

R2 BEAUMONT-DE-LOMAGNE [R-H]

C1 - PRIX DU CONSEIL REGIONAL D'OCCITANIE - 2550m (a1m1/2) - - Mounted - EUR € 34,000

- 1. DUMA NEH D'ASTI** - Respectable at home in Italy but has made no impact since returning to France and can be passed over
- 2. IN THE MOOD GEDE** - Well-beaten in a harness Class H at Mansle a week ago. Returns to his code of preference with a new rider in the irons and can pick up some prizemoney
- 3. DUBLIN FI** - Second in a Class E at Monflanquin over 2,500m on 10 May, her best monte performance to date. Has not raced since but is barefoot for the occasion, and can give this a good go
- 4. HAPPY DE NARMONT** - Unplaced in a Class F at Montignac-Charente over 2,600m on 23 July. Sports modified shoeing but still has no possible chance
- 5. JAGERSRO** - Has found his way this summer, latterly 3rd in a Brehal Class E late last month. Is shod as he was when successful at Cabourg in early-July and merits considerable respect
- 6. JACQUES D'AVEL** - Won 4 on the trot, 2 in each code, before running 2nd under harness in a Castera-Verduzan Class G a fortnight ago. Imposed with Sandy Treich at Biarritz and, from the front row, can do so again
- 7. JANEIRO TURGOT** - Finished 4th in a Class F at Amiens over 2,400m on 29 July. Has been knocking at the door over recent months and will be competitive when push comes to shove
- 8. IRISH SONG** - Finished 11th in a Class F at Castera-Verd. over 2,800m on 10 August. Has made no impact on a hard surface for some time and is not about to begin now
- 9. HAMPTON AMERICA** - Encouraged in a harness claimer here in June but has been a write-off since and is not about to shake things up
- 10. IMPULSIF D'AVENIR** - Finished 7th in a Class F at Royan-La Palmyre over 2,475m on 9 August, 2 weeks after having encouraged at Gabarret, but is being aimed too high
- 11. KATCHINA FOR CLARA** - Finished 3rd in a Class E Apprentices' race at Argentan over 2,875m on 8 August. Is just one of two on the back row but has the capability of imposing
- 12. I LOVE D'AMOUR** - Unplaced on re-entry in a Class C at Enghien over 2,250m on 2 August. Is confirmed at the venue and, while not a priority from the second row, should nevertheless hold his own

Summary: KATCHINA FOR CLARA (11) faces a task well within her capabilities and even from the second row is in with a realistic chance of winning this. She faces strong opposition though from a group of front-row starters, led by the Terry runners, JACQUES D'AVEL (6), who has won both his starts under the saddle this year, JANEIRO TURGOT (7), who is in excellent form, and a re-shod JAGERSRO (5) who has been revitalised this summer.

C2 - PRIX VICTOR GREGORIS - 2550m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **NOUMBA D'YVI** - Finished 2nd in a Class F at Eauze over 2,375m on 2 August, 2 weeks after getting off the mark at Aurillac. In this category though, will have too much to do
2. **NEZHA DU PATURAL** - Has not been seen out since running third in a Class E at Langon over 2,200m on 6 April and is going to need the run
3. **NAIADE SIBEY** - Unplaced in a Class E at Villereal over 2,450m on 14 August, following a trio of good performances. Takes on a better lot here though and will need to find more
4. **NOVA D'ALOUETTE** - Finished 2nd in a Class E at Villereal over 2,450m on 14 August. Has yet to lose her maiden tag, and is unlikely to this time either, but still has the wherewithal to get in on the action
5. **NASA RIRY** - Fifth in a Class E at Biarritz over 2,150m on 7 July, 5 days after losing her maiden status. Sports modified shoeing but is still not a concern
6. **NINO DE LIGNY** - Fifth in a Class E at Villereal over 2,450m on 14 August, failing to confirm good Hyeres performance, and is not a contender
7. **NOUBA D'ATOUT** - Serious sort with considerable potential. Is new to Beaumont but should take well to the new conditions and can bring the fight to NEWTON GAB (12)
8. **NOUBA BAROQUE** - Good, consistent filly that made up for Agen sanction when 2nd under the saddle at Biarritz. Has demonstrated good aptitude for the harness code and despite the hike in category, can still play a small part
9. **NEWTON DU PADOUENG** - Won 2 in a row before being eliminated in an Auch Class C last Monday. Should not be too quickly-condemned though and, with application, can challenge for a place in the frame
10. **NIGHT DE JANEIRO** - Eliminated in last 2, most recently a Class B at Grenade-sur-Garonne last weekend, but will be reunited with her trainer for whom she has never failed to fire, and looks to represent a decent place chance
11. **NIGHT DE BANVILLE** - Unexceptional filly that has twice failed to make any impact lately, most recently 7th in an Auch Class C last Monday, and others easier to recommend
12. **NEWTON GAB** - Fifth in a Class C at Auch over 2,700m on 17 August, her first start since November. Will have come on for the race and, confirmed at the venue, is easy to fancy for the win
13. **NANCY DE GOUYE** - Finished 5th in a Class D at Chatelaillon over 2,500m on 3 August 2026. Has yet to strike for her new handler but it is just a question of time

