C1 - PRIX DE GIENS - 2650m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 6,000

1. **KLEPPER DU LOIR** - In good shape and was third in a Class G at Hyeres over this track and trip on 19 July. can be competitive once again
2. **HISPANO DU REYNARD** - Disqualified in a Class G at Marseille-Borely over 2,300m on 10 June. Unreliable by might pop up in a minor place
3. **JAPON DAIRPET** - Finished 6th in a Class G over this course and distance on 19 July. Capable of better and is not out of it
4. **JOLIE COSTARDIERE** - Remains in very good shape and was runner-up in a Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 25 July. Should be right there at the finish yet again
5. **IVANHOE RENKA** - Unplaced in a Class G over this track and trip on 19 July. Has yet to win a race and others make much more appeal
6. **KAYAK** - In good form and finished fourth in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 27. Can win a race of this nature
7. **JEFFREY** - Unplaced in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 22 July. Off form and needs to find a few lengths to score
8. **JEWEL DE MIRE** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in Class H at Avignon over this distance on 26 July. Others are preferred
9. **KOCKTAIL** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in a Class H at Avignon over 2,675m on 26 July. Yet to win a race and others make more appeal
10. **JORDANA** - Finished fifth in a Class G over this course and distance on 19 July. Has some fair form and has a place chance
11. **JUMPER** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 25 July. Might play a minor role at very best
12. **KRAKATOA BAR** - Disqualified in a Class E at this track over 2,850m on 26 June. Not reliable but is capable of amking the frame

Summary: The vote may lie between Kayak (6), who has struck up an excellent partnership with Virginie Boudier-Cormy, and Jolie Costardiere (4), whose only concern is yet another change of rider. Klepper du Loir (1) and Japon Dairpet (3) both ran with credit behind the selection here on 19 July and look solid place contenders once more, while from the second line.

C2 - PRIX DE TOULON METROPOLE VAR HANDBALL - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **NATURE ET BEAUTE** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a Class F at this course over 2650m on 19 July. Might play a minor role.
2. **NEW ACE GIRL** - Disqualified four times in her last five starts, including last time out in a Class E at Aix-les-Bains over 2700m on 26 July. Hard to trust and others are preferred.
3. **NEVADA DARBY** - Unreliable but did finish fourth in a Class D at this course over 2650m on 5 July. Can be competitive once again
4. **NIKITA GALAA** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, including last time out in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 17 July. Can bounce back to score if smart
5. **NISSA STAR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 17 July. Capable of better but others are preferred
6. **NOTRE DAME** - In good shape and was third in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 17 July. Can get involved in the finish once again
7. **NEW YORK YANKEES** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class B at Marseille-Vivaux over 2675m on 26 June. Not easy to trust but is quite capable of scoring
8. **NASHAAB** - Has done little wrong so far and was runner-up in a Class B at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 27 July. Can go one place better
9. **NIMITZ D'HERIPRE** - Did not show his best when sixth in a Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 13 July. Capable of doing better and has a place chance

Summary: NOTRE DAME (6) shaped better than the bare result last time at Cagnes-sur-Mer and, with a smoother passage, looks the one to beat. NEVADA DARBY (3) made a very encouraging local debut and could prove the main threat if building on that effort. Despite their handicap, NEW YORK YANKEES (7), provided he stays focused, and the dependable NASHAAB (8) both have the class to feature prominently in what looks a competitive contest.

