

R2 LA CAPELLE [L-H]

C1 - PRIX READY CASH - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. NOUNE D'ECHAL** - Made short work of rivals in a Class F at Craon over 2,275m on 6 July. Capable of following up if staying in stride once again
- 2. NACREE DE QUARO** - Did not show her best when 6th in a Class E at La Capelle over 2,700m on 19 June. Did score on debut and is clearly not out of it
- 3. NOISETTE MIKA** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Pornicher-La Baule on 16 July. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
- 4. NINA DU BOCAGE** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class E at Mont St Michel over 2,675m on 16 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 5. NYMPHE DE DURBUY** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class E at Vittel over 2,700m on 12 July. Should contest the finish once again
- 6. NOBLESSE DU CHENE** - In good shape and finished 4th in a Class F at Amiens over 2,400m on 10 July. Can get involved with the finish once again if staying in stride
- 7. NASHVILLE MENCOURT** - Showed promise when third in a Class F at Montier En Der over 2,300m on 5 July. Can earn some more money
- 8. NELIA DU BOIS** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class E at Pornichet over 2,725m on 16 July. Capable of being a threat to these rivals as well
- 9. NIZZA PRESTANCE** - Finished third on debut in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2,825m on 2 March. Returns from a break but should be a threat if smart

Summary: NOUNE D'ECHAL (1) scored easily on the grass at Craon earlier this month and, once again partnered by Paul Ploquin, looks capable of following up. With plenty of scope for improvement, NOBLESSE DU CHENE (6) also has the ability to win a race of this nature. Behind them, the Feelers representatives merit attention: NIZZA PRESTANCE (9), an encouraging third on debut, and NACREE DE CARO (2), who will be driven by a professional, are both worth considering.

C2 - PRIX FACE TIME BOURBON - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 19,000

1. **LIKE YOU MADRIK** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a claimer at Laon over 2650m on 19 July. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
2. **LARGO DU PONT** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out at Vittel on 14 July. Successful in his penultimate start and can challenge for top honours if smart
3. **LACKING SPIRIT** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class F at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,650m on 11 July. Successful twice in last three starts and can score again
4. **LUTIN DE LA BESVRE** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2,825m on 22 June. Some solid wins before that and deserves the utmost respect
5. **LUNDU DE LOU** - Only modest of late and finished fifth in a Class E at Lisieux over 2,675m on 15 July. Might need to do a bit more to beat these rivals
6. **LUPIN DU RIB** - Showed promise and was third in a Class F at Cabourg over 2,725m on 14 July. Can be in the mix of things once again
7. **LUC PAASLOO** - Finished 8th in a Class E at this course over 1800m on 17 July. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
8. **L'ALPHA DE LAUNI** - Finished 5th in a Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 11 June. Might play a minor role at very best

Summary: LACKING SPIRIT (3) made an impressive return to form at Les Sables-d'Olonne and will be a leading contender. LARGO DU PONT (2), who has plenty of stamina, can challenge if he keeps his action together. LUTIN DE LA BESVRE (4), already a winner with his jockey has to be respected. LUPIN DU RIB (6), fitted with front shoes only, could still have enough to secure a place on the podium.

C3 - PRIX DE L'ASSOCIATION CREATIF'ARTS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. MARIE LOU DE LARRE** - Finished 7th last time out in Class E at Le Mans over 2200m on 13 July. Has disqualification issues but is capable of scoring
- 2. MYRTILLE DE SEE** - Victorious last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 27 June. Capable of doubling up in this line-up
- 3. MY QUEEN DELO** - Has only been modest of late and was 7th in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. On a long losing run but does have a place chance
- 4. MAROUBRA** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 10 July. Has a chance to complete the hat-trick
- 5. MONA LE LOUP** - Very consistent this year and was runner-up in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 22 June. Can go one place better
- 6. MAYOTTE** - Not reliable and was 5th in a Class E mounted race at Amiens over 2400m on 27 June. Better under the saddle and others make more appeal
- 7. MAYUMI** - In very good form and was third in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 22 June. Can get involved with the finish again
- 8. MAJESTE DU MENIL** - Holding form and finished 4th in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Can make the frame again
- 9. MAM'ZELLE FRO** - Not reliable and finished 5th in Class F at Laon over 2650m on 19 July. Might play a minor role at best
- 10. MILA CAAL** - Disqualified in Class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 2 July. Unreliable but has a place chance when staying in stride
- 11. MAGIC GIRL** - Unreliable and was unplaced in Class F at Laon over 2650m on 19 July. Yet to win and others make more appeal

Summary: MONA LE LOUP (5) is reunited with Jérémy Koubiche, the only driver to have guided her to victory. She holds solid claims but will face strong opposition from MAROUBRA (4), who has improved markedly since being fitted with hind shoes, and MYRTILLE DE SEE (2), who has also progressed since racing barefoot. Third in a similar contest a month ago, MAYUMI (7) remains capable of getting involved with the finish.

