C1 - GRAND NATIONAL DU TROT - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 90,000

1. **KOVES DU PONT** - Third in a Class E at Rambouillet over 2,800m on 6 September. Has not put a foot out of place since April and while unlikely to shake things up, should nevertheless give an honourable account
2. **HUMOUR FESTIF** - Ran 7th in a monte Class C at Enghien over 2,250m on 2 August. Is here for reasons of conditioning and can be confidently ruled out
3. **JAIN MAB** - Fourth in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 12 August. Is confirmed under these conditions but others still preferred
4. **JACK DES ASS** - Prepped successfully in a Rochefort-sur-Loire Class D on 16 August prior to running 3rd to JEANNETTE PRIORY (12) at Angers. Has come on leaps and bounds recently and must be considered a player
5. **JENTIL DIESCHOOT** - Unplaced in a Group III at Angers over 3,100m on 9 September. Has been out of sorts since winning the Amiens leg last March and even though barefoot is still not a priority
6. **KARNAC WOOD** - Returns to racing clockwise after running 4th over 2350m at Avenches, his first start for almost 2 months. Is in competition-mode this time but others still easier to back
7. **LORD DELO** - Won the Saint-Malo leg only to be subsequently disqualified, then failed to deliver in a Vincennes Gr.3 a month back. Debuts for new yard, with shoes fitted, and best to wait
8. **JIPET DE CREPIN** - Imposed at Enghien prior to running 2nd in a Vincennes Class C 2.5 weeks ago. Starts in front, has already won right-handed this year, and can do so again
9. **LITTLE BROWN** - Was unable to confirm Cabourg success when disqualified in an Enghien Gr.2 on 14 August. Has form at this level and from the front row can give this a good go. First 5
10. **JOLIVERT DU GERS** - Unplaced in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 5 September. Presents solid clockwise credentials and is not incapable of getting in on the action
11. **HESCORT LOVE** - Successful in a Class A at Beaumont-De-Lomagne over 2,550m on 3 September, his 4th success in 3 months, but is being aimed too high this time
12. **JEANNETTE PRIORY** - Brilliant winner of a GNT Gr.3 at Angers 2 weeks ago. Has hardly put a foot wrong since the spring and looks main danger to JIPET DE CREPIN (8)
13. **JUST DE L'OISON** - Superb trotter that completed the hat-trick when victorious in a Craon Gr.3 on 7 September, and adding to this tally is well within his capability
14. **INDUS VAL** - Has not been seen out since running 5th in a Class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 6 July. Is clearly in race-mode but still has his work cut out
15. **IALTO D'HERTALS** - Second in a Class D at Laval over 2,850m on 23 August, 18 days after having placed 3rd in the Saint-Malo edition, and cannot be discounted
16. **HARMONISTA** - Starts for the first time since being disqualified in a Cabourg monte Class A on 17 July and can be overlooked
17. **JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL** - Unplaced in a Group II at Argentan over 1,609m on 8 August. Has not been seen out since and with shoes fitted will have nothing to bring to the party
18. **HULYSSE DIGEO** - Fifth in a Group II at La Capelle over 1,800m on 2 September. Is a quality trotter but with an extra 50m to travel is unlikely to spice things up

Summary: A tough sort that adapts to any situation, JIPET DE CREPIN (8) is in excellent form, excels in the day's configuration, and from the front line should take all the beating. JEANNETTE PRIORY (12), who won the latest GNT leg at Angers, is like a horse reborn and can strike again. The Duvaldestin trio will also need to be taken seriously, with JUST DE L'OISON (13) Theo's pick, JACK DES ASS (4) the only one of the three starting on the front line, and IALTO D'HERTALS (15) battle-hardened and close to his race.

C2 - PRIX DU CHATEAU DE MEDAVY - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 8,000

