C1 - PRIX DE SAINT-GALMIER - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 12,000

1. **KIARA DU SAPTEL** - Imposed at Brehal just over a month ago but has since failed 4 times to confirm and can be passed over
 2. **KYRIELLE JOMUNA** - Won an amateurs Class G at Arras earlier in the month. Simply excels with Sven Hoste who can be forgiven for being bullish
 3. **KINGDOM DE CHENU** - Was unable to confirm Sablé-sur-Sarthe performance when pulled up at Les Sables-d'Olonne 5 days ago. Will be shod this time but could nevertheless secure minor honours
 4. **INDY PIQUENARD** - Reassuring 2nd in a 2300m Abbeville amateurs Class H 10 days ago. Is new to Vincennes and is unlikely to repeat
 5. **KALINE JAMINI** - Has won 3 of last 5 starts, most recently an Argentan Class F on 16 August, and although not a priority, can still pick up a first-five payout
 6. **KAP NORMAND** - Third in a Class H Amateurs' race at Vittel over 2,700m on 15 August 2026, confirming his Arras run. Presents no main-track references though and cannot be considered a player
 7. **KEZIO JOSSELYN** - Finished 8th in a Class F Amateurs' race at Enghien over 2,150m on 13 August 2026. Tends to show more in the claiming division and others easier to back
 8. **JIM DE SUCE** - Finished 5th in a Class H Amateurs' race at Chinon over 3,100m on 15 August 2026. Ran 2nd over the inner course on sole start at the venue, but will have a part to play if he takes to the new conditions
 9. **INKERMAN DE PLAY** - Has not been as sharp as he was when winning a pair in June, most recently 5th in a 2150m Enghien amateurs Class F on 10 August. Incurs the penalty and represents a minor place chance at best
 10. **HORACE DU VIVIER** - Modest individual that has made no impact for some time and is not about to change his ways
 11. **HAHICHA GIRL** - Confirmed Pornichet performance when runner-up in a Class F Amateurs' race at Laval over 2,850m on 19 August 2026, and it is just a question of when, not if, she returns to the winners' enclosure. Claim
 12. **ICONE PLANCHETTE** - Fourth behind HAHICHA GIRL (11) in a Class F Amateurs' race at Laval over 2,850m on 19 August 2026. Is quite evidently back at her best and has a decent chance of fighting out the finish
- Summary:** HAHICHA GIRL (11), who is plainly close to her race, a barefoot ICONE PLANCHETTE (12), partnered by Barbara Guenet, the consistent and well-placed KYRIELLE JOMUNA (2), and JIM DE SUCE (8), who is ideally-entered on the front line, look capable of fighting out the finish.

C2 - PRIX DES CYCLAMENS - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 38,000

1. ONALISA - Could have qualified better than 1'19'8 a month back had she not faulted turning for home. Is an interesting filly and can finish close if she behaves

2. OLYMPE DE BELINE - Disqualified in a Class G at Montier En Der over 2,300m on 23 August 2026, first time out. Showed promise in qualification though and should not be discounted

3. OHLALA OKINA - 5th behind OBELLA DES BORDES (4) in a Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne 2.5 weeks ago, and already looks out of her depth

4. OBELLA DES BORDES - Finished 2nd in a Class E at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,150m on 8 August 2026, showing improvement on her debut run, but in this company will need to find more

5. OLYMPIC JOY - Runner-up to OF AMERICA (8) in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,050m on 4 August 2026. Hails from one of the best nurseries on the continent and must be taken very seriously

6. OBJECTION AR - Finished 2nd, first time out, in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 18 July 2026. Comes here fresh and is unlikely to disappoint if she takes to the new conditions

7. OPEN ALL NIGHT - Runner-up on debut in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 26 July 2026. Will only have progressed for the race and must be considered a contender

8. OF AMERICA - Comfortably got off the mark in a 2050m Cabourg Class E 3 weeks ago. Is plainly a serious trotter in the making and should be good enough to repeat

Summary: There is little to separate OF AMERICA (8) and OLYMPIC JOY (5), who finished in that order at Cabourg, and OPEN ALL NIGHT (7), narrowly beaten on her debut at Enghien. By Idao De Tillard, the unraced and well-qualified ONALISA (1) merits close attention.

