C1 - PRIX TALICIA BELLA - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **MAGIE DES GLENAN** - Has done nothing noteworthy since winning a Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne in February and can be ruled out
2. **MELEUC DU DOUAROU** - Has not been seen out since finishing 8th in a Class F at Sable Sur Sarthe over 2,825m on 28 June. Shoes fitted and no threat
3. **MAYA DU LANDREAU** - Ran 2nd in a Class F at Châtelailon-La Rochelle in July before being disqualified in the other code at Vincennes early this month, and is not an obvious choice
4. **MAYA DE SEVRE** - Finished 3rd in a Class F at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 12 September. Is patently in form but in this company will have too much to do
5. **MAESTRO DELTO** - Returns to the harness code after losing his action in a 2775m monte Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne 3 weeks ago. Is confirmed in this branch of the business and with application can play a prominent role
6. **MAGNIFICA JOSSELYN** - Ran 4rd at Lucon before coming 2nd in a Pornichet Class F a month ago. Comes here fresh and in current form is hard to ignore
7. **MISTY DES CRIERES** - Placed in 3 on turf before being beaten in a Class F at Saint-Ouen-des-Toits 12 days ago and is biting off more than he can chew
8. **MARIO BELLO** - Unplaced, on comeback, in a Class E over course and distance on 10 September. Will have improved for the run and with shoes off this time will be no soft touch
9. **MASTER WINNER** - Made it 2 on the trot when scoring at Alencon 2.5 weeks ago. Competes on a hard surface for the first time but still looks a serious proposition
10. **MELODIA JOSSELYN** - Finished 7th in a Class E at Bernay over 2,800m on 13 September. Should not be too hastily-condemned though, has otherwise been in excellent shape, and can open her autumn account
11. **MIGNON DES MACE** - Out of the picture in last 2, most recently well-beaten in an Agon claimer, and has nothing to offer
12. **MADIBA DE BELLANDE** - Ran 3rd in a Cabourg Class E late last month but failed to confirm when pulled-up in a similar event last week and will first need to reassure
13. **MAESTRO D'OUVILLE** - Already twice a winner this year but out of the picture in 2 of last 3 and at this level will struggle to make his mark
14. **MUSTANG HAUFOR** - Barring a Pornichet sanction has been hard to fault since the spring, lastly 3rd in a Class F on turf 2.5 weeks ago, and can get in on the action
15. **MIGOVE DU CHARME** - Ran 4th in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E 2 weeks ago. Is currently on a productive run of form and can get a look in
16. **MILOU DE SALOMAX** - Finished 9th in a Class E over course and distance on 10 September. Is not short of ability though and, considering the entry, should not be overlooked

Summary: MELODIA JOSSELYN (10) was disappointing at Bernay but is reunited with Benjamin Rochard who has already scored twice with her. MASTER WINNER (9) arrives on the back of two pleasing wins on grass and will lead the opposition alongside MARIO BELLO (8), who is barefoot following his comeback run. MAESTRO DELTO (5) can be tricky, but there is no doubting his ability, and he looks marginally better than MAGNIFICA JOSSELYN (6) who has twice gone close recently.