1. **KLASS D'ESPOIR** - Made up for some modest performances when successful in an Angers Class F on 9 September. Left a good impression that day and although unlikely to repeat can nevertheless give this a good go
2. **JAGUAR DU DOLLAR** - No slouch on a good day but disappointing in his last three outings and can expect to have few friends
3. **HAUGAIN** - Unplaced in a Class F Amateurs' race at Laval over 2,850m on 19 August. Is confirmed at this level but is as inclement as the wind and others easier to back
4. **INDIGO SIMARDIERE** - Has been completely off the boil over recent months and even from the front row has no possible chance
5. **KASHKAI** - Runner-up in 2 before finishing 7th in a Bernay Class F 10 days ago. Is better than the result would suggest, has been re-shod, and is one for the shortlist
6. **KASSIOPEE DU NOYER** - Unplaced in a Class F at Laval over 2,850m on 28 August, when being prepared for this. Is clearly in competition-mode this time and from the front row can finish close
7. **JUSTY DU OLPASI** - Respectable element that lost his action in a Bernay Class F 10 days ago. Has otherwise been in decent shape and should not be overlooked
8. **IVAN LENDEL** - Finished 5th in a Class H Amateurs' race at Villedieu Les Poeles over 2,800m on 13 September, but did win at Tours a week earlier. Takes on a better lot here but should nonetheless hold his own
9. **IOKINA DE KERYANN** - Encouraged twice in early-August but has since lost her way and has shown no sign of an imminent return to form
10. **JALMAROSA** - Won 2 from 3 before losing her action at the start of a Cabourg Class F a week ago. Is plainly in excellent shape though and goes well for Barbara Guenet who will be justifiably expecting to set the record straight
11. **KISS ME DU LIVET** - Imposed at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 21 August before running 4th in a Vibraye Class F 9 days later. Is in conditioning-mode this time though and can be passed over
12. **JUSTESS VIKING** - Useful in both codes but tends to show more under the saddle. Is plainly in decent shape but is still not an obvious choice
13. **KIFF L'OSEILLE** - Has not been seen out since running 2nd in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 19 December 2025. Stays shod for comeback and will not be pushed hard
14. **HATALANTE DE FLO** - Imposed at Laval on 23 August prior to confirming in a Cabourg Class F a week back and the hat-trick is not beyond her reach
15. **JASON BLUE** - Finished 3rd in a Class F Amateurs' race at Craon over 2,775m on 7 September. Simply thrives in the amateur category and is easy to fancy for a spot on the podium
16. **KINDY DU VIVIER** - Makes first start since finishing 9th in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,750m on 21 July. Is shod for the occasion and best to wait

Summary: Disqualified early at Cabourg recently, JALMAROSA (10) has the means to make amends if Barbara Guenet gets her off on the right foot. HATALANTE DE FLO (14), who comes to Argentan on a three-timer, and JASON BLUE (15), impressive finisher at Craon recently, can harbour ambitions. Barefoot for her first objective of the autumn, KASSIOPEE DU NOYER (6) will be expected to get straight back in the game. Recent winner at Angers, KLASS D'ESPOIR (1) is bidding to confirm.

C3 - PRIX DU CHATEAU DE SASSY - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **KADEOS SI** - Won 2 of 3 last month, latterly an amateurs Class H at Les Andelys 3.5 weeks ago. At this level though is unlikely to spring any surprises
2. **KUEEN DE MONGUERET** - Finished 6th in a Class H at Chateauroux over 2,900m on 13 September. Should be fully fit by now but still seems to be taking on too much
3. **KAMALIS** - Gave a fine account on re-entry when second in a Craon Class F 2.5 weeks ago. A repeat seems unlikely but will have come on for the run, sports a new configuration, and cannot be discounted
4. **KANDERO BELLO** - Produced a pair of decent turf performances before being disqualified at Landivisiau 2.5 weeks ago. In this company though, is not an obvious choice
5. **KIAMA** - Easy winner of a Cabourg Class F, for new yard, on 1 September. Starts in front here and is in with a realistic shout of repeating
6. **KENTIA DES RIOULTS** - Has not been seen out since running 4th in a Class E at Saint Malo over 2,950m on 24 May, and will have nothing to contribute
7. **KING DU PRESSEIR** - Disappointing in last 3, most recently a 2750m Ecommoy Class E 10 days ago, and can be ruled out
8. **KRONOS DES LANDES** - Enjoys an excellent entry on the front line but comes here on a hat-trick of disqualifications and is unlikely to have many takers
9. **KIM DE BEAUM** - Serious mare that finished lacklustre 6th in a Craon Class E on 7 September. Is confirmed at this level but incurs the penalty and others easier to back
10. **KAVALO BELLO** - Put away after securing a Class E at Vichy over 1,609m on 30 June. Would be preferred barefoot but can still play a small part
11. **KALITY D'ERABLE** - Finished 5th in a Class E at Vire over 2,800m on 6 September, after having run 2nd in a Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel. Has not got her head in front for some time, but always gives her best and has form under these conditions. First five
12. **KINJAL DE BELLANDE** - Made up for Vire sanction when 3rd in a Class E at Villedieu-les-Poëles 10 days ago, but races shod this time and will have other objectives
13. **KOBRA JENILOU** - Authoritative winner of a Cabourg Class E on 14 August. Comes here fresh and can confirm
14. **KATIA DE MUZE** - Failed to confirm Laval victory when unplaced in a Class F at Les Andelys 10 days ago. Is patently better than that though and Charly Korosi will be eager to put things right
15. **KATINKA COTON** - Made amends for Les Andelys disqualification when successful in a Laval Class E a fortnight ago. Is not the easiest of horses to use but, with form maintained, should not let the side down
16. **KANKAN** - Finished 3rd in a Class E Apprentices' race at Ecommoy over 2,750m on 13 September. Benefits from an excellent entry and it is just a question of time before he gets his head back in front

