

R1 DEAUVILLE-LA TOUQUES [DEAUVILLE-LA TOUQUES]

C1 - PRIX GUY DU FAUR DE PIBRAC - HANDICAP CHALLENGE - CHALLENGE APGO - 2500m (a1m1/2) - ALL WEATHER - Class 4 Handicap - Flat - EUR € 17,300

1. ARGYRON - Came home 5th in a Class 4 Handicap at Clairefontaine over 2,200m on 1 August. Has won over this track and trip and is not out of it

2. AMAZONE ISLAND - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Class 3 Handicap at Deauville over 2,500m on 18 August. Has won over this course and distance and could surprise

3. AIMANT - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a Class 3 Handicap over this track and trip on 11 August. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal

4. FIRST CREATION - Finished 6th in a Class 4 Handicap at Le Lion D'Angers over 3,000m on 2 August. Top amateur rider in the saddle and is capable of scoring

5. PERSEVERANZA - Outclassed the opposition in a Class 4 at Royan-La Palmyre over 2,300m on 16 August. Not reliable but cannot be ruled out

6. GRIS DE MYM - A faller last time out in a Conditions Hurdle at Compiègne over 3,600m on 6 April. Returns from a break and could need this run

7. LUCERO - Has only been modest of late and was unplaced in a Class 4 Handicap at Vichy over 2,000m on 21 July. Could surprise back on this surface

8. DIEGO D'ARTOIS - Has struggled on the flat of late and was unplaced in a Class 3 Handicap at Clairefontaine over 1,600m on 14 August. Better in chases and others make more appeal

9. LA JAVANAISE - Off form and finished 14th in a Class 4 Handicap at this track over 1,900m on 6 August. Needs to find a few lengths to score

10. ROYAL RIGHT - Came home 7th in a Class 4 Handicap at Clairefontaine over 2,200m on 1 August. Capable of doing better and might make the frame

11. BELLA CIAO - Successful in a Class 4 Handicap over this track and trip on 11 August. Showed a return to form that day and could follow up

12. SUCCESS STORY - Finished 8th in a Class 4 Handicap over this course and distance on 11 August. Capable of doing better but others are preferred

Summary: Back over her preferred distance, FIRST CREATION (4) won with Florent Guy in the saddle last March and looks a serious betting proposition in this race for amateurs. BELLA CIAO (11) carries a 5lb penalty for her recent victory, but remains a leading player with Jordan Majorcyrk taking off 5lb. PERSEVERANZA (5) has a good record when ridden by Tom Morisson. ROYAL RIGHT (10) and ARGYRON (1) are both worth some consideration.

C2 - PRIX DE VIRE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 31,100

1. TIMUR - Returned to form with a runner-up performance in a Handicap over this course and distance on 4 August. Can go one place better

2. EN CHANTANT - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Listed race at Mont-de-Marsan over 1,200m on 26 July. Capable of doing better and can be competitive in this line-up

3. VENEZIA QUEEN - Not disgraced when fourth in a Class 2 Conditions race at this course over 1,500m on 4 August. Scored on debut and can contest the finish

4. CHECKERED FLAG - Showed what she is capable of with a success in a Handicap over this course and distance on 4 August. Tougher task but can double up

5. KHAROVSKAYA - Unplaced in a Listed race at Mont-de-Marsan over 1,200m on 26 July. In good form before that and might play a minor role at best

6. YAFTABELLA - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Maiden at Le Lion D'Angers over 1,200m on 2 August. More is needed to beat these rivals

7. IMPA - Showed promise when third in a Maiden at this track over 1,400m on 9 August. Can get involved in the finish once again

Summary: A recent addition to Mathieu Brasme's stable, CHECKERED FLAG (4) finished strongly over this course last time out. Despite a less favourable weight situation this time, she can once again get the better of TIMUR (1), who showed plenty of tenacity after making the running on that occasion. EN CHANTANT (2) drops out of Listed company with the aim of getting back to winning ways. VENEZIA QUEEN (3) tackles 1,200 metres for the first time and has to be monitored.