C3 - PRIX DE PERPIGNAN - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

1. **MOLLY WHITE** - Capable in this branch of the business but latest numbers do nothing to inspire confidence
2. **MARBELLA CHAFS** - Finished 3rd in a Class F at Le Mans over 2,950m on 25 July. Will not be sent out at 32-1 this time but will not be as competitive either
3. **MUSIQUE NAY** - Fourth in a Class D over 2,175m here on 12 May 2026. Has not raced since and with shoes fitted will have little to offer
4. **MEGANE DE CERISY** - Has yet to demonstrate any particular flair for the discipline and can be confidently passed over
5. **MONDAINE** - Completed the hat-trick when successful in a Class F at Saint Malo over 2,950m on 11 August 2026. Has won 3 for 3 with Alexandre Abrivard who will be keen to keep that fact relevant
6. **MAJUSCULE** - No slouch on a good day but disqualified in 5 of last 6 starts. Is barefoot this time, but others still easier to trust
7. **MADINA MESLOISE** - Has not been seen out since running 3rd in a Class B over course and distance on 17 October 2025. Goes first-time barefoot and has a reasonable chance of picking up a first-five payout
8. **MELODY LUDOISE** - Third in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,750m on 14 July 2026, after having won a pair at Laval and Vichy. Gave a fine account on sole start here and is thoroughly capable of imposing
9. **MINA DRY** - Eliminated in all three starts this season, most recently a 2750m Cabourg Class E on 14 August. Has been re-shod for the occasion but looks a minor place prospect at best
10. **MINNEAPOLIS** - Complicated mare that opened her monte account in June. Was eliminated at Cabourg recently but should make amends if she gets off on the right foot
11. **MISSY DE JIEL** - Blows hot and cold but ran reassuring third in a 2750m Cabourg Class E mid-month and can finish in the mix
12. **MALLAURY D'AVEL** - Finished 5th in a Class C at Enghien over 2,875m on 4 July 2026. Sports a fresh configuration, is confirmed here, and has a lot going for her. Place chance

Summary: MELODY LUDOISE (8), who races sparingly but to good effect, MONDAINE (5), who puts her unbeaten record with Alexandre Abrivard on the line, and the reconfigured and ideally-engaged, MALLAURY D'AVEL (12), can be preferred to MINNEAPOLIS (10), who deserves another chance.

C4 - PRIX DE LAGNY - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

1. **NIRVANA DU PONT** - Finished 2nd in a Class F at Vichy over 2,150m on 1 June 2026. Has not been seen out since though and best to keep one's powder dry
2. **NEMO D'ARNHEM** - Finished 3rd in a Class E at Vittel over 2,700m on 12 July 2026, however at this level will have his work cut out for him
3. **NESPRESSO MIJO** - Tricky colt but has talent in spades. Lost his action in a 2150m Enghien Class E a month ago. Is entrusted to Alexis Collette for the first time and, with application, can make this his own
4. **NORDLAND VEDAQUAIS** - Disqualified in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,725m on 7 August 2026 before reassuringly imposing in a Class F at Francheville 8 days later. Yoann Lebourgeois back in the bike and has a decent chance of doubling his money
5. **NEW YORKER** - Returns to racing left-handed following two straight eliminations. Is new to Vincennes but has been entrusted to Mathieu Mottier for the first time and can play an important role
6. **NAZARINO** - Has turned a corner over recent weeks, lastly 3rd in a Mauquenchy Class E on 5 August. In better company this time though and others preferred
7. **NEVERLAND MIJACK** - Reassuring, but surprise, 3rd in a Class E at Enghien over 2,875m on 6 August 2026, his first left-handed start. Takes on a better bunch this time but still warrants respect
8. **NAMOUR DE MONTFORT** - Produced three fine performances before being disqualified in a Saint-Malo Class D three weeks ago. Franck Nivard gets the nod this time and will be expected to set the record straight. Place prospect
9. **NIMEO FLOWER** - Finished 8th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,150m on 12 August 2026, his first appearance for 4 months. Will have come on for the run but is still in conditioning-mode
10. **NOBEL DE PAIL** - Finished 2nd in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,850m on 5 August 2026, showing marginal improvement on Pornichet run. Is competitively-shod for the first time and is not to be underestimated
11. **NARKOS DU PAIN** - 4th behind NEVERLAND MIJACK (7) in a 2875m Enghien Class E 3 weeks ago. Will be fitted with 4 pads for the first time and the engagement of Paul Ploquin will do his chances no disservice
12. **NIDORINO** - Third in a monte Class E at Enghien over 2,250m on 26 July 2026. Presents solid harness form and although not a priority, will sport 4 pads for the first time and is still worth monitoring

