C1 - PRIX DES BAINS DE MER - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 20,100

1. **BOIS DORE** - A three-year-old gelding by Toronado out of Kea who is making his debut. His dam won twice in 25 starts. Could need this experience
2. **BORSALINO** - A three-year-old gelding by Dariyan out of Surprise who is making his debut. His dam never raced in France. Could need this experience
3. **ON THE DOUBLE** - A three-year-old gelding by Reliable Man out of Ragazza who is making his debut. His dam won twice in 13 starts. Could earn some money
4. **ASENOVGRAD** - A three-year-old colt by Kircaali out of Armarante who is making his debut. His dam never raced in France. Others make more appeal
5. **BELLO CONDOR** - A three-year-old gelding by Ectot out of Malagueta who is making his debut. His dam never won a race after 14 starts
6. **FRANTONIO** - A three-year-old colt by Galiway out of Olympe who is making his debut. His dam won twice in just 8 starts. Could contest the finish
7. **ASTROFIGHT** - A three-year-old gelding by Counterattack out of Alwina who is making his debut. His dam won a Listed race in Germany. Monitor the betting
8. **AS CELESTE** - A three-year-old gelding by Shamalgan out of Celesteville who is making his debut. His dam never won a race after 11 starts. Others make more appeal
9. **STAR'S SOPRAN** - A three-year-old colt by Starman out of Sopran Verne who is making his debut. His dam never raced in France
10. **ZITOLOGUE** - A three-year-old gelding by Nathaniel out of Zagzig who is making his debut. His dam won once in 13 starts. Can be a threat
11. **DARYOURA** - A three-year-old filly by Dubawi out of Dariyza who is making her debut. Her dam won three times in 12 starts, including a Listed race. A niece to Arc de Triomphe winner Daryz. Can score
12. **ELLIE'S SECRET** - A three-year-old filly by Dschingis Secret out of Dylanelle who is making her debut. Her dam won 7 of her 69 starts. Can contest the finish
13. **LHOTSE** - A three-year-old filly by Starman out of My Sharona who is making her debut. Her dam never raced in France. Can make the frame
14. **TRUE DAWN** - A three-year-old filly by Dubawi out of Half Light. Her dam won 3 of her 6 starts, including a Group 3. Should fight out the finish
15. **PHILAE** - A three-year-old filly by Toronado out of Age Of Refinement who is making her debut. Her dam never raced in France. Others make more appeal
16. **TREZY CREME** - A three-year-old filly by The Grey Gatsby out of Chantilly Creme who is making her debut. Her dam won twice, including a Listed race. Can make the frame

Summary: A nice to Daryz, DARYOURA (11), a beautifully bred filly from an outstanding family, represents the formidable Barzalona/Graffard/Aga Khan combination and is taken to make a winning start in this contest for late newcomers. She is preferred to the Wertheimer-owned ZITOLOGUE (10), who is also likely to attract plenty of support. By Dubawi, TRUE DAWN (14) is another with the pedigree to make a significant impact. LHOTSE (13), from the G rald Moss  stable, and ON THE DOUBLE (3) complete the shortlist.

C2 - PRIX DE FROMAINVILLE - 1800m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 24,700

1. **ANY MOON** - In good form and was runner-up at Hamburg-Horn over 2200m on 2 July. Should contest the finish once again
2. **DIOPTASE** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 28 June. Has claims in this line-up
3. **ZACAPO** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a claimer at ParisLongchamp over 2100m on 15 June. Might play a minor role at very best
4. **SEA POETRY** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a Listed race at Chantilly over 2400m on 14 June. Capable of contesting the finish
5. **LITTLE LION** - Finished 7th on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on 28 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
6. **LAKOTA BEAU** - Returned to form and finished 3rd in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 5 July. Capable of making the frame
7. **CURRAGH CAMP** - Victorious last time out in a Conditions race at Compiègne over 1800m on 10 July. In good shape and could contest the finish once again
8. **CLIMATE CHANGE** - Consistent and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 5 July. Has claims in this line-up
9. **AVANT L'ORAGE** - A winner of a claimer at Lyon-La-Soie over 2400m on 1 December 2025. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run

Summary: CLIMATE CHANGE (8) made the running when runner-up at Saint-Cloud last time, finding only Mont De Soleil too strong, and that form sets a solid standard here. A winner on his sole previous visit to Dieppe, he can again fight out the finish with CURRAGH CAMP (7), the Francis-Henri Graffard-trained colt who has quickly regained top form after an extended absence. LAKOTA BEAU (6) has been progressing nicely and looks capable of making the frame, while the consistent ANY MOON (1), who has been faultless in Germany this season, also commands respect.

