

R4 MAUQUENCHY [L-H]

C1 - PRIX YVES MALLET - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **NEO DRY** - Surprisingly eliminated in a Class E at Bernay over 2300m on 12 July. Is plainly in form though and if applied can finish close
 2. **NEW LOOK DU GERS** - Finished 8th in a Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 9 July, after having lost his maiden tag at Feurs 19 days earlier. Yoann Lebourgeois gets the nod this time and will be expected to put the record straight
 3. **NEIGE DES LANDES** - Ran 2nd in a 28950m Vichy Class F on 15 June despite being subsequently disqualified, but made amends when second in a Class E over 2150m at the same venue on 23 June. Is unlikely to spring any surprises but is still worth monitoring
 4. **NEBELINE LEMAN** - Has looked rather ordinary this term, most recently 10th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2050m on 7 July, and even though reconfigured still looks an outsider
 5. **NIMES** - Has demonstrated decent ability to date, latterly 3rd in a Class E at Cherbourg over 2625m on 24 June. Is unlikely to impose but has been handed a good draw and can pick up a cheque
 6. **NEW LIFE STAR** - Failed to confirm Alencon victory but still ran good 4th in a Class D at Chartres over 2800m on 17 June. Has a lot more going for her here and can return to winning ways
 7. **NIEBLA** - Has twice failed to confirm Cherbourg performance, most recently 6th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2050m on 7 July, but is back racing left-handed and should have a good card to play
 8. **NOEMIE DU CORTA** - Returns to the mainstream after coming 3rd in an Enghien claimer over 2875m on 25 June. Is forced to start wide but can make first 5 with form maintained
 9. **NATHANIEL** - Eliminated in all 3 starts to date, the latest a Class F at Laon over 2850m on 19 July, and will have few friends
 10. **NAVONA PIAZZA** - Eliminated more often than not but showed her form at Graignes. Prepped at Clairefontaine, will be shod to preference, and despite a poor draw cannot be ruled out
 11. **NOMINEE** - Showed considerable improvement when 2nd in a Bacqueville-en-Caux Class H on 12 July, however at this level chances seem limited
 12. **NON STOP DU WALLON** - Lacklustre 10th in a Class F at Le Mans over 2950m on 13 July. Has otherwise been enjoying a decent run of form but in this company will have too much to find
- Summary:** NEW LOOK DU GERS (2), below-par at Enghien last time, and NEW LIFE STAR (6), a promising filly who will be partnered by Mathieu Mottier, are preferred to NEO DRY (1), whose latest effort was much better than his elimination suggests, and front-row starter NIEBLA (7) who benefits from a good entry here.

C2 - PRIX ICI NORMANDIE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 19,000

1. **LADY MORNING STAR** - Finished 6th in a Class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 17 July. Placed here during the spring but in current condition will have few takers
2. **LORETTE UP STAR** - Finished 6th in a Class F at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2650m on 11 July. Will be fully-fit by now and from the 2 slot can win this
3. **LYRIDE ORLOVE** - Has done nothing outstanding so far this season, latterly eliminated in a Genets Class F on 12 July, and even though well-drawn, is still an outsider
4. **L'ABEILLE DU DOME** - In the frame in 2 of 3 this term, most recently third in a Class F at Lisieux over 2725m on 2 July. Is plainly close to her race and the draw only enhances her already good prospects
5. **LISA DU HEURT** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class F at Saint Pierre La Cour over 2600m on 14 July. Has already won twice this year and it is just a question of time before she gets back in the game
6. **LALOU D'AMOUR** - Eliminated in last 2, the latest a Class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 17 July. Has merit though, starts in front, and with application can go far
7. **LICENCE CASTELETS** - Runner-up in a Class E at Amiens over 2900m on 10 July, following her Graignes elimination, and with form maintained could well make the frame
8. **LADY VICTORY** - Fifth in a Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 11 June after having run 3rd over course and distance a week earlier, and despite the wide draw, can still bring the fight to LORETTE UP STAR (2)
9. **LITTLE STAR JIEL** - 10th in a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 1 June. Has done nothing noteworthy for some time and can be confidently ruled out
10. **LEONE MAGNIFIQUE** - Returns to France after winning over 2000m at Duindigt on 11 July, but chances of a repeat seem slim
11. **L'ELITE DU CHOQUEL** - Fourth in a Class E at La Capelle over 1800m on 7 July, a fortnight after having imposed at Le Croise-Laroche. Is unlikely to win this but still has the wherewithal to pick up a cheque
12. **LIBERTY JIEL** - Disqualified last time out in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 24 March. Stays shod for comeback but cannot be considered a priority
13. **LUTECE** - Ran 3rd over course and distance before being eliminated in Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 20 April. Is barefoot for re-entry but others still preferred
14. **LEXI BIRDIE** - Failed to confirm Nancy performance when eliminated in a Genets Class F on 12 July, and the draw only adds insult to injury

