C1 - GRAND PRIX ANJOU-MAINE - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 100,000

1. **LIGHT MY FIRE** - Starts for the first time since being disqualified in a Class C at Cholet over 2,800m on 27 April. Is undeniably talented, and will be competitively-shod, but is going to need the race
2. **KAMEHAMEHA** - Out of the picture in both starts since returning from his break. Will go barefoot this time but others still preferred
3. **RIKITA JP** - Quality mare but can prove a handful, just as she did in a Feurs Gr.3 2 weeks ago. Imposed on her Laval debut earlier in the year and, with application, should again prove competitive
4. **HURRICANE CARTER** - Handy sort but has not been seen out since early-June and will be race-rusty
5. **JILORD VIVA** - Made up for La Capelle performance when romping in a Group III at Feurs over 2,850m on 16 September. Tends to go well for Eric Raffin who can be forgiven for feeling bullish. Chance
6. **INVICTUS MADIBA** - Finished 2nd in a Class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 6 July. Has not been seen since though and, even racing barefoot, is not a priority
7. **L'AS DESBOIS** - Third in a Group I Criterium des 5 Ans at Vincennes over 2,850m on 12 September. Won over course and distance last time here and from the front row looks superior to his elders. Claim
8. **HORATIUS D'ELA** - Finished 8th in a Group III at Saint Malo over 2,950m on 5 August. Ran 3rd in a Gr.3 over course and distance in June though and, from the front line, will have his supporters
9. **IBISCUS MAN** - Disqualified in a Group III at Enghien over 2,875m on 4 July. Has not been seen out since but is competitively-shod, enjoys a terrific entry, and deserves to take his chances
10. **GENDREEN** - Faces a much stiffer task than he did when sixth over 2600m at Victoria Park a month ago and is unlikely to be troubling the judge
11. **HANNIBAL TUILERIE** - Ran 6th in a Class A at Alencon over 2,625m on 6 September after having imposed at Agon a week earlier. On this occasion, though, will have no possible chance
12. **JABALPUR** - Unplaced in a Class A at Alencon over 2,625m on 6 September. Springs the occasional surprise, but this is not one of those occasions
13. **HARLEY GEMA** - Finished 5th in Group I Grand Prix de Wallonie Belgique at Mons over 2,840m on 19 September. Has nothing to prove at this level and even from the second line can finish close
14. **IDEAL LIGNERIES** - Finished 2nd in a Group II at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 1,609m on 22 August, confirming his run at Argentan. Is better over a shorter trip but in current form is hard to ignore
15. **INMAROSA** - Finished 6th in a Group II at La Capelle over 1,800m on 2 September. Has not been at her sharpest lately, and incurs the penalty, but is still not one to be overlooked

Summary: Third in the Critérium des 5 Ans earlier in the month, L'AS DESBOIS (7) has been re-shod and from the front row can make this his own. JILORD VIVA (5), authoritative winner of the Gr.3 Grand Prix du Centre-Est at Feurs last time, looks the main threat. RIKITA JP (3) ran a blinder in the Gr.2 Prix de Washington in early-summer, and will be reunited with Matthieu Abrivard. HARLEY GEMA (13), drops in category after running 5th in the Grand Prix de Wallonie, and is already a multiple Group-winner with Benjamin Rochard.