C2 - PRIX TRIODE DE FELLIERE - 2050m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. LILYROSE WIND** - Surprise 2nd in a Class F at Les Andelys 11 days ago. Can prove something of a handful but will be re-shod and is worth keeping an eye on
- 2. LEELY DE BLARY** - Back under harness after being sanctioned in a monte Class F at Carentan on 11 July. Never the easiest to gauge but is competitively-shod, with the champion driver reining, and can play a leading role on her first start back
- 3. LADY DE BOUERE** - Finished 3rd in a Class E at Chatelaillon over 2,500m on 3 August. Is plainly close to winning another, however in this category looks more a minor place prospect
- 4. LUCRECE DE CORDAY** - Should not be too hastily-condemned for faulting in a monte Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne 3 weeks ago. Is barefoot this time and should be taken seriously
- 5. LAURENE DE BAILLY** - Unplaced in a Class E at Vincennes over 2,700m on 8 September. Has not made the frame for over a year and is not about to start now
- 6. LIKE THAT** - Easy winner of a 2700m Cagnes Class E on 19 August. New trainer in the bike this time and a repeat is not out of the question
- 7. LADY ANGELE** - Finished 9th, on comeback, in a Class E at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 12 September. Is barefoot for her first target of the autumn and will be expected to show improvement
- 8. LICORNVERASPERANZA** - Seldom gets her head in front but has been showing her form. Can be forgiven her recent disqualification and Benjamin Rochard can be justifiably confident of a big performance
- 9. LADY DU VALLON** - Rather disappointing since returning to competition in early-June. Goes barefoot this time but is unlikely to upset the status quo
- 10. LOUISIANE GIRL** - Quality mare making first appearance since winning a Class E over 2,650m here on 5 March. Shoes on and no danger
- 11. LASKOVA** - Third in a Class F at Les Andelys over 2,525m on 13 September. Consistently gives her best in both codes and, despite the draw, is unlikely to be far off the mark
- 12. LILI D'EVAILLES** - Surprise winner at Brehal on 3 August but failed to confirm 11 days ago when trounced in a Class F at Segre, and can be confidently passed over
- 13. LAVEZZI PEJI** - Finished 4th in a Class F at Lisieux over 2,725m on 29 August. Placed on her sole start here, but takes on a better bunch this time and chances limited
- 14. L'ILE D'HAUFOR** - Unplaced in a Class F over course and distance on 5 July. Has failed to make much of an impact since January 2025 and is unlikely to generate much interest
- 15. LISA MARIA** - Fifth in a Class F Apprentices' race at Erbray over 2,675m on 31 August, a month after having won an Amiens Class F. Shoes on this time though and best to keep one's powder dry

Summary: Narrowly beaten here on 11 June by a mare who has won twice since, LICORNVERASPERANZA (8) has a leading chance on paper. The better-positioned LIKE THAT (6) enjoyed a good Cagnes-sur-Mer campaign and debuts for her new connections with a lot to contribute. She may be capricious but LEELY DE BLARY (2) has buckets of ability, is shod to preference, and will be partnered by Eric Raffin for this favourable engagement. LUCRECE DE CORDAY (4) is ideally-placed behind the car and will have her chances.

C3 - PRIX ROYAL DREAM - 2050m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 24,000

1. **LOUSTIC DE DALINE** - Fourth in a Class F over course and distance on 4 September. Excels on turf, but seldom disappoints on a dirt track, and will have his supporters
2. **LONDON JONES** - It took almost 2.5 years years but got back to winning ways 2 weeks ago when comfortably winning a Class E over course and distance, and in similar form could well repeat
3. **LE GRISBI** - Imposed on turf in early-August, just under a month before coming 2nd in a Class F under these conditions on 4 September, and with Eric Raffin reining this time should not be underestimated
4. **LEONARDO** - Has not excelled this year but ran decent 5th in a Cabourg monte Class E on 18 August. Anthony Barrier in the bike this time and from the 4 slot can make his presence felt
5. **LEONARD DE VINCI** - Never far from losing his action but can trot. David Thomain back in the bike, is ideally-placed in front and, barefoot for the occasion, can give this a good go
6. **LE CONCORDE** - Excellent servant that ran second in an Agon Class F on 16 August, just his second start back. Is clearly close to his race and is easy to like for the win
7. **LOUSTIC D'YVEL** - Disqualified in a Claimer at Vincennes over 2,100m on 2 June. Has not been seen since and has no possible chance
8. **LE ROCKER DE PLAY** - Finished 5th in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,850m on 10 September. Is plainly in decent shape but would be preferred at a lower level
9. **LOUVIERS** - Has been rather disappointing since placing at Chartres 3 months ago. Is not devoid of ability though and, despite a second-row draw, can play a small role
10. **LE GOLDEN PHYT'S** - Finished 8th in a Class F at Landivisiau over 2,600m on 6 September. Has been out of sorts for some time and will have little to contribute
11. **LABRAX DU SKY** - Serious trotter in the other code. Is here for reasons of conditioning and can be confidently disregarded
12. **LATINO BELLO** - Rewarded with success in a Class F at Cabourg over 2,050m on 14 August. Sports 4 pads once more and, despite the draw, should prove competitive when it counts
13. **LEWIS GO** - Ran 3rd at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 26 August but was unable to confirm when sixth in a class E under these conditions a fortnight ago and can be passed over