Summary: Beaten only by the undefeated NUEVO, who since went on to win a Gr.2, at Enghien, NESPRESSO MIJO (3) was disqualified last time but nonetheless showed his form. If he stays in stride, he will have the edge over the talented NORDLAND VEDAQUAIS (4), NEW YORKER (5), who, with Mathieu Mottier reining must be afforded another chance, and NAMOUR DE MONTFORT (8), who should not be condemned for losing his action at Saint-Malo.

C5 - PRIX D'ECOMMOY - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 35,000

1. **NESTINA** - Ran 6th in a harness Class F at Sable Sur Sarthe over 2,825m on 9 August 2026. Has ability though and debuts in the discipline with a respectable chance of getting in on the action
2. **NALLA DE BEYLEV** - Finished 5th in a harness Class F at La Capelle over 2,750m on 22 March 2026, first time out. Will only have improved for the race and with Alexandre Abrivard in the saddle must be taken seriously
3. **NAGOYA MESLOISE** - Ran second on debut at Cabourg on 4 August before losing her action in an Enghien Class D 9 days later. On good behaviour though, can put things right. Chance
4. **NASTREE DU VINOIS** - Lost her action in a Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne last Friday. Is proven over the main track and, if applied, can finish close
5. **NOKITA DU RIB** - Third in a Class F at Cabourg over 2,750m on 4 August 2026. Is unlikely to lose her maiden tag this time either but should still be competitive for a first-five cheque
6. **NICOLETTA DU CLOS** - Third in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 13 August 2026. Is plainly on the right road, goes well for his jockey, and can play a small part
7. **NATURE DU RIB** - Comfortable winner of a Class F at Cabourg over 2,750m on 4 August 2026, on just her second monte start, and looks thoroughly capable of repeating
8. **NORMA FIRST** - Has done little of note since getting off the mark at Ecommoy in April and with shoes back on can be passed over
9. **NEPHY ELDE** - Not the easiest of horses to handle, and was disqualified in last three, but Paul Ploquin gets the nod here and will be determined to keep her on the straight and narrow. Chance
10. **NEW GIRL OF MAMAT** - Spirited filly that ran 3rd in a Class B over course and distance mid-June before being sent for a spell. Was eliminated on re-entry at Cabourg though and is not about to spring and surprises
11. **NOA BY STEED** - Finished 7th in a harness Class E at Enghien over 2,875m on 8 August 2026. Is new to the discipline but others still easier to support

Summary: Impressive winner at Cabourg on 4 August, NATURE DU RIB (7) will attempt to beat NAGOYA MESLOISE (3) again but Thibaut Dromigny will be back in the latter's bike. NASTREE DU VINOIS (4), who was unlucky at Les Sables-d'Olonne, and NEPHY ELDE (9), provided she stays in stride, look the leading dangers.