Summary: This seems an open affair with LORETTE UP STAR (2), who appears to be on the right road, narrowly preferred to LADY VICTORY (8) and a reconfigured L'ABEILLE DU DOME (4), both still looking for that maiden success. LICENCE CASTELETS (7) restored confidence at Amiens and must be taken seriously.

C3 - PRIX BERNARD DELAMARRE - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MON HISTOIRE** - Nicely-bred filly that should not be too hastily-condemned for faulting on debut at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne last week but starts in front and merits considerable respect. Attention
- 2. MADRAGUE GALI** - Moves back to a hard surface following a pair of modest return runs on turf. Has previously won here, and sports a fresh formula, but still not a concern
- 3. MY FRIEND AND ME** - Eliminated in last 2, the latest a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 22 June, and has no possible chance
- 4. MONTANHA DU DOME** - Has no shortage of ability but has been temperamental of late and will first need to get her house in order
- 5. MAMAMIA EL** - Has been knocking at the door since her early-May debut, latterly second in a Class F at Laon over 2850m on 28 June. Enjoys a front-row start and while unlikely to open her account, can nevertheless finish in the mix
- 6. MAXINE FAYS** - Excellent in 2 before being eliminated in a Class F at Le Touquet over 2600m on 14 July. Is competitively-shod for the first time but others still preferred
- 7. MANOU DES BRUMES** - Failed to confirm Carentan performance when eliminated in a Ploublay Class F last Sunday. Sports a fresh configuration but others still preferred
- 8. MOON ROCQ PIERJI** - Authoritative winner of a Class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 5 July. Has been entrusted to a top driver this time and can make her Mauquenchy debut a winning one
- 9. MADAME BOVARY** - Was fifth in a Class E over 2150m here on 4 June. Is still chasing that elusive first win but benefits from an excellent opportunity here and Robin Lamy can be forgiven for feeling bullish
- 10. MAGIC ALOUETTE** - Has turned a corner since returning to racing clockwise, most recently third in a Class E at Cabourg over 2050m on 10 July. Is confirmed at the venue but others still easier to back
- 11. MALICE DELADOU** - Disqualified last time out in a Class E at Lisieux over 2675m on 15 July. Has otherwise been in fine form, and returns to racing left-handed with a decent hand to play
- 12. MONEY DU CHATELET** - Returns to formula of choice after being eliminated in a Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 3 July. Is new to the venue but in current condition is still easy to recommend
- 13. MERVEILLEUSE** - Disqualified 3 in last 4 starts, the latest a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 25 June. Is not devoid of ability though, ran 3rd on sole Mauquenchy start, and will generate interest

Summary: Recent winner MOON ROCQ PIERJI (8) can follow up under Yoann Lebourgeois but will need to see off a barefoot MADAME BOVARY (9) whose consistency is beyond question. Front-row starter MON HISTOIRE (1) is worth another chance after an unsuccessful debut on turf, while MONEY DU CHATELET (12) can be brought back into the fold.

C4 - PRIX ICI PICARDIE - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. MIMI D'AMBRI - Well-beaten in a Class F at Saint Malo over 2950m on 2 May. Is still chasing that elusive first win but would have better prospects at a lower level

2. MISTRAL DES LUCAS - Showed potential at 3 but has done little of note this season and is unlikely to start now

3. MAD MAX BOND - Eliminated in a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 22 June. Is not devoid of ability but others still easier to back

4. MARGOTIN - Has been acquitting himself well of late, latterly fifth in a Class F at Bernay over 2800m on 28 June. Starts on front line here and the engagement of Mathieu Mottier will only work in his favour