C3 - PRIX DE LA CRAU - 2850m (a2m) - Class G - Mounted - EUR € 18,500

1. LORCA DAIRPET - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in Class G at this course over 2650m on 19 July. Yet to win a race and others are preferred

2. MILOU DE CAZOULENE - In good form and was third in a Class E harness race at this course over 2,650m on 19 July. Tries a mounted race and is not out of it

3. MICKEY MICHETTUDE - Disqualified last time out in a Class E harness race at this course over 2650m on 12 July. Can be a threat returning to a mounted race

4. MOON TURGOT - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class E harness race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 17 July. Needs to do more to score

5. KHEOPS DU PERRON - Finished 6th in a Class F mounted race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 22 July. Needs to do a bit more to score

6. KRAKITO BELLO - Disqualified last time out in a Class F mounted race at Biarritz over 2950m on 18 July. Capable of contesting the finish when smart

7. LIBERTIN MAZA - Outclassed the opposition in a Class E harness race over this track and trip on 19 July. Can follow up under the saddle this time

8. MONACO - Returned to form and finished 3rd in a Class C mounted race at Enghien over 2,250m on 18 July. Can score this time around

Summary: MONACO (8) caught the eye with a promising reappearance at Enghien and is taken to build on that effort, though LIBERTIN MAZA (7), back in this sphere with Quentin Seguin aboard, rates a serious danger. MICKEY MICHETTUDE (3) is well placed on the front line and could prove hard to peg back if getting into a rhythm. KRAKITO BELLO (6) has the talent to get involved provided he stays focused throughout.

C4 - PRIX DU CLOS COQUET - 2650m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 43,000

1. **GRAND TRIO LUDOIS** - Finished 10th in a Class A at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 6 July 2026. Remains barefoot but has struggled of late and others are preferred
2. **GUERRIER CASTELETS** - Finished 5th in a Class B at Enghien over 2,875m on 22 July 2026. Reverts to barefoot and has some fair form. Could earn some money
3. **INDY ROCK** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Group 2 at Vichy over 2,950m on 30 June 2026. Remains barefoot and can be a threat when smart
4. **FOSTER WOOD** - Unplaced in a Class B at Vincennes over 2,850m on 6 June. Reverts to barefoot and could contest the finish
5. **HARRY CARISAIE** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class B at Biarritz over 2,950m on 25 July 2026. Remains barefoot but might need to do more to beat these rivals
6. **FRILOUZ DE KERNAS** - Unreliable and was unplaced in a Class B over this track and trip on 16 June 2026. Remains barefoot but others make more appeal
7. **HERALDIQUE** - Successful twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class B over this track and trip on 5 July. Remains barefoot and can score again
8. **FEMTO DE VAUVERT** - Has only been modest on late and finished 6th in a Class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 13 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
9. **ASTRONASCENTE ZAC** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a Group 3 at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 27 July. Remains barefoot and could make the frame
10. **COOL KRONOS** - Finished 8th in a Class C at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 20 July 2026. Remains barefoot and has a place chance on best form
11. **GAVROCHE DE L'ITON** - In good form and finished third in a Class A at Aix Les Bains over 2,700m on 26 July 2026. Remains barefoot and can be a lively danger yet again
12. **HYDROMEL** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a Class C over this course and distance on 19 July. Can go one place better

Summary: HERALDIQUE (7) arrives in peak condition after an authoritative success here and looks the one they all have to beat if reproducing that effort. INDY ROCK (3) has the talent to pose a serious threat provided he remains focused, while course specialist FOSTER WOOD (4) is sure to make his presence felt. ASTRONASCENTE ZAC (9), admirably consistent, adds further depth and should once again be thereabouts in a competitive renewal.