Summary: Authoritative winner at Cabourg last month, KOBRA JENILOU (13) is shod as he was when imposing over course and distance in May, and is thoroughly capable of following up. To do so, he will still have to get the better of KIAMA (5), who imposed on her first start for her new trainer, and KANKAN (16), re-shod and ideally-engaged at the limit of earnings. Recent winner at Laval, KATINKA COTON (15) can again finish in the mix, as can KATIA DE MUZE (14), who will be shod to preference.

C4 - PRIX DU CHATEAU DE CARRONGES - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. NINKASI SOYER** - Ran 2nd in a 2150m Class E here early last month but was disqualified at Vichy next time and appears to be out of her depth
- 2. NEPTUNE D'AVE** - Won a 2150m Class E here on 16 August before being disqualified in a Vincennes Class D 12 days ago. Is not a priority, but will have her supporters
- 3. NUMBER ONE GAGOU** - Finished 5th in a Class D at Angers over 2,425m on 9 September. Has yet to reach his March level but it is just a question of time
- 4. NACOMA RUN** - Runner-up in 2 straight before coming 5th behind NORMA DU VIVIER (6) in a Cabourg Class D on 28 August. Breaks in front and has a reasonable chance of picking up a cheque
- 5. NEED FOR LOVE** - Finished 4th in a Class B at Vincennes over 2,175m on 2 June. Is plainly a good future prospect but races shod for comeback and best to keep one's powder dry
- 6. NORMA DU VIVIER** - Failed to secure the hat-trick when 3rd in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,750m on 28 August. Should take well to Argentan conditions and from the front line can play a leading role
- 7. NARCOS DES LANDES** - Finished 4th in a Class C at Divonne over 2,600m on 20 August. Is as good racing right-handed as left, consistently gives his best, but in this company is unlikely to create an upset
- 8. NEW APPROACH** - Disqualified in a Class A at Vincennes over 2,700m on 22 February. Has not been seen out since and will need the race
- 9. NINA HAGEN D'OR** - Disqualified in last two, but has ample ability. Presents solid right-handed credentials and is unlikely to be too far from the action
- 10. NEUILLY DE PLAY** - Finished 6th in a Class B at Enghien over 2,875m on 10 August. Has placed just once in 3 Argentan starts and is unlikely to play an active role
- 11. NASH PERRINE** - Unable to deliver in a Group III at Vincennes over 2,700m on 22 August, a month after having imposed at Cabourg, and a return to racing clockwise may be just the ticket
- 12. NIGHT FOR YOU** - Disqualified in Group I Prix d'Essai - Etrier 3 Ans Finale at Vincennes over 2,700m on 21 June. Won a Class C last time under harness but is in conditioning-mode on this occasion
- 13. NECTAR DE LA FYE** - Finished 8th in Group I Prix d'Essai - Etrier 3 Ans Finale at Vincennes over 2,700m on 21 June. Makes first start since and will have other priorities
- 14. NELSON THORIS** - Unplaced in a Class A at Vincennes over 2,700m on 24 August after having run 2nd in a Pornichet Class B 11 days earlier. Goes right-handed for the first time and will have a decent chance of opening his harness account
- 15. NONONINO** - Made amends for faulting at Pornichet when 3rd in a Vichy Class B a month ago and will be no pushover if Alexandre Abrivard keeps him focused
- 16. NOTHINGELSEMATTERS** - Has not been seen out since running third in a Group III at Vincennes over 2,700m on 5 June. Trainer in the bike this time and best to keep one's powder dry
- 17. NONEKA** - Starts for the first time since running 4th in a Group III at Vincennes over 2,700m on 5 June. Is shod for re-entry and will have little to offer
- 18. NAVY SEAL** - Won 2 on the trot before coming last of 6 in a Group II at Enghien over 2,150m on 14 August. Returns to a more reasonable level and even from the back row can play a prominent part