C6 - PRIX DE BOSC RENOULT - 2850m (a2m) - Claiming - Harness - EUR € 18,000

1. **LADY DE BEYLEV** - Most impressive in a Cabourg claimer last week despite losing her action after suffering interference. Is plainly in shape though and from the front line can get in on the action
 2. **MANZANA** - Finished last but one in a Class E at Enghien over 2,875m on 4 July 2026 and, quite simply, has nothing to offer
 3. **LALE** - Third in a Class F at La Roche-Posay over 3,175m on 22 August 2026. A repeat, however, seems most unlikely
 4. **LUCKY DELADOU** - Is better than recent 9th in a Cabourg claimer would suggest. Starts in front here and can get a look in
 5. **MAMBO THORIS** - Won a Divonne-les-Bains claimer on 10 August. Alexandre Abrivard in the bike again and is not about to let the side down. First 5
 6. **LE SEPTIEME ART** - Encouraged at La Ferte-Vidame but was unable to confirm when 7th in an Agon Class F 10 days ago, and can expect to have few friends
 7. **LET IT OUT** - Has looked very ordinary since winning a Vichy claimer in May and is not about to create an upset
 8. **LISTEL D'URZY** - Ran 6th in a Class F at La Roche-Posay over 3,150m on 9 August. Has never excelled at Vincennes but can nevertheless hold his own
 9. **LOVE ME MAZELI** - Useful mare making first appearance since 10 May. Is barefoot for comeback but others still preferred
 10. **LUSSABEAU** - Has done nothing of note since returning from a spring spell and can be written off
 11. **LALOU D'AMOUR** - Eliminated in 3 straight before finishing 7th in a Graignes Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Has form with her driver but is still not a priority
 12. **MANOU DU CHENE** - Oddly below-par 5th to MYRTILLE MARBOULA (16) in a 2150m Enghien claimer 2.5 weeks ago. Should not be too hastily-judged and is worth bringing back into the fold
 13. **MOSCANTIDA PEAL** - Could possibly have won a 2150m Enghien claimer 2.5 weeks ago had she not been blocked in. Starts on 2nd row but can wrap this up if Paul Ploquin keeps her out of trouble
 14. **MELODY MUSIC** - Fourth in a monte Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 14 August 2026. Won under harness last month and cannot be discounted
 15. **MERMOZ** - Got back in the game on 8 August when 2nd in a 2150m Enghien claimer. Tends to show more over shorter but presents solid references nevertheless and can contest a place in the frame
 16. **MYRTILLE MARBOULA** - Won her second of the year when securing a 2150m Enghien claimer 2.5 weeks ago, at the expense of MOSCANTIDA PEAL (13), and has a reasonable chance of doubling up
- Summary:** MOSCANTIDA PEAL (13) would have given MYRTILLE MARBOULA (16) a run for her money had she been afforded passage in the closing stages at Enghien earlier in the month. Second that day, MERMOZ (15), goes barefoot this time and should again play a prominent role. LADY DE BEYLEV (1), who showed serious form after being disqualified at Cabourg, can be preferred to MANOU DU CHENE (12) who is in her category here.

C7 - PRIX DE CHARTRES - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. NYMPHE DE BAIS** - Finished 4th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,725m on 11 August 2026. Is clearly being aimed too high and is not about to lose her maiden status this time either
- 2. NIGHT DU SAPTEL** - Finished 2nd in a Class F at La Capelle over 2,750m on 30 July 2026, having got off the mark on previous start, and even though moving up in category still warrants respect
- 3. NINA DU BOCAGE** - Finished 3rd in a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2,875m on 15 August, 3 weeks after running 2nd at La Capelle, and should not be ruled out
- 4. NATURE D'ECHAL** - Missed the break in an Enghien Class E 2.5 weeks ago and was unable to confirm her Le Mans victory, but can set the record straight if she gets off on the right foot
- 5. NEW STAR WIND** - Put 4 straight sanctions behind her to win a Class F at Agon 10 days ago. Is re-shod for the occasion but is out of her depth
- 6. NIKYTA CIBEL** - Reliability not her strong suit but reassured at Vichy early this month and, with Alexandre Abrivard reining, will be afforded every chance
- 7. NAGOYA DE LOU** - Won a Class F at Divonne over 2,000m on 13 August 2026. Takes on a better lot here but still looks up to the task at hand. Attention
- 8. NOORDZEE** - Clearly talented but eliminated in last 2. Debuts at Vincennes and will be dangerous if she takes to the new conditions
- 9. NOUBA DE CHINE** - Runner-up in a Class E at Le Mans over 2,950m on 25 July 2026. Is plainly close to her race and will be no soft touch
- 10. NICCA BREED** - Fourth in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 4 August 2026. Won twice in the spring but takes on a more exalted lot here and chances appear limited
- 11. NINA DU COJEUL** - Finished 7th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 26 July 2026, after having imposed at Amiens the previous month, and is not about to spice things up
- 12. NEED YOU AGAIN** - Finished 8th in a Class D at Enghien over 2,875m on 16 July 2026. Is patently much better than that though and Yoann Lebourgeois has every chance of putting things right
- 13. NOUCHKA ROYALE** - Won a Class E at Chartres over 2,800m on 28 June 2026. Is well in here but takes a notable hike in category and will need to find more