C3 - PRIX DE LA CROIX D'HEULAND - 1500m (a7f1/2) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 25,900

- 1. ORANGETTE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class 2 at La Teste-de-Buch over 1,400m on 10 August. Successful in a Handicap before that and has a place chance
- 2. ARIA FRESCA** - Showed some improvement when successful in a claimer at Compiègne over 1,400m on 28 July. Can make the frame
- 3. KASSAB** - Yet to win a race but did run well when third last time out in a Conditions race at Vittel over 1,600m on 11 August. Capable of scoring
- 4. LUDWIG DER ZWEITE** - Finished 10th in a Maiden at Vichy over 1,400m on 20 July. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 5. MICHELADA** - Finished 8th in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 1,600m on 1 August. Capable of better and can bounce back to score
- 6. PIPPEN** - Victorious last time out in a claimer at Vichy over 1,600m on 3 August. Tougher task this time but can't be ruled out
- 7. TAXXI** - Holding form and was fourth in a Handicap at this course over 1,200m on 4 August. Should fight out the finish
- 8. DICANTO** - Finished 6th in a Maiden at this course over 1,200m on 15 August. Has won a claimer but more is needed to beat these rivals
- 9. DEFI** - Unplaced in a Maiden at Vichy over 1,400m on 12 August. Unreliable so far but could be competitive trying a Handicap

Summary: MICHELADA (5) made a strong visual impression at Cholet on her penultimate start and looks fairly treated on her handicap debut. TAXXI (7) finished fourth on her first appearance at this level, despite being struck on the nose by a rival's whip in the closing stages. DEFI (9) has never been ridden by Mickaël Barzalona before, which is an interesting booking. ARIA FRESCA (2) arrives here on the back of a sound success in a claiming race.

C4 - PRIX HOTEL BARRIERE LE ROYAL DEAUVILLE - TROPHÉE STUDIO HARCOURT - 1400m (a7f) - ALL WEATHER - Flat - EUR € 17,400

- 1. SWEET AS** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class 3 Handicap at this course over 1,300m on 13 August. Much improved of late and could follow up
- 2. RIO** - Successful in a Class 3 Handicap at Clairefontaine over 1,800m on 3 August. Better over further but can't be ruled out
- 3. AZ ZEIVA** - Finished 12th in a Class 3 Handicap at this track over 1,900m on 16 January. Returns from a break but is not out of it if fit enough
- 4. WE RIDE THE WORLD** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in a Class 3 Handicap at Senonnes-Pouance over 1,350m on 31 July. Can be a threat on best form
- 5. OUT OF THE BLUE** - Returned to form when fourth in a Class 4 Handicap at Les Sables D'Olonne over 1,200m on 6 August. Can get into the mix
- 6. ASTON CLINTON** - Came home 6th in a Class 3 over this track and trip on 26 June. On a long losing run and more is needed to score
- 7. GITANO** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a Class 2 Handicap at this course over 2,000m on 4 August. Fitter this time and could make the frame
- 8. DRIMYS** - Showed a form return when third in a Handicap at Saint-Malo over 1,800m on 29 August 2025. Returns from a lengthy break and could need this run
- 9. CREATOR** - Has not shown much so far and was tenth in a claimer over this course and distance on 15 August. Others are much preferred
- 10. BEAU GARS** - Finished 8th last time out in a Handicap at Chantilly over 1,400m on 26 March. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 11. SNOW GHOST** - Finished 10th in a Class 2 Handicap at this course over 1,300m on 30 January. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 12. TYSON** - Unplaced in a Class 3 Handicap at this track over 1,500m on 20 August. Unreliable and more is needed to score
- 13. MY QUEEN** - Unplaced in a Class 2 Handicap at this course over 1,900m on 11 August. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 14. SECRET WOOD** - Came home 7th in a Class 3 at Vichy over 1,400m on 3 August. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals

Summary: SWEET AS (1) has been handed a wide draw, but is in such good form that he should once again play a leading role. RIO (2) has finished in the first two on both occasions when ridden by Astrid Peltier and arrives here in good shape, although he has not raced over such a short distance for quite some time. A four-time Quinté+ winner, WE RIDE THE WORLD (4) has a good opportunity to get back to winning ways. GITANO (7) cannot be excluded of the equation.