C4 - PRIX IDAO DE TILLARD - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. MAWENZI** - Much improved last run and finished 3rd in a Class E at Carentan over 2850m on 11 July. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. MORRIS DE REUX** - Showed good improvement and was a winner of a Class F at Le Touquet over 2,600m on 14 July. Capable of following up if in the same mood
- 3. MASTER PIT** - Returned to form when third in a Class E at this course over 2,750m on 19 June. Big chance in this line-up
- 4. MOONLIGHT ATOUT** - Not reliable but finished third in a Class G at Nancy over 2,600m on 26 June. Capable of contesting the finish once again
- 5. MALAKY FAFA** - Disqualified at Vittel over 2700m on 14 July. Clearly capable of a lot better and could play a minor role in this line-up
- 6. MARWIN** - Has some fair form and finished 5th at Wolvega over 3100m on 14 April. Returns from a break and needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 7. MANGO DU POMMEREUX** - Not disgraced when third in a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2,825m on 22 June. Not reliable but is capable of earning some money
- 8. MAGNUM DE RATILLY** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class E at Lu Mans over 2,200m on 13 July. Capable of better and could upset
- 9. MONOGAME** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class F at Amiens over 2,400m on 10 July. Should be involved with the finish once again
- 10. MERCURY JIEL** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a Class F at Vichy over 2,150m on 4 July. Not easy to trust but is capable of making the frame when smart
- 11. MANCHESTER** - Unreliable and finished 3rd at Wolvega over 2600m on 4 July. Probably needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 12. MONT LIGNERIES** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class F at Laon over 2,650m on 19 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 13. MURMURE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Le Mans on 13 July. Capable of popping up in place when staying in stride

Summary: MASTER PIT (3) has dropped in class and looks ready to make a bold bid at scoring. He should be challenged by MOONLIGHT ATOUT (4), who returns to this discipline with legitimate ambitions. MERCURY JIEL (10) remains a tricky horse to handle, but if his driver keeps him focused, he has the ability to fight for top honors. MORRIS DE REUX (2), a narrow winner last time out, appears to have more in hand than the margin suggests and must be respected as well.

C5 - PRIX GO ON BOY - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 24,000

- 1. L'ESCALE DU CAIEU** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Reims over 2,500m on 20 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 2. LABEL DADDY** - Finished 5th in a Class H at Abbeville over 2300m on 12 July. Successful in a mounted race before that and is not out of it
- 3. LADY DES VALOIS** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class F at Le Touquet over 2,600m on 20 June. has a place chance in this line-up
- 4. LAZIE PONT VAUTIER** - In good shape and finished 4th in a Class E at Vittel over 2,700m on 14 July. Capable of earning some more money
- 5. LE VENT DU HOULET** - Finished 6th in a Class E at Reims over 2,575m on 20 June. Unreliable but is capable of playing a minor role at very best
- 6. LOVE ET CASH RENKA** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Class E at Laval over 2,850m on 25 June. Capable of making the frame yet again
- 7. LOOKIERO** - Made short work of rivals in a Class E at Cholet over 2,800m on 9 June. In very good shape and is capable of following up
- 8. LE RIB** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class E Apprentices' race at Caen over 2,450m on 18 June. Capable of completing the hat-trick
- 9. LE CADOR DE SIMM** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a Class E at Caen over 2,450m on 15 June. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 10. LIBERTY CASH** - Successful last time out in a Class E mounted race at Chartres over 2,800m on 28 June. Can contest the finish once again

Summary: In outstanding form, LE RIB (8) is chasing a hat-trick and clearly sets the standard. However, he will need to be wary of LOOKIERO (7), a tough competitor who could spring a surprise on his debut in this discipline. Fresh from a victory against older rivals, LIBERTY CASH (10) has an opportunity to confirm her progress. LOVE ET CASH RENKA (6), now well-established in mounted trotting, should also play a prominent role at the finish.

C6 - PRIX HORSY DREAM - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **KING GEORGES ELLIS** - Disqualified last time out in Class F at Vittel over 2725m on 12 July. In good form before that and is not out of it
2. **KRACDARCHE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 22 June. Capable of a surprise on best form
3. **KEVERT** - Disqualified last time out in Class G at Le Touquet over 2600m on 14 July. Has a place chance if staying in stride
4. **KITALIANO ALGREF** - Out of form and finished 12th in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 25 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
5. **KAMIKAZE DRY** - Successful last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 19 June. Unreliable but is capable of doubling up
6. **KATITZI** - Returned to form and finished third in Class F at Vittel over 2725m on 12 July. Can get into the mix again
7. **KIT ANGOT** - Unreliable and finished third in Class H at Les Andelys over 2525m on 5 July. Capable of playing a minor role
8. **KYRIELLE JOMUNA** - Disqualified in three of her last four starts, including last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 26 June. Can be a threat when staying in stride
9. **KANTARELLE** - Out of form and finished 9th in Class F at Vittel over 2700m on 12 July. Hard to trust but did win twice last year and is capable of a surprise
10. **KISS ME JAMINI** - Disqualified last time out in Class G at Bernay over 2800m on 12 July. Unreliable but is capable of making the frame if smart
11. **KAABA RINGEAT** - Only modest of late and was 6th in Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 17 June. Has won twice this year and is not out of it
12. **KITTY PIYA** - Non partante
13. **KAPITEN DU MELEUC** - Disqualified last time out in Class E at Vittel over 2700m on 14 July. Battling to regain form and others are preferred
14. **KORONA DU CHIFFRES** - Victorious last time out in Class G at Arras over 2900m on 21 June. Tougher task this time but has a place chance