C3 - PRIX GALORAMA - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Class 3 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 25,900

1. **RINASCERO** - In good form and finished 3rd in a handicap at Compiègne over this distance on 10 July. Can get involved with the finish once again
2. **LIKE IT OR NOT** - Victorious in a Conditions race at Nancy over 2500m on 20 May. Returns from a short break and is not out of it
3. **EXTRAPOL** - Finished 4th in a claimer at Chateaubriant over 2650m on 21 July. Probably needs to do a bit more to score this time
4. **LE ROI LEON** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 2000m on 19 July. Can go one place better
5. **KHAMEPHIS GAME** - Successful in a handicap at Nantes over this distance on 1 July. Carries a penalty but must be respected in this line-up
6. **TORRONE** - Unreliable but was a runner-up in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 26 June. Can be a threat to these rivals if in the right mood
7. **KING KARA** - Finished 8th in a handicap at Compiègne over 2800m on 10 July. Unreliable and others are preferred
8. **SCREEN SHOT** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 2400m on 14 July. Can win a race of this nature
9. **SEVENNA'S BAY** - Has only been modest of late and finished 5th in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine over 2200m on 6 July. Needs to do a bit more to win
10. **LE GAST** - Finished 10th in a handicap at Deauville over 2500m on 6 February. returns from a break and could need this run
11. **TIC TAC** - In good form and finished 3rd in a handicap at Compiègne over 2800m on 10 July. Can get into the mix of things once again
12. **BEAUTIFUL MEMORY** - Not disgraced when 4th in a handicap at Clairefontaine over 2900m on 3 July. Capable of making the frame
13. **LE ROI DAVID** - Finished 11th in a conditions race at Compiègne over 1800m on 10 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score

Summary: SCREEN SHOT (8) landed the second division of this handicap 12 months ago and is expected to strip fitter for his recent reappearance. TIC TAC (11), unbeaten in two starts at Dieppe, appears to have settled in well since joining Yann Barberot and commands plenty of respect. RINASCERO (1) arrives in excellent form and is another leading contender. LIKE IT OR NOT (2), making his handicap debut, LE ROI LEON (4), who is becoming increasingly well treated, are others to consider.

- 1. MAPWORLD** - Finished 5th on debut in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine over this distance on 6 July. Capable of improvement and has a place chance
- 2. SACRIFICE** - Finished 7th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 15 March. Did better on debut and could be a threat if fit from a break
- 3. WIL'DREAM** - Finished 8th on debut in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine over 2200m on 11 July. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 4. FREEHEARTED** - Finished 6th on debut at Clairefontaine over this distance on 6 July. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 5. MAGUELONE** - Finished 3rd on debut at this track over 1800m on 6 June. Steps up in distance and could make the frame once again
- 6. LEDESMA** - Consistent and finished 3rd over this track and trip on 9 July. Should fight out the finish once again
- 7. MICOCOULIER STREET** - Has some fair form and finished 5th at Saint-Cloud over this distance on 5 July. Might play a minor role
- 8. SPIELER** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1900m on 27 June. Is not out of it
- 9. CLAIREMON** - Consistent and finished 3rd at Prague over 2400m on 21 June. Tougher task this time around
- 10. NABOB** - Finished 3rd in both his starts, the latest at Hamburg-Horn over 2200m on 4 July. Has a place chance
- 11. SOUDYA** - Threatening to score and was runner-up in a Conditions race over this course and distance on 9 July. Can go one place better

Summary: LEDESMA (6) has finished on the podium in all four career starts and is presented with an excellent opportunity to get off the mark. Well backed on debut, SACRIFICE (2) finished a creditable third in a useful-looking contest before failing to cope with heavy ground next time, and he is well worth monitoring on his return following gelding. SOUDYA (11) and SPIELER (8), both of whom have already shown their liking for the Dieppe track, look the chief contenders for the minor honours.

