

## R2 ENGHIEU [L-H]

### C1 - PRIX DE SAINT-GAUDENS - 2875m (a2m) - Class F Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- 1. KASSIANO D'IS** - Disqualified in a Class G over 2850m at Laon on 17 May. Was disqualified in both of his last two runs and is best overlooked. Will race unshod
- 2. KOMETE DU RADON** - Unplaced in a Class D over 2200m at Caen on 22 June. She has done little to indicate there will be more to come
- 3. JABALLA** - Unplaced in a Class G over 2400m at Amiens on 16 May. That was her first run in over two years and will need to show more. Will wear padded shoes all round
- 4. JONCTION HAUFOR** - Was 6th in a Class G over 3000m at Nantes on 22 June. has not performed well for quite a while and is best left alone
- 5. KRAC GAILLARD** - Won a Class D over 2750m at Ecommoy on 31 May. That was a convincing victory and he should have a say in the finish in his amateur debut. Will race with padded shoes on all feet
- 6. KIR ROYAL** - Finished 2nd in a Class G over 2400m at Amiens on 23 May. Held up in running but finished well. Will race unshod in front
- 7. IDOLE DE NAVARY** - A moderate 8th in a Class G over 2625m at Le Touquet on 20 June. She has ability on her day and racing without shoes this time, a resurgence is possible
- 8. JUSTE DE MELLERAY** - A poor 6th in a Class H over 2775m at Saint-Aubin on 14 June. Is not performing well enough to be considered
- 9. JAGUAR DU DOLLAR** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2700m at Graignes on 20 June. He won his penultimate start at Vincennes and should bounce back from that last race disqualification
- 10. JAZZ DES MANIS** - A promising 4th in a Class F over 2700m at Segre on 7 June. This gelding won his penultimate with Barbara Guenet and she will be back in the driver's seat for this event
- 11. INDIANO JIM** - Unplaced in a Class F over 2900m at Dozule on 14 May. Form has been poor and even racing unshod this time is unlikely to help
- 12. HECTOR DU MINON** - A mediocre 7th in a Class F over 2625m at Le Touquet on 20 June. Has shown little in the last year and would need to up his game to be considered
- 13. KINDY DU VIVIER** - Ran 4th in a Class D over 2100m at Vincennes on 6 June. She looks highly competitive in this field and could be the one to beat. Will race with padded shoes in front

**Summary:** This is the kind of field in which KINDY DU VIVIER (13) should be able to beat making her debut in this category. She is also teamed up with Aurore Renaudin which should further enhance her chances. KRAC GAILLARD (5) is another making his amateur debut and after a solid last win will provide the biggest threat. JAGUAR DU DOLLAR (9) should recover from his disqualification last time while KIR ROYAL (6) ran on well last time and will race unshod in front.

## C2 - PRIX DE DAMPIERRE - 2875m (a2m) - Class E Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 37,000

1. **L'ULKA DI LEONE** - Ran 2nd in a Class F over 2750m at Saint-Aubin on 14 June. Will have a lot more to do against this field
2. **LILI D'EVAILLES** - A moderate 6th in a Class F over 2700m at Graignes on 20 June. Will need to do more to be a threat
3. **LADY MAURE** - A reasonable 4th in a Class D over 2775m at Craon on 21 June. She is rarely far off the winner and could go close again
4. **LA BELLE MISS** - Finished 3rd in a Class F over 2850m at Durtal on 24 May. She has not run a bad race this year and her good run should continue
5. **LOTTA SUEDOISE** - Finished 7th in a Class R over 2850m at Vincennes on 16 June. That was her first run back from a break and there could be more to come
6. **LOVE WITH YOU** - Finished 2nd in a Class E over 2400m at Amiens on 11 June. She is capable of causing an upset if she can reproduce her best form
7. **LIA DE LA MORTRIE** - Won a Class F over 2950m at Vichy on 10 June. That win was highly impressive and she could have more to come
8. **LIBERTY AVENUE** - Finished 3rd in a Class E over 1800m at La Capelle on 24 May. That was her first run for a new stable so there was some improvement
9. **LAURA SISSI** - A strong 3rd in a Class E over 2200m at Caen on 18 June. She is back in good form and another win cannot be far off
10. **LADIVINA** - A mediocre 8th in a Class E over 2550m at Reims on 31 May. On recent form she is unlikely to be a threat in this field
11. **LUTTE IMPERIALE** - A decent 2nd in a Class E over 2200m at Caen on 18 June. She is a consistent performer and the good run should continue
12. **LINKIA DES APRES** - A moderate 6th in a Class E over 2850m at Laval on 11 June. She is not consistent but can run good races and is well positioned in this event

