

R6 CAGNES-SUR-MER [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DE SAINT-CEZAIRE - 2925m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 43,000

- 1. JASMIN BLEU** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 20 July. Not reliable but is capable of bouncing back with another victory
- 2. IGGY FAFA** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a Class E over this track and trip on 20 July. Capable of earning some money
- 3. GAROU LIONNAIS** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E Apprentices' race at this track over 2,150m on 10 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 4. JAURESS DE CANI** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E over this course and distance on 20 July. More is needed to score
- 5. JALAPENO** - Successful in a Class F at Avignon over 2,650m on 21 June . Has won three times this year and can score again
- 6. HERODE DU CORTA** - Disqualified last time out in a Class B at Hyeres over 2,650m on 5 July. In very good form before that and is a real threat if staying in stride
- 7. GOLDEN VISAIS** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in a Class C over this track and trip on 20 July. Might play a minor role at very best
- 8. HELLO PANAME** - Excellent runner-up in a Class B at Hyeres over 2,650m on 5 July. Showed improvement that day and can be a threat once again
- 9. IRON DU GERS** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class B at this track over 2,925m on 13 July. Can go one place better

Summary: Runner-up last time in stronger company, IRON DU GERS (9) brings the standout form to this contest and rates as the one to beat despite his 25-metre handicap. Back in peak condition, HELLO PANAME (8) shapes as his chief rival. JALAPENO (5) and JASMIN BLEU (1) will look to make full use of their 25-metre head start and could prove difficult to reel in if allowed to dictate the race.

C2 - PRIX DE LIGURIE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 29,000

1. **LA SPEZIA DE LOU** - Unreliable and finished 15th in a Class E at this track over 2,925m on 6 July. Capable of an upset on best form
2. **LAMATTA** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 11 July. Capable of getting into the mix of things once again
3. **LOTHBROCK** - Disqualified at Enghien on 12 July. Capable of better and could surprise if stayin on the tro all the way through
4. **LIVINIO FLAC** - Finished 9th in a Class C at Enghien over 2,150m on 13 March. Returns from a break but is solid at this course and could score if fit enough
5. **LOOKING SIXTY ONE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class C at Marseille-Borely over 2,300m on 24 June. Might need to do a bit more to score
6. **L'AVENIR** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 8th in a Class E at Eauze over 3,025m on 7 June . Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
7. **LIBERTY PAT** - Finished 9th in a class E at this track over 2,925m on 6 July. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
8. **LONDON RECALL** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a class D at this track over 2,925m on 13 July. Can go one place better
9. **LAVAMA** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class D at Marseille- Vivaux over 2,650m on 13 June. Might need to do more to score this time
10. **LADY DU CHENE** - Made short work of rivals in a Class E at this course over 2,925m on 6 July. Not easy to trust but might follow up this shorter distance

Summary: The talented LIVINIO FLAC (4) makes his return from a break but is expected to be ready to fire first-up, with connections expressing strong confidence. Ideally drawn behind the autostart, he gets the nod ahead of LONDON RECALL (8), who races barefoot for this assignment, and LADY DU CHENE (10), who steps up in class after an eye-catching recent success. LAMATTA (2) may lack the credentials of the leading trio but has the consistency to remain competitive and should be poised to capitalize if the principals fail to deliver.

C3 - PRIX DE LA SIAGNE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **KENZO DU MONT** - Finished 4th in a class D at this track over 2925m on 14 August 2025. Returns from a lengthy break and could need this run
2. **KEROZEN** - Off form and finished 10th in a class D at Feurs over 2850m on 12 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
3. **KYLLIAN** - Did not show his best when 10th in a Class F at this course over 2,700m on 17 July. Quite capable of bouncing back to score
4. **KALAGA DU CADRAN** - Very consistent and was third in a class F at this track over 2,925m on 10 July. Can be rewarded for that consistency with success
5. **KANSAS DE CASTELLE** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class D at Hyeres over 2,650m on 5 July. Can get involved with the finish once again
6. **KALGARY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track on 10 July. Hard to trust but can make the frame when smart
7. **KOUGAR DE SIMM** - Finished 10th in a Class F at this track over 2,925m on 10 July. Clearly capable of better and has a place chance
8. **KERNEL DE NUIT** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a Class F Apprentices' race at Hyeres over 2,650m on 5 July. Capable of scoring when in the right mood
9. **KHERMES D'URZY** - Unreliable but was third in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3,000m on 19 June. Might play a minor role at very best

Summary: KALAGA DU CADRAN (4) boasts an excellent record on the French Riviera and made an encouraging return to competition last time out. Barring any major incident, she should be right in the thick of the finish. KANSAS DE CASTELLE (5), who is invariably competitive when staying faultless, and KYLLIAN (3), who races barefoot on this occasion, look set to provide the strongest opposition. KOUGAR DE SIMM (7) appeals as the value outsider of the race and is capable of outrunning his odds.

