C1 - PRIX DE LA CELLE-SAINT-CLOUD - 2875m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- 1. FEDORA KEY COL** - Disappointing of late and was unplaced in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 June. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 2. LINAYA DU CHATELET** - In good shape and was fourth in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 22 June. Capable of making the frame
- 3. LISBETH DRY** - Did not show her best when 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 June. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 4. LUNA KALOUMA** - Showed some improvement when third in Class F at Les Andelys over 2525m on 5 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 5. LUTECE D'OUVILLE** - Hinted at a return to form when 5th in Class E at Lisieux over 2675m on 15 July. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 6. LADY DRY** - Successful last time out in Class F at Pornichet over 2725m on 18 July. Unreliable but is capable of doubling up
- 7. LIGNE BLANCHE** - Faulted last time out in a mounted race at this course over 2250m on 29 June. Capable of an upset on best form
- 8. LUMIERE DE BAILLE** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Cherbourg over 2625m on 24 June. Can complete the hat-trick
- 9. LARAFLE PASMARICK** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 8th in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 10 July. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 10. LUCRECE DE CORDAY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Segré over 2700m on 19 July. Hard to trust but is capable of scoring
- 11. LAURENE DE BAILLY** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, the latest in Class E at La Capelle over 2700m on 20 July. Might play a minor role if staying in stride

Summary: LUMIERE DE BAILLE (8) has been progressing impressively and appears capable of extending her upward trajectory. LADY DRY (6) boasts a similarly progressive profile and rates as the principal threat to the selection. LUCRECE DE CORDAY (10) has the talent to play a leading role provided she remains faultless throughout. LISBETH DRY (3) commands respect if she can maintain her stride in the closing stages, while LIGNE BLANCHE (7) is expected to appreciate a return to her preferred discipline.

C2 - PRIX DU ROULE - 2875m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 62,000

- 1. NEW YORK D'OYSE** - Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when fifth in Class C at this track over 2150m on 11 July. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. NIKITA DU MOUTHIEU** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 June. A good winner before that and must be respected in this line-up
- 3. NOTTINGEN** - Disqualified last time out in a Group 3 at this course over 1609m on 18 July. Consistent before that and could make the frame
- 4. NALIANO D'ECHAL** - Successful in three of his last four starts, including last time out in Class C over this course and distance on 1 July. Can complete the hat-trick
- 5. NISSA LA BELLA** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class C at this course over 2150m on 18 July. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 6. NO MAN'S LAND** - Victorious in three of his four starts so far, including last time out in Class B over this course and distance on 16 June. Has claims in this line-up
- 7. NOBEL VENESI** - Did not show his best when 9th in a Group 2 at Vincennes over 2700m on 13 December. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 8. NICE TO SEE YOU** - Did not show his best when 11th in a Group 3 at this course over 2150m on 4 July. Has ability and can make the frame when smart
- 9. NESPERA** - In good shape and was fourth in a Group 2 mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 20 March. Could need this run returning from a break
- 10. NEREIDA** - Disqualified last time out in a Group 1 mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 June. Not reliable but cannot be completely ruled out
- 11. NIKY ELDE** - - Finished 9th in a Group 3 at this course over 2150m on 4 July. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 12. NAVY SEAL** - Successful in half of his six starts so far, including the latest in Class B at Vichy over 2950m on 18 June. Can score again
- 13. NYASSA DAXEL** - Much improved this year and was runner-up in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 June. Can get involved in the finish once again

Summary: The progressive NO MAN'S LAND (6) and NALIANO D'ECHAL (4) both recorded impressive victories over this course last time out and look set to renew their rivalry for top honours. NAVY SEAL (12) is another with significant scope for improvement and has the ability to make life difficult for the leading pair. Among the fillies, the ultra-consistent NYASSA DAXEL (13) and NIKITA DU MOUTHIEU (2), who races with front shoes removed, have the ability to make their presence felt.