C5 - PRIX DE LA VILLA SAINT-AUGUSTIN - 1600m (a1m) - TURF - Handicap - Flat - EUR € 38,400

1. **CHARLY** - Bounced back to his best with a Handicap victory at this track over 1,300m on 6 August. Knows how to win races and must be respected for that
2. **TESTIFY** - Unplaced in a Class 2 Handicap at Vichy over 1,400m on 20 July. Often competitive before that and could make the frame
3. **ANASHKAYA** - Unplaced in a Group I at Longchamp over 1,600m on 10 May. Has been at his best on the PSF but can score trying a handicap
4. **MIUCCIA** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class 2 Conditions race at Le Lion D'Angers over 1,400m on 2 August. Can contest the finish once again
5. **APOLIDE** - Has only been modest of late and was 7th last time out in a Handicap at this course over 1,900m on 26 June. More is needed to score
6. **MISTER CHARMES** - Consistent and was runner-up in a Class 2 Conditions race at Compiègne over 1,600m on 28 July. Can go one place better
7. **QUEMAZAL** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Class 2 Conditions race at Le Lion D'Angers over 1,400m on 2 August. Should be in the mix
8. **MIA LOT** - Finished 6th in a Class 2 Conditions race at Compiègne over 1,600m on 28 July. Capable of doing better and has a place chance

Summary: Considered good enough to take her chance in the Prix de Diane (G1), ANASHKAYA (3) has been given a break since and looks a serious contender on her first appearance at this level, despite having limited experience on turf. Second to a nice horse at Compiègne, MISTER CHARMES (6) could give her plenty to think about. CHARLY (1) arrives here on the back of a cosy success on the all-weather. TESTIFY (2) should enjoy the return to a mile.

C6 - PRIX DE CRIQUEVILLE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 20,100

- 1. SIRAT** - Unplaced in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 1,800m on 10 August. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 2. KERMADEC** - A runner-up on debut in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine over 2,400m on 3 August. Can go one place better
- 3. PRIDE OF FRANCE** - Came home 6th in a Maiden at Compiegne over 1,800m on 5 June. Capable of a bit better and might play a minor role
- 4. KENERGY** - Has not been disgraced in three starts and was fourth at Kempton Park over 1,400m on 2 July. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 5. ZITOLOGUE** - A runner-up on debut in a Conditions race at Dieppe over 1,800m on 30 July. Capable of making the frame
- 6. ZOAR** - Has some fair form and was fifth in a Conditions Maiden at Compiegne over 1,600m on 28 July. Might play a minor role at best
- 7. GAREYA** - In good shape and was third in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 2,200m on 11 July. Can be ready for a winning turn
- 8. ELLIE'S SECRET** - Finished unplaced on debut in a Conditions race at Dieppe over 1,800m on 30 July. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 9. GAZELLE DU BRIZAIS** - Came home 6th in a Maiden at Clairefontaine over 2,900m on 14 August. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 10. HOUSE OF TUDOR** - A three-year-old colt by St. Mark's Basilica out of Palace who is making his debut. His dam won a Listed race. Could be a threat
- 11. GLORY ALLELUIA** - A three-year-old filly by Olympic Glory out of Lady Marmalade who is making her debut. Her dam never won a race after six starts. May need this experience

Summary: GAREYA (7) has shaped with plenty of promise on her two starts to date and could get off the mark this time around. However, she could face a strong challenge from ZITOLOGUE (5), a son of Nathaniel who made a very encouraging debut when finishing second at Dieppe. HOUSE OF TUDOR (10) is a newcomer representing a leading yard who could make his presence felt. The experienced SIRAT (1) is worth some consideration.

C7 - PRIX DE BREVEDENT - 3200m (a2m) - TURF - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 25,900

- 1. HAVIASSOR** - Not reliable but was fourth in a Class 2 Handicap at Compiègne over 2,800m on 20 June. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 2. SAPRISTI** - Unplaced in a Class 2 Handicap at Dieppe over 2,400m on 30 July. Unreliable and others make more appeal
- 3. MYKISS** - Finished 9th in a Class 3 at Deauville over 2,500m on 6 August. Can do better back on the grass and might play a minor role
- 4. PINK MONDAY** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Class 2 Handicap at Vichy over 2,800m on 23 July. Can play a minor role once again
- 5. LIKE IT OR NOT** - In good form and was third in a Class 3 Handicap at Dieppe over 2,400m on 30 July. Can have consistency rewarded with a winning turn
- 6. KALEO CAESAR** - Unreliable but was fourth in a Class 3 Handicap at Senonnes-Pouance over 3,000m on 31 July. Can make the frame
- 7. RECOLETTY** - Finished third in a Class 3 Handicap at Senonnes-Pouance over 3,000m on 31 July. Can get into the mix again
- 8. MOZART DES BRIERES** - Came home 4th in a Class 3 Handicap at Vichy over 3,200m on 6 August. Has some fair form but may need to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 9. LIGHT OF THUNDER** - Victorious last time out in a Handicap at ParisLongchamp over 3,000m on 2 July. Still improving and could double up
- 10. LE ROI DAVID** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class 3 Handicap at Dieppe over 2,400m on 30 July. Carries a penalty but is not out of it
- 11. DICX** - Finished 6th in a Class 3 Handicap at Vichy over 2,800m on 23 July. Capable of a bit better and might play a minor role at best
- 12. SPLENDINO** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Class 3 Handicap at this course over 2,500m on 11 August. Can complete a hat-trick
- 13. SHEEMA'S ROSE** - Unplaced in a Class 2 Handicap at Compiègne over 2,800m on 20 June. Off form and others make more appeal
- 14. VENDOMYA** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class 3 Handicap at Vichy over 3,200m on 6 August. Can challenge for top honours
- 15. DERBYCAT** - In good form and was runner-up at Vichy over 2,400m on 21 July. Has scope for improvement and must be respected in this line-up
- 16. AUTOROUTE** - Consistent and finished fourth in a Handicap at Vichy over 2,400m on 21 July. Can make it into the frame

