track over 2500m on 6 August. Likes this track and can go one place better
- 7. GOOD SPEED** - Finished 10th at Lingfield over 1600m on 14 April. Returns from a break and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. EL PEQUENIO** - Finished 8th at Chantilly over 2000m on 19 July. Has only been modest of late and others are preferred
- 9. CHIRIMIRI** - Not disgraced when 3rd at this track over 1500m on 27 June. Quite capable of getting involved with the finish again
- 10. DARABJIR** - Finished 5th in a handicap at Pau over 2000m on 9 January. Returns from a break but can earn some minor money if fit enough
- 11. SIDEDREAM** - Victorious in a Conditions race at Royan over 1600m on 2 August. In good shape and might well follow up
- 12. KNUCKLE** - Successful in a Conditions race at Morlaix over 1800m on 29 March. Returns from a break and could need this run

Summary: SIDEDREAM (11) returned to winning ways last time with Arthur Ferland in the saddle and remains well treated at the weights, particularly with her rider's allowance taken into account. She can follow up here. SAMWEST (6) and SAINT HELLIER (2), partnered by the experienced Paul Lotout and Florent Guy respectively are threats. WILLY WINNER (3) arrives on the back of a good win over this course and distance and also has claims in this lucky last race..