- 1. MILLIUM QUESNOT** - Disqualified last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 4 July. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 2. MARCUS BERRY** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class D over this track and trip on 4 July. Has a place chance on best form
- 3. MYSTERE CERIZE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class D at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. Successful before that and could earn some money
- 4. MALKO MESLOIS** - Holding form and finished third in Class E at this course over 2875m on 9 July. Capable of winning a race of this nature
- 5. MISTER YELLOW** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class D over this course and distance on 4 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. MISTER CARNOIS** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D over this course and distance on 23 June. Better under the saddle but is not out of it
- 7. MISTRAL POURPRIX** - Has improved of late and was fourth in Class D over this course and distance on 4 July. Can contest the finish
- 8. MOZART DE L'ITON** - Did not show his best when 8th in Class D at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 11 July. Consistent before that and could make the frame
- 9. MALIGNO** - Not reliable and was 7th in Class D at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2900m on 13 July. Not easy to trust but is capable of scoring when at his best
- 10. MOJITO DE BANVILLE** - In good shape and was third in Class D over this track and trip on 4 July. Has a place chance in this line-u
- 11. MUST DE VILLARD** - Successful last time out in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 5 July. Showed improvement and could be a threat over this shorter distance
- 12. MY DREAM MESLOIS** - Disqualified last time out at Clairefontaine-Deauville over 2900m on 13 July. Has disqualification issues but could make the frame when smart
- 13. MISTER MOUROTAIS** - Successful last time out in Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 17 June. Not reliable but is capable of following up

Summary: This is a wide open contest. Partnered by a driver currently enjoying an excellent run of form, MALKO MESLOIS (4) could well get his head in front and is given a tentative vote. However, he faces plenty of challenges, notably with MISTER MOUROTAIS (13) who comes in the race on the back of a recent cosy success, MISTRAL POURPRIX (7) who is the pick of the lot for top-driver Éric Raffin, and MUST DE VILLARD (11), a sound winner of his comeback run.

- 1. LOYAL DU CHOQUEL** - Not reliable and was unplaced in a Class B at this course over 2,875m on 13 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. FORCE OF NATURE** - Disqualified last time out in Class C over this track and trip on 11 July. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
- 3. LINNA DE VANDEL** - Has been disqualified in 3 consecutive starts, the latest in a Class C at Enghien over 2,150m on 26 June. Capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 4. LEADERBOARD** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class C over this course and distance on 26 June. Capable of better and has claims in this line-up
- 5. LADY BIRD JENILAT** - In good shape and finished 3rd in a Class C over this track and trip on 9 July. Capable of making the frame once again
- 6. LASH PERRINE** - Holding form and was fourth in a Class C at Vichy over 2,800m on 24 June. Capable of earning some more money
- 7. LOVELY WILMA** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class C over this course and distance on 9 July. Should make a bold bid at victory
- 8. LORIGRE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class C over this course and distance on 11 July. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 9. FAST FURIOUS COL** - Not reliable and finished 6th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 10. FORNARINA ROSS** - Has some fair form and finished 5th at Turin over 1600m on 15 July. Tougher task this time and others are preferred
- 11. MISTER LION** - Disqualified last time out in Class C over this course and distance on 11 July. Consistent before that and has a place chance if smart
- 12. LUCIFER DU PONT** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class D at this course over 2,875m on 9 July 2026. Can go one place better
- 13. FAHARAJAH ONE** - Disqualified last time out at turn over 1600m on 17 June. Has won over this course and distance and cannot be ruled out
- 14. PANERAI** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class C over this track and trip on 9 July. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 15. FLAMENCO FER** - Finished 9th in a Class C over this course and distance on 26 June. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 16. LUNGA DES BROUSSES** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest in Class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 17 July. Hard to trust and others make more appeal

Summary: LOVELY WILMA (7) produced an eye-catching late surge to finish a strong second earlier this month and, with a flawless record of never finishing worse than fourth at this venue, she makes plenty of appeal. LEADERBOARD (4) impressed with his performances at Vincennes during the spring and, having secured a favourable draw behind the car-start, is expected to bounce back from his latest disappointment. Gifted but not always straightforward, LINNA DE VANDEL (3) has the ability to fight out the minor honours. LUCIFER DU PONT (12), a previous Group 3 placegetter, appears to be returning to peak form. LADY BIRD JENILAT (5), who finished just behind the selection last time out, also holds sound claims.