Summary: This looks an open contest. NATURE D'ECHAL (4), partnered by Paul Ploquin for the first time, should be up to this level if she stays in stride. NOUBA DE CHINE (9), fitted with pads for the first time, NOORDZEE (8), who should not be judged too harshly for her recent run, and NEED YOU AGAIN (12), partnered by Yoann Lebourgeois, are also in with a shout.

C8 - PRIX DE VIMOUTIERS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 35,000

1. **MARCEL SEVEN** - Useful on a good day but is never far from faulting, as he showed at Enghien a fortnight ago. On better behaviour, though, can get back in the game
2. **MIRAGE QUICK** - Has won 2 of last 3, latterly an Avignon Class E a month ago, but in this category will have nothing to contribute
3. **MAGIC LOMIG** - Has bags of talent but is as capricious as the wind. Has previously won with Paul Ploquin but has too much to find here
4. **MERCATO DES FORGES** - Runner-up in a Class E at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,650m on 4 August 2026, his first start since April. Will have come on for the run and, if applied, will not be far off the mark
5. **MONEYTIME DUCAMPUS** - Has been showing decent ability in the south of France. Debuts in the capital with Yoann Lebourgeois reining and is unlikely to be too far from the action
6. **MALIBU** - Was going well when disqualified at Carentan mid-month. Will be fully-fit by now and, reunited with his handler, can impose
7. **MURO** - Disappointing on the whole since returning from his spring layup and appears to have no possible chance
8. **MIRACLE OF LOVE** - Imposed at Le Mans on 13 July but was quickly disqualified at Pornichet just last week. Is new to Vincennes, and is seen more often racing right-handed, but current form augurs well for his chances
9. **MENJOY QUICK** - Placed in 3 straight prior to finishing 6th in a Pornichet Class E last week. Reverts to a productive formula but faces an even stiffer test this time
10. **MELIUS AVIS** - Runner-up in a Class E at Enghien over 2,875m on 29 July, at 37-1. Will be shod as he was that day but still looks considerably less-competitive
11. **MARABOU DODVILLE** - Gave a reassuringly-good account when 2nd in a Carentan Class E a month back. Has yet to deliver on the main track and looks a minor place chance at best
12. **MAGNUM** - As tricky as they get but has ample ability. Has not raced since being disqualified at Les Sables-d'Olonne in mid-July, but clearly means business here and can make a big impact if Alexandre Abrivard keeps him trotting
13. **MAESTRO DES SARTS** - Finished 4th in a Class E at Enghien over 2,875m on 10 August 2026. Has started to get back in the game following a tough start to the season and although unlikely to impose, should nevertheless give an honest account

Summary: MALIBU (6), who must be given another chance and who will be re-shod for the occasion, MAGNUM (12), barefoot for the first time and capable of making amends, MIRACLE OF LOVE (8), who missed the break at Pornichet, the improving MERCATO DES FORGES (4), are all potential winners.
