

R1 VINCENNES [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DE TOULON - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

1. **MAKING LEMAN** - Disqualified in a Class F at Les Sables D Olonne over 2,000m on 8 August. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
2. **MICHIGAN BLUE** - A winner of the last three starts, the latest in a Class E mounted race at Pornichet-La-Baule over 2,725m on 13 August. Can add another win to the tally
3. **MELKIOR DE BAILLY** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class E mounted race at Divonne over 2,675m on 16 August. Remains barefoot and could earn some money
4. **MATADOR DU PONT** - Disqualified in a Class E harness race at Enghien over 2,875m on 10 August. Remains barefoot and could be a threat for Benjamin Rochard
5. **M'AVEZ VOUS VU** - Finished 5th in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2,250m on 10 August. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role
6. **MISTRAL DE CERISY** - Finished 7th in a Class D harness race at Chatelaillon over 2,625m on 27 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
7. **MISTER CARNOIS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2,250m on 10 August. Capable of making the frame when smarting we,
8. **MID DANCER** - Disqualified three times in last four starts, including last time out in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 10 August. Reverts to barefoot and could contest the finish
9. **MOJITO DES ECUS** - In good shape and was third in a Class F at Saint Malo over 2,975m on 9 July 2026. Tries barefoot and could be ready to strike
10. **MERCURY DELO** - Finished 7th in a Class D harness race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 1 August. Successful under the saddle before that and can score again

Summary: Completely unshod for his first start for Mathieu Mottier, MOJITO DES ECUS (9) has the potential to make a strong impression. MICHIGAN BLUE (2) arrives on a hat-trick of wins and looks the one to beat among the opposition. MID DANCER (8) is also barefoot and could pose a threat. MISTER CARNOIS (7) has produced two good efforts at course and should be involved with the finish.

C2 - PRIX DES BRUYERES - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 38,000

- 1. OPERA WOOD** - Finished fifth on debut in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 22 July. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 2. OFFSHORE MIJO** - A runner-up second time out, in a Class E at Franchville over 2,475m on 15 August. Might play a minor role at very best
- 3. OPIUM D'AMOUR** - A winner of a class D at La Ferte-Vidame over 2,250m on 2 August. Tougher task this time but cannot be ruled out
- 4. ONEY DE MAC** - has run well in both starts and was runner-up in a Class E at Neuille Pont Pierre over 2,400m on 2 August. Tougher task in this line-up
- 5. OKA BEHEM** - Successful on debut in a Class F at Ecommoy over 2,225m on 19 July. Won well that day and might just follow up
- 6. OVER THE HILL** - Outclassed the opposition on debut in a Class E at Saint Malo over 2,150m on 15 August. Must be respected for that success and is not out of it
- 7. OSSAU DU PRE** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,050m on 4 August. Looked good on debut and could double up
- 8. ONLY THE BRAVE ONE** - Threatening to win and was runner-up on debut in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 22 July. Can be competitive once again
- 9. ORION MADRIK** - A runner-up in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 29 July. Much improved that day and could be a threat if staying in stride
- 10. OR DES KALOUMA** - Excellent runner-up on debut in a Class C at Enghien over 2,250m on 8 August. Can be a lively danger

Summary: OSSAU DU PRE (7) made a brilliant winning debut at Cabourg and is likely to attract plenty of support. ORION MADRIK (9) has just had his first experience in harness racing, looks the main danger. OKA BEHEM (5) and OPIUM D'AMOUR (3) both arrive after impressive wins on the grass and can confirm that form so must be respected.