1. **GAMIN DU GAULTIER** - Off form and was unplaced in Class D at this course over 2875m on 27 June. Needs to do a lot more to win
2. **INDIC** - Unplaced in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 10 July. Capable of better and might play a minor role
3. **HOLLYWOOD BOND** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class D at this course over 2,875m on 27 June. Should be involved with the finish once again
4. **I LOVE JOSSELYN** - Made short work of rivals in a Class E over this course and distance on 4 July. Capable of following up if in the same frame of mind
5. **IDOLE ELDE** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class D at Vichy over 2,950m on 30 June. Has improved of late and could double up
6. **HIPPARIS** - Unplaced in a Class E at La Gacilly over 3,100m on 5 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
7. **GALOPIN DE BIANCA** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in a Class D at Vichy over 1,609m on 4 July. Others make much more appeal
8. **IDREAMIS** - Disqualified last time out in Class D at La Capelle over 2700m on 20 July. Has disqualification issues but is capable of scoring
9. **GITANO JACK** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in Class D at this course over 2875m on 11 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
10. **HERMES PAT** - Battling to find best form and was 6th in a claimer over this track and trip on 16 July. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
11. **HOLLYWOOD TORINO** - Returned from a break and finished fourth in Class D over this course and distance on 4 July. Not reliable but is also not out of it
12. **ITALIANO DI PAO** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in Class E at Agon-Coutainville over 3475m on 14 July. Could surprise over this shorter distance
13. **IDEFIX JIHEM** - In good shape and finished third in Class E over this track and trip on 4 July. Should be competitive once again
14. **INFIEL** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and finished fifth in Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 7 July. Might play a minor role at very best

Summary: I LOVE JOSSELYN (4) produced a devastating display over this course last time out and now benefits from the services of Éric Raffin. With everything looking very much in his favour, he stands out as the clear favourite. The main dangers appear to be IDOLE ELDE (5), who has thrived since teaming up with Mathieu Mottier, and the progressive HOLLYWOOD BOND (3), who arrives in excellent form. IDEFIX JIHEM (13) also commands respect despite the disadvantage of a draw on the second-row.

1. **FALCO KILLER GAR** - In good shape and finished fourth at Naples over 1600m on 3 May. Hard to trust but could make the frame if smart
2. **KANTO AVIS** - In very good form and finished fourth in a Group 2 at Vichy over 2950m on 30 June. Big chance in this line-up
3. **HULYSSE DIGEO** - Off form and finished tenth in a Group 2 at this course over 1609m on 11 July. Not reliable but is capable of earning some money
4. **COBRA KILLER GAR** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Group 2 at this course over 1609m on 11 July. Should fight out the finish once again
5. **GENDREEN** - Battling to find best form and was 9th in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 4 July. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
6. **JABALPUR** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Group 2 at this course over 1609m on 11 July. Better over this distance and can be a lively danger
7. **KEEP GOING** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Group 2 at this course over 1609m on 11 July. Capable of scoring if showing best form
8. **KRACK TIME ATOUT** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Group 2 at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 June. Did win a Group 1 last year and must be respected for that
9. **FULTON** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Group 2 at this course over 1609m on 11 July. On a long losing run and others are preferred
10. **KOCTEL DU DAIN** - In good shape and was third in a Group 2 at Vincennes over 2850m on 6 June. Can contest the finish once again
11. **INEXESS BLEU** - Faulted last time out in a Group 1 at Solvalla over 1609m on 31 May. Very talented and could bounce back to score
12. **HOOKER BERRY** - Battling to find best form and finished 6th in a Group 2 at Vincennes over 2700m on 21 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score

Summary: Back in action for the first time since his disqualification in the Elitloppet Final, INEXESS BLEU (11) has a few questions to answer on his return to competition. Nevertheless, he remains an exceptional horse and gets the vote as the one they all have to beat. The powerful six-year-old generation is ready to test him, headed by defending champion KOCTEL DU DAIN (10). KRACK TIME ATOUT (8) and KEEP GOING (7) are two other major players judged on their very best form.