Summary: Judged on his penultimate start at Pornichet, NELSON THORIS (14) has the means to play a leading role here. NORMA DU VIVIER (6), who has been excellent since her first competitive steps, will lead the opposition alongside NASH PERRINE (11), who can be forgiven his Vincennes blip. With application, NONONINO (15) can play an active part in the finish, as can NAVY SEAL (18) even though starting alone on the 3rd line.

C5 - PRIX DU CHATEAU DE CHAMBOIS - 2875m (a2m) - - Mounted - EUR € 53,000

1. **KAP ORNE** - Ran 4th in an Enghien Class E before being disqualified in a Craon Class D on 7 September. Has won going both directions this year, sports 4 pads as he did when imposing at Caen, and will generate some interest
2. **VASTERBO IMTHEMAN** - Has struggled since returning from his sojourn in Sweden, most recently 6th in an Angers Class E 2 weeks ago, and will have few friends in the markets
3. **HASHTAG DE TAGOR** - Takes first competitive monte steps after being trounced in a Class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne 9 days ago and is not an obvious choice
4. **LAMBADA DU GOUTIER** - Disqualified on comeback in an Enghien Gr.3 on 14 August. Has buckets of ability though and will have her chances if she gets off on the right foot
5. **KRACK CLEA** - Finished 9th in a harness Group III at Angers over 3,100m on 9 September. Boasts excellent monte references though and will be no easy touch
6. **JABLO DU CHENE** - Ran 2nd twice in July before being rewarded with victory in a Saint-Malo Class D on 5 August. Has been afforded time to get back to his best and can bring the fight to JAG MAHCATH (7)
7. **JAG MAHCATH** - Smart winner of a Class D at Laval over 2,850m on 10 September. Is consistently in the thick of things, won his only start at Argentan, and is easy to fancy for the win
8. **JIMINY CRICKET** - Second in a harness Group III at Angers over 3,100m on 9 September. Has nothing to prove in this branch of the business and in current shape must not be underestimated
9. **IMELDA** - Good, consistent mare that ran 5th in a Craon Class D on 7 September. Is unlikely to paint the town red but can pick up a first-five cheque
10. **FALTO DES LANDIERS** - Has been a complete write-off since winning a Lisieux amateurs Class E in May and will first need to reassure

Summary: Last-time-out winners JAG MAHCATH (7) and JABLO DU CHENE (6) can again fight out the finish. Back under the saddle and reconfigured, KRACK CLEA (5) can get involved, as can LAMBADA DU GOUTIER (4) provided she keeps her mind on the job.

C6 - PRIX DU PMU LE SULKY - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 35,000