Summary: NEWTON GAB (12) was far from disgraced on his recent comeback and, likely to improve, can take the spoils. NOUBA D'ATOUT (7) gave a fine account despite faulting last time and, if she stays in stride, is also capable of playing a leading role. NIGHT DE JANEIRO (10) has ability and will not be far off the mark if focused. NEWTON DU PADOUENG (9) failed to secure the hat-trick when disqualified at Auch and Pierre Geray will be eager to set the record straight.

C3 - PRIX DE LA COMMUNAUTE DE COMMUNES - 2550m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. MAYA DES BAUX** - Fifth in a Class D at Fleurance over 2,600m on 9 August 2026. Is the least-performant horse in the field and can be confidently ruled out
- 2. MIRAGE D'ERPION** - Got back in the winners' circle 2 weeks ago after securing a Fleurance Class D. Tends to show more on turf though and best to keep one's powder dry
- 3. MONA LISA ELLIS** - Put a pair of eliminations behind her when 3rd in a Class E at Castera-Verduzan a fortnight back. A repeat, however, seems unlikely
- 4. MIDEN DE FONTAINE** - Could well have won a second straight had he not lost his action early in an Argentan Class E a week ago, and Cedric Terry can put things right as long as he gets his gelding off on the right foot
- 5. MONEY AIMEF** - Is not short of ability but is as complicated as they come. Held her own in a Cagnes Class D 10 days ago and, in similar form, can confirm
- 6. MELODIE DU LILAS** - Made it 2 wins in 3 starts - lastly a Class E at Castera-Verduzan over 2,800m on 10 August. Has thrived with Thomas Ducos and is not incapable of adding another victory to her tally
- 7. MANHATTAN GABINLEA** - Unplaced in a Class E at Castera-Verduzan over 2,800m on 10 August after having encouraged at Biarritz, and is not an obvious choice
- 8. MINIE CAUSSANEL** - Makes first appearance since running 4th in a Class D at Toulouse over 2,325m on 17 April. Is clearly in race-mode but has little love for the venue and looks no more than a minor place chance
- 9. MELINE DU VIVIER** - Finished 9th in a Class D at Fleurance over 2,600m on 9 August. Is not as sharp as she was during the spring and others easier to back
- 10. MISSION DU GILET** - Starts for the first time since coming 6th in a Class C over course and distance on 23 May. Is barefoot for the occasion though, is reunited with Louis Lalande who imposed with her earlier in the year, and cannot be ruled out
- 11. MELISSA JOSSELYN** - Runner-up in a Class E at Castera-Verduzan over 2,800m on 10 August 2026. Is clearly close to her race but in this category may have to settle for minor honours
- 12. MELBA DU PADOUENG** - Showed marginal improvement when 5th in a Biarritz Class D a month ago. Has references at the venue but still has more to find
- 13. MOSPEL DU VERGER** - Finished 4th in a Class B at Grenade-Sur-Garonne over 2,700m on 15 August. Has been hard to fault over recent weeks, enjoys a good entry here, and looks competitive for a place in the picture

Summary: A tricky, evenly-matched race to assess, but Franck Terry looks to hold a strong hand with a freshly re-shod MIDEN DE FONTAINE (4), who impressed last time despite being disqualified, and MELODIE DU LILAS (6), who has improved markedly this summer. MOSPEL DU VERGER (13) benefits from a terrific entry and is among the contenders for a podium finish, alongside MELISSA JOSSELYN (11), whose recent finish did not go unnoticed.