C2 - PRIX PATAPAIN - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. NIGHT SESSION** - Made up for Erbray disqualification when 3rd in a Class E over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Is a filly of ample ability and can again finish close
- 2. NEIGE DU KASTEL** - Finished 3rd in a Class E at Ecommoy over 2,750m on 13 September, following on from a pair of 2nd places in August, and it is only a matter of time before she gets off the mark
- 3. NAYAJACQ** - Has not been seen out since running 8th in an Enghien monte Class E 2 months ago. Is shod this time and will not be over-stretched
- 4. NEMROD GEDE** - Ran 4th in a Pornichet Class E in late-August prior to running 6th in a Class E on turf 10 days ago and cannot be considered a priority
- 5. NINJA POTERIE** - Just missed out in a Pornichet Class E on 19 September. Sports pads again and can get his head in front this time
- 6. NIKITA DE BEAUM** - Finished 4th in a Class E over course and distance on 10 September. Finds herself in superior company this time and is unlikely to cause an upset
- 7. NEVERS DE BELLANDE** - Finished 8th in a monte Class D at Vincennes over 2,175m on 8 September, when preparing for this. Sports pads this time and should have a reasonable chance of making first five
- 8. NARDECH DE HOUELLE** - Eliminated on re-entry in a Vincennes monte Class D last week. Is shod as he was when victorious at Graignes in May but is still not an obvious choice
- 9. NEW CHAPTER** - Put away after being disqualified in a Clairefontaine Class E on 12 July. Has ample ability, and comes here fresh, and with application can make his presence felt
- 10. NIN DES BOSCH** - Finished 3rd in a Class D at Chatelaillon over 2,500m on 3 August. Comes here fresh but will be shod and best to keep one's powder dry
- 11. NACRE DU GERS** - Back under harness after running 8th in a Vincennes monte Class D a fortnight ago and will have other priorities
- 12. NEWTON TUILERIE** - Has not been seen out since finishing 5th in a Class C at Enghien over 2,875m on 23 June. Has previously won under these conditions but will pose no danger on comeback
- 13. NOTA PRIMO** - Handy element starting for first time since running 4th in a Vichy Class C on 10 June and best to hold off
- 14. NAMOUR DAB** - Quality colt making first appearance since finishing unplaced in a Group II at Vincennes over 2,700m on 13 December 2025 and will be race-rusty
- 15. NOCTURNE DE BUSSET** - Third in a monte Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 15 September. Is here for reasons of conditioning and can be ruled out
- 16. NAXOS DIBAH** - Third in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 22 September. Benefits from a good entry here, has been knocking at the door, and looks the nearest threat to NINJA POTERIE (5)
- 17. NELSON SWIFT** - Disqualified in a Class B at Vincennes over 2,175m on 11 April. Has bags of ability but has not been seen out since and is going to need the race
- 18. NESTINA** - Victorious in a monte Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 15 September, 11 days after running 2nd in a Class F over course and distance, and returns to the discipline ideally-engaged and with a good hand to play

Summary: Good second at Pornichet recently, NINJA POTERIE (5) will be reunited with Eric Raffin and has a realistic chance of winning this. NAXOS DIBAH (16) will be fully-fit by now and can also play a prominent role. NEIGE DU KASTEL (2), who has plenty of ability, should also acquit herself well, as should NIGHT SESSION (1) who caught the eye here recently.

C3 - PRIX TIEGO D'ETANG - 2850m (a2m) - - Mounted - EUR € 27,000

- 1. KAMELIA DE JEAN** - Made decent monte debut on 25 August when 4th in a Class G at La Capelle. Takes on a serious lot this time, however, and will have few friends
- 2. JAZZ MELODY** - Ran 6th in a harness Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 28 July. Disqualified on sole outing under the saddle and even with 4 pads fitted can be confidently ruled out
- 3. LOOPING DU PERRE** - Just missed out on the three-timer when runner-up in a Class E over course and distance on 10 September. Has been in cracking form since the spring and can bring the fight to KAMIKAZE (8)
- 4. KEEPER PERRINE** - Finished 7th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,850m on 17 September. Has placed just once in 8 starts this year and can be passed over
- 5. MISTER LION** - Looked very ordinary on his return to the discipline last week when seventh in a Vincennes Class C and is unlikely to create an upset
- 6. LICAR SOMOLLI** - Runner-up in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,700m on 22 September. Ran 3rd behind LOOPING DU PERRE (3) here 12 days earlier and must be respected
- 7. KOREA** - Has been out of sorts since returning in June but is significantly better than recent results would suggest and it is just a question of time before she returns to form. Attention
- 8. KAMIKAZE** - Pulled off the monte hat-trick when successful in a Class G at Mauquenchy over 2,850m on 10 September, and has every chance of making it 4 on the trot
- 9. JUSQUIAME** - Third in a Class E at Pornichet over 2,725m on 19 September. Is not the most generous of horses but, with form maintained, could pick up another cheque
- 10. KAIROUAN GLAM** - Followed up 3 straight sanctions with 4th in a Class H at Blain-Bouvron-Le Gâvre 10 days ago. Hind shoes off this time and, with application, will be no pushover
- 11. KING DE GINAI** - Seldom far from faulting but ran fine 3rd in a Mauquenchy Class F on 5 August and returns to the code with a potentially good hand to play
- 12. LION DES ISLES** - Finished 2nd in a Class C at Enghien over 2,250m on 26 July. Has excelled since switching codes and is thoroughly capable of making the frame once more
- 13. KASBAH PERRINE** - Encouraged at Enghien early last month but has twice failed to confirm and her Laval record is nothing to write home about