Summary: LE CONCORDE (6) is only ever asked to race when the conditions are right. Superbly-engaged and partnered by Alexis Collette for the occasion, he should not disappoint. LONDON JONES (2), in top form, LE GRISBI (3), barefoot and reunited with Eric Raffin, and LATINO BELLO (12), a convincing winner when sporting pads for the first time, are serious contenders.

C4 - PRIX TRANSGOURMET - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 35,000

1. **KAPITANO DE SOURCE** - Ran 6th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,850m on 5 September. Is not without merit but is still not an obvious choice this time around
2. **KANSAS DU HOCTI** - Finished 3rd in a monte Class E at Angers over 3,125m on 9 September. Is here for a change of scenery and can be ignored
3. **EXPRESS D'ARC** - Improved on Cabourg run when 3rd in a Vincennes Class C on 5 September. Is new to the venue but takes a dip in category and can pick up another cheque
4. **KNOCKONWOOD** - Showed promise during the summer but disqualified in last 2, most recently a Class D under these conditions late last month, and can be passed over
5. **KAISER** - Did not enjoy the best of trips when 6th in a Chateaubriant Class E 11 days ago. Is clearly in fine condition and will be reunited with Franck Nivard for the occasion. Place chance
6. **IENISSE DE BARBRAY** - Finished 3rd in a Class D at Hyeres over 2,650m on 12 July. Has not been seen out since and with shoes fitted is unlikely too influence the outcome
7. **EVERY TIME WINNER** - Finished 6th in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,750m on 21 August, after having run 2nd at La Rochelle the previous month. Will be reunited with Eric Raffin who will be keen to put things right
8. **KING DE L'OUEST** - Finished 4th in a Group III at Craon over 2,775m on 7 September. Is as good on dirt as he is on turf and recent results bode well for his prospects
9. **GRAZIELA D'EL** - Has been a complete write-off in both disciplines all year and is not about to spring any surprises
10. **JAMAICA PHEDO** - Third in a Class D at Laval over 2,850m on 10 September, her first appearance since early-June. Is shod to preference this time and, already twice a winner here this year, should not be overlooked
11. **ILMAT DES KECHES** - Disappointing on the whole since returning to competition in June and must first get his house in order
12. **JOLYDOLE** - Quality individual that got back in the winners' circle at Sable-sur-Sarthe in early-August. Tends to go well for Matthieu Abrivard and can again finish close
13. **HINDEN** - Fifth in a Class D Amateurs' race at Vichy over 4,275m on 12 September. Takes on a considerably better lot here and will have nothing to contribute
14. **KOUREAS D'ELA** - Was made to work for it but secured the hat-trick when clinching a Feurs Class B 2.5 weeks ago. Has already won eight times this year, enjoys a good entry, and connections will be anticipating a ninth success
15. **IMOKO JIBELAU** - Has done nothing of note in 10 starts so far this year and can be dismissed
16. **INVISIBLE SAM** - Ran 7th in a Class D at Marseille-Borely over 2,300m on 27 August. Is some way off his best form and is not a priority

Summary: Like a horse reborn in 2026, KOUREAS D'ELA (14) ran out a tough winner at Feurs last time, getting the better of the excellent Karambar. In this less-exalted company, she will be a tough nut to crack. KING DE L'OUEST (8) was unsuited by the lack of pace at Craon and has a strong chance under these conditions, as does the reconfigured JOLYDOLE (12) who has a particular liking for Laval. Considerably better than his latest result would suggest, KAISER (5) races shod this time but can still set the record straight. EXPRESS D'ARC (3) gave a fine account in Paris recently and warrants respect.