C5 - PRIX DE BORMES LES MIMOSAS - 2650m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- 1. JAMES BOND** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,700m on 22 July 2026. Remains barefoot and can fight out the finish once again
- 2. ISLA** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 20 July. More is needed to score
- 3. ICARIOS GEMINI** - Disqualified in a class F at Biarritz over 2950m on 25 July. Remains barefoot and is capable of playing a minor role at very best
- 4. JET DU RAVARY** - Disqualified last time out in a Class F at this course over 2,850m on 5 July 2026. Remains barefoot and is capable of scoring when in the right mood
- 5. INDESKAYA BIRD** - Has struggled of late, finishing 7th in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,700m on 17 July 2026. Reverts to barefoot and could make the frame
- 6. HARMONICA** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class H at Avignon over 2,650m on 21 June. More is needed to score
- 7. IZZIE PONCELET** - Was only 8th in a Class G at Marseille-Borely over 3,000m on 19 June. Capable of doing better and can win a race of this nature
- 8. IDOCTRO DE HOUELLE** - Unreliable of late, finishing 7th in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,700m on 22 July 2026. Remains barefoot and has won three times this year. Can score again
- 9. JAGUAR ATOUT** - Finished 5th in a Class F at Avignon over 2,675m on 4 July. Remains barefoot but might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 10. ITYA DE BOSSENS** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class F at Saint-Galmier over 2,650m on 21 July. Not reliable but can double up if smart again
- 11. JUAN LES PINS** - Very consistent and was third in a Class F over this track and trip on 5 July 2026. Remains barefoot and will be competitive once again
- 12. JALISCO DE NEUVY** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, the latest in a Class E at Villereal over 2450m on 24 July. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 13. IBRA DE LOU** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,700m on 22 July 2026. Remains barefoot and has a place chance
- 14. INGENIOUS BOND** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a Class F over this track and trip on 5 July. Has major disqualification issues but can make the frame when smart
- 15. JOLIE MOME CHIC** - Off form and finished 7th in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 10 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: IZZIE PONCELET (7) is ideally configured and, with Théo Briand in the sulky, looks poised to strike. However, the younger legs of JAMES BOND (1), who has rediscovered his form, and the dependable JUAN LES PINS (11) could make life difficult. IDOCTRO DE HOUELLE (8) is better than his latest effort suggests and is worth another look in what shapes as a competitive affair.

C6 - PRIX DE LA LONDE LES MAURES - 2850m (a2m) - - Harness - EUR € 20,000

- 1. JUNINHO SPORT** - Disqualified in his last three starts, including last time out in a class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 25 July. Reverts to barefoot but others are preferred
- 2. KINGSTON SPORT** - Finished third in a class G at Hyeres 2850m on 12 July. In good form and could earn some more minor money
- 3. KID BLACK** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class F at Carpentras over 2,650m on 14 July 2026. Reverts to barefoot and should fight it out
- 4. KEY OF MEMORIES** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class E over this course and distance on 26 June. Remains barefoot and can make the frame
- 5. KRISTAL DES MOYEUX** - Has struggled of late, finishing 7th in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 27 July. Needs to do more to score
- 6. JESSAMINA** - Unplaced in a Class G at this course over 2,650m on 19 July 2026. Reverts to barefoot but is battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 7. KLASSIC DE SYVA** - Finished 4th in a Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 25 July. Hs improved of late and has a place chance
- 8. JUNON DU VASSET** - Consistent and finished 4th in a Class D over this track and trip on 5 June 2026. Remains barefoot and can have a winning turn
- 9. KEONA DELALANDE** - Disqualified in a Class F Apprentices' race at this course over 2,650m on 5 July. Remains barefoot and can be a threat if smart
- 10. KENAVO DU BOUILLON** - Made short work of rivals in a Class G at this course over 2,650m on 12 July. Cannont be ruled out from more success
- 11. KERNEL DE NUIT** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 25 July. Others make more appeal

Summary: A very interesting looking race. Stable strength could prove decisive, with the Roubaud team holding a strong hand through KEY OF MEMORIES (4) and JUNON DU VASSET (8). However, the Tomaselli camp is equally well equipped, with KID BLACK (3) and KLASSIC DE SYVA (7) both capable of making a big impact, setting up what looks a fascinating clash between two powerful yards. KEY MEMORIES(4) is also capable of gettinto the mix of things.