1. **LAFAYETTE DU BOURG** - Has looked very ordinary since returning to competition last month and would be preferred barefoot
2. **L'EXPRESS DE PLAY** - Starts for the first time since finishing 10th in a Class E at Enghien over 2,150m on 25 June. Was trounced last time here and has no realistic chance
3. **LAMA DE CORDAY** - Handy element that produced a pair of good performances before being disqualified in a Vire Class E late last month and cannot be considered a priority
4. **L'ETINCELLE** - Finished 2nd in a Class B at Divonne over 2,650m on 21 August, after having won at Vichy and Le Mans in previous weeks. Faces a much tougher bunch this time though and chances seem limited
5. **LOUP D'ARDENNES** - Complicated individual that has won the last three races he has managed to finish. Is plainly in form and on good behaviour can pick up some prizemoney
6. **LOLA D'OHARA** - Finished 4th in a Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3,000m on 9 September, making up for Vibraye performance, but is still out of her depth
7. **LADY DU CEDRE** - Won a Cabourg Class E in July before running 3rd in a Saint-Malo Class E the following month. Comes here fresh, starts in front, and is not incapable of making her Argentan debut a winning one
8. **LOREZZA ERA** - Finished 8th, on comeback, in a Class E at Vincennes over 2,100m on 11 September. Is nicely-in on the front row, won over course and distance in the spring, and must be respected
9. **LOTUS DU RIB** - Won a monte Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne 3 weeks ago when sporting 4 pads for the first time. Benefits from a terrific entry here and appears to have a realistic chance of doubling his money
10. **LADY DU CHATELET** - Disqualified in a Class E at Agon-Coutainville over 3,450m on 5 July. Sports shoes for re-entry and has nothing to offer
11. **LA VIE EST BELLE** - In the frame in 2 of last 3, most recently close 2nd in a Craon Class D on 7 September. Is never far from faulting but in present shape is easy to like for a first-five payout
12. **LE BOLIDE** - Encouraging 6th in a Vincennes Class C last week after having twice placed on turf, but still has more to find
13. **LAURELINA** - Starts for the first time since running 5th in a Class D at Le Croise-Laroche over 1,900m on 22 June. Shoes on and poses no threat
14. **LOVING DREAM** - Fifth in a Class B at Enghien over 2,875m on 6 August. Has been climbing the category-ladder in good order and is unlikely to be far off the mark
15. **LOVE KILLS** - Has been simply superb in 2026, most recently scoring for the 6th time this year, winning a Class B at Grenade in mid-August. Is new to the venue but in current condition is hard to ignore
16. **LUCAS** - Made it 4 straight sanctions when disqualified in a Class B at Vincennes over 2,850m on 9 June. Has not been seen since and can be written off
17. **LOVE GLYCINES** - Has not been seen out since being pulled up in a 2150m Enghien Class D on 1 July. Is shod for comeback and can be passed over
18. **LARA CROFT** - Ran 6th in a Class B at Vincennes over 2,100m on 12 September, but faces a less-exalted bunch this time and, given the entry, must be considered a player

Summary: Pleasant winner under saddle last time out, LOTUS DU RIB (9) can impose under harness this time, thanks in part to this superb entry on the front line. Currently in fine form, LADY DU CEDRE (7) and a reconfigured LOVE KILLS (15) can play leading roles. Tony Le Beller's two runners, LARA CROFT (18) and LA VIE EST BELLE (11), should also have a say in this relatively open event.

C7 - PRIX DU CHATEAU DES DUCS D'ALENCON - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. MISTRAL JANEIRO** - Disappointing of late, most recently eighth in a Cabourg Class F a month ago. In this company will have nothing to contribute
- 2. MY HAPPY STORY** - Unplaced in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,850m on 5 June. Has not raced since and will have nothing to offer
- 3. MANHATTAN FRANCE** - Unplaced in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 19 June. Starts for the first time since and with shoes fitted can be ruled out
- 4. MOZART DU DOLLAR** - Tricky element with just the one race under his belt since last winter. Is confirmed at this level but still needs another run
- 5. MY DREAM** - Finished 4th in a Class D at Saint Malo over 2,950m on 5 August. Has been hard to fault this year but has been fitted with pads this time and best to wait
- 6. MAGELLANO SUN** - Was unable to confirm Divonne success when eliminated in a Chartres Class B 12 days ago, but is unlikely to disappoint if he gets off on the right foot
- 7. MISTRAL JENILOU** - Was unable to complete the hat-trick when disqualified in a 2950m Vichy Class D a month ago. Starts in front here and, with application, can figure prominently
- 8. MI FA SOL** - Third in a 2100m Vincennes Class D 12 days ago. Is not the easiest to handle but has won 2 of 3 clockwise starts. Racing shod though will do her no favours
- 9. MARIBELLA** - Quality individual making first appearance since winning an Enghien Class D on 11 July. Races shod and will have other priorities
- 10. MUSCDARCHE** - Finished 6th, on re-entry, in a Class B at Lisieux over 2,725m on 29 August. Will have come on for the race, sports 4 pads for the first time, and cannot be discounted
- 11. MYSTIC PARKER** - Sent for a rest after winning an Enghien monte Class C on 18 July. Is here for reasons of conditioning and is not a concern
- 12. MON PLAISIR** - Ran 7th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,175m on 4 September. Is competitively-shod this time and is in with a decent shout of making the frame
- 13. MISSING** - Fourth in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,175m on 5 September, 3 weeks after having won a Class B at Lisieux, and looks main threat to MISSING (13)
- 14. METIDJA** - Showed promise during the spring but has since come off the boil. Sports for pads for the first time but has nothing going for her here
- 15. MUST DREAM** - Comfortable winner of a Class D at Cabourg over 2,750m on 21 August. Has been beaten just once in 9 right-handed starts and should make this his own
- 16. MISTRAL CASTELLE** - Finished 5th, on comeback, in a Class B at Lisieux over 2,725m on 29 August. Will have progressed for the race and can play an important role if he takes to the new conditions
- 17. MARZIPAN** - Moderate colt making his first appearance since being disqualified in an Enghien Class C on 11 July, and can be passed over
- 18. MARIE OH FREDLAU** - Finished 9th in a Group II at Enghien over 2,150m on 14 August. Drops back to a more reasonable level and, even though barefoot, still looks competitively well in