C4 - PRIX LOYD DORE - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. MILLESIME STAR** - Finished 5th in a Class E at this track over 2,150m on 17 July. Showed improvement that day but does need to do more to beat these rivals
- 2. MINK BOKO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Enghien on 9 July. In good form before that and could be a lively danger if staying in stride
- 3. MAESTRO CASTELETS** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a Class E at this track over 2,150m on 17 July. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of scoring
- 4. MILLESIME DI VIN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Carentan on 11 July. Not easy to trust but does have a place chance in this line-up
- 5. MADGIC STRYCK** - Successful in a Class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 12 July. attempting a hat-trick and must be respected for that
- 6. MIGUEL DU CHERISAY** - Disqualified at this track over 2150m on 10 July. Battling to find best form needs to find a few lengths to score
- 7. MILLER DU VIVIER** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class E over this track and trip on 6 July. Capable of playing a minor role
- 8. MANGO CASTELETS** - Disqualified at this track on 10 July. Clearly capable of better and can bounce back and beat these rivals
- 9. MOONLIGHT DU RHIN** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Clairefontaine-Deauville on 13 July. Hard to trust but is a threat when smart
- 10. MYSTERE TURGOT** - Outclassed the opposition in a class D at Marseille Vivaux over 2,650m on 13 June. Has a chance at completing a hat-trick

Summary: This looks a wide-open contest. MANGO CASTELETS (8) made a very favourable impression during the winter campaign and is best forgiven his latest disqualification. He gets a narrow vote to come out on top. MYSTERE TURGOT (10) continues to progress and is ideally placed under the race conditions, making him a major player. MOONLIGHT DU RHIN (9) has the ability to feature prominently if he can remain faultless throughout. MADGIC STRYCK (5) has been in good spirit since joining the stable of David Cinier and commands plenty of respect.

C5 - PRIX DES FRAISIERS - 2925m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. MILADY CYNASOSO - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out at Julliangues over 2450m on 14 July. Hard to trust and others are preferred

2. MONA LISA GEDE - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Montmirail over 3,200m on 12 July. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

3. MONEY AIMEF - Finished 5th in a Class E at Biarritz over 2,150m on 16 July. Showed some improvement that day but this is a tougher task. Might place

4. MAMZELLE CARLESS - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E over thsi course and distance on 8 July. More is needed to score

5. MUSE DU VALLON - In very good shape and finished 3rd in a Class E at Hyeres over 2,650m on 12 July. Can get involved with the finish yet again

6. MISS MARGOT - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class E over thsi course and distance on 8 July. Has a place chance in this line-up

7. MY LADY PRINCESS - Successful in three of last four starts, including last time out in a Class E at this course over 2,150m on 17 July. Can win again

8. MACHA DE CAHOT - Made short work of rivals in a Class E at Hyeres over 2,650m on 12 July. In good form and is quite capable of doubling up

9. MA COPINE FLAC - Holding form and finished fourth in Class D at this course over 2150m on 10 July. Has claims in this line-up

Summary: MA COPINE FLAC (9) finds here a golden opportunity under ideal race conditions, taking on fillies and mares only, and shapes as the banker of the card. MACHA DE CAHOT (8) and MUSE DU VALLON (5) both come here off strong performances in the same race at Hyères and look the most likely to test the Christophe de Groote-trained favourite. MY LADY PRINCESS (7) possesses plenty of natural speed and has the ability to make her presence felt. She commands considerable respect.