5. MARQUIS FORTIS - Has won twice in last 4 starts, most recently victorious in a Class F at Le Touquet over 2600m on 14 July, and can play a minor role

6. MAXIMUS DU DOME - Showed considerable promise last year but eliminated in last 2 and others easier to trust

7. MONSTER WILLIAMS - Eliminated last time out in a Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. Has otherwise been in good shape but would be preferred racing right-handed

8. MYSTIC DE BLARY - Made up for Cherbourg elimination when fourth in a Class E at Le Mans over 2200m on 13 July. Is new to the venue but should appreciate the profile and looks principal danger to MARQUIS DE MALAC (11)

9. MUSTANG DE REUX - Was fifth in a Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 13 June. Was not disgraced here in the spring and should again be competitive for a first-five payout

10. MILLENIUM JOSSELYN - Made amends for La Capelle elimination when runner-up in a Class E at Feurs over 2100m on 3 July. Has taken his game up a notch since starting to race in current configuration and is unlikely to be far off the mark

11. MARQUIS DE MALAC - Lost his way after winning at Chartres in April, but ran reassuring 2nd in a Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 14 June and, winner on sole start with Francois Lagadeuc, can keep that fact relevant

Summary: MARQUIS DE MALAC (11), barefoot and ideally-engaged, has the class to win a race of this nature provided he stays in stride, as does MYSTIC DE BLARY (8) and the same caveat applies. They are preferred to MILLENIUM JOSSELYN (10), who is capable of giving them plenty to think about. MUSTANG DE REUX (9), whose latest effort was encouraging, could spoil the party.

C5 - PRIX RACE AND CARE - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

1. **LIZA DE LA COUR** - Reassured under harness at Châlons-en-Champagne on 14 June but was eliminated in a Class F at Clairefontaine over 2200m on 19 July, and can be confidently ruled out
2. **L'UNIQUE DE GINAI** - Has done nothing of note in either code since June 2025 and with pads fitted will have nothing to offer
3. **LAWRENCE DAIRPET** - Should not be too hastily-judged for being eliminated on return to the code in a Clairefontaine Class F 10 days ago. Has never disappointed for Antoine Voisin and is not incapable of upsetting the apple-cart
4. **LADISLAS DU CANET** - Finished 3rd in a Class F at Du Mans over 2950m on 13 July, complementing his Lucon performance, and will not be far off the mark if he stays in stride
5. **LOU DU BOUILLON** - Reassuring 2nd at Agon on 5 July prior to being eliminated under harness 9 days later. Has merit but would be preferred at a lower level
6. **LASCO DE L'ITON** - Disappointing in 2 after coming 3rd in a Class F at La Roche-Posay in late-May, and can expect to have few friends
7. **LA GASTINE** - Has twice failed to confirm Alencon success, most recently eliminated in 12 July race of reference, and can be passed over
8. **LADY DU LILAS** - Returns to the monte code after a fruitless start to 2026 and is not about to spice things up
9. **LA CANDEUR** - Fourth in a Class F at Reims over 2550m on 6 June, continuing a decent run of form. Enjoys a front-row start and with shoes off for the first time will be no pushover
10. **LADY NANIE** - Eliminated in a harness Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 22 June. Has yet to make her mark in the monte code but, with application, could get a look in
11. **LOVA DE SANA** - Disappointing 5th in a Class H at Abbeville on 12 July. Has otherwise been in decent shape though, is well-engaged in front, and cannot be discounted
12. **LIONEL DU DERBY** - Reassuring third in a harness Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 4 July. Is new to the discipline but with Mehdi Lelièvre in the saddle will be afforded every chance
13. **LOOKING DU CAIEU** - Showed marked improvement when 4th in a 2300m Class H at Abbeville on 12 July, however a repeat seems unlikely
14. **LIBERATOR PHEDO** - Eliminated in 2 under harness after having run 2nd in a Laval monte Class E in late-June. Is reunited with that day's jockey and looks the pick of the field
15. **LORD OF WIND** - Got back in the game under Antonin Andre when 3rd in a Cabourg Class F 2 weeks ago. Has no Mauquenchy references but with form maintained can impose
16. **LABORANTIN** - Finished 7th in a harness Class E at Lisieux over 2675m on 15 July. Is new to the discipline but is nicely-entered and with Adrien Lamy in the irons will be afforded every chance

Summary: LIBERATOR PHEDO (14) has the class to well in a race of this nature and with Mathieu Mottier aboard looks the one to beat on his return to the monte code. LORD OF WIND (15), who is back on the right road, represents the main danger ahead of LABORANTIN (16), who is well-engaged for his first appearance under the saddle. The consistent LA CANDEUR (9) has been knocking at the door, is first-time barefoot, and can do well.