Summary: With four wins and a second place from his last five starts under the saddle, KAMIKAZE (8) and will be no soft touch. LOOPING DU PERRE (3), almost as effective, looks the main danger. LION DES ISLES (12) has the quality to feature in this company if at his best. Reassuring on turf recently, KAIROUAN GLAM (10) will be shod to preference this time and will have his chances if focused.

C4 - PRIX BLEUBLANC - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. MERRY DE MALABRY** - Ran 2nd at Meslay-du-Maine in late-July, before coming 6th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 4 September. Did win her only start under these conditions though and cannot be discounted
- 2. MY DARLING HAUFOR** - Start for the first time since finishing second in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 25 February. Is in conditioning-mode and best to hold off
- 3. MAYBE DU CEBE** - Third in a Class D at Enghien over 2,250m on 10 August. Is proven at Laval but is here for reasons of conditioning this time and is not a concern
- 4. MEDEE DU VIVIER** - Unplaced in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 4 September. Has been disappointing on the whole this summer and must first get her house in order
- 5. METSUYANE ERA** - Won a Class F at Caen over 2,450m on 27 May, making it 2 on the trot, but has not been seen since and will be shod for comeback
- 6. MINUS DE CHENU** - Finished 6th in a Class D at Pornichet over 2,725m on 18 July. Has been disappointing since placing in a Vincennes Class D in May and, even though reconfigured, will have little to offer
- 7. MARVA CALENDES** - Unplaced in a Class C over course and distance on 19 August. Has been fitted with a fresh configuration, but is still not an obvious choice
- 8. MEDICI DE BUSSET** - Finished 10th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 1 September. Already twice a winner here this term and must be considered a contender
- 9. MAMZELL L'AVENTURE** - Unplaced in a Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2,650m on 21 July. Tends to show more in the other code and will not be given a hard race
- 10. MILAN DU BOSQUET** - Finished a reassuring, but surprise, second in a Class B at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,750m on 3 September. Races shod again and, with form maintained, can contest the finish
- 11. MOSTRA DE CHANLECY** - Successful in a Class B at Chartres over 2,825m on 11 September, 3 weeks after running 3rd in a Class C over track and trip, and in current form is hard to ignore
- 12. MELCHIOR JAMES** - Unplaced in a Class B at Rambouillet over 2,800m on 20 September. Will be competitively-shod this time and is unlikely to return home empty-handed
- 13. MISTER LOVE JULMA** - Won two of last three, lastly a Class B at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,750m on 3 September. Has turned a corner over recent months and will be well-backed to win this
- 14. MELIA BARBES** - Serious future prospect but has not been seen out since finishing 3rd in a Class A at Vincennes over 2,100m on 19 February and is going to need the race
- 15. MARIO DE LA VALLEE** - Disqualified on re-entry in a Rambouillet Class B 10 days ago, but is preparing for a monte campaign and will have nothing to offer
- 16. MALIUM** - Finished 5th in a Class B at Vincennes over 2,700m on 12 September. Faces a less-exalted bunch on this occasion and, considering the entry, must be respected
- 17. MY LADY CASTELLE** - Ran 6th in a Group II at Vincennes over 2,700m on 6 June. Makes her first appearance since and is not about to spring any surprises
- 18. MILORD DE BUY** - Successful in a Class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 22 August. Has evident ability but the 50m handicap will do him no favours

Summary: MISTER LOVE JULMA (13) has improved considerably since starting to race barefoot and could take another step forward. His runner-up at Les Sables-d'Olonne, MILAN DU BOSQUET (10), can, however, reverse the placings. Nicely-engaged, MALIUM (16) was very convincing at Vincennes and holds a decent chance, as does the superbly-entered MEDICI DE BUSSET (8) who won twice under these conditions in June. Shod to preference, MELCHIOR JAMES (12) can build on his encouraging comeback.