Summary: A facile winner at Longchamp in early July, LIGHT OF THUNDER (9) is clearly thriving and can make a bold bid on her first start against older horses. Although he has not won a race for almost a year, the experienced HAVIASSOR (1) has the ability to go close in a contest of this nature. LE ROI DAVID (10), who should enjoy the step up in distance, can be included in calculations. KALEO CAESAR (6) shaped nicely at Senonnes last time out and is worth a look in.

C8 - MOROCCO CUP - HANDICAP DE LA MANCHE - 3200m (a2m) - TURF - Class 2 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 50,900

- 1. LE LAVANDOU** - Finished 7th in a Listed at Saint-Cloud over 3,000m on 12 June. Has only been modest of late and may need to do more to score
- 2. THE GOOD MAN** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class 2 at Le Lion D'Angers over 3,000m on 2 August. Capable of having a say
- 3. DON'T SHUT ME DOWN** - Successful in a Class 2 Handicap at Vichy over 2,800m on 23 July. Bounced back to form but does have more to do under a penalty. Place chance
- 4. CHESS** - Very consistent and was third in a Class 2 Handicap at Compiègne over 2,800m on 20 June. Returns from a break but can earn some money
- 5. MON RICIN** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class 3 at Saint-Cloud over 3,100m on 28 June. Returns from a break but can follow up
- 6. BLACK SAXON** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class 2 Handicap at Vichy over 2,800m on 23 July. Capable of an upset on best form
- 7. VAZIRPOUR** - Came home 9th in a Class 2 Handicap at Vichy over 2,800m on 23 July. Capable of doing better and might play a minor role
- 8. ARNAY LE DUC** - Victorious in a Claimer at Clairefontaine over 2,400m on 7 August. Tougher task this time and others make more appeal
- 9. MAIA STAR** - Unplaced in a Class 2 Handicap at Dieppe over 2,400m on 30 July. Tries this distance but is a threat on a soft track
- 10. YES ZARA** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class 3 Handicap at Senonnes-Pouance over 3,000m on 31 July. Successful in three of last four starts and is not out of it
- 11. MIGHTY BOY** - Remains in very good form and was runner-up in a Class 2 Handicap at Vichy over 2,800m on 23 July. Can get into the mix of things once again
- 12. ALMAGUER** - Successful twice in last three starts, including last time out in a Class 4 Conditions race at Rochefort-sur-Loire over 2400 on 18 August. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 13. EL CANEY** - Finished 5th in a Class 3 Handicap at Vichy over 3,200m on 6 August. Has some fair form but needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 14. A BEAUREGARD** - Finished 7th in a Class 2 Handicap at Vichy over 2,800m on 23 July. Can bounce back to score on a soft track
- 15. ACOTANGO** - Finished third in a Claimer at Clairefontaine over 2,400m on 7 August. Tougher task this time and others are preferred
- 16. DEMPY** - Victorious in a Class 3 at Saint-Cloud over 3,000m on 8 July. Has returned to best and is clearly not out of it

Summary: A BEAUREGARD (14) has been disappointing throughout the year, but he has been racing on ground that was simply too quick for him. He will finally get the soft conditions he needs this Tuesday, while his handicap mark has dropped significantly. A tough and genuine performer, MON RICIN (5) has shown that he is capable of winning a race of this nature. MAIA STAR (9) should take a significant step forward following a much needed comeback run. She is retained ahead of DEMPY (16), who always gives his best, and MIGHTY BOY (11), whose first start for Edouard Monfort was highly promising