Summary: KAMIKAZE DRY (5) impressed with an easy victory over this course and distance, clearly looks like the one to beat. KAABA RINGEAT (11) has been competing in stronger company this season and could challenge for top honours. . KISS ME JAMINI (10), despite reverting to her old habits recently, still has the ability to secure a placing if she behaves. KYRIELLE JOMUNA (8) is a risky but talented option—capable of everything or nothing.

C7 - PRIX HOHNECK - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 25,000

1. **JAZZY MAKER** - Disqualified last time out in Class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 3 July. Not reliable and is on a long losing run. Others are preferred
2. **JADE FOR EVER** - Battling to find best form and was 7th in Class G at Cabourg over 2750m on 7 July. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
3. **JUTLAND** - Has some fair form and was fourth in Class G at Reims over 2550m on 20 June. Might play a minor role once again
4. **JAGUAR'S EYES** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E at Le Mans over 2200m on 13 July. Can be competitive over this distance
5. **JAMAQUE DE HOERDT** - Out of form and finished 9th in Class F at Vittel over 2700m on 14 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
6. **JAG DE ROZEVIC** - Unreliable and finished 10th in Class E at Le Touquet over 2600m on 14 July. Not out of it on best form
7. **JAVLAR** - In very good shape and was runner-up in Class F at this course over 2750m on 7 July. Should fight out the finish again
8. **IKAKOU** - Showed improvement when runner-up in Class H at Carentan over 2850m on 11 July. On a long losing run but might play a minor role
9. **JACKPOTINA** - Unreliable and finished third in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 17 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
10. **INDY PIQUENARD** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne over 2850m on 14 July. Does best on grass but cannot be ruled out
11. **IBLISS MAYBE** - Successful last time out in Class G at this course over 1800m on 7 July. Tougher task over this distance but cannot be ruled out
12. **JACKPOT BOOSTER** - On a long losing run and was 5th in Class F at Le Mans over 2200m on 13 July. Has a place chance on best form
13. **JACKPOT DU DOME** - Unreliable and finished 11th in Class F at Moulins over 2800m on 28 June. Can be a lively danger when staying in stride
14. **JOY EASTER** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in Class G at this course over 1800m on 7 July. Can make the frame once again
15. **ISIMONEY DU CHENE** - Disqualified last time out in Class G at this course over 1800m on 7 July. Not easy to trust but might play a minor role
16. **JUNO DAY** - Unreliable but was third at Wolvega over 2600m on 4 July. Might play a minor role at best

Summary: Long overdue for a win, JAVLAR (7) finds an ideal opportunity to get back to winning ways in this field. JACKPOT DU DOME (13), who is capable but unreliable, and JAGUAR'S EYES (4) is better than his recent performances suggest and both are lively dangers. INDY PIQUENARD (10) is returning to form and looks set to confirm his improvement and is capable of shining as well.

C8 - PRIX BOLD EAGLE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. IPSO D'AVIGNERE** - Has only been modest of late and was 5th in Class E at Amiens over 2900m on 18 July. Might play a minor role at best
- 2. JEALOUS GIRL** - In very good form and was third in Class E at Amiens over 2900m on 18 July. On a long losing run but is in good form and can score
- 3. JERIKA DE KERYANN** - Showed improvement when 5th in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 14 July. Capable of improvement and might make the frame
- 4. ILUCE DE BEAUCAMPS** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in Class E at this course over 2700m on 7 July. Hard to trust but is capable of earning some money
- 5. GALON D'AMIRAL** - Unreliable and was unplaced in Class F over this course and distance on 7 July. Hard to trust but might play a minor role
- 6. JIMBO SPORT** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class E at Amiens over 2900m on 18 July. Has already won twice this year and can score again
- 7. HORSE DE GRAMMONT** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class D at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 5 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 8. HEAVEN D'ECAJEUL** - Often competitive and was third in Class F over this course and distance on 7 July. Has claims in a very open looking race
- 9. JULIANO STILE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 5th in Class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 9 July. Capable of contesting the finish in this line-up

Summary: We end the meeting with the most exciting race from a sporting perspective. Despite the small field, it's wide open. That said, HEAVEN D'ECAJEUL (8) has the class to beat this competition. The real danger will come from JULIANO STILE (9), who finished strongly last time out. JERIKA DE KERYANN (3), who has been improving (5th). She can contend for a place on the podium, as can JEALOUS GIRL (2), who is in top form.