Summary: Formidable racing right-handed, MUST DREAM (15) is less competitively-shod than he was at Cabourg but still looks the one to beat. However, he will still need to watch out for the talented MISSING (13), and MON PLAISIR (12) who is clearly in race-mode this time. On good behaviour, MISTRAL JENILOU (7) will give it his all from the front line. After a much-needed comeback run, MISTRAL CASTELLE (16) has a chance of making the frame.

C8 - PRIX PARIS TURF X PMU - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 30,000

1. **TRETIK** - Disqualified at Aby over 1,640m on 9 September. Should be fit by now and makes his clockwise bow with every chance of making the frame
2. **JACQUES MEARAS** - Ran reassuring third at Cabourg before being disqualified at Enghien 2 months ago. Has been reconfigured but others still preferred
3. **XANTHIS IBIZA** - Has made little impression since coming south, most recently 6th in a Class F on turf 2.5 weeks ago, and is not about to create an upset
4. **INES DE GLADJESS** - Modest element that was well-beaten in a Bernay Class G late last month and has no realistic chance
5. **TRIXWITHTRIMMIX** - Ran 3rd in a Chateaubriant class E 10 days ago. Has been acquitting himself well since coming south and can challenge for a spot in the picture
6. **KIBRILLE MONTAVAL** - Ran 6th in a Class E Apprentices' race at Mauquenchy over 2,150m on 10 September. Is an honest trotter but is taking on too much this time
7. **KING OF DAY** - Unplaced in a Class E at Saint Malo over 2,950m on 5 August, having imposed on turf a month earlier, but stays shod this time and can be disregarded
8. **KYUSHU** - Has not put a foot out of line over recent weeks, lastly winning a Vire Class F late last month. Unplaced on sole start at the venue but in present form is easy to back
9. **JASMIN PRECIEUX** - Trounced in a Cabourg Class D on 28 August. Races shod once more and can be ignored
10. **EL DORADO BAR** - Finished 3rd in a Class E at Enghien over 2,150m on 12 August, a fortnight after having won a Class F there, and should represent principal danger to KASSIOPEE WIND (15)
11. **KELLY JANE** - Finished 12th in a Class F at Nort Sur Erdre over 3,100m on 6 September. Is still being conditioned and can be passed over
12. **KISS ME AGAIN** - Quality trotter that is shod to preference following his re-entry freshener at Chateaubriant 10 days ago. Will have come on for the run and even from the second line can make his presence felt
13. **KHEO VIVANCIERE** - Finished 8th on comeback in a Class E at Rambouillet over 2,800m on 6 September. Has no shortage of ability, but is still being conditioned and best to hold off
14. **INITIALE LILA** - 8th in a Cabourg Class E on 14 August. Very disappointing over recent weeks and from the back row will have nothing to offer
15. **KASSIOPEE WIND** - Won 2 of last 3, most recently a Rambouillet Class E 2.5 weeks ago, and looks set to repeat
16. **COMES WITH AGE** - Third in a Class D at La Capelle over 2,700m on 2 September. Has been knocking at the door since the start of the summer and, while not a priority this time, should nevertheless hold his own
17. **DESTINO D.J.** - Gave a good account on return to France, coming 4th in a Vincennes Class D on 11 September. Will have only improved for the race and is unlikely to disappoint
18. **KORONA DELADOU** - Third in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,750m on 28 August. Trainer could not have wished for a better entry and Guillaume Martin will be legitimately hoping to finish in the mix

Summary: Back to her best, KASSIOPEE WIND (15) has the means to shine on her return to a hard surface. In cracking form, EL DORADO BAR (10) is easy to like. Swedish-trained TRETIK (1) makes his French bow with David Thomain reining and can finish close. TRIXWITHTRIMMIX (5) has pleased since coming to France and can play an active part in the finish. Barefoot following a good run at Cabourg, KORONA DELADOU (18) can also have a say.