C4 - PRIX GILBERT ET JEAN-PIERRE GAILING - 2400m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. LAMIE QUICK** - Took no time opening her summer account, winning a Class D at Villereal over 2,450m on 8 August. Has form at the venue and confirmation is a distinct possibility
- 2. LUMIERE DU CHENE** - Moderate mare that ran 6th in a Villereal Class E 3 weeks ago and, even though barefoot, will need to show significantly more
- 3. LILI** - Victorious in a Class E at Fleurance over 2,600m on 16 August, her first victory since May 2024. A repeat seems unlikely but is worth monitoring all the same
- 4. LOYAL FRIEND** - Runner-up in a Class D at Villereal over 2,450m on 8 August 2026. Has impressed in both codes over recent weeks, has previously won at the venue, and is unlikely to be far off the mark
- 5. LOLITA TURGOT** - Put a trio of sanctions behind her to run 4th in a 2050m Cabourg Class D nine days ago and will be no pushover if Cedric Terry succeeds in keeping her focused
- 6. LOUSTIC VAUCEEN** - Third in a Class E at Eauze over 3,025m on 2 August after having won 3 in a row. Has earned the right to race in this category and has a reasonable chance of making first five
- 7. LITTLE CROWN** - Dominated a Class E at Hyeres over 2,650m on 12 August 2026. Trainer back in the bike and looks to have a decent chance of repeating
- 8. LEMON CURD** - Third in a Class E at Chatelaillon over 2,625m on 29 July after having been disqualified at Eauze. Is hard to knock when focused and should not be underestimated
- 9. LOCKWOOD EFJI** - Fourth in a Class E at Villereal over 2,450m on 14 August, continuing a respectable run of form, but is out of his depth this time
- 10. LADIVA DE VILLABON** - Won a Castera-Verduzan Class E in late-June but was unable to confirm a fortnight ago when disqualified at Villereal, and others easier to support
- 11. LIKELY DU PADOUENG** - Third in a Class E at Fleurance over 2,600m on 16 August. Has been re-shod for the occasion and is unlikely to make many waves

Summary: LITTLE CROWN (7) made a stylish winning return at Hyeres and her connections make the trip with genuine ambitions. She faces a tougher task, however, against LAMIE QUICK (1), who quickened well to win impressively a fortnight ago. Back in form, LOLITA TURGOT (5) can also play a leading role, alongside LEMON CURD (8), who gave a reassuringly-good account late last month.

C5 - PRIX #RACE AND CARE - 2400m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 20,000

1. **KASH PRIDE** - Ran 6th in a Class F Apprentices' race at Eauze over 3,025m on 6 July 2026. Has done little of note since July 2025 and can expect to have a few friends
2. **KIRIKOU DU DROPT** - Ran 4th in a monte Class E at Châtelailon-La Rochelle late last month and will have other priorities
3. **KIFILL CHOISI** - Had been enjoying a decent run of form until being disqualified at Fleurance last weekend. In this company though is unlikely to spring any surprises
4. **KIDA DE LA BESSE** - Has done nothing but improve lately, most recently third in a Class F at Chatelaillon over 2,500m on 3 August. Has pulled a good number and Louis Lalande will be keen to take advantage of the good opportunity
5. **KENTUCKY PIYA** - Produced a pair of solid performances at Cabourg before losing his action at Cherbourg. Benefits from a good spot behind the car, has been freshly reconfigured, and looks a serious proposition.
6. **KITALPHAR** - Finished 4th in a Class F Apprentices' race at Biarritz over 2,975m on 30 July. Has been consistently in the thick of things since the spring and is in with a realistic shout of making the frame once more
7. **KENNY PEARL** - Continued her good form when second in a Fleurance Class F a week ago. Sports a fresh configuration for his debut at the venue and should have the wherewithal to play a part
8. **KEEP TIME** - Unplaced in a Class F at Gabarret over 2,550m on 27 July. Has been heavily-campaigned this year and is quite clearly out of sorts
9. **KING PRESTIGE** - Not the easiest of horses to use but imposed smartly in a Gemozac Class H last weekend and, on good behaviour, can confirm
10. **KILLER ZOFÉ** - Is never far from losing his action but is a hardy sort. The back-row start may work to his advantage and has already won for Alexandre Bodin

Summary: KING PRESTIGE (9) recently got back in the game on turf at Gémovac. He has the capacity to compete at this level but Cedric Terry will need to keep him focused. KENTUCKY PIYA (5) has not been seen out since his re-entry run at Cherbourg in mid-June but sports a new formula and the draw will only help his cause. KITALPHAR (6), sporting 4 pads for the first time, should once again run his race. It could be all-or-nothing once more for the flighty KILLER ZOFÉ (10).