**Summary:** There are some strong contenders for top honours in this race and they are headed up LIA DE LA MORTRIE (7). She comes off a solid victory and could easily double up. LAURA SISSI (9) has been improving with each run and her turn should be coming up soon. LA BELLE MISS (4) has not won for some time but rarely runs a bad race, while consistent LUTTE IMPERIALE (11) has finished close up in her recent runs.

## C3 - PRIX DE NANGIS - 2250m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

- 1. M'AVEZ VOUS VU** - Ran 6th in a Class E over 2450m at Caen on 18 June. Has a lot more to do this time but will be racing unshod.
- 2. MICKEY DE CRENNES** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2150m at Enghien on 13 June. Was disqualified in his last start in a mounted race and will need to do more. Will have shoes in front
- 3. MERARU QUANDO** - Winner of a Class E over 2950m at Vichy on 13 June. Impressive victory he could quite easily double up together with Paul Ploquin and racing barefoot again
- 4. MAESTRO ECUS** - Finished 8th in a Class D over 2725m at Lisieux on 7 June. Returns to a mounted race with high hopes, fitted in padded shoes up front and unshod behind.
- 5. MARECHAL TURGOT** - Finished 8th in a Class D over 2700m at Vincennes on 28 April. That was a disappointing effort but he did win his previous two
- 6. MERCURY DELO** - A moderate 6th in a Class E over 2150m at Enghien on 13 June. He's making his debut in a mounted race and will need to prove himself
- 7. MOJITO DE BANVILLE** - Finished 5th in a Class D over 2450m at Caen on 22 June. Overall form has been disappointing and is best left alone. Will race with padded shoes in front
- 8. MAXOU DIGEO** - Looked mediocre when 6th in a Class F over 2450m at Caen on 27 May. Overall he has been disappointing of late and will need to up his game to feature
- 9. MONEY DI MALAVITA** - Winner of a Class E over 2700m at La Capelle on 14 June. He ran well enough in his previous mounted race last year before a misstep and looks an interesting runner in his comeback without shoes
- 10. MILLESIME DI VIN** - A strong 2nd in a Class E over 2950m at Vichy on 16 May. Has done well in harness racing and could do well in his debut under the saddle. Will race unshod behind

**Summary:** MAESTRO ECUS (4) will be having his first run under the saddle since June last year but he does have good form in mounted races and will make his return with strong expectations with a new shoe configuration. The main threat could come from MERARU QUANDO (3) who comes off a solid victory and will race unshod again. MILLESIME DI VIN (10) could be dangerous in his first mounted race while could shine in his return under the saddle.

## C4 - PRIX DE JANZE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. MOSCANTIDA PEAL** - Ran 5th in a Class R over 2850m at Vincennes on 12 May. Has run well at this level and should be competitive again
- 2. MY NAME IS BOND** - Finished 7th in a Class D over 2100m at Vincennes on 5 June. Reunited with Benjamin Rochard with whom he has run 3rd on the three other occasions and drops to this level for the first time
- 3. MANOU DU CHENE** - Disqualified in a Class D over 2700m at Vincennes on 12 June. She was runner-up to MALICE DU CHATAULT (12) in her penultimate start at this level so needs to be seriously
- 4. MACLANDER** - Disqualified in a Class D over 3025m at Nantes on 1 June. Finished 4th in a Claimer in his penultimate but has more to do this time. Will race fully shod
- 5. MILADY MADRIK** - A moderate 7th in a Class D over 2700m at Vincennes on 12 June. Another who placed in Claimers earlier but faces stronger. Will race unshod
- 6. MYRTILLE MARBOULA** - Winner of a Class R over 2175m at Vincennes on 21 April. Another who runs well at this level and must be considered
- 7. MAXOU DES IFS** - Disqualified in a Class C over 2700m at Vincennes on 19 June. Another who disappointed but is making his debut in this category and could show more
- 8. MERMOZ** - A reasonable 5th in a Class C over 2850m at Vincennes on 3 June. Has previously been competitive at this level so could finish in the places on a good day
- 9. MASSILIO BLOND** - A moderate 7th in a Class R over 2850m at Vincennes on 12 May. His form is just not good enough for him to trouble the market leaders
- 10. MANZANA** - Disqualified in a Class F Mounted race over 2950m at Vichy on 15 June. Drops in class this time but overall form has been disappointing
- 11. MIRABILIS VRIE** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2200m at Caen on 10 June. That was a disappointing run but he could show more dropping to a Claimer this time. Will race unshod
- 12. MALICE DU CHATAULT** - A decent 4th in a Class E over 2150m at Mauquenchy on 4 June. Won at this level in her penultimate start and should be competitive again
- 13. MALOU DU BOIS** - Disqualified in a Class E over 3000m at Salon De Provence on 30 May. Will have a tough task in this race