21,100**

- 1. GLORI LEADER** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a handicap at Vittel over 2100m on 6 July. Can be competitive once again
- 2. HOT COLD** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a handicap at Argentan over 2500m on 10 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 3. EASTERN STAR** - Off form and finished 16th in a handicap at Compiègne over 2000m on 13 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. SPLENDINO** - A runner-up four times in a row, the latest in a handicap at Angers over 2300m on 8 June. Can contest the finish yet again
- 5. MISS BRESIL DELF** - Off form and finished 10th in a handicap at Clairefontaine over 2900m on 3 July. Others make much more appeal
- 6. NICK BOUTIQUE** - Showed some improvement and was runner-up in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 14 July. Can go one place better
- 7. PRINCESS KARA** - - Not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 8 July. Successful before that and is not out of it
- 8. BOUSSANT** - Finished 7th in a handicap at Compiègne over 2400m on 10 July. Can do better and might make frame
- 9. MISTER POWER** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a handicap at this track over 3000m on 18 July. Might earn some minor money once again
- 10. STARLIGHT** - -Unreliable and finished 9th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 8 July. Capable of an upset on best form
- 11. MAVILLA TROIS** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a handicap at Compiègne over 2400m on 10 July. Can be a threat when in the right mood
- 12. BORCANO** - Successful in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 2000m on 2 July. Carries a penalty but might well follow up
- 13. KAPO ROSSO** - Has only been moderate of late and finished 6th in a handicap at Deauville over 1900m on 12 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score

Summary: SPLENDINO (4) has filled the runner-up spot on each of his last four starts and, with another wholehearted effort expected, looks capable of going one better this time. GLORI LEADER (1) has been progressing nicely and rates a major threat. NICK BOUTIQUE (6) shaped with plenty of promise last time and merits. BOUSSANT (8) is better than his last start shows and is worth another chance.

C6 - PRIX DU QUEBEC - 2400m (a1m1/2) - TURF - - Flat - EUR € 20,100

1. GOOD TIMING - Finished 8th on debut in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine over 2400m on 6 July. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal

2. JANNET - In good form and finished 3rd at Saint-Cloud over this distance on 24 March. Returns from a break but can score if smart

3. STORY WAY - Has been a runner-up in all three starts, the latest in a Conditions race at this track over 3000m on 23 June. Should be a threat yet again

4. KAISERROSE - Finished 7th on debut in a Conditions race at Le Mans over 1950m on 6 October 2025. Returns from a break and could need this run

5. FIVE LANDS - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine over 2200m on 11 July. Might play a minor role

6. MAJARA - Finished 5th on debut in a Conditions race at Cholet over 2950m on 30 June. Capable of improvement and might play a minor role

7. THE LITTLE SWAN - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a handicap at Chantilly over 2000m on 7 July. Capable of better and can be a threat

8. ARANYANI - Has run well in both starts, the latest when 3rd in a Conditions race at Deauville over 1900m on 27 June. be right there at the finish

9. ESTIMA - Finished 6th on debut in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 1 May. Capable of improvement and has a place chance

10. PAIUTE - Improving and was runner-up in a Conditions race at Clairefontaine over 2200m on 11 July. Can get into the mix of things once again

Summary: André Fabre fields a strong hand here, with the returning JANNET (2) looking the pick of his pair. A staying filly with plenty of scope, she should not be long in getting her head in front. She is unlikely to have things all her own way, however, with THE LITTLE SWAN (7), who has shaped better than the bare results suggest on her last two outings, and the progressive PAIUTE (10) both posing serious threats. ARANYANI (8) is a filly of considerable ability and should appreciate the return to this trip.

Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 50,900

- 1. LOVE IS GOLD** - Not disgraced when 5th in a handicap at Angers over 2300m on 8 June. Can earn some more money
- 2. ZULU WARRIOR** - Victorious in a conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 2400m on 14 July, Has tended to struggle in handicaps but cannot be ruled out
- 3. DOURIANN** - In good shape and finished 4th in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly on 22 June. Can make the frame once again
- 4. MAIA STAR** - In good shape and finished 3rd in a Conditions race at Deauville over 2500m on 8 April. Returns from a break but can be a threat if fit enough
- 5. RAM SEA** - Successful in a handicap at Angers over 2300m on 8 June. Carries a penalty but does have a place chance
- 6. I GOT RHYTHM** - Returned from a break and was runner-up in a Conditions race at ParisLongchamp over 2400m on 18 June. Can go one place better
- 7. SERENISSIMUS** - Disappointing last run when 16th in a handicap at Chantilly over 2000m on 31 May. In good form before that and can score
- 8. ACOTANGO** - A runner-up in a claimer at Evreux over 2500m on 15 April. Returns from a break but must be respected in this line-up
- 9. KING TREZY** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a handicap at Angers over 2300m on 8 June. Can be a threat on best form
- 10. MR TEE** - Four wins in last five starts, including last time out in a handicap at Compiegne over 2400m on 10 July. Can score again
- 11. SAPRISTI** - - Finished 6th in a handicap at Compiegne over 2800m on 20 June. Capable of better and might earn some minor money
- 12. SARASTRO** - A winner of a handicap at this track over 1800m on 18 July. Carries a penalty and may be at best that shorter distance
- 13. WILLY WINNER** - In good shape and finished 3rd in a claimer at Compiegne over 2400m on 10 July. Tougher task but might play a minor role
- 14. TAMYZ** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a handicap at Saint-Cloud over 2000m on 2 June. Capable of making the frame
- 15. SPRING EVE** - Successful in a handicap at Chantilly over 2400m on 19 July. Carries a penalty but is not out of it
- 16. NEPALAIS** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a claimer over this track and trip on 23 June. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: SERENISSIMUS (7) showed plenty of promise in his first three starts in conditions races. He found wanting on his handicap debut and he has since been freshened up and eased 3lb by the handicapper. MR TEE (10) has been faultless since returning to action and rates the chief danger alongside KING TREZY (9), who looks capable of being competitive from his current mark. ZULU WARRIOR (2) arrives on the back of a confidence-boosting victory. TAMYZ (14) has shaped better than the bare results suggest on his last two outings and, provided things fall his way, has the ability to make the frame.

1. **MISS TECH** - Finished 6th in a handicap at this track over 2400m on 13 July. Can win a race of this nature
2. **MERCI CHERI** - Finished 7th in a handicap at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 6 June. Better judged on a good penultimate run. Can contest the finish
3. **THE WHEEL OF TIME** - Unplaced in a Maiden at Compiègne over 1,800m on 16 July. Has not shown much so far and others are preferred
4. **STOP THE ROCK** - Has struggled of late and finished 14th in a handicap at Chantilly over 2000m on 7 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
5. **STEPHANIE** - Unplaced in a Maiden at Compiègne over 1,800m on 16 July. Has not shown much but can improve trying a handicap
6. **SILVAROLE FAL** - Successful in a Class 3 handicap at Dax over 2,300m on 8 July. Tougher task this time but can earn some money
7. **NOTRE ANGLAISE** - Finished 8th in a handicap at this track over 2400m on 13 July. Could like this shorter distance and is not out of it
8. **STIR CRAZY** - Finished 4th in a claimer at Saint-Cloud over 2400m on 8 July. Showed some improvement and can make the frame
9. **PURPLE RAY** - Finished 10th in a handicap at this track over 1800m on 9 July. Has yet to show much and others are preferred
10. **CAPITOL HILL** - In good form and was runner-up in a claimer at Senonnes over 2100m on 2 July. Can get involved with the finish once again
11. **AMELIORE** - Successful in a claimer at this track over 2400m on 9 July. Not reliable but cannot be ruled out of more success
12. **TOLEO** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a handicap at Chantilly over 2000m on 19 June. Capable of an upset on best form
13. **POET DE VEGA** - Has not shown much so far and finished 9th at Prague over 1600m on 10 May. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
14. **SPOTTED TAIL** - Has only been modest of late, finishing 7th in a Maiden at Dieppe over 2,400m on 9 July. More is needed to score
15. **ZARALADY** - Finished 12th in a handicap at ParisLongchamp over 3000m on 2 July. Off form and needs to find a few lengths to score
16. **SONDER EDITION** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a claimer at this track over 2400m on 9 July. Might play a minor role at very best

Summary: A very tricky lucky last race. MISS TECH (1) remains a maiden but shaped with promise last time when not enjoying the best of luck and looks to be sitting on a workable mark so she gets the nod in a race lacking depth. MERCI CHERI (2), now partnered for the first time by Pierre-Charles Boudot, commands respect. Stablemate NOTRE ANGLAISE (7), from the Stéphane Wattel yard, could benefit from this drop back in trip. STIR CRAZY (8) is on an upward curve and is an interesting booking with Cristian Demuro taking over.