C6 - GRAND PRIX BARON D'ARDEUIL AOC BUZET - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Claiming - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. JAVA DE LIGNY** - Ran 4th in a 2800m Auch Class G last Monday, although in this company will have little to offer
- 2. KING KONG** - Finished 4th in a Class C at Chatelaillon over 2,625m on 29 July. Has not put a foot out of line since the spring and is unlikely to return home empty-handed
- 3. JAVANAISE DE FARS** - Fourth in a Class F Apprentices' race at Langon over 2,800m on 14 July 2026. Faces a much stiffer test here and chances appear limited
- 4. KASGAGNAT** - Unplaced in a Class H at Miramont De Guyenne over 2,700m on 15 August, his first appearance for 2 months. Goes barefoot this time but others still preferred
- 5. KOOPLES DE LARRE** - Useful on a good day but disappointing in last 2, most recently 7th in a Mansle Class H, and will first need to reassure
- 6. KAISER GRIFF** - Sprang something of a surprise at Biarritz late last month when clinching a 2950m Class E, and should be taken more seriously this time
- 7. JADE FOR EVER** - Got back in the game at Villereal 9 days ago when convincingly securing a 2450m Class E, and a similar performance would see her in the mix once more
- 8. JUDIRA DE HOUELLE** - Finished 7th in a Class H at Miramont De Guyenne over 2,700m on 15 August after having disappointed at Eauze and will need to get her house in order
- 9. JUNON DU VASSET** - Runner-up in a Class G Apprentices' race at Hyeres over 2,850m on 31 July 2026. Has been knocking at the door all year, starts in front, has form here, and has the wherewithal to make a big impact
- 10. KANSAS DE CASTELLE** - Serious sort that can prove tricky but has bags of ability. Is marginally better racing clockwise and can wrap this up if Christophe Martens keeps him trotting
- 11. IMPARTIAL** - Finished 5th in a Class C at Vichy over 2,950m on 1 August, at 60-1, however a repeat seems improbable
- 12. JOLIE DE L'AUMANCE** - Revitalised over recent weeks, latterly winning an Eauze Class D with ease 3 weeks ago and, with form maintained, should again figure prominently
- 13. ISIS DE LA FERME** - Handy mare that ran 3rd in an Enghien claimer 3 weeks ago. Has no right-handed references and is here for reasons of conditioning
- 14. IKY JOY** - Runner-up in a Class B at Villereal over 3,325m on 8 August 2026. Is nicely-engaged here and Fabrice Rodes will be eager to make hay
- 15. JUDY MATIDY** - Has started to come good again, most recently 3rd in an Amiens Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Is not a priority but is nicely-entered here and will have her supporters

Summary: KANSAS DE CASTELLE (10) benefits from a terrific entry on the front line and, back racing right-handed, will be seeking to make amends for his recent disappointment at Hyères. JUNON DU VASSET (9) gave a very good account that day and looks a serious proposition. On the back row, JOLIE DE L'AUMANCE (12), who won last time with a sharp turn of foot, and IKY JOY (14), who returns to a track he appreciates, are obvious dangers.

C7 - PRIX PIERRE VIGNEAUX - 2400m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. ILOU FIRST RICHER** - Unplaced in a Class A at Eauze over 3,000m on 7 June 2026. Has not been seen out since and is not about to spice things up
- 2. HUGO DE JEMAX** - Has not raced since finishing 12th in a Class E at Montauban over 2,400m on 25 May and with shoes fitted will not be troubling the opposition
- 3. HORUS DES CHAMPS** - Second to IMPATIENTE NAY (6) in a Class F at Trie Sur Baise over 3,325m on 4 August 2026. Is not the most dependable of horses but is clearly in shape and, from the 3 slot, must be respected
- 4. INVICTUS NAR** - Should not be too quickly-judged for failing to deliver in a Class E at Castera-Verd. over 2,800m on 10 August 2026, and can play a part if he replicates his Biarritz performance
- 5. IROCKO STRYCK** - Gave a good account at Argentan a week ago when 4th in a 2150m Class D. Enjoys a better draw this time and has a realistic chance of contesting the finish
- 6. IMPATIENTE NAY** - Successful in a Class F at Trie Sur Baise over 3,325m on 4 August. Is not the easiest of horses to use but she starts in front, is unbeaten in 3 runs over course and distance, and looks dangerous
- 7. KLASSE DE BRUZEAU** - Fifth in a Class E at Enghien over 2,150m on 12 August, 9 days after running 2nd at Rochefort-sur-Loire. Is unlikely to get her nose in front but is still good enough to finish in the mix
- 8. HARLEY DE QUARO** - Finished 12th in a Class E at Castera-Verd. over 2,800m on 10 August. Has been out of sorts for 4 months and will have nothing to offer
- 9. HOUSTON D'ECAJEUL** - Finished 12th in a Class E over course and distance on 13 July. Has done little of note this year and is unlikely to create an upset
- 10. I AM PHYT'S** - Has a pair of runs under his belt since the layoff but is some way off his best and others easier to back
- 11. JUST ELGE DESBOIS** - Unbeaten in 2 starts this summer, lastly a Class F at Castera-Verduzan a fortnight ago. Starts on back row here but is still set to take all the beating
- 12. HADES DE SUCE** - Won a Class G Amateurs' race at Grenade-Sur-G. over 2,725m on 15 August. Takes on a better bunch here but is always game and cannot be discounted

Summary: Imperious on both starts since returning to the track, JUST ELGE DESBOIS (11) looks difficult to beat. IROCKO STRYCK (5), who held his own at Argentan, and a reconfigured IMPATIENTE NAY (6), easy winner at the start of the month, are the most likely challengers. KLASSE DE BRUZEAU (7) faces opposition within her capabilities and can give her elders plenty to think about.