C3 - PRIX ANDRE CHOISSELET - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 35,000

1. NO WIN NO GIN - A three-year-old colt by File Gin out of Hombra De Vandel who makes his debut. His Dam was unraced in France. Could need this experience

2. NALIANO - Disqualified twice in both starts, the latest in a Class F mounted race at Cabourg over 2,750m on 7 August. Heavily backed in both starts and could score

3. NO NASDAK TODAY - Disqualified in three starts, the latest in a Class E mounted race at Cabourg over 2,750m on 18 August. Others are much preferred

4. NEDELWESS - Disqualified in a Class F harness race at Montignac over 2,600m on 6 August. Did better under the saddle but more is needed to score

5. NEW YORK DE JED - Finished 9th in a Class G harness race at Saint-Malo over 2,150m on 15 August. Has not shown much so far and others make more appeal on mounted race debut

6. NEVE LEMAN - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Class F harness race at Les Sables D Olonne over 2,650m on 17 August. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

7. NOE DU BLEQUIN - Disqualified in the last five, the latest in a Class G harness race at Laon over 2,225m on 1 August. Can surprise back in a mounted race

8. NEO MIO - Finished 8th in a Class H harness at Abbeville over 2,300m on 16 August. Needs to find a few lengths to score

9. NARCISSE DU POTEAU - Unplaced in a Class F at Craon over 2,275m on 6 July 2026. Capable of doing better and could play a minor role

10. NUNCIO DE HOERDT - Disqualified in a Class F harness race at Agon-Coutainville over 2,200m on 16 August. Capable of better and could challenge for top honours trying a mounted race

11. NAME IS DAIRPET - Finished 6th in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2,250m on 23 June. Capable of contesting the finish

12. NAUTILUS DU SEUX - A winner of a Class F mounted race at Saint-Jean-De-Monts over 2,625m on 2 August. Quite capable of doubling up

13. NIRVANA DU FER - Outclassed the opposition in a Class F mounted race at Laon over 2,850m on 19 July. Clearly unreliable but cannot be ruled out

Summary: NALIANO (2) started favourite for his first two races and has the ability to win if he can maintain his focus. NUNCIO DE HOERDT (10) makes his mounted debut in front shoes and could play a leading role. NAME IS DAIRPET (11) has already shown his effectiveness over this course and distance. Recent provincial winner NAUTILUS DU SEUX (12) and will bid to follow up, making this an open contest.

C4 - PRIX D'ANTIBES - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 62,000

1. **NELSON DU PONT** - Disqualified in a Class B at Pornichet-La-Baule over 2,750m on 13 August, Capable of doing better but others are preferred
2. **NANTUS D'AVIGNERE** - Holding form and was third in a Class B at Enghien over 2,875m on 8 August. Can earn some more minor money at very best
3. **NEED YOU MESLOIS** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class C at Cabourg over 2,750m on 11 August. Must be respected for a string of runner-up performances. Place chance
4. **NOBEL SPEED** - Successful in a Class C at Enghien over 2,875m on 1 August. Not reliable but is capable of making the frame when staying in stride
5. **NIEHKU** - Disqualified in a Class B at Enghien over 2,875m on 8 August. Very consistent before that and is a threat if staying in stride
6. **NON STOP DE FOOT** - Victorious in a Class B at Bernay over 2,800m on 26 July. Has improved of late and cannot be ruled out from more success
7. **NELSON THORIS** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Class B at Pornichet-La-Baule over 2,750m on 13 August. Can contest the finish
8. **NATURALLY STAR** - Unreliable but was third in a Class B at Enghien over 2,875m on 10 August. Might play a minor role at very best
9. **NINJA DU PLESSIS** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class B at Enghien over 2,875m on 8 August. Clearly is not out of it
10. **NEVALE VET** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class B at Chatelaillon over 2,625m on 27 July. Has won 4 of 6 starts and can score again
11. **NISSA LA BELLA** - Finished fifth in a Group 2 at Enghien over 2,150m on 14 August. Unreliable but is capable of earning some money
12. **NOTTINGEN** - Usually competitive and was third in a Class A at Enghien over 2,875m on 25 July. Can get involved with the finish yet again

Summary: NEVALE VET (10) possesses plenty of ability and is likely to attract strong support on her first appearance at Vincennes. NOTTINGEN (12) is the main danger after finishing third in a decent field recently. NELSON THORIS (7) made a pleasing debut in harness racing and should improve for the experience. NINJA DU PLESSIS (9) was runner-up to a promising colt at Enghien last time and has the ability to shine.