**Summary:** MIRABILIS VRIE (11) could be the runner to beat making his debut in a Claimer and racing unshod this time. But the same applies to MAXOU DES IFS (7) who could also prove a different proposition racing in this category for the first time. MALICE DU CHATAULT (12) won her penultimate start when dropping to this level while MANOU DU CHENE (3), who finished second in that race, is also worth considering.

## C5 - PRIX DE VESOUL - 2250m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 41,000

1. **LOUIS GAILLARD** - Offer competitive and finished third in a Class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 18 June. Might earn some minor money
2. **LORENCE CLOSJASMIN** - Disqualified last time out in a mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 30 May. Not easy to trust but cannot be ruled out
3. **LOVE D'AUTHISE** - Off form and finished 9th in a Class E harness at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
4. **LOOK DU PARCQ** - Has needed both runs this year and was disqualified last time out in a Class E harness at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. Better under the saddle and is not out of it
5. **LUCIOLA DE LOU** - Unreliable but was third in a Class E mounted race at Vichy over 2950m on 10 June. Yet to win but could earn some money
6. **LIGNE BLANCHE** - Kept to harness races so far and finished 8th in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. Capable of contesting the finish on best form
7. **LEGEND DREAM** - Has been in very good form this year and was runner-up in a Class F mounted race at Chartres over 2800m on 31 May. Big chance
8. **LEONARDO** - Not reliable but was fourth in a Class F mounted race at Chartres over 2800m on 31 May. Might play a minor role
9. **LAGUNA SECA** - Disqualified last time out in a Class E harness race at Lisieux over 2725m on 7 June. Has also also been disqualified in all three mounted races but must be respected in this line-up
10. **LUMINEUX** - A runner-up twice in last three starts, the latest in a Class D mounted race at Mondoubleau over 2825m on 14 June. Can make the frame once again

**Summary:** LEGEND DREAM (7), ultra-consistent and sure to run her race and looks the one to beat. LAGUNA SECA (9), partnered by Mathieu Mottier for her return to mounted company, makes plenty of appeal. Preference can be given to them ahead of LIGNE BLANCHE (6), who debuts in this discipline but has some form. LOOK DU PARCQ (4), racing barefoot for his return under the saddle can also get involved with the finish.

## C6 - PRIX DE LOUANNEC - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- 1. LARRY DU DOUBS** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 27 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 2. LEAD ME ON** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 22 June. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 3. LIEUTENANT COLUMBO** - Broke a long losing run with a victory in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 25 May. Has disqualification issues but might follow up if smart
- 4. LALDO LOUZEEN** - Has already won twice this year, including last time out in Class F at Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 25 May, Unreliable but is clearly not out of it
- 5. LOTUS DU RIB** - Successful last time out in Class E at Vire over 2700m on 18 May. Not reliable but is capable of doubling up
- 6. LE CHEF** - Disqualified last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 22 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 7. LESTER DU CHERISAY** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 11 June. Has disqualification issues but will be a danger if staying in stride
- 8. LOCKED UP** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class E mounted race at Nantes over 2275m on 1 June. Better under the saddle these days so others are preferred
- 9. LUCIUS DE PUCH** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 12 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 10. L'AS DE CAZOULENE** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 31 May. Much improved of late and could complete the hat-trick

**Summary:** L'AS DE CAZOULENE (10) has a golden opportunity here and bids for a hat-trick with strong claims, especially with Benjamin Rochard in the sulky. LOTUS DU RIB (5), once again racing barefoot, is an obvious threat. Last-time-out winners LALDO LOUZEEN (4) and LIEUTENANT COLUMBO (3) are both unreliable but they are quite capable of following up over this course and distance and must be respected for that.