C7 - PRIX DU FAUBOURG MONTMARTRE - 2875m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 52,000

- 1. MYSTIC DES FORGES** - Victorious three times in a row, the latest in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 June. Can add another win to the tally
- 2. MILA DES COUPERIES** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class C over this course and distance on 1 July. Can get into the mix once again
- 3. METIDJA** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class C over this course and distance on 1 July. Might play a minor role at very best
- 4. MAC KINLEY** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class B at Vichy over 2200m on 15 June. Unreliable but might play a minor role at best
- 5. MILTON DU NOYER** - Victorious four times in a row, the latest in Class C over this course and distance on 1 July. Capable of scoring again
- 6. MIRISS DE GUEZ** - Faulted last time out in Class C at this course over 2150m on 9 July. Battling to regain best form and others are preferred

Summary: MILTON DU NOYER (5) has maintained a flawless record this season and lines up with a new shoeing configuration for the first time. Given his current form, he deservedly earns the vote as the one to beat. That said, victory is far from a foregone conclusion, with the highly talented MELLOW SPEED (8) and MARINELLA VRIE (9) both capable of mounting a serious challenge. MILA DES COUPERIES (2) is well positioned to capitalize on any weakness among the principals and appeals as an intriguing candidate.

- 1. HARRY DU LYS** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a Class D mounted race over this course and distance on 25 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. ISOCRATE D'ELA** - Has lost his way of late and finished unplaced in a Class A harness race at Agon-Coutainville over 3475m on 5 July. Could be a surprise package back under the saddle
- 3. HORSY ROYAL** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a Class D mounted race at Cabourg over 2750m on 10 July. On a long losing run and others make more appeal
- 4. HANDSOME BOY** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class C mounted race at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 June. Capable of an upset on best form
- 5. JOKER DE FROULAY** - Remains in very good shape and was runner-up in a Class C mounted race over this track and trip on 18 April. Returns from a short break but can score if fit enough
- 6. GAILLARDE QUERAY** - Returned to form and was third in a Class D harness race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 6 July. Might play a minor role at very best
- 7. INSTANT GRAVE** - In good shape and finished fourth in a Class D mounted race at Vichy over 2950m on 1 June. Can be competitive again
- 8. HEVA BLONDE** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class C mounted race at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 June. Can be competitive once again
- 9. IMELDA** - Has some fair form and was fifth in a Class D mounted race at Vichy over 2950m on 1 July. Might play a role at the finish

- 14. IGO CLEA** - Returned to form and finished third in a Class C mounted race at Vincennes over 2850m on 26 May. Has claims in this line-up
- 15. HORS BORD** - Disqualified last time out in Class C at Enghien over 2150m on 9 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score

Summary: JOKER DE FROULAY (5) enjoyed an excellent spring campaign and is expected to make a bold bid following a short break. If resuming where he left off, he should play a leading role. However, IMELDA (9), who finished ahead of him when winning over this course in mid-April, has every chance of following up and looks his main rival. Among the remainder, HAIDA SAUTONNE (13), partnered by Benjamin Rochard, and INSTANT GRAVE (7), who arrives at the top of his game, have the credentials to make their presence felt in what promises to be a competitive affair.

1. **JINA D'ERPION** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class F at Vittel over 2700m on 14 July. Quite capable of getting involved in the finish
2. **KILLARNEY** - Off form and finished 8th in Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 20 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
3. **JALMAROSA** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 10 July. Has a place chance this time around
4. **KELOMA DREAM** - Disqualified last time out in Class D at this course over 2875m on 9 July. Victorious before that and has claims in this line-up
5. **KUEENTRASS** - Remains in good shape and was fourth in Class E at Pornichet over 2650m on 8 July. Successful twice in a row before that and is clearly not out of it
6. **PERFECT** - Unreliable but was third in Class D at this course over 2875m on 26 June. Could contest the finish once again
7. **EDIMA** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 24 April. Returns from a break and could need this run
8. **KALINKA DU BREUIL** - Not reliable but was runner-up in Class G at Langon over 2800m on 14 July. Can go one place better
9. **YES PLEASE** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in Class F at Cabourg over 2725m on 3 July. Can go one place better
10. **RAGAZZA DU CHENE** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in Class D at this course over 2875m on 26 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
11. **KATY'S TIME** - Returned from a lengthy break and was third in Class D at La Capelle over 1800m on 7 July. Very consistent and can be very competitive once again

Summary: The visiting mares PERFECT (6), who was narrowly defeated at this course last time, and the highly consistent YES PLEASE (9) look set to dominate this contest reserved to females. PERFECT (6) went down by the narrowest of margins over this course last time out, while the ultra-consistent YES PLEASE (9) once again brings a rock-solid profile to the race.