C6 - PRIX ECURIE DES PRES LOUVET - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LINGOT LA ROYAUTE** - Close runner-up in a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 1 June. Is forced to start on the rail but still looks eminently capable of imposing
- 2. LIBERAL BABY** - Finished 6th in a Class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 14 July. Has been showing improvement over recent weeks and is not incapable of playing a small role
- 3. LE CHARLY D'YVI** - Fourth in a Class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 5 July, showing Les Andelys performance was no flash in the pan. Benefits from a fine draw and looks a serious proposition
- 4. LUCIFER DU DOME** - Won 2 in a row, latterly a Class F at Le Neubourg over 3000m on 13 June, and returns to the venue with a decent chance of securing the three-timer
- 5. LOTUS JIEL** - Won 2 of 3 before being eliminated in a Genets Class F earlier in the month. Is reunited with Mansour Krouchi who won with him at Elbeuf last month and is well-placed to play a prominent role
- 6. LINDOR DE L'AVRE** - Should not be too hastily-condemned for faulting at Genets on 12 July. Has already won 3 times this year and can get in on the action if François Lagadeuc keeps him trotting
- 7. LOOK DE CARA** - Runner-up in a Class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 5 July, making up for Le Croise-Laroche elimination, and on good behaviour is unlikely to go home empty-handed
- 8. L'OR BLEU** - Was unable to confirm Le Neubourg victory when eliminated in a Genets Class F on 12 July. Is reunited with Robin Lamy who won twice with him last season and will have his supporters
- 9. LUCKY BOY** - 8th in a Class F at La Capelle over 1800m on 14 June. Has been disappointing for some time and will have nothing to offer
- 10. LITTLE LOVE** - 10th in a Class F at Montier En Der over 3025m on 5 July, 9 days before being eliminated at Francheville, and has no realistic chance
- 11. LITTLEKING FOXGLEN** - Has done nothing of note at any level since August 2025 and can be confidently disregarded
- 12. LUCKY DES LANDES** - Useful on a good day but has failed to impress in last 2 starts and from the back line is unlikely to create an upset
- 13. LORD THOMAS** - Serious individual that was sent for a rest after a productive stint during the spring. Is shod for re-entry though and best to hold off
- 14. LUCKY ROSE** - Went off the boil following a fine run of form earlier in the year. Has not been seen out for 2 months and the draw only compounds matters
- 15. LENNY DU PONT** - Finished 6th in a Class E at La Capelle over 1800m on 7 July. Did run 2nd under these conditions early last month but the draw will do him no favours

Summary: Well-drawn, LINGOT LA ROYAUTE (1) has recently shown he is close to his race and, sporting a fresh configuration, gets the nod, although LUCIFER DU DOME (4), who bids for a hat-trick, shapes as a serious rival. Reliable LE CHARLY D'YVI (3) is next best ahead of a re-shod LOTUS JIEL (5).

C7 - PRIX DE LA FETE DU CHEVAL JACQUES BRION - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 28,000