## C7 - PRIX DE CAMBRAI - 2875m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 62,000

1. **NOVA ISTORIA CHOC** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class B over this course and distance on 13 June. Might earn some minor money
2. **NISSA LA BELLA** - Successful twice in last three starts, the latest in Class C at Vichy over 2150m on 11 May, Tougher task this time
3. **NOBEL DU RIB** - Has done little wrong so far and was runner-up in Class B at Vincennes over 2175m on 2 June. Tries further but deserves the utmost respect
4. **NICKNAME** - Disqualified last time out in Class A at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 May, Not reliable but is also not out of it
5. **NELATO BELLO** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in Class B over this track and trip on 13 June. Can be a threat once again
6. **NELSON DU PONT** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 May. Capable of completing the treble
7. **NEPTUNE CHANTE** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class B over this course and distance on 13 June. Can earn some more money
8. **NOTTINGEN** - Consistent so far and finished third in Class A at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
9. **NOT FOR FUN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 June. Others are preferred
10. **NELSON DE CHANLECY** - Clearly talented and has won three of five starts so far, including last time out in Class F at Vincennes over 2175m on 2 June. Just as good this distance and can follow up
11. **NATURALLY STAR** - Victorious in Class B at Vincennes over 2200m on 25 February. Has disqualification issues and is returning from a break so others make more appeal
12. **NAFI DE REVE D'OR** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Group 3 A Vincennes over 2700m on 5 June. Has disqualification issues and more is needed to score

**Summary:** NELSON DE CHANLECY (10) and NELSON DU PONT (6) both made a striking impression on their respective debuts at Vincennes and look set to battle it out for victory. NELSON DE CHANLECY (10) looks talent and gets the vote to score. NICKNAME (4), is not reliable and returns after a disqualification so must be given some respecte. The ultra-consistent NOBEL DU RIB (3) will try to challenge them and is also capable of shining once again

## C8 - PRIX DE PUTEAUX - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 46,000

- 1. KOPRIORO** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 10 June. Quite capable of winning a race of this nature
- 2. KENIDILLE** - Has only been fair of late and finished 5th in a Class F mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 3 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 3. JO DIBAH** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out in a Class G mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 18 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. KEPHYR D'ESTE** - Successful last time out in a Class G mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 4 June. In good shape and can follow up
- 5. KAKOU CAYENNAIS** - Not reliable and finished 5th in a Class D harness race at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 4 June. Capable of an upset on best form
- 6. KEPI ROUGE** - In good shape and finished runner-up in a Class H mounted race at Les Andelys over 2525m on 21 June. Could earn some more money
- 7. KAIROUAN GLAM** - Disqualified last time out in a Class D harness race at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 4 June. More consistent under the saddle and can contest the finish
- 8. KABIR BEDI** - Not reliable and was unplaced in a Class E harness race at Elbeuf over 2750m on 14 June. Has won his last two mounted races and can bounce back to score
- 9. JACAR DE LA DIVES** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Class F mounted race at Rambouillet over 2800m on 7 June. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 10. KRONOS DE VANDEL** - Disqualified last time out in Class D harness race at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. Capable of making the frame if at best
- 11. JACKSON HILL** - Did not show his best when 7th in a Class E harness race at La Capelle over 2750m on 14 June. Back in a mounted race after a long time. Might place
- 12. JUSQUIAME** - Off form and finished 9th in a Class F mounted race at Rambouillet over 2800m on 7 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 13. JAZZ PETTEVINIERE** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out in a Class F mounted race at Chartres over 2800m on 7 June. Has won over this course and distance and could surprise

**Summary:** A very tricky lucky last race and a number of them hold a winning chance. KABIR BEDI (8) puts his unbeaten record under the saddle on the line and sets the standard, though he will need to be wary of KAIROUAN GLAM (7), who is capable of going very close on a going day. KOPRIORO (1), racing barefoot for the first time, and the inconsistent but talented KRONOS DE VANDEL (10) also enter calculations.