C5 - PRIX DE BARBIZON - 2100m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 46,000

1. **LORIGRE** - Unplaced in a class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 12 August. Has struggled of late and more is needed to score
2. **LOLA DU CAMPUS** - Unplaced in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 12 August. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
3. **LUGANO DE LOU** - Disqualified in his last three starts, the latest in a Class F at Plesse over 3,125m on 26 July. Reverts to barefoot and can score if smart
4. **LOVELY MILL** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class D at Le Mans over 2,200m on 13 July. Remains barefoot and is capable of following up
5. **LINOTTE DU MOUCHEL** - Consistent and was third in a Class D at Argentan over 2,150m on 8 August. Remains barefoot and could earn some more money
6. **LYANA D'ARC** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class D Apprentices' race at La Capelle over 1,800m on 7 July. Remains barefoot and could end a long losing run
7. **LUXE D'ERABLE** - Disqualified in a class D at Argentan over 2,150m on 8 August. Successful before that and is not out of it
8. **LEVEL ONE SYGA** - Finished third in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 12 August. Often competitive and could have a winning turn
9. **LADY DES ARRIS** - Finished third in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 10 August. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
10. **LAGUNE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class E at Argentan over 1,609m on 8 August. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal

Summary: LEVEL ONE SYGA (8) made an encouraging return to action at Enghien and has the potential to score. LUGANO DE LOU (3) is racing barefoot this time and should be respected. LUXE D'ERABLE (7) can be judged on his penultimate victory and also holds claims. LOVELY MILL (4) arrives on the back of a recent win at Le Mans and is another who should not be underestimated.

C6 - PRIX DE DIJON - 2100m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 49,000

1. **JUVAMINE RENARDIER** - Successful in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,150m on 23 July. Reverts to barefoot and could double up
2. **JOPLIN DES CROUAS** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2,875m on 28 July. Reverts to barefoot and might play a minor role
3. **KAISER DES GRANGES** - Finished 7th in a Class F at Laon over 2,875m on 1 August. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
4. **KAZAR** - Finished 6th in a Class F at Biarritz over 2,975m on 7 July. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance on best form
5. **KOPA D'ARC** - Finished fifth in a Class F at Le Touquet over 2,625m on 20 June. Capable of a bit better and can contest the finish
6. **KOUROUX** - Finished fourth in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,775m on 24 July. Remains barefoot and can get involved with the finish once again
7. **KISS ATOUT** - Disqualified in a Class F at Enghien over 2,150m on 29 July. Remains barefoot and is capable of bouncing back to score
8. **KISS ME DE NAVARY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class F at Laon over 2,875m on 1 August. Capable of earning some money if staying in stride
9. **IT'S CLASSIC ROCK** - Finished 6th in a Class F at Carentan over 2,875m on 15 August. Remains barefoot but more if needed to beat these rivals
10. **KALAMITY DE CHENU** - Came home 8th in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,725m on 7 August. Has only been modest of late and more is needed to score
11. **KENNEDY STREET** - Finished 6th in a class G at Sable-sur-Sarthe over 2,850m on 9 August. Remains barefoot but has only been modest of late and more is needed to score

Summary: KISS ATOUT (7) was quickly disqualified last time but has an excellent opportunity to make amends and gets the vote. KOPA D'ARC (5) is effective in all shoeing configurations and looks the main danger. The consistent KOUROUX (6) should also be involved with the finish. KAISER DES GRANGES (3) has claims on his best form,

C7 - PRIX DE JUSSEY - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 46,000

- 1. MOZART DES BORDES** - Disqualified in a Class E at Biarritz over 2,975m on 30 July. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 2. MALKO MESLOIS** - Finished fifth in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 25 July. Tries barefoot and can be a lively danger this time around
- 3. MY DREAM MESLOIS** - Finished third in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 25 July. Returned to form and is capable of making the frame
- 4. MAFIATIME DUCAMPUS** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the last time out in a Class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 8 March. Reverts to barefoot but could need this run returning from a break
- 5. MINOTOR D'ALOUETTE** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 16 July. Big chance in this line-up
- 6. MAZAR DE VANDEL** - Finished 8th in a Class D at Carentan over 2,875m on 15 August. Capable of doing better and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 7. MAJOR DE TIMM** - Came home 8th in a Class D at Royan-La Palmyre over 2,500m on 19 July. Remains barefoot and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. MALMO DE PUCH** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Class D at over this track and trip on 12 June. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
- 9. MONTJOIE** - Ultra-consistent of late and was runner-up in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 1 August. Should fight out the finish
- 10. MICHEL MARTIN** - Disqualified in a Class C at Enghien over 2,875m on 22 July, Remains barefoot and is capable of earning some money