C5 - PRIX SPEEDY BLUE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. KHALIFE DELALANDE** - Finished 3rd in a Class F at Castera-Verduzan over 2,800m on 10 August. Embarks on a tougher mission this time and chances appear slim
- 2. KISS ME** - Third in a Class E at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 12 September. Is unlikely to lose his maiden tag here but is a useful sort and cannot be discounted
- 3. KARNAC D'ALCI** - Consistently performant individual coming to Laval on a hat-trick, most recently winning a Tours Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Stays shod this time but still looks capable of finishing in the mix
- 4. KRONO DU TRIO** - Serious element that goes well for Gilles d'Haenens, lastly winning a Bernay Class F here 11 days ago, and is well-placed to repeat
- 5. KOCKTAIL WOOD** - Made amends for Enghien blip when 4th in a 2000m Divonne Class F on 20 August. Is well-positioned in front but represents a minor place chance at best
- 6. KATSUKI** - Second in 2 straight last month before being disqualified in an Erbray Class H 3.5 weeks ago. Has no references here but in current condition is easy to recommend for a place in the frame
- 7. KELYO DU SOLNAN** - Finished 5th in a Class E at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 12 September. Appears to be back on track and, with form maintained, can repeat
- 8. KAYNE RICHER** - Serious element with a particular liking for the turf. Was most unfortunate at Craon and can make amends if kept out of harm's way
- 9. KOH I NOOR** - Surprise winner at Meslay-du-Maine in July but failed to confirm when well-beaten in a Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 21 August and can be passed over
- 10. KRONOS MADRIK** - Fourth in a Class F at Divonne over 2,675m on 20 August, 17 days after opening his 2026 account, but in this company will have his work cut out
- 11. KUROKO LAUAR** - Made up for a pair of clinkers when 3rd in a Vincennes Class E 3 weeks ago but is in conditioning-mode this time and best to hold off
- 12. KYSKO DE FAEL** - Finished 4th in a Class H at Chateauroux over 2,900m on 13 September. Consistently gives a competitive account of himself and looks main danger to KRONO DU TRIO (4)
- 13. KARMA TEJY** - Lost his way after running second in a Cherbourg Class D in June and has shown no sign of an imminent return to form

Summary: Ideally-entered at just €605 from the limit of earnings, and drawn four behind the car, KRONO DU TRIO (4) has plenty going for him. KYSKO DE FAEL (12) has been knocking at the door, has form here, and should again finish thereabouts. KAYNE RICHER (8) was very unlucky at Craon and, despite his wide draw, is worth another chance. KATSUKI (6) sports pads this time but is still a contender.

C6 - PRIX CREDIT MUTUEL - 2050m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 15,000

1. **ODIN DE BUSSET** - Has yet to show much on the track but is well-regarded at home. Breaks in front and should not be discounted
2. **ONDINE FRANCE** - Disqualified on debut in a Class F at Bernay over 2,300m on 26 July. Starts for the first time since then and is not about to shake things up
3. **OPTIMISTA** - Untried filly from a productive family. Set off no fireworks in last week's qualification but looks a serious future prospect and can get straight down to business
4. **OSKAYA** - Makes career debut after qualifying in 1'18"6 at Cabourg on 27 August. Is not a priority but looks good enough to hold her own
5. **OXFORD D'ERONVILLE** - Racecourse debutant from a yard with excellent form with younger horses. Qualified in 1'19"8 at Le Mans on 22 July and it would be no surprise to see him finish close
6. **ONIRIQUE** - Disqualified on debut in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 18 July. Has not been seen out since and chances appear somewhat limited
7. **OURAGANE JENILOU** - Left a good impression in July qualification when posting 1'17"8 and, if as good in competition, will be no pushover
8. **OASIS DREAM** - Qualified in 1'19"6 at Caen on 20 May. Hails from a decent maternal line and despite the draw should have a lot to offer
9. **OLISKA BERRY** - Qualified modestly at Cordemais on 17 June, posting 1'20"8, and can expect to have few takers
10. **OPIO DE LA VALLEE** - Qualified over 2000m here on 8 September, posting 1'19"6. Is unlikely to create an upset but, considering the yard he comes from, should not be ignored
11. **OBAMI** - Posted unexceptional 1'20"2 in qualification but is a well-bred colt and can be considered a decent foundation for this race
12. **OLGA SOLO** - Qualified in 1'18"8 here on 26 May. Has had time to be brought on and with Alexis Collette in the bike, clearly means business
13. **ONE TWELVE** - Qualified in 1'19"1 over 2000m here on 26 May. Has been given ample time to come into herself but faces a tough test first time out
14. **OMAHA JENILOU** - Qualified in 1'19"9 at Caen on 6 August. Takes on a tough bunch first time out and others easier to back