C5 - PRIX VIKING DE VAL - 2850m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. INDIENNE DE VAL** - Ran 3rd at Segre on 13 September but failed to confirm when 7th in a Class E at Pornichet over 2,725m 6 days later, and is not about to shake things up
- 2. JOYAU DE JANZE** - Useful individual with a pair of runs under his belt following the layoff but would be preferred in the other code
- 3. J'ADORE CELESTE** - Has been most impressive this term, most recently 3rd in a Vichy Class F 11 days ago. Has no Laval references but is reunited with Mathieu Mottier who won with him 2 months ago and can expect the lion's share of support
- 4. JOKER DE LA CRIERE** - Fourth in a Class F at La Capelle over 2,750m on 21 September. Is not a contender but is present condition should have the wherewithal to get a look in
- 5. JOKER DES LANDES** - Won 2 from 3 before finishing runner-up in a Class E at Redon over 2,950m on 6 September. Is arguably better on turf but in present shape will generate significant interest
- 6. JACKSON D'ECAJEUL** - Was unable to complete the hat-trick when unluckily disqualified in a Saint-Malo Class F last Sunday, and Mathias Dudouit will be eager to set the record straight
- 7. JOKER GES** - Was duly rewarded with victory in a Class H at Blain over 3,200m on 20 September. Failed to deliver on sole Laval start but in current condition is easy to recommend for a place on the podium
- 8. JUST D'ACADIE** - Finished 11th in a Class F at Les Sables D'Olonne over 2,650m on 3 September, a fortnight after coming 3rd in a Class F over course and distance, but is still being aimed too high
- 9. JAG HAUFOR** - Makes first appearance since finishing 11th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 22 May. Is clearly in conditioning-mode and can be passed over
- 10. JUSTICIA SMART** - Tricky mare going barefoot following a Pornichet freshener 11 days ago. Starts on second line but with Matthieu Abrivard in the bike, must not be overlooked
- 11. JAGUAR DJOB** - Ran 2nd in a Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 21 August but failed to confirm when 5th in an Ecommoy Class E 2.5 weeks ago, and is unlikely to influence the outcome
- 12. JOYEUX NONNA** - Returns to a hard surface following an excellent stint on turf. Should take well to the Laval profile and warrants respect
- 13. JAFLOSA GIRL** - Has not been seen out since being disqualified in a Class D over course and distance on 26 February. Shoes fitted for comeback and is not a concern
- 14. JEWEL DE LA COTE** - Was unable to secure the hat-trick when unplaced in a Divonne Class B in early-August. Is reunited with Eric Raffin for whom he won twice in the spring and must be taken seriously

Summary: J'ADORE CELESTE (3), impressive this summer, reunites with Mathieu Mottier with strong claims. In excellent shape but unlucky at the start at Saint-Malo, JACKSON D'ECAJEUL (6) deserves another chance. Nicely-in on the front row, JOKER GES (7) can continue his productive run. JOKER DES LANDES (5) seldom puts a foot out of line and is not about to start now.