C6 - PRIX DE SALERNES - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. NIDZA DE REVE D'OR** - Finished fourth on debut in a Class F at Lignieres over 2,100m on 12 July. Finished well that day and could be ready to score
- 2. NEED TO ENJOY** - Finished 5th in a Class G at this track over 2,925m on 17 July. Drops in distance but is clearly not out of it
- 3. NUN WARRIOR** - Fifth in a Class F at Saint Malo over 2,950m on 9 July. Not disgraced that day and can contest the finish
- 4. NEMROD GEDE** - Disqualified last time out in a Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2,050m on 19 January. Did betetr at this track on debut and could be a threat if fit enough from a break
- 5. NELSON DE GUELLE** - Finished fifth on debut in a Class F over this track and trip on 6 July. Capable of improvement and has a place chance
- 6. NEMELIOS JIEL** - Disqualified last time out in Class G at this course over 2925m on 22 July. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 7. NIKOS EXPRESS** - Has not shown much in two starts, the latest when 6th in Class F at Hyeres over 2850m on 12 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. NINO DU CAP** - Finished 7th in a Class F at this course over 2,700m on 15 July. Has not shown much so far and others make more appeal
- 9. NOVEL DU MONT** - A three-year-old gelding by Earl Simon out of Dream Perle who is making his debut. His Dam never raced in France. Qualified in a good time and is not out of it
- 10. NARSEO** - Disqualified in both starts, the latest in Class F at this course over 2700m on 15 July. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 11. NELSON D'HERMES** - A three-year-old gelding by Fairplay d'Urzy out of Viva du Loisirn who is making his debut. His Dam never raced in France. Could need this experience
- 12. NOMADO** - Finished 9th in a Class F at this course over 2,700m on 15 July. Needs to do a bit more to score

Summary: NIDZA DE REVE D'OR (1) posted a promising debut run at Lignières with a strong late burst and is racing barefoot for the first time. With natural improvement expected, she looks capable of taking another step forward to get off the mark. Highly rated by his connections, NUN WARRIOR (3) also caught the eye with a strong finishing effort on her latest outing and is expected to play a leading role. NOVEL DU MONT (9) qualified well in Italy and rates as a solid contender in this line-up. NEMROD GEDE (4) merits consideration despite returning from a layoff.

C7 - PRIX DE SAINT VALLIER - 2150m (a1m1/4) - - Harness - EUR € 8,000

- 1. KRUNCH BOCNEUF** - Disqualifeid three times in a row, the latest in Class F at Jullouville-les-Pins over 2700m on 17 May. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. JOLIE COSTARDIERE** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class H Amateurs' race at Avignon over 2,650m on 21 June. Successful in three of last four starts and can score again
- 3. JOLLY LOOK** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Class G Amateurs' race at Saint-Galmier over 2,650m on 28 June. Capable of contesting the finish
- 4. JUMPER** - Has some fair form and finished fifth at Mons over 2,840m on 9 April. Returns from a break but does well for this driver and is not out of it
- 5. JURDIG LESMELCHEN** - Disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 10 July. Hard to trust but can make the frame when smart
- 6. KAP PAASLOO** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2000m on 21 July. Not easy to trust but can score when smart
- 7. INUITS D'EM** - Finished 7th in a Class G Apprentices' race at Marseille-Borely over 3,000m on 19 June. Has only been moderate of late and more is needed to score
- 8. JERELDA** - Disqualified last time out at this course over 2925m on 15 July. Battling to find best form and makes little appeal
- 9. IDAHODARCHE** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class G Amateurs' race at Carpentras over 2,675m on 14 July. can play a minor role
- 10. KYOSHIRO** - Has struggled of late, finishing 7th in a Class F Apprentices' race at this course over 2,700m on 13 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 11. KING GIORGIO** - Has soe fair form and was not disgraced when fifth in a Class H at Avignon over 2,650m on 4 July. Might play a minor role
- 12. JUNINHO SPORT** - Disqualified last time out in Class G over this course and distance on 17 July. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 13. JOIE DU GUELIER** - Finished 8th in a Class G Amateurs' race at Hyeres over 2,850m on 12 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 14. KLASSIC DE SYVA** - Not disgraced when third in a Class F at Hyeres over 2,650m on 12 July. Has a place chance this course and distance

Summary: KAP PAASLOO (6) sets the standard on the back of his impressive success over this very course on July 10. If reproducing that level of form, he will take all the beating. JOLIE COSTARDIERE (2) switches drivers but has the credentials to play a leading role in this grade and should be involved in the finish. JUMPER (4) heads into the race with tplenty of backup from his connections. KING GIORGIO (11) appeals as an attractive outsider, judged on his best efforts, and can spring a surprise if recapturing his best form.