Summary: Niece of champion Love You, **OPTIMISTA** (3) is the obvious attraction and is entrusted to Benjamin Rochard for her much-awaited racecourse debut. **OBAMI** (11) hails from one of the best nurseries on the continent and will also attract plenty of attention. Nicely-related, **OXFORD D'ERONVILLE** (5) will be justifiably well-supported, and **OASIS DREAM** (8), a granddaughter of the excellent Ustie Love, are unlikely to lack supporters.

C7 - PRIX BIRD PARKER - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. NEWBELL DE HOUELLE** - Has not been seen out since finishing 4th in a Class D at La Capelle over 2,750m on 3 May. Is a useful filly though and is not incapable of finishing in the mix
- 2. NYMPHE DAXEL** - Easy winner on debut before losing her action in a Pornichet Class E on 20 August. Comes here fresh and can make a big splash if her handler manages to keep her focused
- 3. NORA D'OLMEN** - Got off the mark in a Brehal Class H on 3 August but was unable to confirm on 5 September when disqualified in an Amiens Class F, and can be passed over
- 4. NIKITA DUAL** - Ran reassuring 2nd in a Pornichet Class F a month ago. Eric Raffin stays faithful and will be justifiably confident of a big run
- 5. NATCHA DES ARRIS** - Made amends for Francheville clinker when running 3rd in a Class F over course and distance earlier in the month and with front pads fitted should not be underestimated
- 6. NISKAYA** - Ran fourth in a Class G over course and distance last month, then won an Alencon Class F 2.5 weeks ago, however confirmation seems most improbable
- 7. NOVA DU BOURG** - Lost her maiden tag in a Montignac Class F early last month but faces a significantly tougher test this time around
- 8. NATURAL CASTELETS** - Should not be too quickly-judged for faulting in a Cabourg Class E last week. Has otherwise demonstrated decent aptitude and can get in on the action
- 9. NEOUVIELLE** - Sprang quite the surprise to win at Brehal in July but was subsequently well-beaten a month later in a Pornichet Class E and can expect to have few friends
- 10. NYMPHE DE CANCHY** - 3rd in a Rambouillet Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Has yet to deliver on a hard surface though and others preferred
- 11. NOMONEYNOHONEY** - Has done little of note since winning an Alencon Class F in late-June and can be ruled out
- 12. NEFLE D'ERABLE** - Handy filly that ran 3rd in a Class F at Avranches early last month. In marginally better company this time but the addition of front pads will do her chances no disservice
- 13. NINA MINIGNA** - Well-campaigned filly that has produced the goods just the once and latest results tell an unfavourable story
- 14. NYMPHE DE PIERRAIS** - Got off the mark in a Class F at Alencon over 2,650m on 6 September. Is confirmed under the saddle at Laval and returns to the venue with every chance of imposing
- 15. NIMOSA** - Runner-up in a Class F at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,775m on 12 September. Is plainly back on the right road and can contest a place in the frame
- 16. NOISETTE MIKA** - Is just 5 Euros from elimination but has made little impact since February and will have nothing to bring to the party

Summary: A particularly open race in which NYMPHE DE PIERRAIS (14) returns to racing with pads after opening her account on turf earlier in the month. NYMPHE DAXEL (2) would have finished close last time had she not blundered and Matthieu Abrivard will be back at the helm. NIKITA DUAL (4), narrowly beaten at Pornichet last month, and NIMOSA (15), in good form and ideally-entered, can also harbour hopes of a podium finish. NATCHA DES ARRIS (5) got back in the game here 3 weeks ago and will sport front pads for the occasion.