C6 - PRIX MONDIAL DU LION - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 27,000

1. **LAGUNE** - Returns to the discipline after running seventh in a monte Class E over course and distance three weeks ago. Races barefoot this time, with Eric Raffin in the bike, and will have her supporters
2. **LASSIE** - Valiant runner-up in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,850m on 10 September, confirming her Vichy performance. Has already won for Mathieu Mottier and is patently on the point of doing so again
3. **LA STAR** - Useful on a good day but failed to make any impact in a Vincennes Class D a fortnight ago and is unlikely to spice things up
4. **LOULIANA DE VANDEL** - Unplaced in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,100m on 17 September. Has not made the frame since early-May and is unlikely to change her ways
5. **LOREZZA ERA** - Finished 4th, against the boys, in a Class B at Argentan over 2,875m on 23 September. Has been knocking at the door over recent months and will be justifiably well-supported
6. **LADY HAUFOR** - Quality individual making her first appearance since coming 3rd in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,850m on 20 February and can be ruled out
7. **LADY DES ARRIS** - Ran 6th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,100m on 24 August, a fortnight after coming 3rd in an Enghien Class D. Reverts to a previous formula and is not an obvious choice
8. **LETTY DE BEYLEV** - Ran 2nd in an Argentan Class E in mid-August, 12 days before coming 5th in a monte conditioning Class F. Is clearly in shape and is unlikely to be far off the mark
9. **LOOK AT ME LULU** - Imposed on turf at Mondoubleau in mid-June but has done nothing noteworthy in either code since and can be confidently passed over
10. **LIBERTE DE L'AUNAY** - Finished 5th in a Class F at Chateau Du Loir over 3,750m on 26 July. Has not been seen out since but is barefoot and reunited with Matthieu Abrivard who won with her in May and ought to be retained
11. **LANISTER SMART** - Victorious in a Class E at Cabourg over 2,750m on 11 August. Is plainly in rude health but tends to go better right handed and looks a minor place prospect at best
12. **LA MITIDJA** - Finished 10th in a Class D at Cabourg over 2,750m on 31 July. Is never the easiest of horses to gauge and can expect to have few takers
13. **LADY DE SAFRAN** - Fourth in a Class E at Angers over 3,125m on 9 September. Is a good, consistent mare with form under these conditions and must not be underestimated
14. **LESDY MAGODA** - Runner-up in a Class F at Chateau Du Loir over 3,750m on 26 July. Is plainly close to her race, enjoys a fine entry, and looks competitive
15. **LA VISTA HAUFOR** - Useful mare but has not been seen out since being disqualified in a Class C at Vincennes over 2,850m on 20 February and will need the run
16. **LA CALLAS** - Was unable to confirm her Vibraye performance when seventh in an Angers Class E three weeks ago and others easier to back

Summary: With just €6,000 separating the field, this should prove a tightly-contested affair. LASSIE (2), who has twice come close recently, could well be rewarded for her efforts this time. The returning LESDY MAGODA (14), a mare of some class, and LOREZZA ERA (5), taking on just her own sex this time, are both place candidates. LADY DE SAFRAN (13), barefoot this time, and the in-form LETTY DE BEYLEV (8), can also make their presence felt at this level.

C7 - PRIX ALPHA SALTOR - 2850m (a2m) - - Mounted - EUR € 35,000

1. M.T.RAMOS - Finished 4th in a Class E at Pornichet over 2,725m on 19 September, 3 weeks after coming 4th over track and trip. Is unlikely to spring any surprises but should nevertheless hold his own

2. VASTERBO IMTHEMAN - Ran 6th in a Class A at Argentan over 2,875m on 23 September. Has struggled since returning to competition last month and will first need to reassure

3. RED HOT ROADSTER - Left a good impression at Vincennes last week when 4th in a 2700m Class D, just his second appearance under the saddle. Mathieu Mottier stays faithful and must be afforded respect

4. HELLO DE LIGNY - Has ample ability but has been disqualified in last three starts and, even going barefoot this time, will struggle to make his mark

5. CAMERON - Runner-up in a Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 22 September. Is plainly close to his race and, sporting 4 pads for the first time, with Alexandre Abrivard in the bike, should not disappoint

6. JUNIOR BERDIERE - Third in a Class D over course and distance on 28 August. Seldom gets his nose in front but has a lot going for him here and could well bring home the bacon this time

7. HERAKLION DESBOIS - Has yet to display any aptitude for the monte code and his latest performance did nothing to inspire confidence

8. JAZZY THOURJAN - Runner-up in a Class E at Brehal over 2,850m on 27 July. Sports pads for re-entry but is not a concern this time around