- 1. JILANZA DU MOULIN** - Was third in a Class F at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2775m on 6 July. Receives a Yoann Lebourgeois drive this time and has every chance of imposing
- 2. IN LOVE DE CHARDET** - Encouraged at Reims a month back but has twice failed to confirm, most recently unplaced in a Bacqueville-en-Caux Class H on 12 July. Is well-in on the front row but others still easier to back
- 3. IYAR** - Got back in the game when 4th in a Class H at Châlons-en-Champagne on 24 May. Has been rested since but benefits from a terrific draw and terrific entry, and looks a leading contender
- 4. IBIS D'AUVRECY** - Finished 13th in a Class D at Pornichet over 2725m on 8 July, but is plainly better than the result would suggest, and from the 4 slot can make a big splash
- 5. JIROBELLO** - Well-beaten in an Enghien claimer over 2875m on 25 June before being eliminated at La Ferte-Vidame on Sunday. Has already won 3 times for Mathieu Mottier and must not be underestimated
- 6. JARVIS** - Has not been seen out since running 10th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 18 January. Imposed last time here but stays shod and will not be given a hard race
- 7. JOLIE QUEEN** - Has done nothing but improve lately, most recently third in a Class E at Lisieux over 2675m on 15 July. Starts wide on front line but in present shape is very hard to ignore. Place chance
- 8. JUVAMINE RENARDIER** - Gave an encouraging account last time when 6th in a Class F at Caen over 2450m on 18 June. Is unlikely to spice things up but can nevertheless make first 5
- 9. JUMBO DES PRES** - 8th in a Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 10 July. Never the easiest of horses to gauge but is confirmed at this level and cannot be discounted
- 10. JEEP DE DALINE** - Finished 6th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 14 July, after a tough start to the season. Has pulled a rough number and is unlikely to upset the status quo
- 11. INDUCTIF** - No slouch on a good day and has form here, but eliminated in last 2 and others easier to trust
- 12. JUSTIN WOOD** - Has not been seen out since January, his first start for 15 months. Is shod to preference this time but is going to need the race
- 13. JOURNAIO DU ROI** - Eliminated in a Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 10 July after having imposed at Arras in June, but has little going for him here
- 14. IAGO CAYENNAIS** - Finished 2nd in a Biarritz claimer over 2150m on 2 July. Is out of his depth in this company and can be passed over

Summary: Versatile JILANZA DU MOULIN (1), effective in both disciplines and sporting pads for the first time, gets the vote ahead of IYAR (3), who will have been specifically prepared for this excellent opportunity. JOLIE QUEEN (7), in fine form, and IBIS D'AUVRECY (4), who is worth another chance, also command respect.

C8 - PRIX URANIE 1920 - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 30,000

1. **HOLLY GREEN** - Finished 13th in a Class E at Le Mont St Michel over 2600m on 30 June, continuing a very unproductive streak, and will have nothing to offer
2. **IMPERIAL MARANDAIS** - Should not be too hastily-judged for failing to deliver in a Class F at Les Andelys 2.5 weeks ago. Top pilot at the helm this time and the draw will do his prospects no disservice
3. **INCREDIBLE GO** - In the frame in last 2, latterly 2nd in a Class E at Biarritz over 3750m on 16 July. Faces a stiffer test here but enjoys a good draw and can play a small role
4. **JURILOVCA** - Got back in the winners' circle after lifting a Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 27 June. Is new to the venue but has been handed an ideal draw and François Lagadeuc will be keen to repeat
5. **JACK L'EVENTREUR** - Finished 10th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 14 July. Has been out of the picture in last 6 starts and will first need to get his house in order
6. **HESPERANCE ELTE** - Surprise winner at Segre in early-June but has done nothing of note in 4 since and can be ruled out
7. **JEUNE AMI** - Finished 10th in a Class E at Laon over 2850m on 1 May, continuing a lousy run of form. Is barefoot this time though, with Yoann Lebourgeois reining, and cannot be ignored
8. **JOURNAL INTIME** - In the frame in 2 before coming fourth in a Class E at Pornichet over 2725m on 2 July. Is proven at the venue and despite a wide draw still looks a player
9. **JACKPOT D'ORGUEIL** - Fourth in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 13 July. Has yet to confirm his May victory but is plainly in shape, and will not be far from the action if Franck Ouvrie defies the draw
10. **INDIANO JIM** - Finished 6th in an amateurs Class H at Clairefontaine over 2900m on 19 July. Has been freshly-reconfigured but has no possible chance
11. **JOLI CLIF** - Successful in a Class F at Chartres over 2825m on 28 June, his 2nd win in 3 starts. Has pulled a rough number but excels with his handler and looks a serious proposition
12. **JET DES BAUX** - 10th in a Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 20 July. Is no longer the horse he once was and can be disregarded

Summary: JURILOVCA (4) is back to his best and, barefoot this time, is the logical choice. JOLI CLIF (11), an impressive winner at Chartres, and JOURNAL INTIME (8), who looks close to his race, head the opposition alongside IMPERIAL MARANDAIS (2) who is worth another chance with Mathieu Mottier in the bike.