C8 - PRIX SCIPION DU GOUTIER - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Mounted - EUR € 18,000

- 1. NARIO MESLINOIS** - Makes first public appearance since qualifying in 1'19 at Meslay-du-Maine on 12 August and more established elements are easier to back
- 2. NEE BELLE LOMIG** - Career debutante that qualified in 1'19'6 at Meslay-du-Maine on 3 July and in this company is not about to spice things up
- 3. NOUGAT ALDO** - Untried gelding that qualified in 1'20 at Meslay-du-Maine on 19 June and is not an obvious choice first time out
- 4. NELSON D'ARIANE** - Finished last of 5 in a Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 21 August and appears to have no realistic chance
- 5. NINOUSKA** - Disqualified on monte bow 3 weeks ago in a Class E over course and distance. Takes on some more established horses and is not about to influence the result
- 6. NAOS VIVROT** - Ran 3rd at Cabourg on 18 August but failed to confirm when disqualified at Chateaubriant 11 days ago. Sports front pads this time though and cannot be discounted
- 7. NYTRO GO ON** - Has not been seen out since finishing 4th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,200m on 26 December 2025. Has 4 pads fitted for the first time but is still not a concern
- 8. NOSCAVIVA LUDOISE** - Returns to racing with pads after being disqualified in a 2650m Alencon Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Looks better on a hard surface and should not be written off
- 9. NIKITA DU NOYER** - Made up for debut disqualification when 2nd in an Auch Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Is competitively-shod for the first time and the engagement of Jean-Yann Ricart says it all. First five
- 10. NATSUMI QUEEN** - Fifth in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,175m on 8 September. Faces a less-difficult task here and, if applied, can contest the finish
- 11. NOSTALGIA QUICK** - Has placed just once in nine starts under the saddle and current form does nothing to inspire confidence
- 12. NUMBER FOUR** - In the frame in 2 last month, lastly 3rd in a Carentan harness Class F on 15 August, and with Guillaume Martin in the saddle can play a leading role
- 13. NUIT TRANSEENNE** - Has been acquitting herself respectably under the saddle but will need to improve on recent Chateaubriant performance
- 14. NEMEKITEPAS FORGAN** - Excellent runner-up in a Class F at Caen over 2,450m on 22 June. Is plainly an improving filly and should have the wherewithal to win this
- 15. NUIT CLASSIC** - Has acquitted herself decently under harness here over recent weeks. Alexandre Angot aboard for monte bow but still represents no more than a minor place chance
- 16. NUIT DU RANCH** - Spirited element making monte debut after running 5th in a Rambouillet Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Alexis Collette in the irons for the occasion and can figure prominently
- 17. NOBLE DU SURF** - Finished 11th in a harness Class E at Pornichet over 2,725m on 19 September and debuts in the discipline with little to no hope
- 18. NE M'ATTENDS PAS** - Disqualified in a Vincennes harness Class C last week but nevertheless showed his form. Is reconfigured for monte debut and could pleasantly surprise

Summary: A very open race. NEMEKITEPAS FORGAN (14) has shown considerable promise and, although unraced since June, she may just prove the horse to beat. The complicated NATSUMI QUEEN (10) showed at Vincennes recently that she has plenty of ability and will be sporting hind pads for the first time. NUMBER FOUR (12) has shown a touch of quality under harness and will have his chances if ability transitions. NE M'ATTENDS PAS (18) is not the easiest of horses to use but is not devoid of talent and, with front pads fitted for the first time, can put in a good showing. Sporting 4 pads on this occasion, the lightly-raced NIKITA DU NOYER (9) looks a player.