C7 - PRIX DU PRADET - 2850m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

1. **LUPIN DOUZOU** - Unplaced in a Class F at this course over 2,650m on 12 July. Reverts to barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
2. **LOVE D'URZY** - Finished 7th in a G at this course over 2650m on 19 July. Unreliable but might play a minor role at very best
3. **LEONITO STAR** - Finished 6th in a Class H at Avignon over 2,650m on 26 July. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
4. **KISS ME AIMEF** - Finished 7th in a G over this course and distance on 12 July. Reverts to barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
5. **KRISTIANO BELLO** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,150m on 10 July. Unreliable but is clearly not out of it
6. **KENT SOYER** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class G over this course and distance on 12 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
7. **L'ECU DALAMEDA** - Showed soem improvement when runner-up in a cCass F at this course over 2650m on 12 July. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
8. **LORD DE BAGI** - Unplaced last time out in a Class F at this course over 2,650m on 12 July. Did score before that but was barefoot that day. Others make more appeal
9. **LADY BLACK ROCHEL** - In very good form and finished third in Class E over this track and trip on 19 July. Can get involved with the finish once again
10. **LUGANO** - Finished 10th in a Class F at Aix Les Bains over 2,000m on 26 July. Remains barefoot but is off form and others are preferred
11. **LE POULIGUEN** - Disqualified last time out in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 15 July. Not easy to trust but can contest the finish when smart
12. **LEE ROCK BOND** - Made short work of rivals in a Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,700m on 15 July. Remains barefoot and could double up

Summary: LEE ROCK BOND (12) impressed when scoring on his debut for Théo Briand and, despite the second-row draw, is taken to confirm that promise with another bold showing. LADY BLACK ROCHEL (9) has been knocking on the door and rates a serious danger if things fall her way. KRISTIANO BELLO (5), a newcomer on the front line, is well positioned to mount a strong challenge. LE POULIGUEN (11) is worth forgiving his latest effort and could easily bounce back into contention.

C8 - PRIX DE CARQUEIRANNE - 2650m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 17,500

1. **MAGICIEN D'OZ** - Disqualified in a Class E over this track and trip on 19 July. Not easy to trust and needs improvement to score
2. **MODELE** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Class E at Montier-en-Der over 3025m on 18 July. Remains barefoot and can complete the hat-trick
3. **MONUMENTAL** - Returned to form and was a runner-up in a Class F at Feurs over 2100m on 17 July. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
4. **MISTER SALTOR** - Has some fair for and finished fifth in a Class F at Feurs over 2,100m on 17 July. Might play a minor role at very best
5. **MONTPELLIER** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Class E at Carpentras over 2650m on 14 July. Needs to do more to score
6. **MONA CROWN** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2,925m on 22 July. Should be very competitive once again
7. **MONEY SIXTY ONE** - Disqualified in a Class E at Avignon over 2650m on 26 July, Remains barefoot but more is needed to beat these rivals
8. **MAPPA DA VINCI** - Not reliable but finished 4th in a Class E over this track and trip on 19 July 2026. Remains barefoot and can make the frame once again
9. **MOON STRYCK** - Disqualified in both starts, the latest in a Class H at Avignon over 2,650m on 4 July. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
10. **MA BELLE AVENTURE** - Finished fifth in a Class F at Graignes over 2,725m on 22 May 2026. Returns from a short break and could need this run
11. **MUTINE DU LUDE** - Finished 7th in a Class E over this track and trip on 19 July 2026. Reverts to barefoot and could surprise
12. **MILADY D'AS** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 15 July. Remains barefoot and can earn some money when staying in stride
13. **MENTION D'HERMES** - Disqualified in a Class F at Feurs over 2100m on 17 July. Remains barefoot and can pop up in a place when in the right mood
14. **MAGIC OHEM** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a Class E over this track and trip on 19 July. Not easy to trust and others are preferred

Summary: A tricky lucky last race. MODELE (2) has been thriving on turf and, with conditions unlikely to pose an issue, he's fancied to bring up a quick-fire hat-trick. MONA CROWN (6) shaped well behind a useful sort last time and rates a big danger if building on that effort. MONUMENTAL (3), preferred by David Békaert, is another to note of. MAPPA DA VINCI (8) is very much at home under these conditions and enters calculations as well.