9. JOSELITO DU VIVIER - Did not enjoy the best of trips when 5th in a Class D under these conditions 3 weeks ago. Is a tough nut to crack when at his peak and Adrien Lamy can be justifiably confident of a good performance

10. STACCATO HL - Third in a Class C at Enghien over 2,250m on 2 August, a fortnight before imposing over 1900m at Mariendorf. Has form with his jockey and winning this is well within his capability

Summary: JUNIOR BERDIERE (6), who caught the eye on his latest start here, has a good opportunity to return to the winners' enclosure. STACCATO HL (10) tends to like a shorter trip but he will be partnered by Benjamin Rochard who will afford him every chance. Even though less-performant this summer, JOSELITO DU VIVIER (9) has more than enough class to produce the goods in this category. RED HOT ROADSTER (3) left a good impression at Vincennes last week and could pleasantly surprise.

C8 - PRIX GALA TEJY - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 27,000

1. **JAYA DU QUENNE** - Makes first appearance since being disqualified in an Enghien monte Class E in mid-July and will have other priorities
2. **KASSIOPEIA** - Sent for a brief spell after running sixth in a Class F at Rochefort-sur-Loire on 3 August. Comes here fresh, is clearly in race-mode, and should not be underestimated
3. **KISMET** - Finished runner-up in two before being disqualified in an Angers Class E three weeks ago. Is patently in excellent shape but races shod this time and can be passed over
4. **KOQUERY DU BUISSON** - Fourth in a Class E at Mauquenchy over 2,150m on 10 September, his first start since coming 5th under these conditions on 3 June. Is barefoot on this occasion but looks a minor place chance at best
5. **KANNABIS JELOCA** - Made it five on the trot when successful in a Class F Amateurs' race at Craon over 2,775m on 7 September. Takes on a better bunch this time but still looks the pick of the field
6. **JINA FOUTEAU** - Finished 6th, on comeback, in a Class E at Angers over 3,125m on 9 September. Sports 4 pads for the first time but in this company will have too much to do
7. **KETBERNY** - Third in a Class E at Angers over 3,125m on 9 September. Barring a Vincennes clinker has not put a foot wrong for some time and is reunited with Benjamin Rochard for whom he excels. Chance
8. **KYNTÉ FLUSH** - Has shown improvement lately, most recently third in a 2100m Vincennes Class B 2.5 weeks ago, and even though in superior company will generate some interest
9. **KER POULGWEN** - Won over course and distance in July before confirming 11 days later at Pornichet. Ran 4th in a Class F at Rochefort Sur Loire over 3,000m on 3 August. Unseen sense but is competitively-shod for comeback and must be respected
10. **KRAKEN CASTELETS** - Made up for Agon disqualification when second in a Rambouillet Class D 10 days ago. Has never failed to fire at Laval but on this occasion appears to be out of his depth
11. **KING D'HERMES** - Runner-up in a Class E at Angers over 3,125m on 9 September. Has been knocking at the door since early-summer, has previously won here, and Matthieu Abrivard would not be running him if there were not a realistic chance of success
12. **KINASSE DE VIVOIN** - Fourth in a Class B at Vincennes over 2,100m on 12 September, 3 weeks after imposing on turf. Seldom disappoints with Adrien Lamy and is not about to begin now
13. **KILOU D'YMER** - Finished 6th in a monte Class D at Vincennes over 2,700m on 12 September. Is here for a change of scenery and unlikely to influence the result
14. **KALMIO DE LOU** - Was going well when eliminated in a Class A at Montier-en-Der on 23 August. Faces a different task this time, but should appreciate the new conditions and, with application, can get in on the action

Summary: KANNABIS JELOCA (5) has been enjoying another exceptional season, with eight wins from ten starts, and still seems to have more to offer. Good second at Angers three weeks ago, KING D'HERMES (11) should again play a leading role. Although his margin for error is now reduced, KETBERBNY (7) remains competitive. In good form and proven over this Laval track, KINASSE DE VIVOIN (12) can also make her presence felt.