Summary: MINOTOR D'ALOUETTE (5) is fitted with front shoes for the first time and has the potential to make a winning impression on his first start at the Vincennes main track. MONTJOIE (9) should benefit from lighter shoeing and looks a serious danger. MALMO DE PUCH (8) is barefoot behind for the first time and could also improve. Pierre Belloche's MALKO MESLOIS (2) is also capable of making the frame in an open looking race.

C8 - PRIX DE MORTAIN - 2850m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 68,000

- 1. HALTO MESSI** - Finished 7th in a Class F at Lignieres over 2,850m on 9 August. Remains barefoot and needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 2. HANUGAN** - In good form and finished third in a Class E at Argentan over 2,150m on 16 August. Capable of playing a minor role at very best
- 3. GENERAL DE CONNEE** - Finished 6th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 12 August. Remains barefoot but needs to do a bit more to score
- 4. HOLLYWOOD BOND** - Unplaced in a Class E at Sable Sur Sarthe over 2,825m on 9 August. Has struggled of late and others make more appeal
- 5. HERAKLION DESBOIS** - A good runner-up in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 12 August. Remains barefoot and could earn some more money
- 6. HANA D'OCCAGNES** - Finished third in a claimer at Enghien over 2,150m on 8 August. Remains barefoot but this is a tougher task. More is needed to score
- 7. GOLZAC DE REM** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a Class D at Amiens over 2,400m on 29 July. Remains barefoot and is capable of a surprise
- 8. HIPPARIS** - Finished 7th in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 17 August. Remains barefoot but is unreliable. Not out of it, though
- 9. HELIOS DJEMA** - Disqualified in a Class E at Sable-sur-Sarthe over 2,850m on 9 August. Remains barefoot but is on a long losing run and others make more appeal
- 10. FULL CASH DE PADD** - Finished 10th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,775m on 7 August. Remains barefoot but is off form and makes little appeal
- 11. FOREVER D'ARIANE** - Finished fifth in a Class D at Rochefort Sur Loire over 3,025m on 16 August. Unreliable but might play a minor role
- 12. GRAZIELA D'EL** - Finished 6th in a Class E at Sable-sur-Sarthe over 2,850m on 9 August. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to score
- 13. HENRIQUE** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 17 August. Good form at this track and could score again
- 14. HERMES D'ECROVILLE** - Finished 7th in a Class C at Chatelaillon-La-Rochelle over 2,500m on 27 July. Remains barefoot but has only been modest of late. Has a place chance
- 15. HENZO DE CARSI** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 17 August. Remains barefoot and can be competitive once again
- 16. HISTORIC DAY** - Holding form and was fourth in a Class B at Villereal over 3,325m on 8 August. Remains barefoot and can get into the frame
- 17. HEAD OF STATE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 12 August. Remains barefoot and can be a real threat to these rivals if smart
- 18. HOLD UP RANAIS** - Finished fifth in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 12 August. Reverts to barefoot and could get into the mix of things

Summary: HENRIQUE (13) arrives on the back of a strong effort at Cagnes-sur-Mer and, with his trainer reporting that he has lost none of his enthusiasm at home, looks a leading contender. He has also proven himself over this course and distance. He is reunited with Franck Nivard, who knows him well. HEAD OF STATE (17) can be inconsistent due to his tendency to struggle around the turns, but if he keeps things together he has the ability to make the podium. HENZO DE CARSI (15) finished alongside the selection on the French Riviera and, with Alexis Collette in the saddle, should again play a leading role, while trainer Jean-François Senet also expects HIPPARIS (8) to be competitive if enjoying a clear passage.
